Another Gospel

But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. Galatians 1:8

This month we continue looking at the false doctrines and teachings of the Catholic church. Once again we will be taking the actual teachings from the Catholic Catechism which is the document laying out the doctrines of this church and comparing them to what the Word of God says.

"Mary Mother of God"? Part 2

The Catholic Catechism teaches the following..." the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son ... In giving birth you kept your virginity... You conceived the living God and, by your prayers, will deliver our souls from death". Again this shows the false teaching that Mary is somehow part of the plan of salvation and that somehow "her prayers" can deliver us. There is not one single scripture in the Word of God that even hints that this would be true. "Queen over all things"? "fully conformed to her son?" "her prayers will deliver our souls from death?" Absolutely none of these claims can be backed up with the Holy Scriptures...as a matter of fact they go against what the Scriptures teach! Jesus plainly told his disciples with no room for doubt that he is the ONLY WAY...the ONLY TRUTH...and the ONLY LIFE. And as for Mary's prayers for us....the Bible teaches in Hebrews 7:25 Wherefore he is able (Jesus) also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. None of the writers of the Bible ever spoke of Mary as deity. NONE of them. The Catholic Catechism goes on to teach "... Taken up to heaven she did not lay aside this saving office but by her manifold intercession continues to bring us gifts of eternal salvation. ... Therefore the Blessed Virgin is invoked in the Church under the titles of Advocate, Helper, Benefactress, and Mediatrix." None of this is Biblical. Not only does the Catholic Catechism teach that "Mary prays for us" BUT that we should also pray to Mary..."The Church's devotion to the Blessed Virgin is intrinsic to Christian worship." The Church rightly honours "the Blessed Virgin with special devotion. ..." The liturgical feasts dedicated to the Mother of God and Marian prayer, such as the rosary, an "epitome of the whole Gospel," express this devotion to the Virgin Mary." Once again there is no proof of this to be found in the Word of God. To teach that Mary is the "mother of God" and that prayers should be made to her while counting the beads of a Rosary is completely unbiblical. The Bible teaches from beginning to end that God the Father sent his Son Jesus to be the ultimate sacrifice and the ONLY WAY to Heaven. Jesus is... the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. John 1:29. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life: John 14:6. Jesus is the one mediator between God and men...1 Timothy 2:5. Jesus is the only name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. Acts 4:12. Mary was indeed blessed and highly favoured to be the vessel chosen to birth our Saviour. We are grateful for her obedience and sacrifice...that being said. Mary herself would have went to hell had it not been for the shed blood of Jesus on the cross of Calvary. The Bible does not teach that she is deity or has any power to answer prayer or to somehow save a sinner. For a religion or a church to teach such a thing is heresy and certainly NOT the Gospel of the Bible. Next month we will continue our series and take an even deeper look at the false teachings of the Catholic Church. In the upcoming articles we will be looking at their teaching on salvation through the church, baptism and works. Purgatory, hell, prayers for the dead and more. It is our prayer that this series will be enlightening and helpful to you. Until next time may the LORD keep you is our prayer.

It was enough for the woman found in adultery. It was enough for Saul the Christian killer. It was enough for Peter the cussing fisherman. It was enough for Zacheaus the I.R.S. man. It was enough for the wicked jailer. It is enough for the poorest man on the earth, The richest man, The most intelligent, The most simple minded, The most powerful, The most famous, And the most wicked, vile, person on death row. His Grace is enough for anybody that will come to Him in faith, believing. It's enough. I am so glad that God saves ole sinners. I'm thrilled and amazed that He sets them free, The biggest surprise in saving ole sinners, Is that He would save an ole sinner like me. It's because His Grace is enough. Don't give up on that lost loved one, His Grace is enough. Don't think He will give up on you, His Grace is enough. 2 - GRACE IS ENOUGH TO KEEP ALL THAT EVER WERE SAVED Jude 1:24 - Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, We have eternal salvation. Not because we deserve it or because we earned it, but because of God's Grace. I don't understand it, but I know His Grace is enough. We have everlasting Life. You can't wear it out, your sin can't wear it out, it's everlasting because of God's Grace. Jesus said in John 10:27-29 - My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: 28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. ROMANS 8:31-39 - What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? 32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. 35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Eternal means eternal Everlasting means everlasting Never perish means never perish Freely give means freely give God's Grace is enough to keep all that are saved. 3 - GRACE IS ENOUGH TO LIFT ANY MAN THAT IS FALLEN I wish we never failed. I wish all of us always did what pleased the Lord and there was never any reason to regret. I believe that it is the will of God that we do right and never fail, but we do fail, and Grace heaped upon Grace is enough to lift us from our failure. Hebrews 4:15-16 - For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need. In the story of the prodigal son we find that he started out a son, was a son even while we was away in sin, and ended up a son. How could that be? Grace heaped upon Grace. Grace made him a son, Grace kept him a son, and Grace lifted him up. It matters not how far you have fallen, Grace heaped upon Grace is enough to lift you up. Too many of us are like to older brother and want God's Grace to be selective. But thank God it's for ALL. It is enough to lift ANY that are fallen. Don't let the Devil keep you in the hog pen, come to the Father, He has Grace heaped upon Grace for you. It's enough, it's all you need. That fallen boy could never understand that new robe that was put over his sin ravaged body, but his father whispered, its Grace heaped upon Grace. He could never understand that ring that was put on his dirty finger, but his father whispered, its Grace heaped upon Grace. He could never understand the fatted calf and the party to welcome him home, but his father whispered, its Grace heaped upon Grace. What Can the Righteous Do?

Psalms 11:2-3 "For, lo, the wicked bend their bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the upright in heart. If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?"

What a day we live in. As Americans we see how the wicked have bent their bow to shoot their arrows at the upright in heart by attacking the foundations of the Church (the Body of Christ), the church (religious institutions), the Constitution (the law of the land that protects our freedoms, including our religious liberties), our society (particularly the family, which is the God-chosen building block of it), and the list goes on; we find that we live in an ever-present question mark. That ever-present question mark is also ever-changing in many aspects; yet it remains, at its simplest, the same: "What can the righteous do if these foundations be destroyed?" As usual, the answer is simple, though hardly ever easy. When we recognize that God is ever-present and never-changing; His desire, expectations, and commands for us remain the same; and we remember that the greatest commands to love the Lord our God with all that we are and our neighbor as ourselves haven't changed; we KNOW what the righteous are to do. We are to continue walking in the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit, regardless of what the enemy does. We are to continue growing in grace, being rooted and built up in Jesus. No matter how hard angry progressive thought assails against God's Word or His people, we are to continue living, walking, and talking in the way of holiness. The Left may destroy the foundations; but they cannot destroy what is right. God continues to say, "Be ye holy; for I am holy;" and He continues to make the paths of the righteous straight. That's simple, right? Although it's not so easy as we find ourselves facing our own fiery furnace or lion's den. But then again, how does one threaten a man with heaven? What can the righteous do? They can continue believing, proclaiming, and living the holy life to which they are called. They can recognize that the same God who brought Israel out of Egypt or pulled Peter out of prison or held the soul of the faithful who were sawn asunder is the same God we serve today. He is faithful and He will keep the righteous in life and in death. Remembering that all which assails us is Father-filtered, we recall the words of Spurgeon to mind, "A dauntless faith in God brushes fear aside like the cobwebs in a giant's path. No man can harm us unless the Lord permits. He who makes the devil himself to flee at a word, can certainly control the devil's agents. Maybe they are already more afraid of you than you are of them. Therefore, go forward, and where you looked to meet with foes you will find friends."

Strawberry Delight

1 large angel food cake

2 pkg. fresh strawberries

Pinch up cake in a 13x9" pan. In a separate bowl mix together cream cheese, cool whip and sugar. Add mixture to cake. Spread glaze and strawberries over the cake mixture. Chill.

2 apples, chopped
2 bananas, chopped

In a pan mix flour and sugar.While cooking add the juice from the can of pineapple. Add lemon juice. Add eggs. Cook until thick. Put the fruit in a bowl. Pour sauce over the fruit and top with cheese.

Sweet & Sour Pasta

1 lb. penne rigate pasta
1 1/2 cup sugar
1 cup apple cider vinegar
1/2 cup canola oil
2 Tbsp spicy mustard
1 Tbsp salt
1 Tbsp garlic powder
2 tsp pepper
1 Tbsp minced onion
1 medium cucumber, diced
1/2 green bell pepper, diced
1/2 red bell pepper, diced

Cook pasta until slightly tender. Drain. Mix remaining ingredients. Add pasta, refrigerate overnight. Stir occasionally to coat all pasta.

Vegetable Casserole

1 jar cheese whiz
2 small cans Veg-All
1 small onion, chopped
2 stalks celery, chopped
1 can cream of mushroom soup
1 sleeve Ritz crackers

Mix cheese, vegetables, onion, celery and soup. Pour into casserole dish and top with crushed crackers. Bake at 350 for 20 minutes. Brown top of crackers.

Hudson Taylor's Providential Career

The providences of God are marvelously displayed in the life of J. Hudson Taylor, who by prayer founded the China Inland Mission. Hudson Taylor said, "Prayer is sober, matter-of-fact transacting business for God." This is seen in Taylor's life in numerous cases; perhaps most strangely, however, in his call to be a missionary. J. Hudson Taylor's father was an evangelist, who felt a call to China; but he was unable to go. He and his wife dedicated their son, J. Hudson Taylor, to God before birth. When son Hudson

was born, the evangelist and his wife asked God to take this offering as a sacrifice in place of their not being able to go to China. Hudson Taylor was a strange, wild, unconverted young man; one day he went into his grandfather's library and picked up a tract entitled, The Finished Work of Christ. Hudson felt the stir of conviction as he read that little booklet. Falling on his knees he dedicated himself to Christ. God accepted the offering of his life and from that time on, Taylor's career was China-ward. When Hudson Taylor told his mother of his conversion, he was surprised to learn that though she was some twenty miles away, at the very instant when he was converted, she was on her knees praying for her son's salvation and feeling assurance that God had heard.

The two came up with this plan after Samantha shared about the need for flowers for the special community festival that would be happening toward the end of summer. Cassandra thought her mom's idea was excellent and she began making preparation to teach a unit on Botany. Floriculture, specifically, as this would teach everything they needed to know about how to care for the flowers. Sophia, Isabella, and Charlotte thought the idea was very exciting. They all did well with their studies and learned a lot about the different kinds of flowers that their grandma had shown them. On the day of their final lesson, their grandma brought the seeds to give the girls. To Sophia she gave seeds for lilies, daisies, lilacs, lily of the valley, and orchids. To Isabella she gave carnations and sunflowers. The pansies were given to Charlotte. Each of the girls were given the location and tools needed to start their garden and instructions for their specific seeds. 
