Banana Split Cake

Ingredients

- Vanilla Wafers
- 1 (8 oz) pkg cream cheese
- 2 eggs
- 1 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1 stick butter melted
- bananas
- 1 large can crushed pineapple in syrup, drained
- 1 large bowl Cool Whip

1st Layer: crushed vanilla wafers about 1/2 inch.

2nd layer: Cream together cream cheese, eggs, powdered sugar and butter. **3rd Layer:** Sliced bananas. **4th Layer:** crushed pineapple.

5th Layer: Cool Whip.

Garnish with Marciano Cherries

Christmas Cheese Ball

Ingredients

- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened
- 2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- 2 green onions, chopped
- 1 (2 ounce) jar diced pimientos, drained
- 2 tablespoons butter or margarine, melted
- 2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- Assorted crackers

In a mixing bowl, beat cream cheese until fluffy. Beat in cheddar cheese, onions, pimientos, butter and Worcestershire sauce. Press into a small bowl; smooth top. Cover and refrigerate. Remove from the refrigerator 15 minutes before unmolding. Serve with crackers.

Snowflake Biscuits

- 1 c. milk
- 2 tbsp. sugar
- 1/2 tbsp. salt
- 2 tbsp. Crisco
- 1 cake yeast
- 1 1/2 c. flour

Scald milk, add sugar, salt and Crisco. When lukewarm add yeast to dissolve, add flour. Beat well and let rise. Add 1/2 cup flour to knead. Roll 1/2 inch thick, cut with snowflake cookie cutter, brush with butter and bake 20 minutes at 400 degrees.

Red Velvet Cake

- 2 1/2 cups flour
- 1/2 cup cocoa
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup (2 sticks) butter, softened
- 2 cups sugar
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 bottle (1 ounce) Red Food Color
- 2 teaspoons Vanilla Extract

Frosting

- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) butter, softened
- 2 tablespoons sour cream
- 2 teaspoons Vanilla Extract
- 1 box (16 ounces) confectioners' sugar

Preheat oven to 350°F. Grease and flour 2 (9-inch) round cake pans. Sift flour, cocoa powder, baking soda and salt; set aside. Beat butter and granulated sugar in large bowl with electric mixer on medium speed 5 minutes or until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs, 1 at a time. Mix in sour cream, milk, food color and vanilla. Gradually beat in flour mixture on low speed until just blended. Do not overbeat. Pour batter into prepared pans. Bake 35 to 40 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool in pan 10 minutes. Remove from pans; cool completely on wire rack. **For the Frosting,** beat cream cheese, butter, sour cream and vanilla in large bowl until light and fluffy. Gradually beat in confectioners' sugar until smooth. Fill and frost cooled cake with frosting.

Cheezy Mexicorn Casserole

Ingredients

- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 (5 ounce) can evaporated milk
- 3 tablespoons melted butter or margarine, divided
- 3 (11 ounce) cans Green Giant Mexicorn, drained
- 2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1 cup crushed Ritz crackers, divided

In a large bowl, combine the eggs, milk, 2 tablespoons butter, corn, cheese and 1/2 cup cracker crumbs. Spoon into a greased 11-in. x 7-in. x 2-in. baking dish. Toss the remaining crumbs and butter; sprinkle over corn mixture. Bake, uncovered, at 350 degrees for 25-30 minutes or until edges are bubbly.

Chocolate Chip Sugar Cookies

Ingredients

- 1/3 cup butter, softened
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 3/4 cup white sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup buttermilk
- 1 1/2 cups mini semi-sweet chocolate chips

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Lightly grease a medium cookie sheet. Cream butter or margarine, brown sugar and sugar in a large mixer bowl until light and fluffy. Add egg and vanilla; beat well. In a separate bowl, combine flour, baking soda, baking powder and salt; add alternately with buttermilk to creamed mixture. Beat well. Stir in chips. Drop by rounded teaspoons onto the prepared cookie sheet. Bake for 10-12 minutes in the preheated oven, or until lightly browned. Remove from cookie sheet and cool.

Million Dollar Fudge

Ingredients

- 4 1/2 cups white sugar
- 1 pinch salt
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1 (12 fluid ounce) can evaporated milk
- 2 cups chopped nuts
- 1 (12 ounce) package semisweet chocolate chips
- 12 (1 ounce) squares German sweet chocolate
- 2 cups marshmallow creme

Butter two 9x9 inch baking pans and set aside. Place chocolate chips, German chocolate, marshmallow creme, and nuts into a large mixing bowl. Set aside. In a 4 quart saucepan, combine sugar, salt, butter, and evaporated milk. Stir over low heat until the sugar dissolves. Bring to a boil, and cook for 6 minutes. Pour boiling syrup over ingredients in bowl, beat until all chocolate is melted. Pour into prepared pans. Let stand a few hours before cutting.

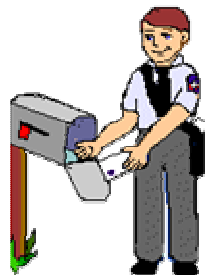
