
THE OLD CANE-BOTTOMED CHAIR

"How To Have Revival When Your Wood Is Wet"

1st Kings 18:19-24, 27-30, 36-39

Now therefore send, and gather to me all Israel unto mount Carmel, and the prophets of Baal four hundred and fifty, and the prophets of the groves four hundred, which eat at Jezebel's table. 20 So Ahab sent unto all the children of Israel, and gathered the prophets together unto mount Carmel. ²¹And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word. ²² Then said Elijah unto the people, I, even I only, remain a prophet of the LORD; but Baal's prophets are four hundred and fifty men. 23 Let them therefore give us two bullocks; and let them choose one bullock for themselves, and cut it in pieces, and lay it on wood, and put no fire under: and I will dress the other bullock, and lay it on wood, and put no fire under: ²⁴And call ye on the name of your gods, and I will call on the name of the LORD: and the God that answereth by fire, let him be God. And all the people answered and said, It is well spoken. ²⁷And it came to pass at noon, that Elijah mocked them, and said, Cry aloud: for he is a god; either he is talking, or he is pursuing, or he is in a journey, or peradventure he sleepeth, and must be awaked. ²⁸And they cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the blood gushed out upon them. ²⁹And it came to pass, when midday was past, and they prophesied until the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that there was neither voice, nor any to answer, nor any that regarded. 30 And Elijah said unto all the people, Come near unto me. And all the people came near unto him. And he repaired the altar of the LORD that was broken down. ³⁶And it came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be known this day that thou art God in Israel, and that I am thy servant, and that I have done all these things at thy word. ³⁷Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that thou art the LORD God, and that thou hast turned their heart back again. ³⁸Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. 39 And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, he is the God; the LORD, he is the God.

2nd Chronicles 7:14 - If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

What is revival? Revival is not the fire falling. Revival is the result of preparation made by broken and contrite hearts that causes God to respond and send the fire. Revival is changed hearts and minds. God has chosen fire to be a symbol of His Presence. Fire destroys and fire refines. Fire led the children of Israel in the wilderness. Here fire consumes the sacrifice. When we desire revival then we desire for the fire to fall. Elijah called for a showdown with the religious order of the day. Elijah was driven with a passion to see his nation return to God and the contest on Mount Carmel is a biblical example for true Holy Ghost Revival. Step 1 - Prayer. The first is prayer, not the kind of prayer we often hear, but prayer that brought the people to their need. He prayed that it would not rain. The drought was to prepare the people to repent and to awaken their sleeping conscience through the door of human need. He prayed "earnestly". Sometimes God has to get our attention in the natural world in order for us to listen in the spiritual world. Step 2 - Choose whom you will serve. There is no middle ground. Either Jesus or Satan. 1st Kings 18:21 - And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt ye between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word. Step 3 - Repair the altar. Elijah repaired the broken altar. 1st Kings 18:30 - And Elijah said unto all the people, Come near unto me. And all the people came near unto him. And he repaired the altar of the LORD that was broken down. Altars symbolize prayer, fellowship with God, dying to self, and yielding to the will of God. The fact that the altar was in a state of disrepair was a powerful symbol of just how far the people were from God. Step 4 - Remember. Elijah reminded them of who they were prophetically supposed to be. 1st Kings 18:31 - And Elijah took twelve stones, according to the number of the tribes of the sons of Jacob, unto whom the word of the LORD came, saying, Israel shall be thy name: Step 5 - Prepare for a sacrifice. Elijah arranged the wood and the sacrifice. 1st Kings 18:33 - And he put the wood in order, and cut the bullock in pieces, and laid him on the wood, and said, Fill four barrels with water, and pour it on the burnt sacrifice, and on the wood. Understand that revival comes from God but you and I have our part to do. We have to prepare the altar. Where there is no altar there will be no fire. Preparation is not an option. It is essential. Step 6 -Make it where God is the only one who can do it. Elijah drenched the altar with water. He made it impossible for a fire to light except it be God who did it. Nothing was going to happen except what God made happen. Water, in the Bible, is symbolic of the cleansing Word of God. Revival will not come without foundations built by God and a sacrifice drenched with the Word of God, no matter how difficult. We want the fire to fall. Step 7 - Watch God act. The fire came down. 1st Kings 18:38 - Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. Step 8 - Follow through. Sin was removed from the camp. 1st Kings 18:40 - And Elijah said unto them, Take the prophets of Baal; let not one of them escape. And they took them: and Elijah brought them down to the brook Kishon, and slew them there. There was a dramatic result. The people forsook their sin. When revival falls upon us we will forsake sin too. All that Satan had built up was pulled down through one man who was committed to God. God has a destiny that he wants you to fulfill, but that destiny requires that you: 1. Leave the middle ground. Take a stand for Jesus. Confront the enemy. 2. Repair your broken altar. Make prayer and worship a priority in your life. Prepare your life for sacrifice. 3. Call upon God today. 4. Turn from sin. Repent of every known sin in your life. 5. Follow through so that the sin will not return again.



REESIE'S RECIPES



Peppermint Patti Pie

8 large York peppermint patties, broken into quarters 1/4 cup milk 1(8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed 1 Keebler chocolate wafer pie crust

Place peppermint patties in a microwave-safe bowl and add milk. Microwave on HIGH for 30-45 seconds. Stir until candy is melted and mixture is smooth. Cool 5 minutes. Fold in whipped topping. Spread into crust. Cover and place in freezer for at least an hour.

Bubble Pizza 1 pound ground beef

1/4 pound sliced pepperoni sausage

1 (14 ounce) can pizza sauce
2 (12 ounce) packages refrigerated buttermilk
biscuit dough
1/2 onion, sliced and separated into rings
1 (10 ounce) can sliced black olives
1 (4.5 ounce) can sliced mushrooms
1 1/2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese
1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Grease a 9x13 inch baking dish. Place ground beef in a large, deep skillet. Cook over medium high heat until evenly brown. Stir in pepperoni, and cook until browned. Drain excess fat. Stir in pizza sauce. Remove from heat, and set aside. Cut biscuits into quarters, and place in the bottom of baking dish. Spread meat mixture evenly over the biscuits. Sprinkle top with onion, olives and mushrooms. Bake uncovered in preheated oven for 20 to 25 minutes. Sprinkle top with mozzarella and Cheddar cheese. Bake an additional 5 to 10 minutes, until cheese is melted. Let stand 10 minutes before serving.

Coconut Candy Bar Cake

14 squares Semi-Sweet Chocolate, divided
1/2 cup butter or margarine
1 cup sugar
2 eggs
1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla
1 2/3 cups flour, divided
3/4 teaspoon baking soda
1/8 teaspoon salt
1 cup water
1 (14 ounce) package flake Coconut

1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
3/4 cup whipping cream

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place 4 of the choco-

late squares and 1/2 cup butter in large microwaveable bowl. Microwave 1 to 1-1/2 min. or until butter is melted. Stir until chocolate is completely melted. Blend in sugar. Add eggs, 1 at a time, beating on low speed after each addition until well blended. Add vanilla; mix well. Add 1/3 cup of the flour, the baking soda and salt; beat well. Add remaining 1-1/3 cups flour alternately with the water, mixing until well blended. Pour into greased and floured 13x9-inch baking pan. Bake 30 min. or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool completely in pan on wire rack. Mix coconut and sweetened condensed milk until well blended; spread over cake. Microwave whipping cream and 2 Tbsp. butter in large microwaveable bowl 2 min.; stir. Microwave an additional 30 sec. or until mixture comes to boil. Add remaining 10 chocolate squares; stir until chocolate is completely melted. Cool until mixture is of desired spreading consistency, stirring frequently. Spread over cake. Let stand until chocolate layer is firm.

Cheesy Corn Casserole

1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened
6 tablespoons butter, softened
1 (15.25 ounce) can whole kernel corn, drained
2 teaspoons chopped fresh chives
1/2 teaspoon onion salt

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Grease a small baking dish. Blend together the cream cheese and butter in a mixing bowl. Gently fold in the corn, chives, and onion salt, and turn the mixture into the prepared baking dish. Bake in the preheated oven, uncovered, until heated through and bubbly, about 40 minutes. Stir the casserole after the first 20 minutes. Top with shredded cheddar cheese.



then Nahash the Ammonite came up, and encamped against Jabesh-Gilead: and all the men of Jabesh said unto Nahash, Make a covenant with us, and we will serve you. And Nahash the Ammonite answered them, On this condition will I make a covenant with you, that I may thrust out all your right eyes, and lay it for a reproach upon all Israel (I Sam. 11:1–2).

We find here that Saul began well, but he did not conclude that way. I Samuel 12:12 states that it was anxiety because of the threatened Ammonite invasion that influenced the people to demand a king. Their conduct illustrates the unbelief and rebellion of man's heart. They would rather lean upon a king whom they could see, and who was mortal, than upon a King unseen and Almighty. When God did give them such a king as they desired, they despised him (I Sam. 10:27). When Satan, symbolized by Nahash the Ammonite, invaded Israel, the first reaction of God's People was to yield to the enemy, and, in fact, to serve him. Such characterizes far too many in the modern Church. They have made a covenant with Satan, which means they have compromised the Word of God, which means they have become slaves to the Evil One. Satan's demands are always more than one can afford to pay. There can be no covenant made with Satan, not in any form or fashion. As stated, the demands of the Evil One were harsh. He demanded that every fighting man in Israel put out his right eye. Why the right eye? The shield, as held by the soldier of those days, covered the body, the shoulders, and the face, except for the right eye. With his right eye, the soldier would look over the top of the shield, thereby seeing how to fight the enemy. If that eye is blinded, he could not see to fight; he was, therefore, rendered useless. This is why Nahash demanded the blindness of the right eye. If it is to be noticed, the modern Church accepts false doctrine readily, plus most anything else that Satan has to offer. The reason? It has made a covenant with the Evil One, and the price is the blindness of the right eye, spiritually speaking; now they cannot see what is right or what is wrong. As stated, no covenant can be made with Satan—not of any nature. And let it be understood: If we make anything the object of our faith other than Christ and His Cross, we are, in effect, whether we realize it or not, making a covenant with Satan.
