REESIE'S RECIPES

Strawberry Punch

- 3 sm. pkg. strawberry jello
- 1 pkg. strawberry kool-aid
- 3 c. sugar
- 4 c. hot water
- 12 oz. frozen orange juice
- 6 oz. frozen lemonade
- 1 gallon cold water
- 2 qt. ginger ale
- 1/2 gallon strawberry ice cream

Mix first 4 ingredients until well dissolved. Add juices and cold water. At time of serving add the ginger ale and ice cream.

Peanut Butter Cheese Ball

- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, at room temperature
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 3/4 cup creamy peanut butter (not all-natural)
- 3 tablespoons packed brown sugar
- 3/4 cup milk chocolate chips
- 3/4 cup peanut butter chips

Graham cracker sticks, teddy grahams, and/or apple slices for dipping

Beat cream cheese, powdered sugar, peanut butter and brown sugar in large mixer bowl until blended. Spoon onto a large piece of plastic wrap; bring up all four corners and twist tightly forming into a ball shape. Freeze for 1 hour 30 minutes or until firm enough to keep its shape. Place peanut butter and chocolate chips in flat dish. Remove plastic wrap from ball and roll ball into morsels to completely cover, pressing morsels into the ball if necessary. Place ball on serving dish; cover and freeze for 2 hours or until almost firm. (Can be made ahead. If frozen overnight, thaw at room temperature for 20 to 30 minutes before serving.) Serve with graham cracker sticks, teddy grahams, or apple slices for dipping or spreading.

Jalapeno Popper Dip

- 1 4oz can diced jalapenos, well drained
- 1 8oz package cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup sour cream
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 3/4 cup + 1/4 cup shredded parmesan cheese
- 1 cup Italian seasoned bread crumbs
- 4 tablespoons butter or margarine, melted
- 1 tablespoon dried parsley

In a mixer or by hand, combine cream cheese and sour cream. Add cheddar cheese, 3/4 cup parmesan cheese, and diced jalapenos, mix well. Spoon into 8x8 baking dish, spreading evenly. Blend bread crumbs, melted butter, 1/4 cup shredded parmesan cheese, and dried parsley, using a fork or your fingers, until crumbly. Sprinkle the buttery crumb topping evenly over the cream cheese mixture. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes, or until hot and breadcrumbs are golden brown. Do not overcook. Serve with bread or crackers.

Cheese Ball

- 2 (8oz) cream cheese
- 2 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 1 T. chopped green pepper
- 1 T. chopped green onion
- 2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tsp. lemon juice
- dash of salt
- 1 pkg. thin beef slices
- 1 pkg. dry onion soup mix
- Pecans finely chopped

Mix softened cheese well. Add the rest of the ingredients except pecans. Mix well. Shape into a ball and roll in pecans. Refrigerate.



Got Breath? Give Praise!

Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power. Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness. Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp. Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs. Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals. Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD. Psalms 150:1-6

Years ago the milk producers came up with the “Got Milk?” slogan; many centuries before that, God brought to us a similar command, “Got Breath? Give Praise!” Did you notice how many times we are told to praise within these short six verses? A baker’s dozen, thirteen times, in thirteen ways, we are told to give praise to the only true God. Go ahead count them for yourself, thirteen times! What does the word praise mean? Glad you asked! The Hebrew word means “to be clear, to shine; hence, to make a show, to boast; and thus to be clamorously foolish; to rave; to celebrate; to foolishly give glory, give light, to praise, rage, and shine.” As you can see, we ought to be doing more than just whispering, “Praise the Lord” or “Praise the Lord anyway” with a half-hearted shrug of the shoulders. Even though the day of “Thanksgiving” has come and gone, you need to realize that EVERY day should be a day of praise and thanksgiving; EVERY day that you have breath, you are to be clamorously foolish about Him, and to Him with thanksgiving. EVERY day that He has blessed you with life, you should give Him glory; give light to His goodness and awesome holiness in the midst of this dark world. If you look again at these verses, you see that it’s about making noise; it’s not just noise though, it’s the noise of praise directed to the God of all. Perhaps you are like me and don’t like to draw attention to yourself. Read this chapter again; it’s not about drawing attention to yourself; it’s about drawing attention to the Holy Creator Jesus. It’s about glorifying Him, shining the spotlight on Him; it’s about us doing our best to make sure He gets the attention and focus that He deserves and commands. Shout “hallelujah,” which is praise God! Where? EVERYWHERE! On the earth and in the sky, give Him praise! At the gas pump, in the store, at work or at play, let the world know that Jesus lives, Jesus saves, and Jesus is coming again! Giving praise to God is a witness in itself; if the Spirit leads you to share the gospel with someone specific, do so! If we gave more verbal praise or more physical praise in public, we’d have many more opportunities to witness of the saving power of Jesus, even if it’s only to the officers dragging us away. Seriously though, people clap at movies and concerts, giving praise to men; they are clamorously foolish at sporting events and plays, giving praise to men, at political events or social events they shout out, celebrate, rain or shine—to men and for men. Let’s take our eyes off men and give glory and honor to whom it is due—the LORD!

Bonus Recipes

Amish Broccoli Salad

- 1 head broccoli, chopped
- 1 head cauliflower, chopped
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 pound bacon, fried and crumbled
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

Mix mayo, sour cream, sugar and salt. Pour over broccoli and cauliflower and coat well. Fold in bacon and cheese. Chill and serve.

Grinch Punch

- 1/3 cup sugar
- 6 tablespoons plus 1-1/2 teaspoons water
- 1/3 cup evaporated milk
- 1/2 teaspoon almond extract
- 12 drops neon green food coloring
- 1 bottle (2 liters) lemon-lime soda, chilled
- 2 pints vanilla ice cream

In a large saucepan, combine sugar and water. Cook and stir over medium heat until sugar is dissolved; remove from the heat. Stir in milk and extract. Transfer to a bowl; cool to room temperature. Cover and refrigerate until chilled. Just before serving, transfer milk mixture to a punch bowl. Stir in the food coloring and soda. Top with scoops of ice cream.

II. THE PURPOSE OF THE CROSS - A. About Making A Statement Since way back in the Old Testament, the Lord has been telling me of His love for them, Deuteronomy 7:7-8 - The Lord did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people: 8 But because the Lord loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers, hath the Lord brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Jeremiah 31:3 - The Lord hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee. However, in Christ's death on the cross, God was able to declare boldly, for all to see, His boundless, matchless love for the lost of this world. Romans 5:6-8 - For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. 7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. 8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. The cross is God's statement of love to the world! John 15:13 - Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. B. About Providing Salvation The Bible, tells us that there is no other way to cleanse sin, but through the sacrifice of an innocent one in the of the guilty one. Hebrews 9:22 - And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission. This is seen all the way back in the beginning when Adam and Eve sinned in the Garden of Eden. This same line of thought continues all the way through the days of the Tabernacle and the Temple. There, sin was atoned for by the blood of sheep, bulls and goats, but it was never taken away. Hebrews 10:4 - For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. Hebrews 10:10-11 - By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. 11 And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: However, the Lord Jesus went to the cross and died for the sins of humanity. When He did, His death on the cross forever settled the sin debt of man. Hebrews 10:12-14 - But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; 13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool. 14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. It is clear yet? If not, then listen to these two precious passages of Scripture, Revelation 1:5 - And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, 1st Peter 1:18-19 - Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; 19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: C. About Defeating Satan Ever since the Lucifer sinned and became the devil, he has been in the business of trying to hinder the work of God. He loves nothing better than keeping souls in bondage and seeing them condemned to Hell. Ephesians 2:1-3 - And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins; 2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: 3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others. But, when Jesus went to the cross, I am of the opinion that the devil thought he had won the victory that day. I am sure he rejoiced when Jesus cried out, "It is finished!" But, what the devil did not know that day was that the Lord Jesus wasn't planning to stay dead! Maybe the devil should have listened closer and he would have understood that Jesus did not say, "I am finished!" He said "It is finished!" You see, when Jesus died on the cross, He did not die to stay dead, but He rose from the dead three days later and nailed old slew foot's coffin lid shut! The Bible tells us that the victory over the devil is found in the blood of the Lamb. Revelation 12:11 - And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. III. THE POWER OF THE CROSS When the power of the cross is appropriated, three great and wonderful things take place. Notice what they are: A. Sin Dies When a person places his/her faith in the shed blood of the Lord Jesus Christ, that person is forever changed! The chains of sin are broken. (Romans 6:14 - For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.) They are made into a new creature. (2nd Corinthians 5:17 - Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.) Now, the new born believer does not have to live his life in bondage to sin. B. Hell Is Defeated No blood washed, blood bought individual will ever experience the flames and fires of Hell! One of the most precious verses in the Bible pertaining to this subject is found in John 5:24 - Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. There, the Bible tells us that we will never come into condemnation! Romans 8:1 - There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. Thank God, no child of God will ever have to go to Hell, Satan will not get his wish! That ought to cause us to rejoice! C. Heaven Is Delivered The blood is the key that unlocks the gates of glory! When the blood is applied, the child of God becomes instantly destined for an eternity in Heaven with the Lord! That is His promise to every believer in John 14:1-3 - Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. 2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. And, there is only one way to get to that glorious place, John 3:3 - Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Conclusion: When evangelist John Wesley was returning home from a service one night, he was robbed. The thief, however, found his victim to have only a little money and some Christian literature. As the bandit was leaving, Wesley called out, "Stop! I have something more to give you." The surprised robber paused. "My friend," said Wesley, "you may live to regret this sort of life. If you ever do, here's something to remember: 'The blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin!'" The thief hurried away, and Wesley prayed that his words might bear fruit. Years later, Wesley was greeting people after a Sunday service when he was approached by a stranger. What a surprise to learn that this visitor, now a believer in Christ as a successful businessman, was the one who had robbed him years before! "I owe it all to you," said the transformed man. "Oh no, my friend," Wesley exclaimed, "not to me, but to the precious blood of Christ that cleanses us from all sin!" Has the blood been applied to your life? Is your name written down in Heaven? When Osella and I worked as Directors here at the homeless shelter in St. Joseph, a young lady in her early 30's came to stay: we'll call her Sarah. She wasn't your ordinary street person. The first thing we noticed was her designer jeans and designer shoes - and her hands were soft and supple as though she had just come from a salon. Where she had come from was just the opposite of pampering. She had been beaten almost daily by her husband who not only bruised her body but broke her bones and broke her spirit. She became an alcoholic to anesthetize the pain as her husband was a prominent Physician and she couldn't get help for fear of his colleagues finding out.. So, Vodka became her drug of choice, as she began to drink the pain away. It was Christmas time when Sarah came to stay with us. Remember this was a Homeless shelter and we didn't have much in the way of decorations and what we had was old and drab - with no finances to get anything better. Going through the motions of stringing tinsel here and hanging an ornament there, we were decorating ... but no one had "the spirit" of Christmas; that is not until Sarah asked if she could help. It was the first we had seen Sarah smile and amidst her awesome pain and a dislocated shoulder that was still healing, she went to work with pieces of ribbon and that old silver tinsel, and made masterpieces of every ornament. With every stroke of genius and curl of the ribbon, Sarah brought a little more Christmas "spirit" into the Center. Singing and laughing midst the grimacing pain, she had single-handedly captured the "JOY" of Christmas and pointed all of us to the central theme of Christmas, which was, "Jesus is the Reason for the Season". When she was finished it looked as though the top decorators of Macy's had walked in and decked the Halls with boughs of holly. When we asked her where she had learned to create such beauty, she told us her story. You see, she wasn't always an alcoholic. She had a beautiful, large home, which she decorated for every season and holiday. But her "Physician" husband would come home from work and for no reason, would beat her and then cry and say he was sorry, until this last time when he dislocated her shoulder and threw her out. She had no place else to go, so she came to the Center. Out of the darkness of Sarah's life, Jesus came that Christmas and she bowed to the King of Kings and Lord of Lords and gave her heart to Him. Just like that "first" Christmas, God sent a star to point our way back to what was important.
