
His Voice

The man replied that if he had not killed it, the dog would have torn him to pieces. "Well," said the owner, "why did you hit with the blade? Why didn't you just hit it with the handle?" "I would have," replied the man, "if it had tried to bite me with its tail." When dealing with sin, some people say, "Why don't you go about it more diplomatically? Why don't you choose less offensive words to describe it?" Banana Pudding

1 large box instant vanilla pudding1 can eagle brand milk1 bowl of Cool Whip4 bananasvanilla wafers

Make pudding as directed on box. Whip and then add eagle brand milk and 1/2 of cool whip. Layer wafers, bananas and pudding mixture. Cover with remaining cool whip. Sprinkle with vanilla wafers.

Onion Cheesy Taters

5 lb. bag red potatoes
1 pkg. Lipton onion soup mix
2 sticks butter, melted
8 oz. bag Velveeta shredded cheese
6 to 8 slices crisp crumbled bacon, optional

Cut potatoes in chunks leaving skin on. Put potatoes in a deep pan. Mix dry soup mix into melted butter and pour over potatoes, stir to coat well. Sprinkle with cheese and bacon. Bake on 425 for 20 minutes.

Chocolate Peanut Butter Eclair Cake

1 box chocolate graham crackers
2 (3 1/4-ounce) boxes vanilla instant pudding
1 cup peanut butter
3 1/2 cups milk

1 (8-ounce) container Cool Whip, thawed
1 can chocolate frosting

Spray the bottom of a 9x13 pan with cooking spray. Line the bottom of the pan with whole graham crackers. In bowl of an electric mixer, mix pudding with milk and peanut butter; beat at medium speed for 2 minutes. Fold in whipped topping. Pour half the pudding mixture over graham crackers. Place another layer of whole graham crackers on top of pudding layer. Pour over remaining half of pudding mixture and cover with another layer of graham crackers. Heat the container of prepared frosting, uncovered in the microwave for 1 minute. Pour over the top of the cake. Refrigerate for at least 12 hours before serving.

Pork Chop Casserole

1/2 of 5 lb. Bag of potatoes
3/4 cup milk
1/2 onion
Shredded cheese
3 to 4 pork chops

In a baking dish peel and slice potatoes to fill the bottom of the pan. Dice onion on top of potatoes. Add milk to cover potatoes. Bake at 350 for 20 minutes. Remove from oven and add pork chops to top of potatoes. Bake for 45 minutes. Remove from oven cover with shredded cheese and bake once more until cheese is melted.

Then the fire of the LORD fell, and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood, and the stones, and the dust, and licked up the water that was in the trench. And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, The LORD, he is the God; the LORD, he is the God." (1 Kings 18:30, 36-39) We must not only build up the alter of the Lord in our hearts and in our families but we must begin by tearing down the alters of the false gods we now serve. I spoke of sports and entertainment earlier; if these things have become gods to you, you must forsake them, put them away, not spend your time and money there. Too often we have the alter of self to contend with. We must start asking ourselves and allowing the Holy Ghost to answer whether these things are gods in our life or no. Fathers and husbands must repair the family altars so that the fire might fall once again. Wives must join in, using holy wisdom in discussing with their husbands and in supporting their husband's decision to draw the family nearer to the cross and our crucified, yet living, Saviour. Parents must focus more on being their child's parent rather than their friend. We must rather desire the holy fire that burns the carnality out of our lives rather than the friendship of the world that leaves us with the chaff and dross abundant in our lives! WE NEED THE FIRE! "The Orphan Spirit" part 01

Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; 21 And having an high priest over the house of God; 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) 24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: 25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. Hebrews 10:19-25

One of the key aspects of Christianity is that when we are born again we become sons (or daughters) of God. Galatians 3:26-29 - For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise. Romans 8:15 - For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. Ephesians 1:5 - Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, It is the Father's intention that we know and enjoy the privileges and the sense of belonging that is inherent in being a part of the family of God. However, the Lord knew that it would be difficult for a person to truly believe that one can be adopted as a child of God, so, He sent the Holy Ghost to testify to us, to give us the confidence to cry out "Abba! Father!". Romans 8:14-17 - For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. 15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. 16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. An adopted child receives the un-revocable privilege of participating in the will and testament of the parents. He becomes an heir of all that the parents have. So, it is by adoption that we become heirs of the Father. Prior to coming into the family of God, we were spiritual orphans, cut off from God. The enemy continues to foster in us the same orphan spirit even after we come into God's family. Jesus recognized this in His disciples. John 14:18 - I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. John 16:7 - Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. John 15:9-16 - As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. 10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love 11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. 12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. 13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. 14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. 15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you. 16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you. Since He came to us in the form of the Holy Spirit, it further emphasizes the truth of Romans 8:16 - The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: An orphan is someone who had been abandoned by his/her primary care giver. This can be literal with physical abandonment or it can be spiritual. The kingdom of God is based upon relationships, and the central relationship is one of parent to child. For example: Titus 2:4 - That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, 1st Timothy 1:2 - Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord. 1st Corinthians 4:15 - For though ye have ten thousand instructers in Christ, yet have ye not many fathers: for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. We become orphaned when those who are caring for us abandon us to the vagaries of life, or when those who should care for us, do not do so. We may have an orphan spirit because of the nature of the parenting that we received. In some cases, you may have been literally abandoned, or adopted out. Perhaps you had an absent father, or an abusive mother. Maybe you had to raise yourself because of the financial situation in your family, or because of the number of children in the home. On the spiritual side, neglect happens at every level in Christianity. Leaders demand instead of admonish, berate instead of beseech, are busy with church life instead of Body life. While there are promises of parental love, the reality is little more than a request for the tithe, the Church is in desperate need of true fathers who know how to parent their spiritual children. Our spirit ceases to feel orphaned when we have confidence that we belong to a family - God's family, and that we are being cared for by the Father or one who has the Father's heart. It enables us to connect with our brothers and sisters, and yield ourselves fully to those in authority in the church.

Be A Bold Voice For Him!

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth! Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again Zion. Isaiah 52:7-8

In the 4th century lived a Christian named Telemachus, in a remote village, tending his garden, and spending much time in prayer. One day, he believed he heard the voice of God telling him to go to Rome, so he obeyed, setting out on foot. Some weeks later, weary from his journey, he arrived in Rome about the time of a great festival. The little man followed the crowd surging through the streets into the Colosseum. He saw the gladiators standing before the Emperor and proclaiming, "We who are about to die salute you." Then Telemachus realized that these men were going to fight to the death for the entertainment of the cheering crowd. So he cried out in a loud voice, "In the name of Christ, Stop!" Yet the games began, so he pushed his way through the crowd, climbed over the wall and dropped onto the floor of the arena. The entire Colosseum watched this tiny figure rushing toward the gladiators, crying, "In the name of Christ, STOP !!!" The gladiators thought it was part of the show and began laughing. But in a few moments, they realized it was not part of the show, and then the crowd became angry. Telemachus stood his ground, insistently pleading with the gladiators to stop their bloody show, when one of them plunged a sword into the saint's body. He fell to the sand. As he was dying, his last words were, "In the name of Christ, STOP!!!" Then a strange thing happened. The gladiators stood there looking at the tiny Christian lying there dead. A hush fell over the Colosseum. Way up in the upper rows, a man stood and made his way to the exit. Others followed. In dead silence, one by one, everyone left the Colosseum. The year was 404; and that day saw the last battle to the death between gladiators in the Roman Colosseum. Telemachus' martyrdom initiated an historic ban on gladiator fights by the Roman Emperor Honorius. Never again in the great stadium did men kill each other for the entertainment of the crowd. One tiny man's bold voice — one voice — reshaped Roman history, and saved thousands of lives, by fearlessly proclaiming the truth in God's name! You may be a little man, or woman, spending time alone with Jesus. And He may be preparing you in the quiet place, for a moment when you will be called to raise your voice in some public square or stadium, to fearlessly stand for His truth, even if it might cost your life.
