2nd Kings 4:1-6

Now there cried a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets unto Elisha, saying, Thy servant my husband is dead; and thou knowest that thy servant did fear the LORD: and the creditor is come to take unto him my two sons to be bondmen. And Elisha said unto her, What shall I do for thee? tell me, what hast thou in the house? And she said, Thine handmaid hath not any thing in the house, save a pot of oil. Then he said, Go, borrow thee vessels abroad of all thy neighbours, even empty vessels; borrow not a few. And when thou art come in, thou shalt shut the door upon thee and upon thy sons, and shalt pour out into all those vessels, and thou shalt set aside that which is full. So she went from him, and shut the door upon her and upon her sons, who brought the vessels to her; and she poured out. And it came to pass, when the vessels were full, that she said unto her son, Bring me yet a vessel. And he said unto her, There is not a vessel more. And the oil stayed.

There is a tale of a young man who was desperately seeking God. He went to a well-known and wise old man for help. He asked him how he could find God. Sugar Free Strawberry Pie

2 cups water
 2 Tablespoon corn starch
 2 (3 oz.) pkgs. Raspberry sugar free jello
 4 to 5 cups sliced strawberries, frozen, no sugar
 Pie crust, baked
 Cool Whip

Heat water and corn starch. Remove from heat. Add jello. Let cool. Mix in frozen strawberries. Pour into baked pie shell. Chill and serve with cool whip.

Macaroni & Spam Salad submitted by Lula Chancellor

1 Box Macaroni
 1 Can Spam
 1 (8 oz) block cheddar cheese
 Green Onions
 Mustard
 Salad dressing

Boil macaroni and drain. Dice up spam and cheddar cheese and add to cooled macaroni. Dice and add green onions. Mix well and add mustard and salad dressing as desired.

Cheddar Chili Pie

1 cup flour
 3/4 cup Jiffy corn bread mix
 3/4 teaspoon salt
 1/2 cup butter
 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese
 2 tablespoons water
 1/2 lb ground beef
 1/2 cup onion, chopped
 1 (15 ounce) can diced tomatoes
 1 (15 ounce) can chili beans, drained
 1 teaspoon chili powder
 1/8 teaspoon pepper

In large bowl, mix flour, Jiffy mix, and 1/4 teaspoon salt. Cut in butter until mixture resembles coarse meal. Stir in 1/2 cup cheese and the water. Press firmly to bottom and sides of 9" pie plate. Bake in preheated 400* oven for 10 minutes. Cool. Cook beef and onion in large skillet over medium heat until meat is browned and onion is tender. Add tomatoes, beans, chili powder, 1/2 teaspoons salt and pepper; simmer 15 minutes, stirring often. Turn into pie shell. Cover with cheddar cheese. Bake on 350 degrees 20-30 minutes, or until filling is bubbly and cheese is melted.

Lime Jello Salad

Ingredients

3 Oz. Pkg. lime jello
 1 cup boiling water
 1 small can crushed pineapple, drained
 1/2 cup walnuts, chopped
 8 oz cream cheese softened
 3/4 cup sugar
 8 oz. cool whip

Stir jello into boiling water until dissolved. Chill until almost thickened. Beat cream cheese and sugar well together. Fold jello into cheese mixture. Fold in cool whip and put into mold. Refrigerate.

Six Layer Breakfast Casserole

Ingredients

6 eggs
 1/4 cup heavy cream
 1 teaspoon salt
 1/4 teaspoon black pepper, ground
 16 oz pkg. hot roll sausage, cooked, crumbled, and drained
 1/4 cup jalapeno pepper, diced
 1/2 cup cheddar cheese, shredded
 2 tablespoons garlic, minced
 1 teaspoon ground cumin
 4 slices bread

Preheat oven to 350. Mix the eggs, heavy cream, salt, and pepper in a bowl. In a separate bowl place the cooked sausage, jalapeno pepper, cheese, garlic, and cumin. Place a third of the egg mixture in the bottom of a 2-quart baking dish. Place a slice of bread into the dish. Place 1/3 of the amount of sausage mixture onto the slice of bread. Repeat until last slice of bread is on top. Add the remaining 1/3 sausage ingredients evenly across the top slice of bread and bake in oven for 15 minutes.

All of us at one time or another in our life no doubt have lost friends and loved ones that have went on to be with the LORD. And I am sure like me many of you have thought...*I wish I had one more chance to talk to them...many of us would want to tell them how much we loved them or maybe a chance to tell them goodbye one last time.* Nine years ago my Pastor...my friend and the man that I looked up to probably more than any man I have ever known in this life went home to be with the LORD. His name was Lindel Hinton...he was not a rich man...he was not even well educated or at least not by the standards of the religious crowd...yet he was the wisest man that I have ever known. As I write this article and look back over the years since the day he went to be with the LORD...I began to wonder just what I would say to him...what I would say if I had one last chance. I could certainly tell him how much I loved his preaching and WOW could that man preach...I could tell him just what it meant to me to have him put his arms around me and tell me that he was proud of me...but then again I am at a loss for words to describe how that felt. No...I think if I had one last chance I would thank him for a song that I heard him sang so many times...the name of the song is "To Be Like Jesus"...did he have a heavenly voice? No...For you see it wasn't the way that he sang the song even though I loved to hear him sing it...but that wasn't what made such a lasting impression on me...an impression that I still carry with me today...even nine years after he has gone home. No it wasn't the way he sang the song BUT rather the way HE LIVED THE SONG...for that I will be forever changed. In closing I would like to share some of the words of that song with you....*To be like Jesus...To be like Jesus...All that I ask is to be like Him...All through lifes journey...From Earth to Glory...All that I ask is to be like Him.*

Seeking The Lord - Again

"And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever. 1 Chronicles 28:9 (KJV)

What a powerful admonition and blessing that a Father can bestow upon his son. Obviously David was wounded in his spirit for his wrongs in life. Look at what he says there in verse 2 and 3 of 1 Chronicles 28: *"Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: As for me, I had in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building: But God said unto me, Thou shalt not build an house for my name, because thou hast been a man of war, and hast shed blood."* In his quest to be King and leader of the people Israel, to be a man after God's own heart, David found himself in many precarious situations being led by his lust rather than by the spirit of God. Sound familiar? I can't tell you how many times I have thought I was working for God and yet I have merely been busy with something of my own choosing rather than that of God's anointing upon me. Now, I've got to tell you: I'd much rather have His anointing than I would be busy at something that was merely of my choosing. But wait! Just as David was effective in what he did in God's Name, and just as he worked the works of God as he seen fit to do it and was successful as a king and leader of the nation of Israel, he didn't have the approval of the Lord. You and I can be as busy as we want to be for God - maybe even trying to be better at something than somebody else is, yet if it isn't what the Lord wants; if it doesn't have his stamp of approval on it, and is not the will of God for your life, God will express his displeasure in one form or another because it is not what He desired for you. In David's case, it wasn't that he had been doing the wrong thing - he just hadn't been doing it the right way. Unless we seek God every day - with our whole heart, we will never know His complete will for our lives.

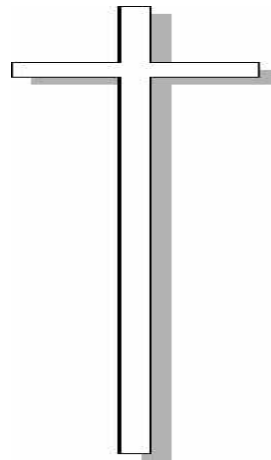
