

## REESIE'S RECIPES

### Catalina Salad

- 1 head lettuce, cut in layers, then chopped
- 1 large tomato, diced
- 1 large sweet onion, diced
- 1 can hot chili beans, drained and rinsed
- 12 oz. sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 9-1/4 oz. bag Fritos corn chips
- 1 cup Kraft Catalina salad dressing

Toss together all salad ingredients except for the Fritos and Catalina dressing. Chill until ready to serve. Just before serving add the Fritos, partly crushed, and toss with 1 cup Catalina dressing (add more dressing, if desired). Serve immediately.

### Frosted Strawberry Salad

- 2 (6oz) packages strawberry gelatin
- 3 cups boiling water
- 2 (10oz) packages frozen sweetened sliced strawberries, thawed
- 1 can (20oz) crushed pineapple, undrained
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1/2 cup chopped maraschino cherries

#### TOPPING:

- 1 package (8oz) cream cheese, softened
- 1 jar (7oz) marshmallow creme
- 1 carton (8oz) frozen whipped topping, thawed
- Fresh strawberries and mint

In a large bowl, dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Stir in strawberries and pineapple. Refrigerate until partially set. Stir in pecans and cherries. Transfer to a 13-in. x 9-in. dish. Chill for 2 hours or until firm. **For topping**, in a small bowl, beat cream cheese and marshmallow creme just until combined; fold in whipped topping. Spread over salad. Chill for several hours or overnight. Cut into squares. Garnish with strawberries and mint.

### Chocolate Icebox Pie

- 2/3 cup milk
- 3/4 cup semisweet chocolate morsels
- 1/4 cup cold water
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 1 (14-ounce) can sweetened condensed milk
- 3 large eggs, beaten
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3 tablespoons butter or margarine
- 1 ready-made chocolate crumb pie crust
- 1 cup whipping cream
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1 milk chocolate candy bar, chopped

Heat milk until it just begins to bubble around the edges in a 3-quart saucepan over medium heat (do not boil). Remove from heat, and whisk in chocolate morsels until melted. Cool slightly. Stir together cold water and cornstarch until dissolved. Whisk cornstarch mixture, sweetened condensed milk, eggs, and vanilla into chocolate mixture. Bring to a boil over medium heat, whisking constantly. Boil 1 minute or until mixture thickens and is smooth. (Do not overcook.) Remove from heat, and whisk in butter. Spoon mixture into piecrust.

Cover and chill at least 8 hours. Beat whipping cream at high speed with an electric mixer until foamy; gradually add sugar, beating until soft peaks form. Spread whipped cream evenly over pie filling, and sprinkle with candy bar pieces.

### Cheesy Chicken and Rice

- 3 cups cooked rice
- 1 cup shredded mozzarella
- 1 cup grated Parmesan
- 1 cup chicken, diced
- 2 eggs
- 1/3 cup of milk or half and half
- Salt and pepper

Heat the oven to 400 F. In a bowl combine meat and mozzarella and rice. In another bowl mix the milk or half and half, eggs, salt and pepper Parmesan cheese. Combine mixtures. Spray a large 9 x 9 baking dish with cooking spray. Bake for 30 minutes.



## Character Still Counts

"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind." 2 Timothy 1:7

During the presidential primaries (which seemed more like a circus than grown men running for the highest office in the land), evangelical Christians were at odds about who should receive their vote. As some very conservative voters went to the polls they held deep convictions stating that they could never vote for a candidate who was foul-mouthed, ran casinos, strip clubs, and bars, and never felt a need for repentance. They touted phrases like, "character counts" and quoted Saint Paul, "What does light have to do with darkness?" They felt that their vote was strongly tied to their person and to support a person whose policies and stances were so diametrically opposed to their own that it would be not only a mark against their conscience but against their soul as well. Now that their candidate has left the arena, it would appear that character no longer counts and they sound as though they are voting from fear instead of a prayerful spirit. Let me interject here that I am NOT condemning anyone but I do hope to give you—the reader—some food for thought. I don't want to influence you how to vote; but, I do want to help you slow down and look at things biblically. The only thing I want to impress upon you is that CHARACTER STILL COUNTS—both yours and the candidate's. Your vote still speaks volumes to your character. Ask yourself, "Am I voting from fear or am I voting from character?" First let me say, when your choice appears to be either to neglect your civic and God-given duty to vote or to cast your vote for Jezebel or Ahab, it does leave one in a quandary. It hurts to realize that a vote for the lesser of two evils still puts you in the position of voting for evil. Rather, listen to Spurgeon: "Of two evils, choose neither." I have young children and well understand the position we are in. I understand that there is a candidate whom we fear will win, who will remove our religious liberties, do their best to take away our guns, and further destroying this country which I love. I understand that there is another candidate that might do what is right to protect our Constitution and Bill of Rights for a season. I understand that it's a fearful thing to fall into the hands of a president who cares nothing of liberty, constitutional law, and desires to sell us out to foreign countries and false religions. Believe me, I get it... BUT... I also have seen in God's Word the dangers of "falling into the Hands of an angry God." We live in a nation that has been poking God in the eye for a long time. We treat marriage as insignificant and murder children in the womb—Israelites and Molech anyone? We have embraced homosexuality to the extent that the White House was lit up in rainbow colors and we are the first generation since the days of Noah to have the audacity to call it a marriage—Sodom and Gomorrah anyone? We use the Holy name of God as a curse word with our lips through slang and invite such wicked language into our homes through entertainment. We take His name in vain with our lives as churches and Christians accept all manner of sin instead of embracing a life of personal holiness—Third Commandment (not suggestion) anyone? Shouldn't the men and women of God stand up for what is right and align ourselves with Righteousness rather than "running to Egypt" for protection? Shouldn't we fear God rather than men? Will we vote from the fear of man or from the fear of God? Character still counts. Do we pray about our precious voting commodity or does fear prey upon our conscience, pressing our trembling hand? True character is shown under pressure—indeed, if honest with ourselves, we see our own true character under pressure. Do we desire truth and right? Or do we desire safety over truth? Is there real safety outside truth? Are we willing to sell our character for a bowl of fearful pottage? Does character mean so little to us? God states that the healing of a land starts with 1) God's people humbling themselves, 2) praying, 3) seeking His face, and 4) turning from their wicked ways. It is ONLY THEN that God will hear our prayer, forgive our sin and HEAL OUR LAND! It's either God's way and win or man's way and lose. Our nation is sick and needs healing but we must depend more on God for the healing than some political leader. For too long, wherever he (national leader) leads, we follow. We can no longer afford to follow the donkey or the elephant...we must follow the LAMB! Obviously we can't write in Jesus for our vote; but, we should be hitting the prayer closet long before and frequently before we hit the voting booth. Check out ALL the candidates (there are more than two) and vote your values, vote your convictions, and be Biblically correct instead of politically correct. What hath light to do with darkness—be not unequally yoked!

## What the Word Of God Says About Transgender Issue part 01

Scripture Reference:

Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Look at today what the bible says about transgender or transsexual behavior. Society has lost its way – anything goes – there is no standard anymore. BUT...there is a standard...the WORD OF GOD! Look at various scriptures as we go...Trans: First let's define a few terms from Webster's dictionary...A. TERMS DEFINED 1. What is a Male? A person bearing an X and Y chromosome having a male genitalia – a boy or man – masculine. 2. What is a Female? A person bearing two X chromosomes having female genitalia to include a uterus and ovaries and breasts – a girl or woman – feminine. 3. What is a Transgender? A person whose gender identity does not correspond to a person's biological sex assigned at birth. 4. What is Gender Identity Disorder or Gender Dysphoria? It is the desire to change one's sex or to fulfill the role of the opposite gender. Transgenders describe themselves as "trapped" in a body that does not match their gender They will often seek hormone therapy or surgery to bring their body's in line with their "perceived" gender These people often practice transvestism 5. What is Transvestism? The practice, especially of men, of wearing clothing associated with the opposite sex for psychological gratification. Well with these definitions in mind, let's see what the bible says about: B. GENDER AND HUMAN SEXUALITY Genesis 1:27 - So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. Matthew 19:4-5 - And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female, 5 And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? Mark 10:4-9 - And they said, Moses suffered to write a bill of divorce-ment, and to put her away. 5 And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the hardness of your heart he wrote you this precept. 6 But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female. 7 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife; 8 And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh. 9 What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder. God created two and ONLY two genders: male and female!!! That means a man and a woman – masculine & feminine Notice what God didn't say in Genesis: 1. He never asked Adam or Eve is they were comfortable or happy with their assigned sex. 2. He never created multiple wives for Adam or multiple husbands for Eve. 3. He never asked them about their sexual orientation or preference. All of the social stigmas and modern day acceptance about numerous genders is UNBIBLICAL. Yet our young people are being bombarded and brainwashed that being able to choose your gender is normal behavior. All this really amounts to is an attempt to normalize sin and make people feel better about sinning.
