Sadly we also see that in the end the result was the same for them all "none of those men which were bidden shall taste of my supper". We too have received an invitation...an invitation to come to Jesus. An invitation to follow Jesus. Maybe you are saved, you know the Lord but you keep excusing yourself out of being faithful to church, faithful to His work, faithful to His call. What The Bible Says Homosexuality And The LGBTQ Lifestyle part 02

The reason why Sodom is remembered this way is because the Biblical account tells us that the sin of Sodom was homosexuality; not pride, greed or inhospitality as some have so foolishishly suggested. In Genesis 19, we see that two angels have come to pull Lot and his family out of Sodom. They lodge with Lot in his home for the evening, and as soon as this is noised abroad, there comes a crowd of men to Lot's house, demanding that the two angels be handed over to them for sexual purposes. They mean to rape the angels. Genesis 19:5-7 - "And they called unto Lot, and said unto him, Where are the men which came in to thee this night? bring them out unto us, that we may know them. And Lot went out at the door unto them, and shut the door after him, And said, I pray you, brethren, do not so wickedly." This second mention of homosexuality in the bible, like the first mention, ends badly. We all know the story...the angels tell Lot that he must take his family and flee because God is planning on destroying both Sodom and Gomorrah for their wickedness. Genesis 19:13 - "For we will destroy this place, because the cry of them is waxen great before the face of the LORD; and the LORD hath sent us to destroy it." The wages of sin is ALWAYS Death! God will deal with it. Before I move on to Homosexuality in the New Testament I want to address The Major Difference Between God's Rainbow And The LGBT Pride Rainbow. We are seeing these flags so much and you need to understand what it means. The number 7 in the Bible as well as in nature show the completeness and perfectness of our Heavenly Father. The number 6, on the other hand, does not fare so well. The number is first mentioned in connection with the flood of Noah, and last mentioned with the Mark of the Beast and the Battle of Armageddon. All judgments on sin. The Mark of the Beast includes three 6's, a complete judgment on sin. How many colors in the LGBT Pride Rainbow? You guessed it - 6.God's rainbow, the one that He set in the sky as a sign to Noah, has 7 observable colors in it - red, orange. yellow, green, blue, violet, and indigo. Genesis 9:11-13 - "And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth. And God said, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations: I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth." I was reading a story on how Skittles back in June 2016 traded in its iconic rainbow packaging for a monochromatic black-and-white design in honor of LGBT Pride parade celebrations in London. The candy company joined in the celebration and handed out limited-edition black-and-white bags filled with white Skittles, with a black S imprinted on them. An all-white Skittles float was also seen making its way through the thousands of revelers during the Pride parade in London. And it got me thinking about the major difference between God's rainbow and the counterfeit LGBT Pride rainbow symbol. God's rainbow, the one that He set in the sky as a sign to Noah, has 7 observable colors in it - red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet, and indigo. The number 7 is strongly associated with God and His perfect completeness. Please note the following about the number 7:•There are 7 days of the week - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday •There are 7 continents – Africa, Antarctica, Asia, Australia/Oceania, Europe, North America, and South America •The Name Jehovah appears 7 times in the King James Bible - Genesis 22:14, Exodus 6:3, Exodus 17:15, Judges 6:24, Psalms 83:18, Isaiah 2:2, Isaiah 26:4 •There are 7 Churches in Revelation – Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamos, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia, Laodicea •There are 7 notes in the musical scale – C, D, E, F, G, A, B •There are 7 colors when light passes through a prism – the three primary colors and four secondary ones affectionately known as ROYGBIV •There are 7 levels in the Periodic Table of the Elements – the 7 levels of periodicity Further, there are the 7 Mysteries given to the apostle Paul, 7 baptisms of fire, 7 resurrections, and a whole host of other 7's. Multiples of 7 also figure into the biblical narrative: the "seventy weeks" prophecy in Daniel 9:24 concerns 490 years (7 times 7 times 10). Jeremiah 29:10 predicted the Babylonian Captivity would last for seventy years (7 times 10). According to Leviticus 25:8, the Year of Jubilee was to begin after the passing of every fortyninth year (7 times 7). Are you starting to get the picture? The number 7 in the Bible as well as in nature shows the completeness and perfectness of our Heavenly Father. The number 6, on the other hand, does not fare so well. The number is first mentioned in connection with the flood of Noah, and last mentioned with the Mark of the Beast and the Battle of Armageddon. All judgments on sin. The Mark of the Beast includes three 6's, a complete judgment on sin. How many colors in the LGBT Pride Rainbow? You guessed it – 6. Gilbert Baker, an artist and drag gueen, first created the Rainbow Flag in 1978.

Responding to Rebellion

How would you describe Antifa?

Sen. Ted Cruz (R-TX) describes them thusly, "Antifa is a group of hateful, intolerant radicals who pursue their unhinged agenda through aggressive violence." Sen. Cruz went on to say, "Time and time again their actions have demonstrated that their only purpose is to inflict harm on those who oppose their views. The hate and violence they spread must be stopped..." Sen. Bill Cassidy (R-LA) described Antifa as "violent masked bullies who 'fight fascism' with actual fascism." These two Senators introduced a bill this month (July) that would label Antifa as a domestic terror organization. The resolution "calls for the groups and organizations across the country who act under the banner of Antifa to be designated as domestic terrorist organizations" and "unequivocally condemns the violent actions of Antifa groups as unacceptable acts for anyone in the United States." How does the Bible describe this domestic terrorist organization? Although the term "antifa" isn't named, its spirit is aptly painted in Psalm 140:1-3. "Deliver me, O Lord, from evil men; preserve me from violent men, who plan evil things in their heart and stir up wars continually. They make their tongue sharp as a serpent's, and under their lips is the venom of asps." (ESV) and again in Psalm 144:11 "...whose mouth speak lies and whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood." There is no need to recount the havoc and vast plethora of crimes, violence, and destruction of property that these domestic terrorists have committed. What we should point out though is that the Left refuses to condemn their actions because it fits in with their agenda. It's a militia to propagate communism and division within these United States. One recent example of this would be Willem Van Spronsen attempting to firebomb the ICE detention center in Tacoma, Washington. Every communist revolutionary movement needs a martyr; and now, Antifa has its first in Mr. Van Spronsen. By and large, local authorities and even this administration have been slow to act on these criminals. Remembering the wise words of Thomas Jefferson wrote to John Jay in 1785, "Weakness provokes insult and injury, while a condition to punish it often prevents it. ... I think it to our interest to punish the first insult: because an insult unpunished is the parent of many others." Terrorism, foreign or domestic, should be dealt with quickly and justly. We are a nation of laws; and by various unrestrained acts, our society cries out for justice. Instead of silence from the White House, we should be hearing President Trump condemning these vile acts, at least personally declaring Antifa to be a domestic terrorist organization, and promising to do all within his power to squelch these illegal acts which put innocent people, particularly our law enforcement agents, at risk. We dare not sit idly by, accepting the largely apathetic response from local law enforcement in many of these blatantly illegal situations. If we do, things will get increasingly worse. As Leo Hohmann reports, "It's about to get ugly, folks, especially if the FBI and local law enforcement continue to stand down against antifa anarchists. "According to the website Far Left Watch, which tracks radicalized left-wing groups, antifa-affiliated radicals have been raising money for arms in preparation for an all-out revolution." Dear Reader, you may not be interested in politics or culture wars; maybe you don't worry about Antifa because "who would bother with me?" Regardless, the Left and its "Red-Green Axis" (Communist/Islamist) and "rainbow" agendas are interested in you! Various Leftist politicians have dehumanized conservatives and have called for violence against them. Add to this that they won't condemn an Antifa arm which carries out its bidding, and we are all facing troubled days when the Left gets back in power. (This is the same path that was forced upon the Jews during WWII.) Regardless of one's reasons for non-involvement, let me remind you of Joseph McCarthy's words. "No one can terrorize a whole nation, unless we are all his accomplices" In a sense, our silence and lack of action make us accomplices of Antifa and its terrorist designs. Remember those famous words of Edmund Burke? "The only thing necessary for the triumph of evil is for good men to do nothing."

What's my part in stopping evil?

1) Contact Congress and encourage them to pass the bill which would designate Antifa as a domestic terrorist organization. Be respectfully assertive and affirming.

2) Speak the truth with others; particularly those with whom you have some influence. Remind them that freedom of speech is not a violent act and shouldn't be met with violence.

3) Contact your local law enforcement, asking them if they have a plan in place to deal with Antifa should they show up in your community.

4) Pray and let your light so shine before men that they will look to your Heavenly Father. May our prayers be imprecatory prayers remembering both God's sovereignty and man's responsibility. One such fitting prayer can be found in Psalm 144. "Blessed be the Lord, my rock, who trains my hands for war, and my fingers for battle; he is my steadfast love and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer, my shield and he in whom I take refuge, who subdues peoples under me." (v 1-2) "Bow your heavens, O Lord, and come down! Touch the mountains so that they smoke! Flash forth the lightning and scatter them; send out your arrows and rout them! Stretch out your hand from on high; rescue me and deliver me from the many waters, from the hand of foreigners, whose mouths speak lies and whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood."

Fritos Treats

2 packages (9-3/4 ounces each) corn chips, divided

2 cups semisweet chocolate chips, divided

1 cup sugar

1 cup light corn syrup

1 cup creamy peanut butter

Spread 1 package of corn chips on the bottom of a greased 13x9-in. baking pan; sprinkle with 1 cup chocolate chips. In a large heavy saucepan, combine sugar and corn syrup. Bring to a boil; cook and stir 1 minute. Remove from heat; stir in peanut butter. Pour half of the peanut butter mixture over chip mixture. Top with remaining corn chips and chocolate chips; drizzle with remaining peanut butter mixture. Let stand until set. Cut into bars.

Upside Down Peach Cake

1 box yellow cake mix

2 cups brown sugar

Peaches (fresh) peeled and cut up

1 stick butter

Preheat oven to 350. Melt butter in a 13x9x2 pan. Sprinkle brown sugar over butter. Spread peaches over brown sugar. Mix cake as directed on box only substitute pureed peaches for the water. Bake at 350 for 35 to 40 minutes. Cool for 10 minutes before turning out.

Pepper Jelly

2 jalapeno peppers, seeded and chopped

3 medium green peppers, cut into 1-inch pieces, divided

1-1/2 cups white vinegar, divided

6-1/2 cups sugar

1/2 to 1 teaspoon cayenne pepper

2 pouches (3 ounces each) liquid fruit pectin

About 6 drops green food coloring, optional

Cream cheese and crackers, optional

In a blender or food processor, place the jalapenos, half of the green peppers and 1/2 cup vinegar; cover and process until pureed. Transfer to a large Dutch oven. Repeat with remaining green peppers and another 1/2 cup vinegar. Add the sugar, cayenne and remaining vinegar to pan. Bring to a rolling boil over high heat, stirring constantly. Quickly stir in pectin. Return to a rolling boil; boil for 1 minute, stirring constantly. Remove from the heat; skim off foam. Add food coloring if desired. Carefully ladle hot mixture into hot half-pint jars, leaving 1/4-in. headspace. Remove air bubbles; wipe rims and adjust lids. Process for 10 minutes in a boiling-water canner. Serve over cream cheese with crackers if desired.

Green Bean Bundles

1 pound fresh green beans, trimmed

8 bacon strips, partially cooked

1 tablespoon finely chopped onion

3 tablespoons butter

1 tablespoon white wine vinegar

1 tablespoon sugar

1/4 teaspoon salt

Cook the beans until crisp-tender. Wrap about 10 beans in each bacon strip; secure with a toothpick. Place on a foil-covered baking sheet. Bake at 400° for 10-15 minutes or until bacon is done. In a skillet, saute onion in butter until tender. Add vinegar, sugar and salt; heat through. Remove bundles to a serving bowl or platter; pour sauce over and serve immediately.

Bobby Jones was one of the greatest golfers to ever compete, uniquely known for winning the "Grand Slam" of golf winning all four major tournaments in the U.S. and Britain in a single year. In 1925, early in his career, having reached the final playoff in the U.S. Open, at a certain point in the match, Jones was setting up to strike his ball which was in the rough just off the fairway. His iron accidentally touched the ball. He immediately became angry with himself, turned to the marshals, and called a penalty on himself. But the marshals had not seen the ball move, so they left the decision to Jones, whether to invoke the penalty -- a two-stroke penalty. Bobby called the penalty on himself, not knowing that he would lose the tournament by a single stroke. When praised for his honesty, he replied, "You may as well praise a man for not robbing a bank!" Jones may have lost the tournament, but his character was legendary and today the United States Golf Association's award for sportsmanship is known as the "Bobby Jones Award." It's been said, "Character is what you do when nobody is watching. Character is how you treat people who can do absolutely nothing for you. Character is how you react when the pressure is on. Character is deciding beforehand that you are going to do the right thing." Every day we're faced with decisions -- many of which are made when no one is watching, at least no one we can see. Her mind raced as her body reacted to the fact that it would all be over in seconds. Screaming out for help to the God that she had denied was the instant response. As the earth came rushing up to her, Analisa screamed louder, waking herself from the horrible nightmare. Life was rough for the 12 year old Analisa. Her parents had separated last year and now the divorce was final. Nothing would ever be the same. Analisa and her siblings had been close before the break up and now they were all separated. Traci her oldest sister had just turned 18 and rather than moving in with one of her parents chose to move in with her current boyfriend. Kenny at 15 had chosen to live with their Dad and she was given to her Mom. The nightmares that started a little over 3 weeks ago, traumatized her day and night. After they separated, she did it all over again asking that they would move back together and not get divorced, and yet now the divorce was final. Most of her friends from church told her that she needed to trust God; that His ways were higher than her ways and that even though she didn't understand now, one day, when she was able to see the big picture she would understand. All this did for Analisa was make her angry with them too. She knew what she had been taught. She knew God could do all things. But, He hadn't. He had let her life fall apart, leaving her hopeless and living a horrible nightmare and she hated Him for it. The day she told Jimmy, a friend from school, that she hated God and decided to get high with him, the nightmares had begun. The first time had been hard. She felt guilty! Each day as she continued to meet up with Jimmy, just so she didn't have to go home and face the real world, the guilt lessened. As she continued to fall into the darkness, the nightmares increased. She always woke in a panic and never could get back to sleep. Analisa was growing to hate her life and everything that she was coming to find as normal. The drugs were taking a toll on her and her grades were slipping. The nightmares and lack of sleep had turned her world upside down. And her hatred for God resulted in a loneliness that she had never dreamed possible. Her friends appeared to be her enemies and she didn't want to spend time with anyone, not family, nor friends. She wasn't sure where to put Jimmy as he wasn't really a friend but, she knew she really didn't even want to be around him. He just always seemed to show up and she just didn't seem to be able to say no and get away. The changes in Analisa hadn't went unnoticed by Ms. Sondie. Being her math teacher helped her see quickly the slippery slope that Analisa seemed to be traveling. And noting that she was no longer at church or with the other girls from church brought the prayer warrior to her knees. Ms. Sondie recognized that Analisa was losing this spiritual battle and she wasn't about to let her slip away. A knowing look in the eye was not the only evidence of the faith and hope that this special lady carried with her. The smile and joy that radiated from her and the quiet words of wisdom that she often shared quickly told of a godly woman that was ready for battle. And battle was what was needed to save the soul of young Analisa. She began by praying for a clean heart and a removal of the rebellion that had taken root. This would take a miracle, but, Ms. Sondie knew that the Lord Jesus Christ was more than able to cleanse and redeem this child. She also knew that when the Holy Spirit filled the space, dwelling inside her, she would live the life of a child of God.


