

they said, We will not walk therein. Jeremiah 6:16*





The average U.S. citizen has no clue as to what has made this country great. He may actually believe some stupid radio commercial that says something like, "Remember, our strength is our diversity." Maybe he just thinks some countries are luckier than others. There is a reason why America has a heritage of greatness. Proverbs 14:34 Righteousness exalteth a nation: but sin is a reproach to any people. There is a reason that Mexico is a dangerous country in which to live and raise a family. There is a reason that Africa is a continent ravaged by AIDS. I've been living in this country for 58 years. I'm saddened by what I've seen happen in our culture. If there is any bumper sticker that would be "timely" for our day, it would be one that says: BACK TO THE BIBLE, OR BACK TO THE JUNGLE! There is a whole chapter in the Bible that deals with the cause of corruption in a society. It tells why nations go crazy. No person has had a thorough education unless somewhere along the way he studied Romans 1. Are you acquainted with that chapter? America is becoming a jungle, a land with jungle music (Vance Havner warned about this way back in the 1950s), jungle morals (no marriage, just have sex with anything or anyone you can), and a jungle mentality. ## REESIE'S RECIPES

### Milk Chocolate Bundt Cake

- 1 can (16 ounces) chocolate syrup
- 1 milk chocolate candy bar (5 ounces), broken into chunks
- 1 cup butter, softened
- 2 cups sugar
- 4 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 2-1/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 1 cup chopped pecans

#### FROSTING:

- 1/4 cup butter, cubed
- 2 tablespoons baking cocoa
- 3 tablespoons milk
- 2 cups confectioners' sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/4 cup chopped pecans

In a saucepan over low heat, stir chocolate syrup and candy bar until candy bar is melted; cool. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add chocolate mixture and vanilla; mix well. Combine flour and baking soda; add to creamed mixture alternately with buttermilk. Fold in pecans. Pour into a greased and floured 10-in. fluted tube pan. Bake at 350° for 70-75 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack to cool completely.

**For frosting**, in a saucepan, melt butter. Stir in cocoa until smooth. Add milk. Bring to a boil. Remove from the heat. Stir in the confectioners' sugar and vanilla until smooth. Spread over cake. Sprinkle with pecans.

### Layered Gelatin Salad

- 1 package (3 ounces) lemon gelatin
- 2-1/2 cups boiling water, divided
- 2 cans (8 ounces each) crushed pineapple
- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup whipped topping
- 1 envelope unflavored gelatin
- 3/4 cup cold water, divided
- 1 package (3 ounces) lime gelatin

In a bowl, dissolve lemon gelatin in 1-1/2 cups boiling water. Drain pineapple, reserving 2/3 cup juice; set juice aside. Stir pineapple into gelatin. Pour into a 2-qt. glass bowl. Cover and refrigerate until firm. In a small bowl, combine cream cheese, mayonnaise and whipped topping; set aside. Sprinkle unflavored gelatin over 1/4 cup cold water; let stand for 1 minute. In a small saucepan, bring the reserved pineapple juice to a boil; stir in dissolved unflavored gelatin. Add to the cream cheese mixture; mix well. Carefully spread over the chilled lemon layer. Refrigerate until firm. In a bowl, dissolve lime gelatin in remaining boiling water. Stir in remaining cold water. Chill until partially set. Beat with a portable mixer until foamy. Pour over cream cheese layer. Refrigerate until firm, about 3 hours or overnight.

### Honey & Spice BBQ Chicken

- 1 1/2 cup Heinz 57 sauce
- 1/4 cup honey
- 2 to 2 1/2 pnd. Chicken pieces
- Melted butter

Combine Heinz 57 sauce and honey. Place chicken on grill or broiler pan. Brush with melted butter, then the sauce mixture. Grill or broil until chicken is tender, turning and basting frequently.

### Italian Chicken & Vegetables submitted by Amy Willis

In a 9x13 pan cut 3 boneless chicken breast in half. Add 2 cans of green beans (drained) on one side. On the other side add cut up red skinned potatoes. Sprinkle a packet of Zesty Italian seasoning mix on top. Drizzle 1/2 stick of melted butter over all. Bake @ 350 for 1 hour.



### The Power of Prayer

Samuel Logan Brengle, a lead officer in the Salvation Army in its younger days, had much to say about holiness and faithfulness. He wrote many helpful books and gave godly counsel to those who approached him. Read carefully this quote by him and examine your own life in view of eternity; then examine your life according to the Scriptures. Read soberly: "Do you ask, 'How can we get the fire?' I answer, 'Not by feasting, but by fasting; not by playing, but by praying; not by sleeping and slothfulness, but by watching and by diligently seeking God and the souls that wander from Him; not by skimming The War Cry once a week and reading the newspapers and devouring the comic sections and sporting news, but by searching the Scriptures.'" [The War Cry is the Salvation Army's denominational magazine.] Friends, if this quote from Brother Brengle doesn't stir a spark in you, then perhaps your wood is too wet! We NEED a stirring of the Spirit in our lives something fierce! But, too many are too preoccupied with too many things. Many today will cry out, "There's nothing wrong with these things; you're being pretty legalistic." Friends, we often must choose either heavenly things or earthly/worldly things. The Apostle Paul in the third chapter of his letter to the Colossians encouraged them, and you who are IN Christ, to set your affection on heavenly things, not earthly things. You will either feed at the banqueting table of the Spirit or you will feed at the trough of the world. I see a lot of people who spend so much time at the trough, stuffing themselves full of worldly things that their souls are too filled to enjoy the things of the Spirit; they have left no room for the good things of God. The simple fact is, you may try to eat from both the trough and the table for a time; but, eventually you will develop a taste for one or the other. The more you desire to be filled from the world's trough the less you will desire the things of God. The converse is true as well; the more you desire and feast on the things of God [Bible reading, prayer, meditation on heavenly things, thinking on God, fasting, etc.] the less you will desire to taste the worldly things. There simply isn't room in your soul for both. Some wonder why there doesn't seem to be such mighty men of God today as there used to be. Well, you will either embrace the Spirit and catch on fire or you will quench the Spirit while you embrace the world. Too many are too fond of earthly things to give them up. Even as your soul cannot eat from the trough and the table neither is there enough time in the day to chase after heavenly and worldly things. To be a mighty man, woman, or child of God costs you something. Those who would spend great amounts of time in prayer like John Hyde, William Carey, or Jonathon Edwards had to give up other things. But here's the catch, they didn't consider it giving up ANYTHING for they gained an intimate presence with the Father! It's recorded that Pastor Jonathon Edwards spent 13 hours a day in prayer; you can't hardly find a pastor who spends 13 hours a week in prayer! David Brainard, missionary to the Indians, prayed so passionately and fervently while in the snow laden woods that when he was done the snow had melted from around him. John Hyde was called from his private prayer time by a man saying you are to preach at 3 and it's 2:45. Mr. Hyde's response was, "how is that possible, I only just knelt down here at 9 this morning a few moments ago. The list of godly men who "gave up" much of worldly pleasure for a glimpse of eternity goes on and on. We must begin fearing God instead of men; we must begin truly loving God instead of ourselves; we must start looking out for the eternal welfare of others instead of our own temporal gain. Do you think once you step into eternity you'll have wished you had done more for Christ or more for yourself? Press on, my friends, press on in the things of eternal value! ## “Don't Let Distractions Cause You To Miss Your Blessing”

Scripture Reference: Matthew 14:22-33

And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away. 23 And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone. 24 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary. 25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea. 26 And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. 27 But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. 28 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water. 29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. 30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. 31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? 32 And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased. 33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.

People often wonder...“Why didn't God help me?” “Why didn't God answer me?” “Where was God when I needed him?” Often the answer to these questions is that we allowed ourselves to become distracted. Some may say, “No not me...I prayed”, “I sought after God”, “I did what I was supposed to do” and nothing changed. Well then I would like to ask the questions...What made you stop praying? What made you stop seeking God? What made you stop doing what you were supposed to do? Could it be it was because you saw no results taking place, in other words you were distracted by what was not happening. Blessings, faith, and answers are often missed because of distractions. You start out strong and mighty. Your mind is made up that I'm going to wait on God until my change come. But then you realize time is moving on and it seems like nothing still is happening. In fact, it seems like things are getting worse and the small thought “maybe this is not God's will for me” or “maybe God is not with me” creeps in. Once the first distraction takes root, it causes you to take your eyes off of the Lord God Almighty that you are waiting on and instead place your eyes on the situation which seems all so wrong. The more you look at it the more it grows until it now seems bigger than God. Don't be fooled, a distraction does not always have to be a problem or a situation that seems to be getting worse. Sometimes it can be a situation that seems all so right...“I know he's not saved but I believe he really loves me” “I know this job is going to keep me from church but I'll now be able to pay all of my bills” “I know I shouldn't be hanging around those old friends but I'm tired of being by myself” These distractions are going to cause you to miss out on the things God has for you and leave you asking yourself why didn't God help me? God was helping you, but you became distracted before it became manifested. Let's look at the book of Matthew chapter 14. We find the disciples in a ship that was caught in a storm. They see Jesus walking on water towards them. Peter yells out Lord if this is you let me walk on the water and come to you. He receives the answer “come”. Now let's focus on the 30th verse - But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. The 29th verse tells us that Peter actually walked on the water until he began to look at the boisterous winds and waves. His eyes were taken off of Jesus, he became afraid and then started to sink. Peter became distracted with what was going on around him instead of continuously focusing on Jesus. It's only when you truly come to trust God that you will be able to overcome distractions. However many of us never take the time to learn how to trust God. We see him as a genie in the bottle that's supposed to grant us our every desire. We must learn how to develop faith in the bible and come to know him as the God who is there. The question should not be how can I trust God but rather a strong acclamation-it's God I Trust! No matter what I see, hear or feel...I will trust God. What blessings are in stored for the person that comes to the place of fully trusting God. The storms of life will surely come but let me ask another question...Who is God to you? Is he a god who runs from problems or does he hide himself because he doubts himself? Is he a god that does not know how to help you or maybe your situation took him by surprise and he must now figure out what to do. Of course not, remind yourself from Luke 1:37 - For with God nothing shall be impossible Psalm 84:11 - For the Lord God is a sun and shield: the Lord will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly. We can't afford to get distracted, but if we do remember this - God's mercy endureth forever. God gladly waits to put you back on the right path. God wants to bless you...He wants to help you...He wants to heal you...He longs to answer you...God has so much in stored for you. So don't let distractions cause you to miss out on the things God has just for you.

### God is SO Good

*"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning." James 1:17*

In verses 12-18, the writer returns to his discussion of temptation. He emphasizes here the fact that God never tempts anyone. (although we are tested, and tried) I think it's important that we understand that "Evil does not come from God". But every "good and perfect gift" does. God always has, and always will be the source of all good. So, what's your take on God today? One of the Names that the Bible describes God is "ABBA" - meaning "Daddy". There is no second guessing how God sees us in that word picture is there? In fact, God's WORD tells us over and over that he loves us, but he also says... "For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth." Proverbs 3:12; Hebrews 12:6; Revelation 3:19 Most in the WORLD sees Him as a God Of "Judgment, and a God of Wrath"; and there are times when He must punish the wicked for their sin. But He would so much rather love them. In fact, He tells us that he chastens those that He does loves. You and I get up every morning, as it is our routine... get ready for our jobs, and take off so as not to be late - forgetting all the time that it is...He that wakes us in the mornings. It is...He who has numbered our days, & counted the very number of hairs on our heads. It is He who listens to our heartbeat, and knows every thought and intent therein. It is He who hears our prayers, and has told us that He wants to give us the very desires of our hearts. (Psalm 37:4) What's more - our text today doesn't just paint Him as a Gift Giver - but it proclaims the nature of His Parentage. He was the Father of Lights. This was the Same Father That hung the Galaxies in their place and then flung the stars across the heavens so that man would never be in total darkness. This was the same Father who took Abraham out beneath those stars and promised that his seed would be even greater that he could count. Then the writer goes on to say that "in Him", "...there is no variableness, nor shadow of turning". That's a hard thing to find in a Father today. In fact, that's a pretty tough thing to find in the character of most anyone that we meet on a Daily basis. How many times have you made promises to your children - and had to break them? What about your best friend? Your own Mother? Saying one thing and doing another, tends to leave a bad taste in the mouth. Our scripture reminds us today that Our God is not like that. Our text tells us that this same "Father of Lights" is unchanging, and that there is "no shadow of turning" in Him. I can guarantee you that my Kids will never say that about their dad. But YOU AND I can be sure of it in Our Heavenly Father! What do you have need of today? Call on Him... He'll be excited to hear from you.
