

REESIE'S RECIPES



Chocolate Ribbon Pie

Ingredients

4 ounces Fat Free Cream Cheese, softened
 1 1/2 cup cold fat free milk, divided
 1 tablespoon sugar
 2 cups thawed Fat Free Cool Whip, divided
 1 ready-to-use reduced fat graham cracker crust
 1 package (4-serving size each) Chocolate Sugar Free Instant Pudding & Pie Filling

Beat cream cheese, 1 Tbsp. of the milk and sugar in medium bowl with electric mixer on medium speed until well blended. Gently stir in 1/2 cup of the whipped topping. Spread onto bottom of crust. Pour remaining milk into large bowl. Add dry pudding mix. Beat with wire whisk 2 minutes or until well blended. Spread over cream cheese layer. Refrigerate 4 hours or until set. Top with remaining 1-1/2 cups whipped topping just before serving.

Strawberry Dessert Pizza

1 pkg. (20 oz.) refrigerated sugar cookies
 1 pkg. (8 oz.) Cream Cheese, softened
 1/3 cup sugar
 1 tub (8 oz.) COOL WHIP Strawberry Whipped Topping, thawed
 2 cups strawberries, sliced

Preheat oven to 350°F. Press dough firmly onto bottom of greased 12-inch pizza pan. Bake 20 min. or until golden brown. Cool in pan on wire rack. Beat cream cheese and sugar in large bowl with wire whisk or electric mixer until well blended. Stir in whipped topping. Spread cream cheese mixture onto crust; top with strawberries. Serve immediately. Or, cover and refrigerate until ready to serve. Store leftovers in refrigerator.

Yellow Squash Casserole

Ingredients

4 medium yellow summer squash
 1/2 cup chopped onion
 1/4 cup melted butter or margarine
 1/2 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
 1/2 cup Ritz cracker crumbs

Cook sliced squash in a small amount of boiling salted water for about 10 minutes, or until tender; drain. Sauté onion in margarine until tender. Combine drained squash, sautéed onion, butter, and cheddar cheese in a 1-quart casserole dish. Top with Ritz cracker crumbs and drizzle melted margarine over crumbs. Bake at 350° for 20 minutes.

Mushroom Stuffed Peppers

Ingredients

1 pound ground beef
 1 cup sliced mushrooms
 1/2 white onion, diced
 2 cups beef gravy
 salt and pepper to taste
 3 small red bell peppers, halved and seeded
 3/4 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Brown beef in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Halfway through browning, add mushrooms and onion. Continue cooking until meat is fully browned; drain fat from skillet. Stir in enough gravy to bond mixture without making it soupy. Season with salt and pepper, and set aside. Meanwhile, heat a medium saucepan of water until boiling. Place peppers in water, and boil for 2 to 3 minutes, until just tender; remove from water. Place peppers, hollow side up, in a 9x13 inch baking dish, and fill each with beef mixture. Bake in preheated oven for 15 to 20 minutes, until bubbling. Top with cheese, and bake for an additional 5 to 10 minutes. Serve with remaining gravy

Ingredients

6 tbsp. butter
 1/3 c. shortening
 2/3 c. brown sugar
 1 egg
 1 tsp. vanilla
 1 3/4 c. flour
 1/2 tsp. baking soda
 1/2 tsp. baking powder
 Small bag chocolate chips
 MILKY WAY® candy bars

Cream first 8 ingredients and chill. Roll dough into 1 inch balls. Cut candy bars into 8 slices and press 1 slice into each cookie ball. Cover candy by wrapping dough around it. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes. When cool melt chips and ice cookies.

Cheezy Corn Pups

Ingredients

8 oz Can refrigerated dinner rolls
 8 Hot dogs
 8 Strips cheddar cheese, 3 x 1/2 x 1/4 inch
 3 tb Barbecue sauce
 1/2 c Cornmeal
 Wooden popsicle sticks

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Lightly grease cookie sheet. Separate dough into 8 rolls. Cut a slit in each hot dog - insert the cheese. Shape each roll evenly around each hot dog. Pinch roll ends together to seal. Brush with the barbecue sauce and then roll each one in corn meal. Insert a wooden stick in one end of each hot dog. Place each on the cookie sheet and bake for 15 to 20 minutes until rolls are brown. Serve with ketchup and mustard.

Another Gospel

But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. Galatians 1:8

This month we continue looking at the teachings of the Catholic church. Once again we will be taking the actual teachings from the Catholic Catechism which is the document laying out the doctrines of this church and comparing them to what the Word of God...The King James Version has to say about it.

CATHOLIC SALVATION...

The Catholic Catechism states the following...*"The sacrament of Penance is necessary for salvation for those who have fallen after Baptism, just as Baptism is necessary for salvation for those who have not yet been reborn"* Here we see that the Catholic Church teaches that without works and baptism one cannot be saved. What does this do for the malefactor that hang next to Jesus on the cross and asked the LORD to remember him when he came into his kingdom? Did Jesus lie to this dying man? For this man had neither works nor time for baptism...yet Jesus said **"today thou shalt be with me in paradise."** Paul said in ***Eph 8:9 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.*** Salvation comes only through Faith in Jesus Christ and his shed blood. ***Purgatory...***The Church also teaches there is a purgatory...a place that is never mentioned one time in scripture...the Catholic Catechism states *"All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation, but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect for certain lesser faults."* There is absolutely no truth to this, the Bible plainly teaches in ***2 Cor 5:8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.*** When one dies who is saved by the blood of Jesus we go into the presence of God not a place that no one ever heard of until the Catholic Church made it up. They go on to make the teaching even more ridiculous by saying *"Since the faithful departed now being purified are also members of the same communion of saints, one way we can help them is to obtain indulgences for them, so that the temporal punishments due for their sins may be remitted."* In other words through your prayers, works, charity or giving of money to the church you can help those in purgatory to get out! This is completely unbiblical and can be found no place in the teachings of Jesus or any of his true followers. We haven't even come close to covering all of the false teachings of this church even though we have been teaching on it for a few months now, however...if we haven't convinced you by now that this is without a doubt a false church full of false teachings then I am not sure what else we can say. I would like to wrap up our study on this church by looking at one more teaching...***The Role of the Priest ...***The Catholic Catechism states *"One who desires to obtain reconciliation with God and with the Church, must confess to a priest all the unconfessed grave sins. All mortal sins of which penitents after a diligent self-examination are conscious must be recounted by them in confession, Individual and integral confession of grave sins followed by absolution remains the only ordinary means of reconciliation with God and with the Church."* In other words if you do not confess your sins to a priest it is impossible to be saved! The Bible says ***1Ti 2:5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;*** When Jesus died on the cross and the temple veil was rent in twain God opened the door for man to come to him through Jesus Christ and his shed blood and that meant there was no longer a need for an earthly priest! ***Hebrews 4:14, 16 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God,...Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.*** We no longer have need of a priest on this earth we can go to the Father through HIS SON! Hallelujah! ***Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.*** It is our prayer that this study has been enlightening and helpful to you. Until next time may the LORD bless and keep you is our prayer


