Keep Your Fork...The Best Is Yet To Come

The following story was sent in to the newsletter almost 10 years ago by a dear ministry partner named Sister Mary Ford who has already gone home to be with the LORD now...I felt led to share it with you again this month. "There was a young woman who had been diagnosed with a terminal illness and had been given three months to live. So as she was getting her things "in order," she contacted her pastor and had him come to her house to discuss certain aspects of her final wishes.

She told him which songs she wanted sung at the service, what scriptures she would like read, and what outfit she wanted to be buried in. Everything was in order and the pastor was preparing to leave when the young woman suddenly remembered something very important to her. "There's one more thing," she said excitedly. "What's that?" came the pastor's reply. "This is very important," the young woman continued. "I want to be buried with a fork in my right hand." The pastor stood looking at the young woman, not knowing quite what to say. "That surprises you, doesn't it?" the young woman asked. "Well, to be honest, I'm puzzled by the request," said the pastor. The young woman explained. "My grandmother once told me this story, and from there on out, I have always done so. I have also always tried to pass along its message to those I love and those who are in need of encouragement. In all my years of attending church socials and potluck dinners, I always remember that when the dishes of the main course were being cleared, someone would inevitably lean over and say, 'Keep your fork' It was my favorite part because I knew that something better was coming ... like velvety chocolate cake or deep-dish apple pie. Something wonderful, and with substance! So, I just want people to see me there in that casket with a fork in my hand and I want them to wonder "What's with the fork?". Then I want you to tell them: "Keep your fork ... the best is yet to come." The pastor's eyes welled up with tears of joy as he hugged the young woman good-bye. He knew this would be one of the last times he would see her before her death. But he also knew that the young woman had a better grasp of heaven than he did. She had a better grasp of what heaven would be like than many people twice her age, with twice as much experience and knowledge. She KNEW that something better was coming." The year of 2014 was a blessed one but it was also a hard one. In the last couple of months I have stood by the casket of 2 of the best friends I have even known in this life. The first was my sweet sister Nancy who had suffered for so very long going through surgery after surgery and enduring more pain than anyone I have ever known yet her faith in Jesus remained strong and sure to the very end. The second was my dear friend Sister Dessie Sheriff...she lived a long life of 82 years and most of those for the LORD. She too suffered pain and heartache in this life BUT she never lost her faith in Jesus. Neither one of them had an easy life on this earth BUT today they are in the presence of the LORD. The story that we started this article with is now a reality for them. Nothing that this world has to offer compares to that which they possess today. The LORD truly does save the "best for last"...for them there will be no more sorrow, no more pain no more tears. Maybe you too have lost someone dear to you...and that loss has left you with questions that no one seems to be able to answer. That loss has left a void and a pain in the depths of your heart and soul that words cannot describe. I pray that somehow if only in some small way that the words of this story can be an encouragement to you as they have been to me. Keep your faith in Jesus today and know that their faith in Him in this life was not in vain. That though they are absent from this world they are with Him in a far better place never to feel the pain and grief of this life again. I have cried more tears than I can count the last two months but somewhere down deep beneath the pain, the grief and the empty feeling that losing them has left...there is a contentment and even a peace in knowing that they have finished the race, that they have made it home. Today if there was a way to get a message to them I would simply like to say "Save me a place at the table"....and somehow I can hear them reply..."Keep your fork...The Best is Yet to Come!" REESIE'S RECIPES

Peanut Butter Pie

1 1/4 cups chocolate cookie crumbs
1/4 cup white sugar
1/4 cup butter
1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese,
softened
1 cup creamy peanut butter
1 cup white sugar
1 tablespoon unsalted butter, softened
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 cup heavy whipping cream

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Combine 1 1/4 cup cookie crumbs, 1/4 cup sugar, and 1/4 cup butter; press into a 9-inch pie plate. Bake in preheated oven for 10 minutes. Cool on wire rack. In a mixing bowl, beat cream cheese, peanut butter, 1 cup sugar, 1 tablespoon butter, and vanilla until smooth. Whip the cream, and fold into the peanut butter mixture. Gently spoon filling into crust. Garnish pie with chocolate or cookie crumbs if desired. Refrigerate for several hours before serving.

Five Star Chili

1 pound ground beef
1 small onion, chopped
1/2 small green pepper, chopped
1 can chili beans
1 can (14-1/2 ounces) fire roasted diced tomatoes,
undrained
1 cup coca cola
2 tablespoons chili powder
2 tablespoons tomato paste
1 tablespoon ground cumin
1 beef bouillon cube
1/3 cup ketchup

In a large saucepan, cook the beef, onions and green pepper over medium heat until meat is no longer pink. Drain. Add the tomatoes, cola, chili powder, tomato paste, cumin, ketchup and bouillon. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 20-30 minutes to allow flavors to blend. For a bigger pot simply double all ingredients.

Sock It To Me Cake

3 cups all-purpose flour
1/4 teaspoon baking soda
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 cup butter
2 cups white sugar
6 eggs
1 (8 ounce) container sour cream
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 tablespoons ground cinnamon
3 tablespoons brown sugar
1/2 cup chopped pecans

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and flour a 10 inch tube pan. Sift together the flour, baking soda and salt. Set aside. In a large bowl, cream together the butter and white sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in the eggs one at a time, then stir in the sour cream and vanilla. Beat in the flour mixture until well blended. Pour half of batter into prepared tube pan. Sprinkle with cinnamon, brown sugar and nut mixture. Pour in remaining batter. Bake in preheated oven for 45 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted into the center of the cake comes out clean. Let cool in pan for 10 minutes, then turn out onto a wire rack and cool completely.

Dorito Chicken Casserole

2 cups shredded chicken, cooked
2 cups shredded Mexican cheese, divided
1 (10oz) cream of chicken soup
1/2 cup milk
1/2 cup sour cream
1 can rotel tomatoes
1/2 pkg. taco seasoning
1 large bag Doritos, crushed
Shredded lettuce, diced tomatoes (optional)

Preheat oven to 350. In a large bowl mix together chicken, 1 cup cheese, soup, milk, sour cream, rotel, taco seasoning and mix well. Grease 2 qt. casserole dish, add a layer of crushed Doritos on the bottom, top with chicken mixture then another layer of Doritos. Add another layer of chicken mixture. Top with remaining cheese and more Doritos if you like. Cover and bake 30-35 minutes or until bubbly hot. Add lettuce and tomatoes if desired.



YOU...DECIDE...NOW!

I've been greatly saddened and greatly concerned this past year as I have watched those who have been raised in the faith walk away from it. Those who were taught to hold the Bible in high regard have spurned it as though it's nothing more than another book. Instead of it being a holy book, describing a holy way, of a holy God, who sent a holy Christ, to bring unto Himself a holy people, sanctified to a holy heaven, it's been looked at as a book of hand me down tales or full of legalistic mumbo jumbo. It saddens me to see our nation and our children and the churches of this once great country turn holiness on its head calling good evil and evil good. If you hear but one message this year or next I want it to be this short devotional calling you to live obediently IN a Holy Jesus. Let us remember the words of the Apostle Paul: Romans 5:12 "Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:" Romans 5:19-21 "For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord." Read Gen. 1:27-2:3; Matt. 4:1-2/Luke 4:1-2 –then read; Gen. 3:17-19; —but! Gen. 3:15 –then read Matt. 4:10-11 Let's look at the differences between the first Adam and the second Adam (Christ): "Adam was in the garden; Christ was in the wilderness. Adam was satisfied; Christ was hungry. Adam was surrounded by tame animals; Christ was surrounded by wild animals. Adam had every advantage; Christ had every disadvantage. Adam chose NOT to delight in God; Christ chose to delight in God. Adam chose to ignore God's Word; Christ chose to cling to God's Word. Adam disobeyed; Christ obeyed. Adam succumbed to the devil; Christ triumphed over the devil." The question is this: This new year, these upcoming 365 days (or however long the Lord tarries and God gives you life) will you live in Adam who failed and was overcome by Satan or will you live IN Christ, the second Adam, being victorious over Satan and sin. Will you delight in self or will you delight in God? Will you ignore God's Word or cling to it? Will you walk in disobedience or in obedience? Will you succumb to the devil or will you, IN CHRIST, triumph over him? Jesus showed us a way to defeat the devil. He used Scripture. Too many have given up the Word of God and have went into battle completely defenseless. Too many have not only surrendered their weapon but they have surrendered the ground of their family, their, lives, their, church and their nation! It's time to pick up our sword, the Holy Word of God, and reclaim surrendered ground. Friends, we are called to walk in obedience IN Him who walked in obedience to God the Father. It's not a matter of law and legalism; but it is a matter of love and duty! It's not because of what we can get but it's because of what we HAVE ALREADY received. It's not because of what we might earn; it's because of what we owe. John Wesley put it so well: "God loves you; therefore love and obey him. Christ died for you; therefore die to sin. Christ is risen; therefore rise in the image of God. Christ liveth ever more; therefore live to God till you live with him in glory. So we preached; and so you believed! This is the scriptural way, the Methodist way, the true way. God grant we may never turn therefrom, to the right hand or to the left." -- John Wesley Friends, obedience will take you to AND through some really tough spots this coming year. I can't even imagine what this next year will hold but if you aren't resolved to walk obediently with Christ through it all I can't see you staying faithful to Him. It may bring persecution or even death; but suffering or death with Christ is far better than life without Him. I want to close with an excerpt from a poem called The Pilgrim's Song. It explains why obedience is so vital and a blessing regardless of earthly outcomes. There are persecuted brothers and sisters around this world who live the words to this poem every day; and I will not be surprised if you and I have to make such decisions as well this coming year. Here's the thing, you don't decide when the time comes; YOU ... DECIDE.... NOW! Here's the poem: The Pilgrim's Song: (An excerpt from it) "My rest is in heaven; my rest is not here; Then why should I murmur when trials are near? Be hushed, my dark spirit, the worst that can come, But shortens thy journey and hastens thee home. It is not for me to be seeking my bliss, And building my hopes in a region like this: I look for a city which hands have not piled, I pant for a country by sin undefiled. Afflictions may damp me, they cannot destroy; One glimpse of Thy love turns them all into joy. And the bitterest of tears, if Thou smile but on them like dew in the sunshine, grow diamond and gem. Let doubt then, and danger, my progress oppose; They only make heaven more sweet at the close. Come joy, or come sorrow, whate'er may befall, An hour with my God will make up for it all. A scrip on my back, and a staff in my hand, I march on in haste through an enemy's land. The road maybe rough, but it cannot be long; I'll smooth it with hope, and I'll cheer it with song." The Sleeping Church - Part 02

Judges 16:19 - And she made him sleep upon her knees; and she called for a man, and she caused him to shave off the seven locks of his head; and she began to afflict him, and his strength went from him. Our scripture passage is more or less a vivid depiction of the contemporary church. How the Enemy Has Slowly Rocked the Church to Sleep? 1. Allured by Enticing Words (vs. 10-17) Proverbs 7:21-27 - With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him. 22 He goeth after her straightway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks; 23 Till a dart strike through his liver; as a bird hasteth to the snare, and knoweth not that it is for his life. 24 Hearken unto me now therefore, O ye children, and attend to the words of my mouth. 25 Let not thine heart decline to her ways, go not astray in her paths. 26 For she hath cast down many wounded: yea, many strong men have been slain by her. 27 Her house is the way to hell, going down to the chambers of death. Psalm 5:8-9 - Lead me, O Lord, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make thy way straight before my face. 9 For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; their inward part is very wickedness; their throat is an open sepulchre; they flatter with their tongue. We're like modern-day Samson's, seduced and lulled to sleep by devilish Delilah's and losing our power to combat the enemy's onslaught. Of course, we haven't really lost our power. But by compromising with the spirit of the world, much of the church has effectively and willfully taken off its armor and laid down its weapons because it makes it more comfortable to sleep through the noise of sin that's erupting all around us. Many in the church have taken off the belt of truth and embraced lies that it's OK to practice homosexuality or to neglect prayer or to lie around with people to whom you're not married. Many in the church have set down the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God, and picked up pornography. Many others have traded church service for occultic entertainment like Harry Potter or danced to the demonic beats of modern music. Many in the church have taken off the breastplate of righteousness, compromising who they are in Christ to avoid conflict in the workplace—or in the church, or even in the pulpit. Lay members laugh at dirty jokes to fit in or turn Sunday morning worship into a worldly event, or preach a nice, kind message to keep tithes up. Many have traded their shoes of peace for some chic fashion designer's shoes of the season while neglecting to bring an offering to God. Oh, sure, many are still wearing helmets of salvation, but they sometimes wish they could hide that hat because they don't want to seem uncool in a contemporary society that shuns Christ. This is the first stage of slumber for the church. Your eyes are closed and, according to WebMD, there's a reduction of activity. From a spiritual sense, this activity reduction could be caused by weariness, apathy, compromise or sin. Our eyes are closed. We don't want to see it—we may even justify it. The good news is it's easy to wake up without much difficulty during stage 1. The bad news is this stage doesn't last long, so the opportunity to shake yourself loose from weariness, apathy, compromise or sin is short. 2. Embracing Harlotry (vs. 1, 4-5, 15-17) Proverbs 6:24-29 - To keep thee from the evil woman, from the flattery of the tongue of a strange woman. 25 Lust not after her beauty in thine heart; neither let her take thee with her eyelids. 26 For by means of a whorish woman a man is brought to a piece of bread: and the adulteress will hunt for the precious life. 27 Can a man take fire in his bosom, and his clothes not be burned? 28 Can one go upon hot coals, and his feet not be burned? 29 So he that goeth in to his neighbour's wife; whosoever toucheth her shall not be innocent. Much of the church is playing the harlot—forsaking the Bridegroom for sin. Harlotry was ultimately Samson's downfall. The Bible says in Judges 16:1 - Then went Samson to Gaza, and saw there an harlot, and went in unto her. Samson was literally sleeping with the enemy as he followed the passions of his flesh rather than the God he served. The Word of God tells us that he met Delilah, with whom he fell in love—but her motives toward him were not pure. The Philistines—enemies of Israel—offered her 1,100 pieces of silver if she could persuade him to share the source of his great strength so they could overpower him, bind him, afflict him (Judges 16:4-5). She asked him time and time again, and he lied to her time and time again, foiling the enemy's plans to capture him until finally she wore him down and he told her the truth. This is a key strategy of the enemy. Daniel 7:25 reveals the enemy wearies the saints but we know that those who wait on the Lord shall not grow weary (Isaiah 40:31.) Samson didn't wait on the Lord. He had the call of a Nazarite, the judge of Israel and God's anointing but he just messed it up by trading it in for the pleasures of the flesh. He allowed the devil's words to press him. Judges 16:16 - And it came to pass, when she pressed him daily with her words, and urged him, so that his soul was vexed unto death; That's what we do many a times—we allow the enemy's persistent words to vex our hearts until we fail to fight back. This is the second stage of slumber. Stage 2 is a light sleep. WebMD reports there are peaks and valleys, or positive and negative waves, as the heart rate slows and body temperature decreases. At this point, experts say, the body prepares to enter deep sleep. Catch that! Your heart rate slows and your body temperature decreases. Can you see the spiritual parallel? In Stage 2, your heart is not on fire for Jesus as it once was. Your love is growing cold. You are in a very, very dangerous place. The “Letteth” Crowd

"For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.
And then shall that Wicked be revealed," 2Thessalonians 2:7 (KJV)

I want to speak to you today about "praying the WORD". I don't think there has ever been a time when praying is more important than it is right now. Why? Because so many Christians have left it out of their everyday life, we're a mess in this WORLD - and without prayer my dear brothers and sisters... were doomed. There is right now a vast unrest WORLDWIDE and behind it all I believe, is the lack of prayer. I've spoken of this before - in fact I've tried to tell people about it for years now, but praying is seemingly that area of our walk with Christ that we think we can dismiss or at most - use it only sporadically. That is the great deception of Satan!!! Before I get too far into this let me stop and mention it again for those of you who may not be into Prophecy. This isn't really a lesson on prophecy today but it is prophetic - and what's interesting is that it transcends every age. The Just of it is that when you DO NOT PRAY - you open the door to Satan and all of His demons. Look with me at the scripture reading for today - you can find it there in 2 Thessalonians 2:7-10. It says there: "For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved." 2Thessalonians 2:7-10 (KJV) The Greek word for that word "letteth" speaks of someone who "holds off" or "stays the execution" of a coming event. But the Apostle Paul in his letter to Timothy - giving him an understanding of the work of Satan and the "place" of the Christian to "STAY" the hand of Satan, spoke of a spiritual warfare that must not be neglected, or the result was the increase of evil in the world - which is what we are seeing even today. Let me just say that I believe that you and I could very well have played a part in that day when the Father will say, "Enough is Enough..." and call for the Rapture. What I am saying here is, (and this is only my opinion in light of this passage I have just quoted), I believe that even now - you and I, the Christians of the WORLD - could yet change the course of history so that the Rapture might be stayed yet for some two or three more centuries - maybe longer. But here's what has happened: we have not prayed - or have not been praying everyday living in an attitude of His Presence at all times, thus giving room for the devil to have his way. In fact, Paul speaks of that in another letter he wrote to the Ephesians where he says, "neither give place to the Devil". Every moment of every day that we are not in an attitude of prayer we are giving place to the devil. I know that it's impossible to be in prayer 24/7 - but the point is, many of us, as Christians, haven't prayed for days. Some I have spoken with in my tenure as a Pastor, have gone years without ever uttering a prayer to the Lord on their own - and then they wonder why they can't seem to get the victory and feel as though God has somehow abandoned them. I often hear them say, "When I try to pray it seems as though my prayers never even reach the ceiling." Well, duh?!? I used to play the guitar all of the time too and I played it for at least two hours and every day - singing unto the Lord and blessing His Name - it came easy for me. Not any more; it hurts my fingers and my voice sounds like a cat just got jumped in an old dark alley. SO WHAT HAPPENED! Why can't I play anymore or sing anymore like I used to? I got out of the practice of it. Prayer is not mere words that we pray - it is a communication that moves heaven and earth, and if we're going to be victorious in Christ we need to get serious about how we pray and what we pray. We're going to continue this tomorrow, but let me challenge you today to do yourself a flavor. Buy yourself a bag of M&M's or Skittles and treat yourself in prayer. Every time you take a Skittle or an M&M's piece... while your letting it melt in your mouth or while your chewing up that Skittle... Pray for God to bless this country. Pray for God to bless Israel and keep her strong. Pray for God to bless your Pastor - or if you don't have one, to give you one. In other words, to lead you to a good church fellowship. WHATEVER YOU DO, BEGIN TO PRAY AND PRAY AS OFTEN AS YOU CAN until you learn what it means to live in an attitude of prayer. You are not just getting God to meet your needs or the needs of the people you are praying for... you are strengthening "the letteth crowd" and HOLDING BACK the power of the ENEMY in this world.
