I heard Happy Caldwell tell the story of a great turn around in his congregation. It happened years ago, but still holds a message for us today. When this turn around occurred, there was a lot of strife in the church, a lot of sin and backbiting. People blatantly gossiped about each other and worse. The church was split over certain issues and people were taking sides. In short it was a mess. Happy tried to remedy the situation by preaching on every sin that he saw and preaching it hot. He told them like he saw it. He said there were too many liars, cheats, adulterers, etc. in the church and that many of them were right there in their own congregation. He called them gossipers and heathen. He brought every scripture he could think of to try to turn them around. Fire, damnation and wrath became prominent sermons in those days. He preached hell and made it as hot as he could get it, but the situation just deteriorated and got worse instead of better. Happy didn't know what to do. He was at his wits end. Finally he bundled up the whole messy situation and laid it before the Lord in a special season of prayer. He prayed, "Lord, I just don't know what to do anymore. These are the worst bunch of sinners I've ever seen that still claim to be Christians. I've preached them Your Word, I've told them exactly what they are. I've prayed and cried and counseled with them and it seems like it's just not working. The congregation is dwindling horribly because of their sin. What am I missing, Lord? Please show me something." As Happy waited before the Lord, the Holy Ghost began to speak into his spirit. He said, "Tell them they are righteous." What?! Happy could hardly receive what the Lord was saying. "But Lord, how can I tell them that when they really aren't righteous? Haven't You heard what I've said?" The Lord continued, "Happy, if they have believed on Me and made Me the Lord of their life, then they have been made the righteousness of God in Me, but they can't walk in that righteousness unless they believe it and they can't believe it unless someone tells them. Tell them, Happy. Show them that with Me all things are possible. Start telling them all the things they are capable of because of My sacrifice. Tell them they are more than conquerors and children of the Most High God. Preach love and joy and righteousness in the Holy Ghost. Show them that sin and death no longer have dominion over them. Preach the rewards that come from walking in My Word. Call them righteous." Happy's message changed that very day. He began telling his people of things they could do in Christ. He told them how the love of God had been shed abroad in their hearts and how they had the ability more than any other people to operate in that love. He showed them they had the power of forgiveness, mercy and love working in them, because Jesus worked in them. He called them righteous over and over again. Months later as Happy looked over the congregation from the pulpit, he began to realize some things. Sin was no longer a predominate issue. Joy and peace had begun to reign like never before. People were walking in unity and love where strife and backbiting had once been. Most had become quick to help one another and quicker to forgive. The congregation was suddenly growing and his little church was reaching out on every side with the love of Christ and really making a difference in the community. The people were also experiencing the benefits of living in God's Word. They were beginning to prosper in every area. He leaned over toward the visiting evangelist and whispered, "You'd be hard pressed to find a more righteous bunch of people anywhere.".... And it was true.

Good works will not bring righteousness but righteousness will always bring good works.

Hark the Herald Angels Sing

Charles Wesley of England was without doubt one of the most productive hymn writers and preachers of all time. Yet, strangely enough, Wesley was able to get only one hymn poem into the Church of England's Book of Common Prayer, and that one by error! An eighteenth century printer didn't know that the "established Church" of England frowned with disapproval upon Wesley's hymns. Since he needed material to fill an empty space in the new hymnal, he took it upon himself to insert a Christmas poem called, "Hark, How All the Welkins Rings!" by an Anglican clergyman named Charles Wesley. When the error was discovered attempts were made to have it removed, but it proved so popular that it was allowed to remain. It was written in 1738, but is still very moving today. "Hark the herald angels sing. Glory to the new born King. Peace on earth, and mercy mild: God and sinners reconciled."

REESIE'S HOLIDAY RECIPES



Dreamsicle Cake

Ingredients

- 1-box orange supreme cake mix
- 1-3 oz. box orange jello
- 1 small box vanilla instant pudding
- 4 eggs
- 1 1/2 cup milk

Frosting

- 8- ounces of sour cream
- 1 cup sugar
- 8-ounces Cool Whip
- 1-12 ounces of crushed pineapple (well drained)
- 1 package of frozen coconut (put in freezer over night)
- add crushed walnuts if desired

Blend cake ingredients for 3 minutes, Grease and flour three 8 or 9 inch cake pans Bake 350 degrees for 20 or 25 minutes. When cakes layers are completely cool use Frosting Refrigerate for 1 hour before eating...and refrigerate left over

White Chocolate Peppermint Fudge

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 teaspoons plus 1/4 cup butter (no substitutes) -- softened, divided
- 2 cups sugar
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 12 (1-ounce) squares white baking chocolate -- chopped
- 1 (7-ounce) jar marshmallow creme
- 1/2 cup crushed peppermint candy
- 1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract

Line a 9-in. square pan with foil. Grease the foil with 1-1/2 teaspoons butter; set aside. In a heavy saucepan, combine the sugar, sour cream and remaining butter. Cook and stir over medium heat until sugar is dissolved. Bring to a rapid boil; cook and stir until a candy thermometer reads 234F (soft-ball stage), about 5 minutes. Remove from the heat; stir in white chocolate and marshmallow creme until melted. Fold in peppermint candy and extract. Pour into prepared pan. Chill until firm. Using foil, lift fudge out of pan. Gently peel off foil; cut fudge into 1-in. squares. Store in the refrigerator.

Pineapple Coconut Angel Fluff

Ingredients

- 1 (15 oz) can crushed pineapple
- 2 (6 oz) cans pineapple juice (1 1/2 cups)
- 1 (.3 oz) package sugar-free lemon gelatin mix
- 1 (1 oz) package sugar-free instant coconut pudding mix
- 1 (8 oz) carton fat-free whipped topping, thawed
- 5 oz angel food cake, cut in 3/4" cubes
- 1/4 cup toasted shredded coconut

Drain the crushed pineapple and set aside, reserving the juice. Add the 2 small cans of pineapple juice to the reserved juice. In a small saucepan bring 1 cup of this pineapple juice just to a boil. Remove from heat and stir in gelatin mix until dissolved, set aside to cool. When gelatin has cooled, in a bowl measure 1 1/4 cups of the remaining pineapple juice (adding cold water, if necessary to make the 1 1/4 cups liquid.) Whisk the pudding mix into this liquid until smooth. Whisk cooled gelatin mixture into pudding; fold in whipped topping, crushed pineapple and cake cubes. Spread mixture in an 11x7" glass dish. Refrigerate for 4-6 hours; sprinkle with the toasted coconut before cutting into squares to serve.

Spinach Dip

Ingredients

- 1 (10 ounce) package frozen chopped spinach, thawed and drained
- 1 (16 ounce) container sour cream
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 envelope dry vegetable soup mix
- 1 (8 ounce) can water chestnuts, drained and

In a medium bowl, mix together spinach, sour cream, mayonnaise, dry vegetable soup mix, water chestnuts and green onions. Cover and chill in the refrigerator approximately 2 hours before serving.

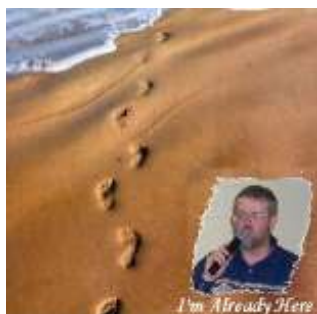

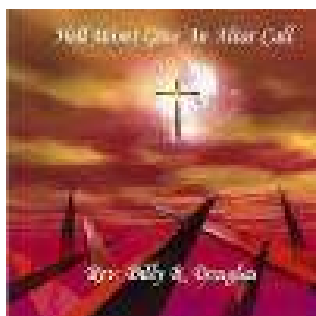

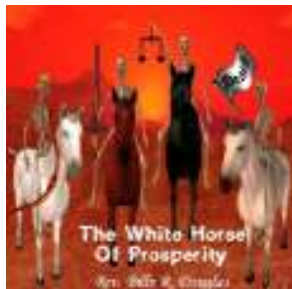

Bacon Cheese Ball

Ingredients

- 1 pound bacon
- 2 (8 ounce) packages cream cheese, softened
- 3 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 1 green onion, chopped
- 1 cup chopped pecans

Directions

In a large skillet fry the bacon. Remove the bacon from the skillet and drain on paper towels. Chop or break the cooled bacon into small pieces. In a medium-size mixing bowl, combine cream cheese, bacon, mayonnaise, and green onions. When mixed well, form 2 balls out of the mixture. Cover and refrigerate 3 to 4 hours, or overnight.

Before serving, roll the cheese balls in the chopped pecans.

Clay Ornaments

Ingredients

- 4 c. flour
- 1 c. salt
- 1 1/2 c. water
- Cookie Cutters

Directions

Mix in a large bowl the flour and salt. Add water gradually. Knead dough for 5 to 10 minutes. Shape dough. Keep unused dough in a plastic bag while shaping some. Bake 10 to 15 minutes at 325 degrees. Time depends upon the shape of figures. Cool.

Paint and decorate.

Apple Dumplings

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 2 cups water
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon, divided
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutmeg, divided
- 1/4 cup butter or margarine
- 2/3 cup sugar
- 2 (15-ounce) packages refrigerated piecrusts
- 8 medium apples, peeled and cored*
- 3 tablespoons butter or margarine, cut up
- Vanilla ice cream (optional)

Bring 1 1/2 cups sugar, 2 cups water, 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon, and 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg to a boil in a saucepan over medium-high heat, stirring constantly; reduce heat, and simmer, stirring occasionally, 10 minutes. Remove from heat, and stir in 1/4 cup butter. Set syrup aside. Combine 2/3 cup sugar, remaining 1/4 teaspoon cinnamon, and remaining 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg. Cut piecrusts in half, and roll into 8-inch circles. Place 1 apple in center of each circle. Sprinkle each evenly with sugar mixture; dot evenly with 3 tablespoons butter. Fold dough over apples, pinching to seal. Place in a lightly greased 13- x 9-inch baking dish. Drizzle with syrup.

Bake at 375° for 40 to 45 minutes.

Serve with vanilla ice cream, if desired.

Miniature Pecan Tassies

CRUST:

- 1 (3 oz. pkg. cream cheese
- 1 c. sifted all purpose flour
- 1 stick butter

For the crust, have all ingredients at room temperature. Mix together and chill for at least 2 hours.

Pinch off dough and shape into two dozen 1 inch balls. Place balls in 1 3/4 inch ungreased muffin tins. With thumb, press dough against bottom and sides of tins. Set aside and mix filling.

FILLING:

- 1 egg, beaten
- 3/4 c. brown sugar, firmly packed
- 1 tbsp. soft butter
- 1 tbsp. vanilla
- 2/3 c. chopped pecans

For filling, mix all ingredients together. Fill each tassie 3/4 full. Bake at 325 degrees for 25 minutes.

Cool on cake rack. To remove, run sharp knife around edge and lift out.
