## REESIE'S RECIPES

### Heavenly Ice Cream

- 12 (1 3/4oz.) Milky Way candy bars, cut into small pieces
- 1 (5.5oz) can chocolate syrup
- 1 (14oz) can eagle brand milk
- 3 to 4 qt. milk

Combine candy bars and eagle brand milk in sauce pan. Cook over low heat until candy melts stirring occasionally. Cool. Add 1 qt. of milk to candy mixture. Beat with electric mixer until well blended. Pour mixture into one gallon ice cream freezer, add chocolate syrup. Add milk to fill freezer. Freeze per freezer instructions.

### Corn Bread Salad

- 1 box jiffy corn bread mix
- 1 cup tomatoes, chopped
- 1 cup cucumbers, chopped
- 1 cup cauliflower, chopped
- 1 cup salad dressing
- 1 small bottle bacon bits
- 1 cup onion, chopped
- 1 cup celery, chopped
- 1 cup green pepper, chopped
- 1 cup broccoli, chopped
- 1/4 cup sugar

Bake corn bread as directed on pkg. Let cool completely. Crumble half of the corn bread in the bottom of a bowl. Sprinkle half of the bacon bits on the corn bread. Mix salad dressing and sugar, pour over bacon bits. Mix all vegetables together and pour over salad dressing. Add remaining bacon bits and top with remaining corn bread crumbs. Serve chilled.

### Dreamsicle Cake

- 1 box orange supreme cake mix
- 2 eggs
- 1/2 cup oil
- 1/2 cup orange juice
- 1 large box vanilla instant pudding
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 1/2 cups water
- 1 small box orange jello
- 1 (8oz) pkg. cream cheese
- 1 (20oz) can crushed pineapple, drained
- 1 (12oz) cool whip

Mix with mixer cake mix, eggs, oil, water and jello. Pour into 13x9 pan. Bake at 350 for 30-35 minutes. Cool. Mix cream cheese, orange juice, pineapple, sugar and pudding mix until smooth. Fold in cool whip. Spread onto cooled cake. Store in refrigerator.

### Baked Beans

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 2/3 cup bbq sauce
- 1/2 green pepper chopped
- 2 cans pork and beans
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- Salt, pepper, mustard and Worcestershire sauce to taste

Brown ground beef and green pepper and onion, drain. Place in crock pot with remaining ingredients. Cook on low for several hours.

### Sweet Italian Chicken

- 2 lbs. boneless skinless chicken breast - 2 ( 0.7 ounce) packets of Italian dressing mix - 1 cup brown sugar

Preheat your oven to 350. Line pan with aluminum foil, spray with non-stick spray. Rinse chicken, pat dry with paper towels. Combine dried Italian seasoning mix and brown sugar, mixing together well. Dip chicken pieces into the mixture, coating front and back and place into your prepared pan. Any extra coating that remains can just be sprinkled over the chicken. Cook for 45 minutes or until chicken is done turning every 15 min and basting each time with the drippings.



### **EXTRA! CRISPUS!**

"And CRISPUS, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized." Acts 18:8 (KJV)

When was the last time you just felt like just giving up? You have studied, and prayed, and studied, and prayed, and yet it seems as though you're talking to a brick wall? I mean, you might as well. The response you get from the people in your congregation, or the co-workers in the office, is about the same as talking to a brick wall. You might say that this was the state that Silas and Timothy found Paul in, when they returned to Corinth from Thessalonica. Verse 5 says: "And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit," WOW! Have you ever read that before? A man of God such as Paul - depressed? For one thing - Paul was a bit overworked. During his time there in Corinth, Paul worked as a Tent-maker from around 11 AM in the Morning to 4 PM in the afternoon, and he would go to the synagogue and "reason with the Jews" before and after work. What's worse, the Bible clearly states what kind of response Paul was getting. "And when they opposed themselves, and blasphemed..." Acts 18:6 Not what Paul had in mind! On every turn - Paul was refuting any scriptures that they would throw at him, and he was providing scripture after scripture - proving that Jesus was the Christ, and they were in effect "opposing themselves", because their arguments he had already answered, but they would not hear him. All that they would do was to continue to slander Paul, and try to belittle him for he was drawing crowds, and people of the Jewish faith (not necessarily those of the Synagogue) were hearing what Paul had to say. "But when the Jewish leaders saw the crowds, they were jealous; so they slandered Paul and argued against whatever he said." So you can see why Paul may have been a bit "pressed in the spirit" - or depressed. So Paul decided that he would leave them to their own decisiveness, and brush the dirt from off his feet, and go back to preaching Christ to the Gentiles only, when God did a wonderful thing. He showed Paul that all of his preaching, and teaching had not been in vain. "And he departed from there and entered the house of a certain man named Justus, one who worshiped God, whose house was next door to the synagogue." v.7 "Then Crispus, the ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his household. And many of the Corinthians, hearing, believed and were baptized." v.8 Talk about your big fish!!! CRISPUS WAS THE RULER OF THE SYNAGOGUE. The whole time that Paul had been preaching and teaching, and thinking that he was not getting through - SOMEONE was listening. SOMEONE HAD HEARD - and was so moved, that he believed on the Lord; and all of house believed on the Lord - and everyone was baptized in His name. Friend - you may think that all of your speaking is in vain. You may think that you are at the end of your rope, and that you might as well just hang it up, because it's just not going anywhere for you. Oh Hallelujah! I've got one word for you. "CRISPUS!" If that isn't enough for you I've got a six more words for you, "and all of his house believed!" Remember the question I asked you at the beginning of this devotional? Let me re-ask the question. Have you ever felt like just giving up? You have studied, and prayed, and studied, and prayed, and yet it seems as though you're talking to a brick wall? I mean, you might as well. The response you get from the people in your congregation, or the co-workers in the office, is about the same as talking to a brick wall. What did you do? Did you quit? Don't forget !! He will go before you and strike fear in the hearts of your enemies!

### God's Recipe For Revival

*If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14*

The Last Day Revival...It's something that we have all heard...especially if you were raised on the pew of a Pentecostal church like I was. It has been heralded as the "great outpouring" that will sweep around the world before the coming of the LORD. Yet as I write this article and as we have just finished a sermon series on this subject my heart is grieved. Grieved because I do not see IT happening anytime soon at least not as a "worldwide" event anyway. Why? Because I know what God's Word teaches us that it takes to have real Revival and I am not seeing that in the modern day church as we know it today. God has a "recipe" for Revival and that has never changed...we see that in the scripture that we opened with we see that in the words that Peter spoke on the day of Pentecost. Peter stands before all of Jerusalem the day that the Holy Ghost came and filled the house AND THEM and speaks these words...*"But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel; And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:"* That is the scripture that the last day revivalist have cut their teeth on and built their message around AND of course it's TRUTH for it is God's Word. But to get the full meaning of the message...to study to show yourself approved...to rightly divide the Word of truth one must turn to the book of Joel and read what else Joel said. We find in Joel the second chapter those powerful words that Peter spoke...*Joel 2:28-29 "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my spirit."* Notice that Joel says "And it shall come to pass **afterward**"....after what? In order to find that out we have to read the first part of this chapter. I don't have the space to go into all of the detail of what Joel was speaking of but to sum it up he was saying...AFTER the people put away their false gods...AFTER the people turn back to God in humility and repentance...AFTER the ministers weep and cry out to God for the condition of His people. Then "**Afterward**"....*after those things*...then HE WILL pour out His Spirit upon all flesh...what flesh? Those that have turned to him with their whole heart...those that are seeking His face and His will and turning from their own! This is what brings Revival...and let me say this...Revival is not angel feathers and gold dust. REVIVAL is a rekindling of a fire that once burned but has faded away to embers...REVIVAL is once again finding our first love! REVIVAL is being stirred and burdened for the work of God and for lost souls! REVIVAL is being filled to overflowing to the point where you cant help but tell people about what God has done for you! Revival is not just a few nights of running the isles and jumping the pews...REVIVAL will bring back to life that which was dead!!! It doesn't come in a bottle of holy water or a brief case...you cant buy it with a thousand dollar seed! No, it comes when men and women of God begin to seek the face of God once more. When God's people begin to hunger and thirst for Jesus more than they do the world! When we begin to see more people riding the altar than we do riding the pews. That is when REVIVAL comes!! A few weeks ago during my prayer time at the church the Lord spoke to me concerning the "body" or the "church" today and told me that He is grieved by our entertainment...He is grieved by our playing instead of praying...He is grieved by our gimmicks and fads! He is looking today for the same thing He was looking for when he found David...a man after His own heart...someone who was thirsty and hungry for HIM! You see...I am not saying we will not see Revival...we have been experiencing Revival at Voice of the LORD...we will see seasons and pockets of Revival BUT Revival will only be as widespread as the repentance is.
