REESIE'S RECIPES

Strawberry Cheesecake Ice Cream

1 cup half-and-half cream
1 tablespoon vanilla extract
2 teaspoons grated lemon peel
2 teaspoons lemon juice
1 cup sugar

1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, cubed and softened

1 cup heavy whipping cream

1-1/2 cups fresh strawberries

Place the first six ingredients in a blender; cover and process until smooth. Add whipping cream; cover and process until blended. Remove to a large bowl. Add 1-1/2 cups strawberries to blender; cover and process until pureed. Stir into cream mixture. Fill cylinder of ice cream maker no more than two-thirds full; freeze according to manufacturer's directions. (Refrigerate any remaining mixture until ready to freeze.) Transfer ice cream to freezer containers, allowing headspace for expansion. Freeze 4-6 hours or until firm.

Oreo Ice Cream Cake by Laura Jackson

1 gal. vanilla ice cream
Chocolate syrup
9 x 13 inch cake pan
1 pack of Oreos
1 large bowl of Cool Whip
1 stick butter, melted

Crush Oreos, set aside a small amount to garnish top. Melt butter and mix well with the rest of the Oreos. Cover bottom of pan with Oreo/butter mixture. Drizzle syrup over cookie mixture. Spread softened ice cream over cookie crumbs. Drizzle some chocolate syrup on top. Then spread Cool Whip. Freeze for 1 hour.

Easy Apple Dumplings

2 (8 ounce) cans crescent rolls
2 sticks butter
1 1/2 cups brown sugar
1 teaspoons vanilla
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1 1/2 cup mountain dew
2 apples

Butter a 13 x 9 inch baking dish. Preheat the oven at 350 F. Peel and core apples, than cut each apple into 8 slices Roll each apple slice in a crescent roll and place in a buttered dish. Melt butter, stir in sugar, vanilla and cinnamon, and when it's thickened, remove from heat and pour over the dumplings. Pour the soda in the middle and along the edges of a pan(not over the rolls) Bake for 35-45 minutes, or until they become golden brown. Serve warm.

Western Chicken Pot Pie

1 can (10 3/4 oz) fiesta nacho cheese soup
2 cups chicken broth
1 teaspoon pepper
1 can (4.5 oz) chopped green chiles, drained
1/2 cup chopped onion
2 cups chopped cooked chicken breast
1 box Jiffy cornbread mix
Milk, butter and egg called for on cornbread box
1 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese
2 tablespoons chopped green onions

Heat oven to 400°F. In large bowl, stir together soup, broth, pepper, green chiles, onion and chicken. Spoon mixture into 10-inch ovenproof dish. Make cornbread mix as directed on box, using milk, butter and egg. Fold cheese and green onions into batter. Pour over chicken mixture. Bake 20 to 25 minutes or until filling is bubbly and cornbread is golden brown.



Liberty In Jesus

With all the national and worldwide troubles, with financial and racial tensions, with losses of liberty and seemingly more to come, people are asking, "What can we do?" The good news—the answer is simple; the bad news—it's not easy. Simply said, "Jesus is the answer." But even Jesus said that it isn't easy. He tells His followers to count the cost and that they must strive if they would enter in. Jesus points to Himself as the Answer and says those He sets free are free indeed. Simple...but not easy. In truth, without spiritual freedom we aren't really free regardless of where we live. Please note, I said, "spiritual freedom" not "religious freedom." There's a world of difference. Religious freedom speaks to government "guarded" rights; spiritual freedom points to our ability to speak and live freely in Christ. There may be penalties to pay if we must transgress man's law; but as we live and speak IN Christ, we have true freedom which no man or government can take away. We will say with Peter, "We must obey God rather than man." Identifying the real problem isn't easy because issues and people tend to sidetrack us. Paul tells us that our trouble isn't with flesh and blood, but rather it's within the spiritual realm. (Ephesians 6) What caused such tyranny in England that would drive our Founding Fathers to take such desperate action? What would make them count the cost and choose to give up their lives, their fortunes, and their sacred honor? What causes such oppression and tyranny in our government and in our society today? It's a little three letter word that has troubled mankind from the beginning....SIN!!!!!!!! It's the corrupt passions and vices of men that in all ages have been the overflowing source of tyranny. It's the same corruption that has brought about every kind of political and domestic oppression. It's sin that binds; it's sin that pushes us away from true freedom! It was sin that kept Adam from re-entering the paradise of the Garden of Eden. It's sin that keeps us from enjoying the fruits of the banqueting table of freedom and liberty as a nation; and it's our own sin that limits the freedom we have in Christ. What of political freedom? One preacher from our founding era states, "Politically, the general prevalence of real Christianity, in any government, has a direct and immediate tendency to promote, and to confirm within itself, political liberty. That is a truth that we experienced for a long time." But what of today? There is NO prevalence of real Christianity within our government, and sadly within the peoples of our nation. So, what are we to do? Isaiah 59 makes the issue of sin clear. God is still mighty, He still hears, His saving arm is not short...BUT....their sin is blocking His blessing. Isaiah goes on to describe the nation: none call for justice, all speak perverseness, they're blind and groping, they love falsehood, and have left truth lying in the street. Sound familiar? Look around and see if this doesn't describe our beloved country. What could Israel do? What can America do? The last part of Isaiah 59 describes Jesus, the Redeemer. It tells how He will come as their Victor. He will save those who will turn from their sin. It'll cost us something to enjoy liberty...it'll cost us our sin. To be free, we dare not lovingly hold on to it; we must let it go. The answer is to humble ourselves in repentance—the death of our ways and our will. It's repentance from sin to salvation and redemption from self to sanctification. Real national change, and lasting change, will only be found in the changed heart of its people. Our liberty will only be realized when we stop looking elsewhere and look only to Christ for it. But as we have said, it takes effort. God's people can't judge themselves by looking at the wickedness of their nation or even others in the church; that will only give them a skewed perception of the difference between the profane and the holy. Instead, as Isaiah looked upon the Lord, high and lifted up (Isaiah 6), allowing the prophet to see himself for the sinner he was, so we must look upon Jesus that we might see ourselves as we truly are and that we might be drawn closer to Him. Let us look upon Jesus with II Chronicles 7:14 in mind. "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." Instead of maintaining our own ways before God, we Christians, not the world, are called to humble ourselves, confessing that what the Lord says is right, regardless of our traditions, desire, and habits. We are to be humble servants, ears and eyes alert with hands and feet ready for unquestioning service to the Son of God. We are instructed to pray—really pray—that God's will be done in our lives and in the life our nation. Humble prayers of confession and repentance. We must seek the face of God. In this busy world of increased entertainment and social media, with all the pulls that we feel, most do not truly seek God. Admittedly, we don't do it well; we learn more of God and seek Him through times of meditation upon our Bible reading, times of prayer—calling desperately upon Him and listening in our spirit for His still small voice, and being devoted to Him, trusting in His direction. Finally, we are given a call to repentance—to turn from our wicked ways. Unless we humble ourselves, pray, and seek God, repentance isn't possible. Repentance starts with a humble looking only to the face of the Savior, being changed into His image as we grow in Him. If we do these four things, God promises to do three: Hear our prayer, forgive our sin and heal our land. The need of healing in our land is so very great; the forgiveness of our sin is greater yet. What a blessed promise that a holy God would come down to heal His people.....and then their land. Real hope and change, real liberty—both personal and national—will only be found in humbly seeking God's face and repenting of our wickedness. God alone raises nations up and brings them down, but His people, following His instruction, can stay the hand of judgment for a time. What can we do? It's what each of us must do, repent! What the Word Of God Says About Transgender Issue conclusion

The bible clearly tells us that homosexuality is a sinful perversion of God's gift of sexuality. Romans 1:18-32 - For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; 19 Because that which may be known of God is manifest in them; for God hath shewed it unto them. 20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse: 21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. 22 Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, 23 And changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things. 24 Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves: 25 Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen. 26 For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature: 27 And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet. 28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; 29 Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, 30 Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, 31 Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: 32 Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. This passage alone describes where we, as a society, are at today. In the Law, Transvestism was specifically forbidden - that is the wearing of the opposite gender/sex clothing. Deuteronomy 22:5 - The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are abomination unto the Lord thy God. Also another possible reference to transgenderism is 1st Corinthians 6:9-10 - Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. The KJV calls it "male prostitutes - effeminate" which means "soft or feminine Which leads to these male prostitutes who might be transsexual men who act as women. Lastly, you may be asking...C. WHAT'S THE DANGER IN THIS TYPE OF THINK-ING? 1. If we rationalize one sin, we have no grounds not to rationalize ALL sin. (murder; rape; incest; stealing; lying; cheating;) James 2:10 - For whosever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. 2. It puts our children at greater risk to ACCEPT this type of thinking (Makes it much easier for Satan - Did God really say?) 3. It puts our women and daughters at risk for those who just POSE as transgender for other perverted sexual desires 4. Further perverts God's created design of marriage and tearing down the home life. 5. Suicide rate among trans genders is an atrocious 41%. Conclusion: No matter if the gender distortion is genetic; hormonal, physiological or psychological The bible clearly and consistently labels any sexual activity outside of marriage or not between a man and a woman. As sin and rebellion against God's plan. The bible clearly teaches that we're all wicked sinners who have fallen short of God. The bad news is...that applies to everyone who has ever been born - to include you and me...just like the Corinthian church 1st Corinthians 6:9-10 - Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. (now remember - this letter was written to who? THE CHURCH) 11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. But the good news is but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. But just because I am under Grace now and not the law doesn't mean I can continue in my sin. If I meet someone who is transgender, my response hopefully will be one of love and compassion but not one of acceptance of the sin. Romans 5:20 - 6:2 - Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: 21 That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord. 6:1 - What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? 2 God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? Ephesians 4:17-24 - This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, 18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: 19 Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. 20 But ye have not so learned Christ; 21 If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus; 22 That ve put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; 23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; 24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. Listen, Jesus is the only hope for any and all sin...to include transgenderism No matter how sinful a life you have lived, Christ stands ready to forgive any sinner who turns to Him.

Thought for Today: Make Good Choices! Choose to serve Christ rather than self.

Story for Today: Jackie sat astonished at the thought of where she was today. Five years ago her life was that of a wild and carefree teenager. Today, at 23, she would be starting over. Well, as much as one can start over. She had been talking with Nikki, a true friend who stood by her through thick and thin. Nikki had shown Jackie how bad choices led to more bad choices, which led to more bad choices, and eventually led to destruction unless a person changed their ways. Jackie was ready for that changed life the day she arrived at the jail as an 18 year old prisoner. She believed Nikki and had proven the truth of what she was saying, spending the last 5 years of her life behind bars as a result. Jackie never thought things would turn out this way. She never imagined that she would get caught, tried, convicted, and sentenced her first year as an adult. She knew she deserved the punishment. She just never thought it would happen to her. Jackie was thankful for one thing that had come as a result of this horrible experience, a changed heart! Because of the change in her heart, she now had a close walk with God and Jesus was the Master of her life. She had Nikki to thank for that, Nikki and God! At first Jackie thought that if she just said a prayer everything would be alright; she might even get an early release. But, through the many weeks of Bible study with Nikki, she found that would not be the case. She realized that just like remodeling an old house, she too had some things that needed to be torn out and new things put in their place. Praise the Lord, God could do that! Nikki had shown her Proverbs 4:23-27 and explained that what we care about will determine our actions. When she spoke about bad things it caused her to care about the wrong things. If she was unreasonable in her speech, she was not guarding her heart. She needed to look at godly things if she wanted to make good choices. And these verses also warned her to look at where she was going. Choices have predictable outcomes and she needed to be aware and always proceed with caution. During the last five years, Jackie had been working on living out these verses. She had made a paper heart to remind herself that she was precious and needed to pay close attention at all times to what was going on when she talked (even to herself). She practiced making sure her words were true, honest, just, pure, lovely good reports, virtuous or praises. She made sure she was cooperative and kind to others, not being unreasonable. She stopped using bad words or words that weren't being used appropriately. She also decided to spend time learning about God rather than watching things for pleasure. And she determined never to watch things that would displease God. (So no more shows that used his name as a curse word!) And no more shows that glorified the bad guys or showed murder or drunkenness and other works of the devil. Everyday she would begin and end her day the same way, talking with God. She even took time to reflect on what she had done that day, to see if it pleased her Master or not. If not, she confessed and changed her ways. Then she found the source of the thing that was wrong so that she would recognize it in the future to avoid it. Jackie felt like she was a brand new house that had been completely gutted and remodeled with new fixtures. Today she would enter society a new person. She now had the tools to be able to make better choices and her focus was on serving Christ rather than self. She was headed for an eternal life with a beautiful mansion in Heaven rather than destroying her life here and ending up with a place in hell that awaits all who reject the Master!

Questions for Today: Do you know the outcome of the path you have chosen? Are you guarding your heart? What is the fruit of your mouth? What do you put before your eyes? Are you pondering the path of your feet? Will you choose to remove your foot from evil?
