"God's Love"

by Evangelist Mike Heltsley

1st John 4:16 - And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.

As we look at the evil in this sin-sick world it is easy to see why non-believers say that God cannot be a God of love. It's hard to find words to describe how low mankind has sunk and, despite all the empty talk, things are only going to get worse until Jesus returns. God is allowing the world to continue on its sinful free-fall into greater filth, violence and apostasy. However, there is a limit as in Acts 17:31 - Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead. [that is, Jesus]. But why is Jesus so slow in returning? Speaking about Jesus' return, 2nd Peter 3:9 gives the answer where it says, The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. It is because of His great love for mankind that God is patiently waiting for sinners to repent and then He will return to judge the world with justice and great wrath. If He was not patient and loving then He would have returned to destroy all sinners long ago. So, lets look at the love of God. The cross - God's love is not a dizzy-headed, fuzzy feeling that fades away after a honeymoon period. His love is an unchanging, solid and selfless commitment. For over three years Jesus walked towards the cross knowing the awful agony that He would soon endure. On the night before He was crucified, He was in such anguish that, while praying, "his sweat was like drops of blood" (Luke 22:44). This occurs with extreme trauma but despite the trauma Isa 50:7 tells that "He set His face like flint" in His determination to suffer on the cross to save you and I from hell. Now, THAT is love! On the way to the cross, after being whipped and beaten, Jesus was more concerned about the women weeping for Him than for Himself (Luke 23:27-31). On the cross, in awful agony, He selflessly continued to think of others. In mortal agony - He forgave a thief being crucified beside Him (Luke 23:39-43); He asked God to forgive His executioners (Luke 23:33-34) and He asked a disciple to care for His mother (John 19:26-27). Through all of this, God watched Jesus' agony and Isaiah 53:10 tells us, Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in his hand. We sinned against God and Jesus paid the penalty of death for us. Now, THAT is love far beyond measure and understanding. In John 15:13, Jesus said, Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. God's love since the cross - God's love did not end with the cross. He continues to lovingly draw the unsaved to Himself and sends the Holy Spirit to live within all who repent of their sins and put their trust in Jesus. The Holy Spirit lovingly and patiently disciplines and guides believers to be conformed to God's will. It is because of His love that He disciplines us, even severely if necessary. Hebrews 12:5-6 tell us, And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him: 6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth. The Prodigal Son is a perfect example of God's patient love and discipline. This young man arrogantly asked for his inheritance while his father was alive and then went off to waste the money in wild living. When his money was gone, he ended up feeding pigs that were eating better than he was. These conditions caused him come to his senses and repent so he went back home hoping to work for his father as a slave. To his surprise, his father saw him in the distance and ran to him and welcomed him back home as his son, not as a slave. This parable is given to tell us how our heavenly Father controls our circumstances and emotions to bring us to repentance whenever we go off the path of holiness. God is extremely patient and loving toward us. Psalm 100:5 says, For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations. Finally - 1st John 3:16 - Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. We should not have the slightest doubt about the love God has for each one of us because His love and faithfulness are ever present in our lives. Nor should we doubt the love He has for the unsaved as He continues to patiently draw them to Himself in the hope that they will repent. If anyone says that God is not loving and asks why He does not put an end to evil then we can safely tell them that He plans to do that soon enough but in the meantime He is waiting for them to come to repentance. As sure as night follows day, the present time of Love and Grace will end and God's fierce wrath will be poured out on the earth. Amen.

**REESIE'S RECIPES****Potato Chip Cookies**

- 1 cup butter-flavored shortening
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 cups crushed potato chips
- 1 cup butterscotch chips

Preheat oven to 375°. In a large bowl, cream shortening and sugars until light and fluffy. Beat in eggs. In another bowl, whisk flour and baking soda; gradually beat into creamed mixture. Stir in potato chips and butterscotch chips. Drop by tablespoonfuls 2 in. apart onto ungreased baking sheets. Bake 10-12 minutes or until golden brown. Cool on pans 1 minute. Remove to wire racks to cool

Deluxe Meatloaf

- 2 pounds lean ground beef
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 cup dry bread crumbs
- 2/3 cup milk
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 3 tablespoons horseradish
- 1 teaspoon prepared mustard
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1/2 cup chili sauce

In a large bowl, combine first nine ingredients and mix well. Press into a 9-in. x 5-in. loaf pan. Bake at 350° for 1 hour. Remove from oven; drain. Spoon chili sauce over loaf. Return to oven and bake 20 minutes longer or until no pink remains

Chocolate Pecan Pie


- 1/2 cup chopped pecans
- 1/2 cup dark chocolate chips
- 1 frozen pie shell (9 inches)
- 3 eggs
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 cup dark corn syrup
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup pecan halves

Sprinkle chopped pecans and chocolate chips into pastry shell. In a small bowl, whisk the eggs, sugar, corn syrup, butter and vanilla. Pour into pastry; arrange pecan halves over filling. Bake at 350° for 55-60 minutes or until set. Cool on a wire rack.

Campfire Stew

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 can (15 ounces) mixed vegetables, drained
- 1 can (10-3/4 ounces) condensed tomato soup
- 1 can (10-1/2 ounces) condensed vegetable beef soup
- 1/4 cup water
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper

In a large saucepan, cook beef over medium heat until no longer pink; drain. Stir in the remaining ingredients. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 8-10 minutes or until heated through.

From Impossible to I'm possible

Luke 8:49-56

Faith that touches Jesus is surely rewarded. He touches back. We have seen throughout the Bible and will continue to see that Jesus has power over ALL spheres of life. He can calm the storms; He can make the blind to see; He can loosen the tongue to speak. With Jesus, NOTHING is impossible. He can meet a financial need and He can lift an oppressive burden. Jesus IS enough; and with Him, nothing is IMPOSSIBLE. People will accuse you, the world will mock you, things will look dark and drear; however, regardless the situation, Jesus IS enough; Jesus turns the impossible to the possible. Regardless the accusation, Jesus IS enough. Regardless of the problem, Jesus IS enough and NOTHING is impossible for Him. For Jesus says, "I'm Possible." He points to the Father and says, with God, ALL things are possible. Here in Luke we have a ruler that came to Jesus on behalf of his daughter. Oh how he must have loved this little 12 year old girl. I can imagine, I have an 11 year old girl. Who wouldn't do anything for any of their children of any age. Death seems like the great impossibility. We often look at death as finality. Jesus took the faith that this man came to Him with and bolstered it. He looked at this man with compassion; this man's faith had touched Jesus and now Jesus touched back, "Fear not, believe only...When Jesus got there he threw out all who had no faith. Jesus took this little girl by the hand and she arose. There was no power left in that body; she couldn't help to respond but Jesus did it ALL. It was the faith of the father that touched Jesus and Jesus touched back. Jesus not only touches the physically dead, He is the ONLY One who can raise the spiritually dead as well. Do you remember when we had no power of our own to touch Jesus? (Romans 5:6-12) You probably have those on your prayer list who seem to be impossible for God to reach. You've been praying in faith, witnessing in faith and it's been so long. Perhaps the devil's been whispering in your ear, "it's IMPOSSIBLE!" Friends, DON'T GIVE UP! Keep praying, keep your faith and pray. Jesus takes the IMPOSSIBLE and he says, "I'M POSSIBLE." I can't word what I want to say any better than Adam Clarke does here, so him I quote: "So the soul that is dead in trespasses and sins - that is, sentenced to death because of transgression - and is thus dead in law, can only be restored to spiritual life by the mighty power of the Lord Jesus; because He alone has made the atonement, and He alone can pardon transgression. If the spiritually dead person be utterly unconcerned about the state and fate of his soul, let a converted relative either bring him to Christ by leading him to hear the unadulterated Gospel of the kingdom; or bring Christ to him by fervent, faithful, and persevering prayer." My friend, Jesus IS enough and with Him NOTHING is impossible because He's the One who says, "I'm Possible." Without Jesus we'd never find our way to God the Father. Without Jesus it's impossible to be saved, you'd still be dead in your sin without Him; but praise God, with Him ALL things, even moving from death to life is possible because He is the "I'm Possible." It takes faith to touch Jesus on behalf of someone else; but IF you touch Jesus, He'll touch back! NOTHING is too hard for Jesus. FAITH is the VICTORY! Come to Jesus in belief. Hidden within the word "Impossible" is the reason God says that with Him NOTHING is impossible. Within this word of doubt and fear (Impossible) we see why God says that with Him ALL things ARE possible. Have faith. If we'll only change our trust from the problem to the Provider, if we'll only focus our faith on the Solution Giver instead of the sinking ground, if we'll only believe in the Word instead of the world, we'll hear God say, "Nothing is Impossible because I'm possible" Trust the "I AM" today.
