



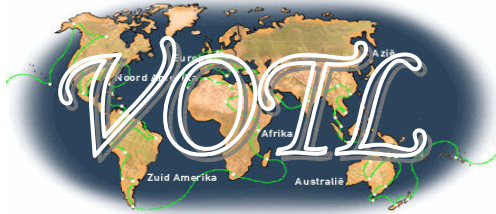

The Scent of Heaven

A cold March wind danced around the dead of night in Dallas as the doctor walked into the small hospital room of Diana Blessing. Still groggy from surgery, her husband David held her hand as they braced themselves for the latest news. That afternoon of March 10, 1991, complications had forced Diana, only 24-weeks pregnant, to undergo an emergency cesarean section to deliver the couple's new daughter, Danae. At 12 inches long and weighing only one pound and nine ounces, they already knew she was perilously premature. Still, the doctor's soft words dropped like bombs. 'I don't think she's going to make it' he said, as kindly as he could. "There's only a 10-percent chance she will live through the night. Numb with disbelief, David and Diana listened as the doctor described the devastating problems Danae would likely face if she survived. She would never walk; she would never talk; she would probably be blind; she would certainly be prone to other catastrophic conditions as well. 'No! No!' was all Diana could say. She and David, with their 5-year-old son Dustin, had long dreamed of the day they would have a daughter to become a family of four. Now, within a matter of hours, that dream was slipping away. Through the dark hours of morning as Danae held onto life by the thinnest thread, Diana slipped in and out of drugged sleep, growing more and more determined that their tiny daughter would live - and live to be a healthy, happy young girl. But David, fully awake and listening to additional dire details of their daughter's chances of ever leaving the hospital alive, much less healthy, knew he must confront his wife with the inevitable. David walked in and said that we needed to talk about making funeral arrangements, Diana remembers 'I felt so bad for him because he was doing everything, trying to include me in what was going on, but I just wouldn't listen, I couldn't listen. I said, 'No, that is not going to happen, no way! I don't care what the doctors say Danae is not going to die! One day she will be just fine, and she will be coming home with us!' Little Danae clung to life hour after hour. But as those first days passed, a new agony set in for David and Diana. Because Danae's underdeveloped nervous system was essentially 'raw,' the lightest kiss or caress only intensified her discomfort - so they couldn't even cradle their tiny baby girl against their chests to offer the strength of their love. All they could do, as Danae struggled alone in the tangle of tubes and wires, was to pray that God would stay close to their precious little girl. There was never a moment when Danae suddenly grew stronger. But as the weeks went by, she did slowly gain an ounce of weight here and an ounce of strength there. At last, when Danae turned two months old, her parents were able to hold her in their arms for the very first time. And two months later - though doctors continued to gently but grimly warn that her chances of surviving, much less living any kind of normal life, were next to zero. Danae went home from the hospital, just as her mother had predicted. Five years later Danae had grown into a petite but feisty young girl with glittering gray eyes and an unquenchable zest for life. She shows no signs, whatsoever, of any mental or physical impairments. Simply, she is everything a little girl can be and more - but that happy ending is far from the end of her story. One afternoon in the summer near her home in Irving, Texas, Danae was sitting in her mother's lap in the bleachers of a local ball park where her brother Dustin's baseball team was practicing. As always, Danae was chattering non-stop with her mother and several other adults sitting nearby when she suddenly fell silent. Hugging her arms across her chest, Danae asked, 'Do you smell that?' Smelling the air and detecting the approach of a thunderstorm, Diana replied, 'Yes, it smells like rain.' Danae closed her eyes and again asked, 'Do you smell that?' Once again, her mother replied, 'Yes, I think we're about to get wet, it smells like rain.' Still caught in the moment, Danae shook her head, patted her thin shoulders with her small hands and loudly announced, 'No, it smells like Him. It smells like God when you lay your head on His chest.' Tears blurred Diana's eyes as Danae then happily hopped down to play with the other children. Before the rains came, her daughter's words confirmed what Diana and all the members of her family had known, at least in their hearts, all along. During those long days and nights of her first two months of her life, when her nerves were too sensitive for them to touch her, God was holding Danae on His chest - and it is His loving scent that she remembers so well.

REESIE'S RECIPES



Banana Freeze

Ingredients

- 2 cups Bananas -- Mashed
- 2 cups Orange Juice
- 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- 1 cup Crushed Pineapple -- undrained

Combine all ingredients in a food processor, processing until smooth and creamy. Pour mixture into a 9x9x2-inch baking dish and freeze overnight or until firm. Serve chilled.

Goober Cake

- 1 pkg. (18.25 oz.) yellow cake mix
- 1 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1/2 cup packed light brown sugar
- 1 cup water
- 3 large eggs
- 1/4 cup vegetable oil
- 1 cup (6 oz.) Peanut Butter & Milk Chocolate Morsels, divided
- 1 cup (7-oz. pkg.) GOOBERS Milk Chocolate Covered Peanuts

Preheat oven to 350° F. Lightly grease 13 x 9-inch baking pan. Beat cake mix, peanut butter and sugar in large mixer bowl until crumbly. Set aside 1/2 cup crumb mixture. Add water, eggs and oil to remaining crumb mixture; blend on low speed until moistened. Beat on high speed for 2 minutes. Stir in 1/2 cup morsels. Pour into prepared baking pan. Sprinkle Goobers, remaining morsels and reserved crumb mixture over batter. Bake for 40 to 45 minutes or until wooden pick inserted in cake comes out clean. Cool completely in pan on wire rack.

Loaded Twice Baked Potatoes

Ingredients

- 4 medium russet potatoes
- 8 ounces ground beef
- 1 cup broccoli florets, finely chopped
- 1 cup water
- 1 cup Cheddar cheese, divided
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 3 green onions, diced

Pierce potatoes all over with a fork. Place in the microwave and cook turning once or twice, until the potatoes are soft, about 20 minutes. Meanwhile, brown meat in a large skillet over medium-high heat, stirring often, about 3 minutes. Drain and put in a large bowl. Increase heat to high, add broccoli and water to the skillet, cover, and cook until tender. Drain the broccoli; add to the meat. Carefully cut off the top third of the cooked potatoes. Scoop the insides out into a medium bowl. Place the potato shells in a small baking dish. Add 1/2 cup cheese, sour cream, salt and pepper to the potato insides and mash with a fork. Add green onions and the potato mixture to the broccoli and meat; stir to combine. Evenly divide the potato mixture among the potato shells and top with the remaining 1/2 cup cheese. Microwave on high until the filling is hot and the cheese is melted, 2 to 4 minutes.

Mexican Meatloaf

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 cup crushed Doritos
- 1 egg - beaten
- 2 Tbsp. onion, chopped
- 1 Tbsp. mild jalapeño, chopped
- 1 envelope taco seasoning
- 1 1/2 cup shredded Colby jack cheese - divided
- 1 1/2 cup salsa - divided
- 1/2 can refried beans

Combine first 6 ingredients, 1/2 cup of the cheese, and 1 cup of the salsa. Form mixture into a loaf and place in a greased loaf pan. Bake in 400 degree F oven for 50 minutes, or until done. Remove from oven and drain. Spread refried beans over the top of the meat loaf. Drizzle remaining salsa over top. Sprinkle remaining cheese on top. Bake additional 5 minutes or until cheese is melted and toppings are hot.

Heath Bar Cookies

Ingredients

- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 cup (2 sticks) unsalted butter, softened
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 1/2 cups chopped Heath Bar pieces
(Eight 1.4 ounce bars or Heath Bar toffee bits)
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts

Sift together the flour, salt, and baking soda. Set aside. In a separate bowl, combine Heath Bar pieces and chopped walnuts. Set aside. Cream butter until fluffy. Add the sugar and continue to beat until light and fluffy (a couple minutes). Beat in eggs one at a time, and vanilla. Mix in the Heath Bar mixture and the flour mixture, a third at a time, until well blended. Chill cookie dough for an hour. Preheat oven to 350°F. On cookie sheets lined with parchment paper, spoon out the cookie dough in small 1-inch balls. Place dough balls 3 inches apart. Bake for 10-12 minutes, until the edges are just starting to brown. Remove from oven and let cool for a few minutes.

Ingredients

- 1 3-ounce package Berry Blue JELL-O
- 3/4 cup boiling water
- 1/2 cup cold water
- Ice cubes
- Gummy Fish
- Whipped topping

In a mixing bowl, stir hot water into gelatin mixture 2-3 minutes or until completely dissolved. Add ice cubes to 1/2 cup cold water to measure 1 1/4 cups. Add to gelatin, stirring until slightly thickened. Remove any remaining ice. Place 1 to 3 Gummy Fish in bottom of clear dessert dish. Pour 1/2 cup thickened gelatin over the fish. Refrigerate 2 hours or until firm. Just before serving, top with a surf of whipped topping

Another Gospel

But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. Galatians 1:8

This month we continue looking at the teachings of the Catholic church. Once again we will be taking the actual teachings from the Catholic Catechism which is the document laying out the doctrines of this church and comparing them to what the Word of God...The King James Version has to say about it.

“THE SUPREMACY OF THE POPE”

I remember watching on television some time ago as the masses stood in Rome waiting for the appointment of a new pope and I remember that it was almost as if they were waiting and watching for a supreme being to step forth. And then more recent when the Pope made a visit to the United States it was more of the same as thousands and thousands looked on in awe as this mere mortal man was lifted up to the level of deity. The Catholic church is very clear on its beliefs concerning their leader. The Catholic Catechism states...*“The Pope, Bishop of Rome and Peter's successor, “is the perpetual and visible source and foundation of the unity both of the bishops and of the whole company of the faithful.” “For the Roman Pontiff, by reason of his office as Vicar of Christ, and as pastor of the entire Church has full, supreme and universal power over the whole Church, a power which he can always exercise unhindered.”* it goes on to state...*“The Roman Pontiff, head of the college of bishops, enjoys this infallibility in virtue of his office, when, as supreme pastor and teacher of all the faithful -- who confirms his brethren in the faith”.* This ridiculous doctrine teaches that the Pope is the “Vicar” of Christ...meaning that he has taken the place of Christ on earth...in other words he is the substitute for Jesus on the earth! This reminds me of the scripture where Jesus was teaching of the last days and said in **Matthew 24:5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many!** I know what I am about to say is fighting words...and please believe me I do not say them out of hate but out of love for the millions of souls that have been swallowed up by this false church. Many teach that the antichrist will be a pope...I am not saying that, BUT any man who can think of himself as Christ in the flesh has been deceived by **strong delusion**. The Church also commends almsgiving, indulgences and works of penance undertaken on behalf of the dead. Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them.”* There is not one place that can be found in scripture that supports prayers for the dead...**NONE**. As a matter of fact the Bible teaches just the opposite...it teaches that those who die in their sins stay in their sins... **Ecclesiastes 11:3 If the clouds be full of rain, they empty themselves upon the earth: and if the tree fall toward the south, or toward the north, in the place where the tree falleth, there it shall be.** In Luke the 16th chapter when Jesus spoke of the rich man in hell there was no hope spoken of or prayers to be made for him....because it was too late. You must be born again to go to heaven and that must take place in this life not the life to come. You must accept Jesus while you are alive and to teach otherwise is simply unbiblical and FALSE! 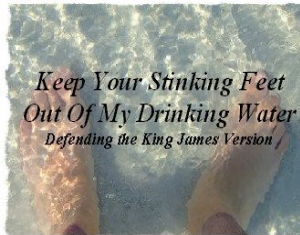

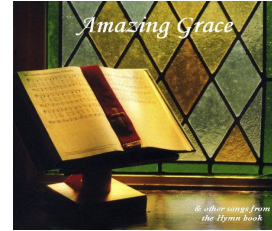

Another Child Gone Home

A few days ago I had the honor of singing at the home-going service of Brother Theo Carter, a 93 year old saint who had the Holy Ghost baptism for 78 years. He had seen the dead raised, and saw many miracles as he prayed for the sick. He quoted chapter after chapter from the New Testament by memory. But most of all, under the powerful anointing, the Word came alive. No one could preach Revelation Chapters 21 and 22 about heaven like Brother Carter. He made it so real that you felt like you were there. He would tell us, "Children, pray. You must pray and fast." He was in the great outpouring in the Appalachian Mountains, just after the turn of the 20th century, which fell upon my grandmother and so many people. They suffered persecution and cared nothing for the things of the world. Brother Carter built many churches across the mountains, never taking a salary. Since he had no transportation for many years, he walked untold miles across the rugged mountains, preaching and baptizing untold numbers of men, women and young people in the cold mountain rivers, with his precious wife by his side, full of the Holy Ghost. There is no way to know all God did through His humble servant. During Brother Carter's memorial service (which was really "church"), the people were singing and shouting and praising the Lord. One preacher after another stood and gave testimony of how they were saved under Brother Carter's ministry, and what his life had meant to them, and pledged to carry this message of Jesus Christ until their life on earth ends. This blessed servant of God sowed 78 years of his life into others. Wherever he pastored, young people followed him. He preached the Word under great anointing, and the gifts that operated in his life operated by love. Precious are the death of the saints. Precious means costly, and oh how the church needs these old saints, who are going home one by one. However, their works do follow them. I was reminded with great joy, just a few days ago in a service, "UPON THIS ROCK I WILL BUILD MY CHURCH AND THE GATES OF HELL SHALL NOT PREVAIL AGAINST IT." This rock is Christ Jesus - Hallelujah to the Lamb of God!

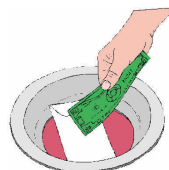
