**“A Word to the Wise – The “ifs” of Wisdom**

“Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God.” Proverbs 2:5

The Word of God is full of conditional promises – “IF...then...” And today’s lesson in wisdom is full of them. Wisdom is a treasure available to all who will pay the price of diligence, denial of self, and duty to God. God desires to draw us to Him and share His wisdom and knowledge with us, but there is a cost. In this day and age there is little desire for diligence, self-denial, or duty; it’s about what I can get for as little effort as I can expend and it’s all about me. Friends, that’s dangerous; it’s in the church; and it’s an apathetic laziness that comes from and leads to the pit of hell. Beware! Instead, let us look at the “ifs” of wisdom, apply ourselves to them, and find joy here and for eternity. In this second chapter of Proverbs we answer these two questions: 1. How do we obtain wisdom? and 2. IF I obtain wisdom, how will it benefit me?

Solomon answers our first question with verses 1-4. IF we follow the ifs of these verses, we have little doubt that God, who is rich in mercy and wisdom, will readily grant our request, for the Apostle James exhorts that any who lack wisdom should “ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.” (James 1:17) The rest of the chapter explains the benefits and blessings showered on us IF we follow the ifs!

1. The first step is to have a humble readiness of heart and mind to receive godly instruction, protecting it from all who would steal this precious treasure or cause it to lose its luster in the eyes of the beholder. (v 1-2) Do you cherish the word of God? Scottish theologian George Lawson (1749-1820) encouraged his readers with these words: “We are to receive the words of our heavenly Father, with reverence and love, with faith and diligent attention. No gift is so precious as that knowledge which God imparts to us in the scriptures, and we ought to receive it with eagerness, like that which the covetous man shews for gold and silver; and as he who receives money is careful to lay it up where he may find it when he has occasion to use it, so in like manner it becomes us to lay up in the midst of our heart the instructions of wisdom, collecting and hiding the precious treasure, till the word of Christ dwell in us richly in all wisdom.”

2. We must be in prayer (v 3) for it as James exhorted us above. We cry out to God for He alone is the Source and Provider of wisdom and it is only by His Spirit that we hope to gain understanding of the commands, promises, and insights found in the Bible.

3. We must strive for it, like searching for buried treasure. When God has helped us to ready our minds and has opened our ears to understanding, we would be fools to not dig in Wisdom’s mine for choice nuggets and study with diligence at Wisdom’s school and in her sanctuary, for wisdom is not granted to the apathetic or lazy.

The remainder of this space will be used to just describe the benefits we receive from following the IFs of obtaining wisdom from our all-powerful and all-knowing Creator.

1. “We shall know how to maintain our acquaintance and communion with God.” (Matthew Henry) (v 5)

2. Wisdom, knowledge, and understanding can be ours by His mouth, His teaching. (v 6)

3. When we live by God’s wisdom, walking rightly, He is our Protector. (v 7)

4. God preserves the way in which He calls us to live; we are protected when walking in wisdom. (v 8)

5. “We shall know how to conduct ourselves aright towards all men.” (Matthew Henry) (v 9)

6. Wisdom transforms us from the inside out; our desires and then our actions are changed. (v 10)

7. When we’ve obtained wisdom and God’s ways are known and loved by us we will have discernment and discretion. Through these benefits of wisdom we are preserved and protected, as by a hedge of thorns, and we recognize the ways of evil men, helping us to recognize who the evil are, delivering us from their snares, and keeps our footsteps sure. (v 11-20)

8. Verses 21-22 describe the reward for both those who travel the path of evil and the wise who are secure in Christ’s saving power – those who “let the word of Christ dwell in [them] richly with all wisdom.”



Racism: The Real Solution

“For therein is the righteousness of God revealed...The just shall live by faith.” Romans 1:17

For more years than I care to count, I have grown weary of “the race card.” Anytime someone disagrees with a plan of action, desires a feeling of victimhood over being responsible for one’s actions, wants to undermine reality, they throw down the “race card” as though it’s the trump ace – “I absolutely win, nothing you can do or say competes. Game over!”

There have been wrongs committed (both ways) between people bearing different shades of color as well as within one’s own ethnicity. BUT there is only one “race” - the human race made up of multiple ethnicities. In an effort to promote Marxism with its division and destruction, the Left is bent on including LGBT+ persons under the “race” umbrella in order to give them special privileges and to demand that they are not only accepted, but promoted and celebrated as well. Instead of discussing the varied “race” cards like Critical Race Theory, social justice, or numerous LGBT “race” cards, as a Christian, I need to understand these “race” cards for what they are and cling to the only viable solution. Let us take to heart the words of the Getty’s song Speak, O Lord: ***“Speak, O Lord, and renew our minds. Help us grasp the heights of Your plans for us. Truths unchanged from the dawn of time that will echo down through eternity. And by grace, we’ll stand on Your promises. And by faith, we’ll walk as You walk with us.”***

These “race” cards are little more than Satan’s attempt to attack the image of God and erase a nation that was dedicated to God from off the face of this earth. Or, in reading Romans chapter one, perhaps they are signs that he is winning this battle. Regardless, take heart, believer, God WILL win the war. **In the end, all the earth shall see that Christ reigns!** Let’s look at the only real solution to social justice and all the other “race” cards being thrown down as “trump” cards. **First**, we must live out the truth that there is only one race physically speaking; we are one blood, so love your neighbor as yourself. Spiritually speaking, however, there are two races and we must also live out this truth; love the Lord your God with all that you are. Each person either belongs to the race of the “First Adam,” still ruled by sin and lustful passions, or belongs to the race of the “Last Adam”- Jesus Christ. In the line of the “Last Adam” we are transformed by His atoning blood, made to be new creatures, and are following after the Spirit instead of living after the flesh. These are two different races, living in contrast one to another, and have two different eternal destinations. **Second**, it’s vital that we see these “race” cards for what they are spiritually: an attempt at **self-atonement**. We will either take God’s remedy and God’s justice, which is the atoning work of Jesus on the cross at Calvary, or we fall into insanity, which is what we see running rampant all around us.

I recently heard a preacher speaking on social justice proclaim: *“The way we rectify past discrimination is to encourage present discrimination. In other words, if you were the underdog in the last cycle, then you get to be on top in this cycle and you get to discriminate against those who were in the high place last time. Will that fix things? No, we’re still as out of balance as we were before. Of course, we’re out of balance in different ways, but present discrimination will be rectified by future discrimination. It’s an endless cycle of one group oppressing and exacting retribution from another. All of this is an attempt to bring justice but the whole attempt is unjust. We are ALL guilty; we are all one race. This is a failed attempt at atonement, at reconciliation. Jesus dying on the cross is not just religious talk; it is the only answer for this problem that we are facing in the world today. The only thing that will get us anywhere is to go back to the cross and start over. We are all level at the cross and when we kneel at the cross, we’re born again. It doesn’t matter what I did the first time, I’m going to start over and you can start over. The Bible says that if I’ve wronged a person on a personal level, I need to do everything I can to make it right, but it is totally impossible for me to try to account for all the wrongs of my ancestors against your ancestors. We need to go to the cross and start over afresh and anew. We preach a gospel that deals with us personally and has social ramifications; they deal with a social gospel that is unworkable but does not change the person at a personal level.”*

The fact is that justice, equity, marriage, and all other definitions are defined by God and that is how we must live and love – God first and then our neighbor. **God’s Word is the “Ace of trump!”**



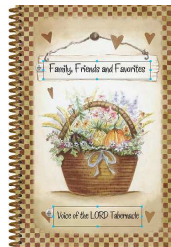
Reesie's Recipes



Oreo Cheesecake

- 1 (20 oz) pkg. Oreo's, divided
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- ¼ cup margarine, melted
- 1 cup sour cream
- 5 (8 oz.) pkgs. Cream cheese, softened
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup sugar

Preheat oven to 325. Line 13x9 inch pan with aluminum foil, with ends of foil extending over sides of pan. Finely grind 30 of the cookies and add margarine, mix well and press firmly onto bottom of pan. Beat cream cheese, sugar and vanilla in large bowl on medium speed until well blended. Add sour cream: mix well. Add eggs 1 at a time until well blended. Chop remaining 15 cookies. Gently stir in some of the cookies into batter; pour over crust, sprinkle with remaining cookies. Bake 45 minutes. Cool: refrigerate 3 hours. Lift cheese cake from pan using foil handles. Cut and serve.

Zucchini Relish

- 12 c. shredded zucchini
- 2 red sweet peppers, chopped
- 4 c. chopped onion
- 2 green peppers, chopped
- 4 c. shredded cabbage
- 5 T. salt

Mix together well and let stand overnight. The next morning rinse with cold water and drain well.

- 6 c. sugar
- 1 ½ tsp. celery seed
- 2 ½ c. vinegar
- 1 tsp. tumeric
- 5 T. cornstarch
- ½ tsp. nutmeg
- 1 T. dry mustard
- ½ tsp. black pepper

Combine in saucepan and cook until slightly thickened. Add vegetables and mix well. Fill jars leaving ¼" headspace. Tighten lids. Process in boiling water bath for 15 min.

Cheesy Mushroom Chicken Bake

- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 1 soup can milk
- 1 pkg. onion soup mix
- ¾ cup regular rice
- 1 can sliced mushrooms
- 4 chicken breast halves
- Shredded cheddar cheese

Blend soup and milk: reserve half cup of the mixture. Stir together remaining soup mixture, rice, mushrooms and half the onion soup mix. Pour into a 11x7 dish. Arrange chicken breasts on the rice mixture. Pour half cup reserved soup mixture over chicken and sprinkle with remaining onion soup mix. Cover and bake 1 hour at 350. Uncover, sprinkle with cheddar cheese and bake another 10 min.



I Am Not Ashamed

“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.” - Romans 1:16-17

Having a desire to visit the Romans in order to speak to them, Paul tells them that he is “not ashamed of the gospel” that he looks to deliver to them, because “it is the power of God unto salvation”. Paul is completely and entirely convinced that the Gospel he seeks to spread is the true Gospel, and anything else is bound to fail. This brings us to the question - are we convinced like Paul was? How can we be convinced the way Paul was? Paul’s strong belief in the power of the Gospel comes through two things.

First, Paul had a personal encounter with Jesus Christ - he had first-hand experience of what the Gospel could do in a person’s life, having been saved after years spent persecuting the Church. Who else but Paul could demonstrate the magnificent power of the Gospel? To be fully convinced of the Gospel, you need to know who God is. You need to experience His saving power in your life.

Second, Paul had verified the Gospel he taught with the rest of the Apostles. In the letter to the Galatians, Paul tells us that once he started to encounter false teachings he took a trip to Jerusalem to verify the Gospel with the Jerusalem Council, made up by Peter, James, and John (Galatians 2:1-2; Acts 15:2). Paul tells us that in this meeting with the council, they gave verification to the Gospel he had been preaching for the last fourteen years:

“But of these who seemed to be somewhat, (whatsoever they were, it maketh no matter to me: God accepteth no man’s person:) for they who seemed to be somewhat in conference added nothing to me: But contrariwise, when they saw that the gospel of the uncircumcision was committed unto me, as the gospel of the circumcision was unto Peter;” - Galatians 2:6-7

The council added no additional details to Paul’s Gospel, nor did they redact anything - all they learned was that Paul was intended to reach the gentile as Peter was intended to reach the Jewish community. To be fully convinced of the Gospel, you have to verify it. While we may not have a council living on earth that consists of the original apostles, we do have the letters and Gospels that were written by the apostles, and these writings are more than enough evidence to verify our beliefs. The fact of the matter is, you cannot be unashamed of a Gospel that you are not fully convinced of, and in order to be convinced of the Gospel you must know what the Gospel really is.

THE ONLY WAY TO FREEDOM!

When a person is being held captive in a prison cell, there are three obvious facts concerning the situation: first, he is not stronger than the iron bars that contain him; second, the lock is not on the inside, but on the outside of his cell; third, the key is in the hands of the officer in charge, who is also on the outside of the cell. These facts should profoundly limit the options to the one in the cell, should he desire to be freed. It should be clear, first of all, that there is **NOTHING** he himself can, in his own power, do. He is at the mercy of the iron bars and the key-holder. He cannot take out a knife and whittle at the bars, for even if he had a knife it would do little damage. He cannot attempt to squeeze through the bars, for they were designed to hold even the thinnest of men! He cannot use muscle to try to bend the bars, for that would be a useless tiring of himself and would yield no reward. He could demand, loudly and repeatedly, that he be loosed, but there is no hope in that either, for they are bars and cannot hear, and he is confined by law that wavers for no man.

I have just painted a picture in the physical of where the Christian who finds himself in bondage is in the spiritual. You say "a **CHRISTIAN** in **BONDAGE**??" Yes...I was once one and I promise you there are many. Are you one? When we don't understand our identity in Christ as a child of God, when we don't know that we are to reckon the old man, the sin nature, as crucified with Christ by faith, we are vulnerable to bondage of some sort, be it drugs, alcohol, depression, anger, bitterness, pornography, or any of a host of sins. And, just as the man in the prison cell, we will be helpless to break out of the bars of our prison.

Now, some will come along and say, "well, you just need to '**SPEAK THE WORD**' to that thing! **YOU** have **POWER** to **COMMAND** it to **GO!!**" Others will say, "**YOU** just need to read this book on a 40-day fast...**THAT** will free you!" Others may say, "you just need to have some accountability...join our Christian 12-step group-**THAT** will get you free!" Others will declare that you just need to "think positive!" All of these things are akin to telling the man in the jail cell that **HE** can somehow get himself out- with a knife, or his arm strength, or squeezing through, or demanding verbally. It simply **CANNOT WORK** because it's **SOURCE** is wrong!! The **ONLY MEANS** to freedom lies in the key that is in the hands of one above him in power and authority- the jail-keeper! Need I say another word?

When you see a Christian struggling in a bondage, or if you yourself are that Christian, **UNDERSTAND THIS**: this man in the cell is not there because he "**WANTS**" to be held in confinement! And he is not still in bondage because he hasn't tried all these various ways to get out, for they are worthless! He is in bondage because he **KNOWS NOT** that he **CANNOT PUT HOPE** in his **OWN ABILITY**, but must trust in the One Who is able to free him! He must cease from his foolish attempts at freeing himself, and reject every false way, and focus all his attention on **BRINGING THE MATTER BEFORE THE ONE** Who has **ALREADY PAID THE PRICE** for his freedom! He it is Who will indeed set Him free- for He stands ready to do just that!

As long as we think there is something within us that is powerful enough to free us, we will remain in bondage. The Bible is replete with this truth!

A Word for TODAY!

Verse for Today: 1 John 2:21 I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth.

Additional passages for Today: Proverbs 9:8-9; Romans 15:14-15; 2 Peter 1:12; John 8:42-47;

Thought for Today: What you do with truth often reveals what is in your heart. Being a follower of Christ, you will seek truth and speak truth.

Story for Today: Ashlyn dropped wearily down on the sofa as she gave way to the sadness that filled her being. Today, she and Maddy had spent the morning shopping with her mom and the three of them had found some amazing deals. However, purchases and deals couldn't erase the sadness that filled her from the loss of her relationship with Tim. They had been an item for almost 22 months and at 17 that seemed like forever. At first, Tim had seemed pleased to go to church and other church functions but recently he had seemed more reluctant, until he had quit going altogether about a month ago, with the requirement that if she wanted to see him it had to be outside of church activities.

Tim wasn't the most athletic guy she knew, but he was good at football and was on the track team. He was also into racing and working on old cars. He wasn't a drinker, gambler, or someone that even dabbled in illegal drugs. He was good in school and at 18 was a good worker on the family farm where he milked cows and was responsible for several head of steer that he raised for meat.

Tim had been close to Dillon Blake, the youth pastor at their church, until the accident that had taken his wife and daughter from him and had left Dillon reeling in pain and grief. Tim had spent a lot of his free time trying to help the middle-aged man get through this difficult time of life. It was during those days that Tim started asking hard questions. And it was during that time that Dillon had spoken the truth into Tim's life. Tim hadn't wanted to hear everything that his pastor had shared. He didn't want to hear that he was supposed to die to himself and live for Christ in every area of his life. He had thought if he did the majority of things right it would be ok. Pastor Dillon was able, through his grief, to take Tim to passage after passage until Tim had no choice but to see the truth for what it was. Only he wasn't ready to accept it. He was not ready to live for Christ alone. Pastor Dillon continued to pray for and with the young man even after Tim stopped coming around as frequently. Tim found excuse after excuse until he just finally stopped showing up or answering the messages that were left for him altogether.

Ashlyn knew she needed to pray. Tim knew the truth and she believed he would yield to God in this area too. She just needed to be patient and willing to speak the truth no matter the cost. She recognized that compromise would be devastating. She was determined to be a good friend and speak the truth at every opportunity no matter what it might do to her future.

Questions for Today: Do you know the truth? Jesus said He is the way the TRUTH and the life, no man comes to the Father but by Him. The devil wants us to believe that we don't have to be concerned about little things. But in James, chapter two, we are told that if we offend in only one point of the law, we are guilty of all.

Prayer for Today: Dear Heavenly Father, Thank You for the truth and for revealing Yourself to us through Your son, Jesus Christ. Please help us to seek and speak the truth even when we fear it will cost us relationships. Please help those that are struggling to submit in every area of their life.
