Do all things without murmurings and disputings: That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom you shine as lights in the world; Holding forth the word of life."*

Lately the Lord has brought part of the above scripture to my attention often. "Do all things without murmuring and disputing." Every time it comes to mind I remind myself that every correction the Lord gives is good for me and I am mindful to give these corrections deliberate and prayerful attention. If you will listen closely to the Lord, He will always send correction before trouble comes, before you've acted on your emotions or fleshly desires and caused pain and heartache for yourself or someone close to you. Proverbs says that a wise man will see trouble in the path and step aside and be spared, but a fool will rush in and be destroyed. When you listen and heed the corrections of the Lord, you are like the wise man but when you stubbornly refuse to hear you become like the fool. I shared this correction with my sister Carol and the Lord dealt with her to look up the opposites of each key word. The opposite of murmuring is, praise and rejoicing. The opposite of disputing is, harmony. So we could say it this way, "Do all things with praise, rejoicing and harmony." When you approach any task with this attitude you will find there is no more room for murmuring and disputing, (arguing and fighting). Murmuring, complaining and disputing never start with an action, they always start with a thought. The action only comes after you've allowed the initial thought to take root in your heart by meditating and mulling over it. The wise thing to do is stop these things before they become hurtful actions, while still in thought form. So the next time your thoughts become dark with murmuring, complaining or disputings, remember this correction and stop, back up for a minute and read-just your thinking, then approach the situation with an attitude of praise and rejoicing, determined to do things in harmony and peace. You will not only find your task easier to deal with, but you will find this attitude contagious and affecting all those around you. Soon, your co-workers will "catch" your joyful and bright attitude and eventually the entire environment surrounding your tasks will be rearranged for the better by the change in you. May you always be as the wise man who saw trouble in the path and stepped aside. God bless you.

# REESIE'S RECIPES



## Sugar Free Raisin Bars

### Ingredients

- 1 cup raisins
- 1/2 cup water
- 1/4 cup margarine
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 egg, beaten
- 3/4 cup unsweetened applesauce
- Sugar substitute equivalent to 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon vanilla extract

In a saucepan, over medium heat, cook raisins, water, margarine, cinnamon and nutmeg until margarine is melted; continue cooking for 3 minutes. Add all remaining ingredients. Spread into a 8-in square baking dish that has been sprayed with non stick cooking spray. Bake at 350 degrees F for 25-30 minutes or until lightly browned.

## Veggie Pizza

### Ingredients

- 2 cans Crescent Rolls
- 2 8oz Cream Cheese
- 1/2 Cup Mayonnaise
- 3 TBS Pet Milk
- 1 Pkg. Dry Ranch Dressing
- 1 cup Chopped Broccoli
- 1 cup Chopped Cauliflower
- 1 cup Chopped Tomatoes
- grated cheese

Press crescent rolls in baking sheet & press edges together and bake till brown. Cool and spread cream cheese, ranch mix, mayonnaise and milk. Put on other veggies and press down and eat.

## Steak Soup

### Ingredients

- 1 1/2 lb. steak, cubed
- 4 Tbsp. butter
- 1 16 oz. can diced tomatoes
- 3 Tbsp beef base
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 tsp. pepper
- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1 (10 oz) pkg. Frozen mixed vegetables
- 1 cup chopped onion
- 1 cup chopped carrots
- 1/2 cup soft butter
- 1 1/2 cup
- 2 cups water

Brown steak in 4 tablespoons butter. Add 6 cups water, tomatoes, beef base, salt and pepper. Bring to a boil: cover and reduce heat. Simmer for thirty minutes. Add mixed vegetables, celery, onion and carrots. Continue to simmer covered for another thirty minutes. Combine 1/2 cup butter and flour. Gradually blend in 2 cups water. Add to meat: mix, cook and stir until mixture is thick and bubbly.

## Ham Cheese Ball

### Ingredients

- 2 (8 oz) cream cheese
- 4 green onions , chopped
- 1 Tbsp Worcestershire sauce
- 1/2 cup shredded Colby jack cheese
- 6 oz. shaved ham
- 1 cup chopped pecans

Mix all ingredients by hand in large bowl except pecans. Form mixture into one large ball or two small balls. Roll in pecans and refrigerate.

#### Andes Candies Cookies

##### Ingredients

- 3/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 2 Tablespoons water
- 2 eggs
- 2 cups chocolate chips
- 2 1/2 cup flour
- 1 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 3 boxes Andes candies

In sauce pan over low heat, melt butter; add sugar and water. Then add chocolate chips. Stir until partially melted. Remove from heat; stir, then cool for 5 minutes. Add eggs and dry ingredients; mix with a mixer on low speed until blended. Chill 1 hour. Make into little balls and bake on an ungreased cookie sheet at 350 degrees for 10-13 minutes. While still hot, put Andies candy mint on each cookie, let it get soft then swirl mint with spoon. Cool on baking rack.

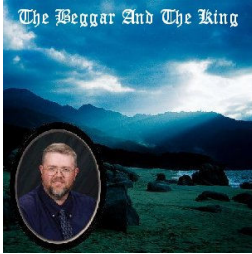
### ***"It's Time To Burn Your Books!"***

*And many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds. Many of them also which used curious arts brought their books together, and burned them before all men: and they counted the price of them, and found it fifty thousand pieces of silver. So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed. Acts 19:18-20*

In the above passage of scripture these people who had practiced witchcraft had now come to know the LORD and been born again. Notice that their first reaction was to bring their books of sorcery and burn them for all to see. These books represented more than just ungodly books...these books contained and represented that which had "hindered" and "kept" them from coming to the LORD. In Gal 3:1 Paul asks this question of the Galatians...*"O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?"* In other words who is it or what is it that that has kept you, hindered you from obeying the Word of God? As we look back over the past year and beyond we can pose that same question to our walk with the LORD...what things have we allowed in our life to keep us from being what we should be in God. In Heb 12:1 Paul again challenges us to examine our life by saying...*"Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us."* Are we willing to look back and see what it is in our life that so easily besets us...and strive to *lay it aside* out of our way *and to run the race* like never before? Just as those believers in the book of Acts brought those books to burn them, maybe its time that we have a *book burning* of our own! The LORD is calling his *people to come out from among them*, cast those things into the fire that have kept us bound and trapped in the same place! To *lay aside* that which so easily keeps us from *running the race* and keeps the *Word of God from having FREE COURSE* in our life. I challenge you to take a small tablet and begin to search your life and begin to write down those things which only you and the LORD know hinders you and keeps you from being as free as you should be. And after searching your soul take that little book and as a demonstration unto the LORD and a confession to him that here they are LORD here are the things that I know have kept me bound...here are the things that I have become comfortable with...I confess these things before you...I am tired of them...I want them out of my life! Then take that book as these believers did and caste it into the fire and watch it burn and *forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, AND press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus!*
