Don't Be Fooled...Hell is Real part 01

People don't like to hear about hell. But I'm here to tell you that if Jesus is not your Lord and Savior, you are on your way to hell. Some of you will be upset at this bad news. You think that I'm all gloom and doom. Tell me this...if your house were on fire, would you want me to let you know? Of course you would. You'd probably thank me for telling you. Well, if you go to hell, you will be the one on fire--and your soul will be lost forever. Hell may not be a politically correct topic these days, but many people enter hell everyday. Out of the 120,000 people that die everyday, most end up in hell. Hell is a real place in spite of the fact that people laugh and say that they want to go there. They simply don't understand how horrible hell is. Just because you've never seen hell doesn't mean it doesn't exist. We have descriptions of what hell is like in God's word. Hell is dreadful--and if you don't believe in Jesus and obey him, you'd better get on the stick or else that's going to be your eternal destination. Satan, the god of this world, WILL NOT always cause havoc. His doom is already foretold, "And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever." (Revelation 20:10) Did you know that if you do not belong to Jesus Christ you belong to Satan? You don't have to be a card carrying Satanist to serve Satan. You don't have to be a murderer, drunkard or drug addict, either. All you have to do is ignore Jesus Christ. If you don't have Jesus today, you are deceived and hell bound--you are a child of hell, a child of the devil. How many times have I heard someone say, "A loving God wouldn't put his creatures in hell." Well I have news for you, friend, God is loving and he is not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance (II Peter 3:9). Hell is for the devil and his angels, and all the rebels that want to break God's laws on this earth-- Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, PREPARED FOR THE DEVIL AND HIS ANGELS. (Matthew 25:41) The devil is the god of this world (2 Corinthians 4:4)--men go to hell because they choose the devil's way and reject the Lord Jesus Christ. God is holy and will not allow any sin in his kingdom. As a result, when people die in their sins they are forever banished from the presence of God to hell and the lake of fire. They will go to a place of everlasting shame, contempt, and torment. Incidentally, Satan will not be ruling in the lake of fire. He will be condemned and tormented just like everybody else-- the devil...shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. (Revelation 20:10) Think about this...God, out of profound love for you--a vile sinner who has transgressed his commandments--sent his own beautiful, dear Son to this earth be sacrificed for YOUR sins! To save YOU! Jesus was not a sinner. He did not sin one time. He did not die for himself. HE DIED FOR YOU. To take your punishment and to save YOU. That is why he is called the Saviour. Because he SAVES from sin and hell! If you reject his sacrifice and trod it underfoot it should not be too hard for you to understand that the same God who sacrificed his perfect, beloved, only begotten Son for your soul will expeditiously cast your rebellious hind parts into hell and the lake of fire. NOTHING unclean will ever enter God's heaven--and all unregenerate people are unclean. I too was once dead in trespasses and sins, but one day, by God's grace, I turned my face to Jesus and got saved--I believed on his word, repented of my sins, and got washed in his blood--my life quickly began to change as I read God's word, the Bible, and started obeying it. You do not have to be tormented forever in the lake of fire, you can be saved too--that is what God wants for you. The Bible teaches that God hath no pleasure in the death of wicked. He sent his only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to be the propitiation and payment for your sins so that you can be whole and live forever. For God so loved the world, that he gave us his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life (John 3:16). God wants to save you and make you whole. Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool. (Isaiah 1:18) God does not want you in hell! Jesus came to save you from that horrible place! Get right with Jesus and you won't go there! Look at these scriptures: As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die... (Ezekiel 33:11) The Lord is...not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. (II Peter 3:9) The Bible teaches that God loves you so much that the Creator of this universe (Jesus Christ) came to "taste death" for every man. Jesus wasn't just some baby for a manger scene (we are not to make images and pictures of the Lord). He is God manifested in the flesh to save you from both the guilt and power of sin--he holds the keys, people! If you say yes to Jesus, hell won't be your final destination. If you say no to Jesus, the lake of fire will be your eternal home. There is no getting out and no comfort--it is everlasting. Regardless of whether you believe it or not, hell exists and the Bible says that it is never full. I've heard folks say that hell is not mentioned in the Bible or that hell is just the grave. Well, let's take a look at what the AUTHORIZED King James Version of the Bible says (we are not looking at the unauthorized bibles here like the NIV that deletes verses, we are looking at the truth--there is only one Authorized Version). Here are a few scriptures that deal with hell and the lake of fire (at the final judgment, hell, death and those not written in the book of life will be cast into the lake that burneth with fire and brimstone): Matthew 25:41 [Jesus speaking to people at the final judgment], ...Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels. Revelation 14:11, And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night... Revelation 20:12-20 - And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. Matthew 10:28, And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. Luke 12:5, But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which AFTER he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him. Matthew 25:46, And these shall go away into EVERLASTING punishment: but the righteous into life eternal. II Thessalonians 1:9 - Who shall be punished with EVERLASTING destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power. Jude 7, Sodom and Gomorrah...are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire. Matthew 22:13, ...Bind him hand and foot, and take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Matthew 13:41-42, The Son of man [Jesus] shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; and shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth....Please be sure and look for Part 2 of this powerful teaching in next months issue of The Trumpet. REESIE'S RECIPES

Elvis Cake

- 1 (18.25 ounce) package white cake mix
- 1 (8 ounce) can crushed pineapple with juice
 - 1 cup white sugar
- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese
 - 1/2 cup butter, softened
 - 4 cups confectioners' sugar
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
 - 1 cup chopped pecans

Prepare cake according to instructions on package. Bake in a 9x13 inch pan. Allow to cool. Make holes in cake with fork. Combine pineapple and sugar in saucepan. Bring to a boil. Spoon over cooled cake. In a large bowl, cream butter and cream cheese until smooth. Add powdered sugar and beat until smooth. Add vanilla. Add pecans and mix well. Spread cream cheese frosting over cake.

Fantastic Taco Casserole

- 1 lb ground beef
- 1 (1 1/4 ounce) package taco seasoning
- 1 (15 ounce) can refried beans
- 2 cups monterey jack cheese, divided (or mixed cheddar, jack etc.)
- 1 cup salsa
- 2 green onions, chopped
- 1 (2 1/3 ounce) can sliced black olives
- 1 tomato, chopped

2 cups corn chips (coarsely crushed or chopped)

Brown ground beef and drain. Add taco seasoning and cook according to package directions, adding proper amount of water. Put corn chips on bottom of 8x8" dish. Cook refried beans on stove until hot. Add 1 cup cheese and 1 cup salsa. Stir until combined. Pour beans over corn chips in dish. Add beef to top of beans. Sprinkle remaining cheese over top. Sprinkle green onions and black olives over cheese. Bake in a 375 degree oven until the cheese is sufficiently melted. Take out of oven and sprinkle chopped tomatoes on top.

Oreo Peanut Butter Cup Dessert

- 20 chocolate cream-filled chocolate sandwich cookies, divided
- 2 tablespoons butter, softened
- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- 1/2 cup peanut butter
- 1-1/2 cups confectioners' sugar, divided
- 1 carton (16 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed, divided
- 15 miniature peanut butter cups, chopped
- 1 cup cold milk
- 1 package (3.9 ounces) instant chocolate fudge pudding mix

Crush 16 cookies; toss with the butter. Press into an ungreased 9-in. square dish; set aside. In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese, peanut butter and 1 cup confectioners' sugar until smooth. Fold in half of the whipped topping. Spread over crust. Sprinkle with peanut butter cups. In another large bowl, beat the milk, pudding mix and remaining confectioners' sugar on low speed for 2 minutes. Let stand for 2 minutes or until soft-set. Fold in remaining whipped topping. Spread over peanut butter cups. Crush remaining cookies; sprinkle over the top. Cover and chill for at least 3 hours.

Potato Casserole

- 8 tablespoon (1 stick) butter
- 1 small bell pepper, sliced thin
- 1 small onion, sliced thin
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 2 cup mashed potatoes
- 1 1/2 cup grated Cheddar cheese
- 4 medium potatoes, cooked
- 6 slices of bacon, cooked crisp

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spread mashed potatoes evenly on bottom of casserole dish. Layer sour cream evenly over top. Saute onion and bell pepper in butter; evenly layer over top of sour cream. Next, layer with 1/2 cup Cheddar cheese. Slice potatoes and layer over cheese until top is completely covered with potatoes. Finally top with remaining 1 cup cheese. Bake for 25-30 minutes. Remove from oven and crumble bacon over top.

Sometime the morning of (February 27) I had a dream, a very serious dream that must have lasted for a long while. I awoke groaning in the spirit and was very troubled at what The Lord showed me. Why Do We Use The King James Version?

The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever. Psalms 12: 6-7

This is a subject that we have talked about many times before but in light of some recent comments that I have heard I felt lead to go in this direction once again. Ask yourself this question..."Does it really matter what version of Bible I read?" We believe it matters a great deal! We also believe that when you compare any of the modern day versions to the Original King James Version it is clear that ONLY the King James stands the test of time and can be proven to be the closest thing we have to THE Word of God. First let us look at a brief history of the KJV - In 1604, King James announced that fifty-four Hebrew and Greek scholars had been appointed to translate a new Bible for English speaking people. Rather than working together all at one location, these men were divided into six separate groups, which worked at three separate locations. Each group was given a selected portion of Scripture to translate. Each scholar made his own translation of the scripture, and then passed it on to be reviewed by each member of his group. The whole group then went over the scripture together. Once a group had completed a book of the Bible, they sent it to be reviewed by the other five groups in the same manner. All objectionable and questionable translating was marked and noted, and then it was returned to the original group for consideration. A special committee was formed by selecting one leader from each group. This committee worked out all of the remaining differences and when they believed that they had it as close to the original text as possible then presented a finished copy for the printers in 1611. This means that the King James Bible was gone over time and time again and had to pass several vigorous examinations before going to press. It is also important to note that all of the KJV translators were men of faith who treated scripture and their work with the highest regard and respect. The work was finished in 1611, seven years after it was commissioned by the King. Next I want to give you a little information concerning modern translations of scripture. There were two men who had a major influence on the modern day versions of scripture more so than any others. Brooke Foss Westcott (1825-1901) and Fenton John Anthony Hort (1828-1892) were two English "scholars" who produced the corrupt Greek text of the modern versions. Their dominating influence on the revision committee of 1871-1881 accounts for most of the corruption that we have today in those translations. Here are some important facts that we should look at concerning these two men. Unlike the King James translators these two men did not believe you should approach the text as being the Word of God but rather as just another book. With that in mind here are a few of their beliefs. Westcott was a firm believer in Mary worship, he did not believe in the Second Coming of Christ, the Millennium, or a literal Heaven. He also confessed that he was a communist by nature. Hort believed in keeping Roman Catholic sacraments, he believed in baptismal regeneration as taught in the Catholic church, and like Westcott he rejected the infallibility of Scripture. He also took great interest in the works of Charles Darwin, while both he and Westcott rejected the literal account of Creation. Both men rejected the doctrine of a literal Hell, and they supported prayers for the dead in purgatory. While working on their Greek text and while working on the Revision Committee for the Revised Version Westcott and Hort were also keeping company with "seducing spirits and doctrines of devils" (I Tim. 4:1). Both men took great interest in occult practices and clubs. They started the Ghostly Guild in 1851, and Hort joined a secret club called The Apostles in the same year. They also started the Eranus Club in 1872. These were groups which believed in such unscriptural practices as communicating with the dead. These are just a few of the facts about these two men that should concern anyone that is considering "trusting" their work as it pertains to the Word of God. The best selling version of all of these corrupt versions is the NIV...a version that has more than 60,000 less words than the King James Version. A version that scholars will tell you is "by far not the most accurate"...think about that for a moment. It's not the most accurate BUT it is the best selling? What a scary thought today. Someone told me recently that they didn't care what version they used...sadly many must feel the same way. Oh my friend but it does matter! The Bible says..."All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." 2 Timothy 3:16-17. If we truly believe this scripture we must also believe that if one takes away from scripture than you also take away part of the inspiration as well...you take away part of the instruction that helps us to "be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works." Jesus said "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away." Matthew 24:35. The Word of God is our guide, our foundation and forever settled in Heaven. And if we truly believe this than why wouldn't we want to stay with the closest thing we have to the original? In closing...David said in Psalms 119:105 "Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path."...if that lamp is dimmed or darkened how then shall we find our way?
