Romans 8:35**Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:37-39*

## REESIE'S RECIPES



### Oriental Coleslaw by Cathy Hardison

#### Ingredients

**Cabbage/coleslaw mix**  
1 lb bag of coleslaw mix

Keep coleslaw mix refrigerated until topping and dressing are ready to combine.

#### Crunchy Topping

1 pkg. Ramen noodles (chicken flavor)  
1/2 cup slivered almonds  
3 tbsp. sesame seed  
4 tbsp. butter

Crush noodles in package, reserve seasoning packet for dressing. Brown noodles, almonds, and sesame seed in butter, let cool.

#### Dressing

2/3 cup light oil (sunflower)  
2 tbsp. rice vinegar  
4 tbsp. sugar  
6 green onions, thinly sliced  
1/2 tsp. salt  
1 tsp. pepper  
Ramen seasoning packet

Combine all dressing ingredients in a jar and shake vigorously. When ready to serve, combine coleslaw mix, crunchy topping and dressing.

### Banana Pudding by Diane Dearing

#### Ingredients

2 small boxes instant vanilla pudding  
2 cups milk  
8 oz. sour cream  
Large container of cool whip  
Vanilla wafers  
bananas

Mix pudding and milk, add sour cream and cool whip. Begin layering: vanilla wafers, pudding mixture and bananas. Top with crushed vanilla wafers.

### Beef Roast by Annette Hinton

#### Ingredients

3 lb. sirloin tip roast  
3 cans golden mushroom soup  
1 stick butter

Preheat oven to 325. Brown roast in 1 stick of butter. Brown well, take your time. Place in roasting pan. Mix mushroom soup with 1 1/2 cans of water. Pour soup over roast and cover with lid. Bake until tender, this will vary depending on cut of meat.

### Potato Salad by Beck Case

#### Ingredients

5 lb. potatoes  
4 boiled eggs  
1 small onion  
1 tbsp. mustard  
3/4 cup thousand island dressing  
3/4 cup miracle whip salad dressing  
4 tbsp sweet pickle relish  
2 tbsp poppy seed dressing  
Salt & pepper

Wash potatoes then boil with skin on until fork slides through potato easily. Cool and peel. Chop eggs and onion. Add all ingredients to potatoes and mix well. Salt and pepper to taste. Refrigerate 1 hour before serving

### Moonlite Corn Muffins by Patricia Case

2 eggs  
1 1/2 cups milk  
1 1/2 cups buttermilk  
1/2 cup oil  
1/2 cup melted butter  
3 tbsp. sugar  
1/2 cup self rising flour  
3 cups self rising corn meal

Beat eggs in large mixer bowl. Add milk, buttermilk, oil and melted butter: mix. Add sugar, flour and cornmeal: mix well. Pour into greased muffin tins. Bake at 500 degrees for 10 minutes.

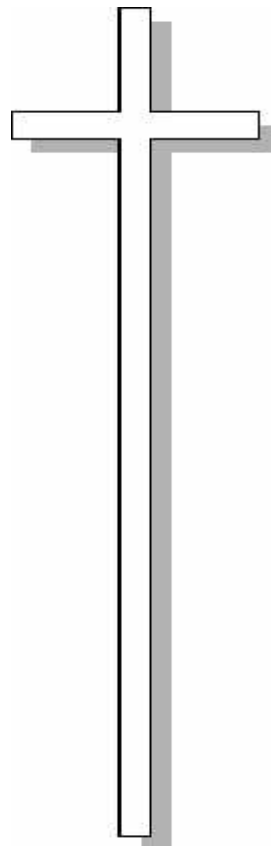
