





One of my favorite and most admired men of faith is a man named George Mueller. George Mueller (1805-1898) did many great works for the Lord in his lifetime, among them building several orphanages. The following is a great story he tells: It was time for breakfast at one of my orphanages in England and there was no food. Not only was there no food in the kitchen, but there was no money in the home's account. A young girl whose father was a close friend of mine was visiting the home. I took her hand and said, "Come and see what our Father will do." In the dining room, long tables were set with empty plates and empty mugs. We sat down at the table with the others and I prayed, "Dear Father, we thank Thee for what Thou art going to give us to eat." At once, we heard a knock at the door. There stood the local baker. "Mr. Muller," he said, "I couldn't sleep last night. Somehow, I felt you had no bread for breakfast, so I got up at 2 o'clock this morning and baked you some fresh bread. Here it is." Muller thanked him and gave praise to God. Soon afterward, a second knock came. It was the milkman. His cart had broken down in front of the orphanage. There was no way to move and repair the cart except to empty it of the milk he needed to still deliver so he asked me if we could use his milk. We had a wonderful breakfast that morning. Faith was the pinnacle of George Muller's life. Without a personal salary, he relied only on God to supply the money and food he needed to support the hundreds of homeless children he befriended in the name of Messiah. A man of radiant faith, he kept a motto on his desk for many years that brought comfort, strength, and uplifting confidence to his heart. It read, 'It matters to Him about you.' Mueller believed that those words captured the meaning of 1 Peter 5:7, and he rested his claim for divine help on that truth. He testified at the end of his life that the Lord had never failed to supply all his needs. Remember that God is concerned with our every need! Cast your cares upon Him today.

## REESIE'S RECIPES



### Orange Pineapple Upside Down Cake

- 1/2 cup butter , at room temperature, plus  
3 tablespoons butter
- 1 (11 ounce) can mandarin orange sections
- 1 (8 ounce) can pineapple slices
- 1/3 cup firmly packed light brown sugar
- 2/3 cup granulated sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 1/3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/3 cup buttermilk

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place 3 T butter in a 9 inch round cake pan. Place pan in oven until butter is melted. Sprinkle with brown sugar. Drain oranges and pineapple slices on paper towels. Arrange in bottom of pan. In medium bowl, beat remaining 1/2 cup butter and sugar until creamy. Add eggs and vanilla. Stir in flour, baking powder and salt. Stir in buttermilk. Spread batter over fruit. Bake 35 to 40 minutes, or until cake tester inserted in center comes out clean. Let stand 5 minutes. Run a knife around edge of cake. Place a plate over cake and turn cake out onto plate.

### Backwoods Bonfire Bark

- 1 pound semisweet chocolate, chopped
- 1-1/2 cups honey bear-shaped crackers
- 1-1/2 cups miniature marshmallows
- 3/4 cup dry roasted peanuts

Place chocolate in a microwave-safe bowl. Microwave on high for 1 minute; stir. Microwave 1 minute longer in 20-second intervals until melted; stir until smooth.

Spread to 1/4-in. thickness on a waxed paper-lined baking sheet. Immediately sprinkle crackers, marshmallows and peanuts over chocolate; press in lightly.

Chill until firm. Break or cut into pieces..

### Upside Down Bacon Pancakes

- 6 bacon strips, coarsely chopped
- 1/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 cups complete buttermilk pancake mix
- 1-1/2 cups water
- Maple syrup and butter, optional

In a large ovenproof skillet, cook bacon over medium heat until crisp. Remove bacon to paper towels with a slotted spoon. Remove drippings, reserving 2 tablespoons. Return bacon to pan with reserved drippings; sprinkle with brown sugar. In a small bowl, combine pancake mix and water just until moistened. Pour into pan. Bake at 350° for 18-20 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before inverting onto a serving plate. Serve warm with maple syrup and butter if desired.

### Parmesan Potatoes Au Gratin

- 2 cups grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh thyme or  
1 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1 tablespoon grated lemon peel
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 2 pounds red potatoes, very thinly sliced
- 2-1/2 cups heavy whipping cream

Combine the first five ingredients. Layer a third of the potatoes and 2/3 cup cheese mixture in a greased 8-in. square baking dish; repeat layers. Top with remaining potatoes; pour cream over top. Sprinkle with remaining cheese mixture. Cover and bake at 325° for 65 minutes. Increase temperature to 375°. Uncover; bake 25-30 minutes longer or until potatoes are tender and top is golden brown. Let stand for 10 minutes before serving.




## Love

### Go Your Way, Tell His Disciples AND PETER



*And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him. But go your way, tell his disciples and Peter that he goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see him, as he said unto you. Mark 16:6*

Out of all four Gospels this would be the only one that would use these words "tell His disciples and Peter"...but as with all of scripture there was a purpose for letting us know that the angel said "and Peter". Why not just say go and tell His disciples? Well, you probably already know and are familiar with the fact that Peter had denied the Lord. Not just denied Him but did so three times! After Jesus had told him he would deny Him three times his reply to Jesus was that he would never do it...he even went so far as to tell Him that he would go with Him even to death! Can you imagine how Peter must have felt knowing that he had told Him all of that yet...denying Him in the way that he did? This man that he had walked with...this man that he had seen open blinded eyes...caused the deaf to hear and raise the dead!! Yes, this man that he called LORD...Peter found himself denying. The Bible tells in great detail the way the events took place. Peter followed when they took Jesus and as he sit outside the place where Jesus was being judged Peter was approached by more than one person who would ask or make the statement...you were with him! And to each one Peter would deny that he was with him...deny that he even knew the man...and at that moment when he had denied him the third time the Bible says in Luke 22:61-62 "And Peter said, Man, I know not what thou sayest. And immediately, while he yet spake, the cock crew. And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And Peter went out, and wept bitterly." I cannot even begin to imagine what Peter must have felt...there he was he had denied Jesus and through the open doors of the judgment hall he would look into the eyes of his Lord that he had just forsaken!! The Bible then says that Peter went out and "wept bitterly"...the word bitterly in the Greek there means "violently...a piercing violent cry". After that of course Jesus was lead as a lamb to the slaughter...crucified and placed in a borrowed tomb. And no doubt during that time Peter was about as low as one man could ever be...I would imagine that he cried and wept till there were no tears left...agonizing over what he had done. And then...on Resurrection morning the women come running from the tomb proclaiming to the disciples that JESUS HAD RISEN! And they didn't just stop there but they probably said something like...AND the angel said to tell you too Peter!!! I hope you are getting this...Peter being flesh no doubt would have felt not worthy to be mention with the rest of the men...after what he had done maybe even some of the men didn't think he should be mentioned with them BUT!! Oh can I say that again? BUT!!! Jesus would let him know through this messenger and through the testimony of the women...that he wasn't done with Peter yet!!! You may be reading this and maybe you have been thinking the same as Peter...you have failed and not just failed but feel as though you have failed terribly...you have wept until it seems there are no tears left to cry. You feel so unworthy...not only that but others have made you feel that way as well. Jesus has a message for you today...the same message he had for Peter...HE IS NOT THROUGH WITH YOU!! Peter would go on to become one of the greatest preachers of the Gospel that this world has ever known and I doubt very seriously that he ever forgot those words....just two words....AND PETER!! ### Our Passover

Why is Jesus Christ called our Passover? Have you ever thought about it? Even if you have let's take another look at it. Thanks be unto God the Father for His unspeakable gift, Jesus Christ (2 Cor 9:15), we are able to be freed from sins penalty. Of course we know the Passover lamb is symbolic, i.e., with Christ. The Passover lamb also foreshadowed Christ in other ways. It was to be "without blemish" or with no deformities (Ex 12:5)! This was symbolic of the spiritual purity of Jesus Christ, "who committed no sin, nor was deceit found in his mouth" (1 Peter 2:22). The Apostle Peter pointed out that we have been redeemed, or brought back by God not with material wealth, "but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Peter 1:19). Even some aspects of how the Passover lambs were to be killed were symbolic of Jesus' death. The Israelites were told not to break any of the lambs bones (Ex 12:46). Although a common practice in crucifixions was to break the legs of the suffering criminals to hasten death, Christ was already dead when the Roman soldiers came to break his legs, so they were not broken. Here scripture was being fulfilled, "Not one of his bones shall be broken" (John 19:36). These and many other scriptures help us understand the wonderful truth that, as the Lamb of God "Christ our Passover was sacrificed for us."

Now how can you pray that prayer and then go out and try to do your own thing? How can you pray that prayer and then sit and ball when something happens instead of seeking God's Will in it all? Hold on a minute - you're not going to like this - but it's the WORD FROM THE LORD. Listen now, Jesus said these WORDS:"As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent." Do you know when He said those WORDS? He was having the Apostle John write to the Church of Laodicea.
