“Standing For The One True Faith”

Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called: ²Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied. ³Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. ⁴For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. Jude 1:1-4

Jude is writing to the believers to be aware of these people that have gradually crept into our assemblies and are under minding the truths of Gods Word, there had been men who had come in to the Church with a cloke of deception so subtly that most of the believers didn't even realize what had taken place, that is exactly the way the devil's crowd operates, their like Satan himself. Look at Genesis 3:1 - Now the serpent was more subtle than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? Satan will try anything to lead you away from the Lord. We can see how he's corrupting the truth especially with different versions of the Bible. The only version we should be reading, studying and using is the King James Version. All these other versions are corrupt and leading many folks down the wrong path by changing the true Word. It's so very important to be grounded in the true Word and to contend for the faith. What does contending for the faith mean? It means to stand true to the forever settled Word, to not compromise, not even a single word. It means to oppose, and expose false prophets and warn the people of their corrupted theology. Here's an example of what Jude is referring to. The following statement was made by Rick Warren who wrote the books: "The Purpose Driven Life" and "The Purpose Driven Church": He said, "no matter how wonderful a translation is, it has its limitations" he then goes on to say "read scripture from a newer translation with all the wonderful translations and paraphrases available today, there is no legitimate reason for complicating the GOOD NEWS with four hundred-year old English. Using the King James Version creates an unnecessary cultural barrier--- clarity is more important than poetry". If we compromise on this, then all kinds of strange doctrines will start coming in the church. Let's take a look at 2nd Peter 2:1-2 - But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. ²And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. Mr. Warren states "there is no legitimate reason for complicating the GOOD NEWS with four hundred-year old English..." This is how the truth gets twisted. Satan knows the Word and he knows how to twist it to benefit him and cause you and me to be deceived. Let me also remind you what Paul says on this in 2nd Corinthians 11:3, 13-15 - ³But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. ¹³For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. ¹⁴And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. ¹⁵Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works. I'm certainly not Rick Warren's judge, or anybody else's judge, but this is what Jude is talking about here, we're not to change God's Word, we're not to encourage people to read these perversions of the Word. There are people that will listen to these so called famous men and will simply take what ever they say must be right, but if what a man says is contrary to what the One True and Living God has already declared, these men are wrong. We're contending today for "the common salvation, -the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. Who are we to trust and believe? Psalm 118:8-9 - It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man. ⁹It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes. Any person that talks down the forever settled Word has allowed himself to become a tool of the Devil, either knowingly, or unknowingly. As we contend for the faith, let's keep in mind that "the faith" is what gets the job done, & not our worldly wisdom or knowledge. Let's take the true Word (King James Version Bible) and use it to defeat the enemy!

REESIE'S RECIPES



Banana Cake

- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 2 large eggs, beaten
- 2 cups flour, sifted
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1/4 teaspoon vanilla
- 3/4 teaspoon baking soda (add to pureed bananas)
- 3 pureed bananas, very ripe

Cream Cheese Frosting:

- 1/2 stick butter, softened
- 8 oz. cream cheese, softened
- 1 box powdered sugar (1 lb.)
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and flour a 9x13" baking pan or two 9" layer cake pans. Cream butter, sugar and eggs. Sift flour several times, then add the salt and baking powder to the flour. To the creamed butter mixture, add the milk and flour (alternating, beginning and ending with flour). Add vanilla and mashed bananas (with the baking soda added to the bananas) to this mixture. Bake layer cakes (9") for 25-30 minutes, oblong (9x13") for 35-40 minutes.

Frosting Directions:

Mix cream cheese and butter until smooth, add sugar and vanilla and blend well. Spread on cooled cake.

Mexican Beef Mac-n-cheese

- 1 1/2 pounds ground beef
- 2 tablespoons dried onion flakes
- 2 boxes Velveeta shells and cheese
- 15 ounces nacho cheese dip
- 1 cup medium or mild salsa
- 1 (7 ounce) can diced green chiles

In a medium skillet over medium-high heat, cook beef with onion flakes until beef is browned. Drain. In a large saucepan, cook the shells and cheese according to package directions. Stir in the meat and onion mixture, nacho cheese dip, salsa and green chiles. Reduce heat and simmer 15 minutes, or until heated through.

Never Fail Divinity

- 1/2 cup water
- 2 cups sugar
- Pinch of salt
- 1/4 tsp cream of tartar
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1 (7 oz.) jar marshmallow crème

Place marshmallow creme in large bowl and beat with vanilla until smooth. Set aside. Combine water, sugar, salt and cream of tartar in sauce pan. Bring to a rolling boil over medium heat. Boil for 2 minutes only. Remove from heat and pour hot syrup into marshmallow crème bowl and beat until candy loses its gloss. Spoon onto wax paper and let cool.

Chicken Pot Pie Casserole

- 2 c. cooked diced chicken
- 1 c. cooked peas
- 1/2 c. celery chopped fine
- 1/2 c. butter
- 3 c. rich chicken stock
- 1 c. cooked sliced carrots
- 1/4 c. chopped onions
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- Dash pepper
- 1/2 c. flour

Saute onions and celery in butter. Make paste of butter and flour, cook gently. Heat stock adding to paste slowly, stir constantly. When blended, beat vigorously and cook 5 minutes. Add salt and pepper. Add vegetables and chicken. Pour mixture into casserole dish sprayed with oil and top with crust.

Crust

- 3 egg yolks, beaten until fluffy
- 3 egg whites, beaten until stiff
- 2 tsp. baking powder
- Dash of salt
- 3/4 c milk
- 1 1/2 c. flour
- 2 tsp. butter

Sift together flour, baking soda and salt. Cut butter into flour and mix well. Add milk to egg yolks and beat vigorously. Mix with flour mixture, then fold in beaten egg whites. Spread over top of casserole to edge of dish. Bake 375 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes or until crust is lightly browned.



Pretenders of the Faith? I DON'T THINK SO!

Read: Acts 6:9 Thru 7:60

Scripture Text: "Ye stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye." Acts 7:51(KJV)

Sometimes diplomacy is just a waste of time. I mean, try to color sin in pastel colors, and tie a ribbon on it, and it is still sin... it's just wrapped in a more palatable facing. I have to admit, Stephen started out really well. He took time trying to explain to his accusers the truth starting back from the time of Abraham, all the way up to the coming of the Messiah, and it's almost like he said, "What's the use? You guys are going to paint the picture to suit you anyway." Then He lets it rip... "Ye stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye. Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? and they have slain them which shewed before of the coming of the Just One; of whom ye have been now the betrayers and murderers: Who have received the law by the disposition of angels, and have not kept it." Uh-oh!!!! Do you hear a bunch of legalistic Christians going, "Stephen... full of the Holy Ghost?" Now, many scholars have translated the phrase, "full of the Holy Ghost" to mean someone who is "full of the grace or graces of God." Again, I guess you can put anything in pastels and put a ribbon on it... but the truth is... the truth isn't always palatable, and it most generally stings like a wasp the size of Texas. But getting down to the truth was at the threshold of eternity for Stephen. And what he said, or did next, was not as important as the fact that he called sin, "sin". He didn't play "deaf or dumb" about what had been going on concerning the power of the Gospel. Stephen was called out of a group of Greek speaking Jews, and there were several of that same group who out of jealousy began to pick at the "signs and wonders" that were evident in Stephen's ministry and that's still being done today. I'll never forget... about 25 years ago, people were shunned for their belief in what was called the "move of God the Holy Spirit". People were actually excommunicated for their beliefs, and consequently sought refuge in other "like" groups who worshipped in the same manner. I know... I was one. One of my best friends who was someone who I looked up to and even went to Bible College with came with three others from the Regional office and asked my wife and I to be packed up and gone by the following Thursday. That was on a Monday that they came. Ever since the Pentecostal Movement has found it's way into the main-stream church... Pastors have been asked to "step down" for their allowance of this "flow of God's Spirit" in their services. Regular attendees were even asked in many cases to stay away from the church if they persisted in this "new style" of worship and praise before the Lord. In many cases, false statements were made about them as well to just get this new move of God's Spirit to cease. But even Jesus said "The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit" John 3:8 "The rise of winds, from whence they come, and whither they go, cannot be ascertained; the treasures of them are only with God, and known to him." (From John Gill's Exposition of the Bible) Listen. The Mighty Spirit of God is a "free agent". He works how, and where, and when He pleases. His "acts of grace" on the heart, and in all influences of our lives, are freely given. It is His design and of His good pleasure to "distribute at will" of His gifts to men, for the Glorification of God the Father. This "grace of the Spirit" in regeneration... like the wind, is "powerful and irresistible!" It blasts all who stand against it and there is no withstanding it. It tears down Satan's strong holds, demolishes the fortifications of sin in our lives; in fact, all the demons of hell, and the corruption of a man's heart, are not a match for it. For when the Spirit works, NO ONE can stand against it? Stephen was found to have these very attributes of the Holy Spirit in his life. He was regenerated by grace, that was as free and sovereign, and as powerful and irresistible, and as secret and imperceptible, as the wind is. And for those from his own kind, knowing so ordinary a thing as the blowing of the wind as so little to be accounted for... the regeneration by the Spirit of God in Stephen's life was more than they could bare. For who is comparable to the wind, and whose name given by mere men to a mere man, can be thought so marvelous and astonishing. So here stands Stephen at the threshold of truth. A place often visited by many men and women of God, but never crossed because of the natural warning they feel. A feeling of physical peril, and at least - social excommunication. Those who dare to "crossover" find marvelous riches, and wonders of His grace. Oh My Brothers and Sisters... Those who do not - pretend to be deaf and dumb, and try to "fit in" with the crowd "less bothered", and where less is required will find the very Power Of God.
