






## **Cousin Leroy**

## REESIE'S RECIPES

#### Frozen Fruit Salad

1/2 cup white sugar

2 cups water

1 (6 ounce) can frozen orange juice concentrate, thawed

1 (6 ounce) can frozen lemonade concentrate, thawed

4 bananas, sliced

1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple with juice

1 (10 ounce) package frozen strawberries, thawed

Dissolve sugar in the water. Add orange juice, lemonade, bananas, crushed pineapple with juice, strawberries and mix well. Pour into 9x13 inch glass pan. Freeze until solid. When ready to serve, let it sit out for about 5 minutes before attempting to cut.

#### **Sweet Bacon Wrapped Tater Tots**


Approximately 50 - 55 tater tots (thawed to room temperature)

1-16-ounce package bacon (strips cut in 4 pieces)

<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> cup brown sugar

2 tablespoons chili powder

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Line a cookie sheet with foil and place a cooling rack on top of the pan Cut each bacon strip into 4 even pieces. In a small bowl, mix brown sugar and chili powder until well combined. Wrap each thawed tater tot in bacon and then roll it in the brown sugar mixture Place on top of the cookie rack. Bake 10 to 15 minutes at 375, then increase the oven to 400 and let them cook another 5 to 10 minutes minutes or until crispy. Serve warm

#### No-Bake Strawberry Banana Twinkie Cake

10 Twinkies

4 cups whipped cream

2 cups strawberries, diced

2 cups strawberries, sliced

1 3.4 ounce box Jell-O banana cream pudding mix

1 cup heavy cream

1 cup whole milk

2 tablespoons confectioners sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla

Rinse strawberries, pat dry. Slice half the strawberries, mix with confectioners sugar and set aside. Dice remaining strawberries place in separate bowl and set aside to top cake with. Place unwrapped Twinkies in a medium casserole dish. Mix pudding with milk, vanilla and heavy cream, and pour over Twinkies. Next, top pudding with sliced strawberries, then top strawberries with whipped cream. Lastly, place extra diced strawberries on top of whipped cream layer, cover and refrigerate for about 3 hours.

## Salsa Meatloaf

2 eggs

2 lbs ground beef

1 cup of Red Cactus salsa or your favorite salsa

1 to 2 sleeves crushed buttery round crackers

1 tsp salt (or to taste)

1 tsp ground black pepper (or to taste)

1 cup ketchup

1 Tbsp. brown sugar

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Mix together ketchup and brown sugar for topping and set aside. Beat the eggs in a mixing bowl, add salt and pepper, then add the ground beef and salsa. Gently add crushed crackers until meat mixture is thick and forms well. Form loaf in a pan sprayed with cooking spray. Bake in preheated oven 45 minutes. Remove from oven and top with ketchup and brown sugar mixture. Return to oven and cook 15 minutes longer or until no longer pink in the center. Let stand 10 minutes before slicing.

Summary: We need to believe in God, Pray to God and He will in return instruct and direct us. If we can trust in God, have total confidence in Him, we will have results. Beloved there is difference between instruction and direction, In the above text after the lord instructed Moses to tell the children of Israel to move on (Instruction) and to lift up your rod, God then directed him to stretch out his hand over the sea and divide it. TRUST Psalms 20:7 - Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the Lord our God. Proverbs 3:5-6 - Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Moses trusted in God, we all need to put our trust in The Lord, when you believe in God, He will instruct you and then direct you. He sees your issues and He's just waiting for you to approach Him in the appropriate way and not crying. Crying won't help. Trusting God will. CONFIDENCE Proverbs 3:26 - For the Lord shall be thy confidence, and shall keep thy foot from being taken. Moses was confident that God would deliver them, when you put your confidence in God, you get results, remember you can believe in a friend, but don't trust him; you can also trust a friend but don't have confidence in him. Do you know someone who just rubs you the wrong way? No matter what you do or say they want the opposite? Well there is only a couple of answers to this problem. One is to get an arbitrator, and the other is to have absolutely nothing to do with them. By the way.... the second solution (having nothing to do with them) is not an option when considering scuffles in marriage. Seeking a counselor there is always the best solution. The vertical relationship of course refers to Spiritual matters, while horizontal relationships have to do with others (or flesh). So, where do you think your dislike for your co-worker comes from? Does God dislike your co-worker? Listen, when you're vertical relationship is right, your horizontal relationship will be right. It's so true... the biggest battles we fight every day are the battles within. ## **God's Simple Plan of Salvation**

My Friend: we are about to ask you the most important question of your life. Your joy or your sorrow for all eternity depends upon your answer. The question is: Are you saved? Do you know Jesus Christ as your personal LORD and Saviour? It is not a question of how good you are, nor if you are a church member, but have you put your faith in Jesus? Are you sure you will go to Heaven when you die? The Bible makes the plan of salvation plain and simple. Romans 10:13 says For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
