I am talking to all the lost folks out there including unsaved church members and anyone who has ever prayed a prayer and been told that they are saved when there is no evidence of salvation in their lives. When a man or woman is TRULY born again, you will notice the change. The question I have for you today is: ARE YOU SAVED AND STILL GOING TO HELL? Have you had some false prophet assure you that you are saved when you have no evidence of salvation in your life? The Bible says in Matthew 7:13-15 - Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: 14 Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it. 15 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves. Matthew 7:21-23 - Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. 22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? 23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity. I would ask you again: Has some false prophet assured that you are going to heaven when you know deep down that you are not saved. Salvation eternally changes people and their destiny. Have you been deceived? Have you been sent such strong delusion that you believe the lie that you are saved and on your way to heaven regardless of how you live? Proverbs 12:15 says: "The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto counsel is wise. I would counsel and warn you to examine yourself and whether you be in the faith. The Bible says in Proverbs 16:25:" There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death". So there is a way that leads to eternal death, but there is also a way that leads to eternal life. John 14:6 - Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. John 10:7-15 - Then said Jesus unto them again, Verily, verily, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. 8 All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. 9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. 10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. 11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep. 12 But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth them, and scattereth the sheep. 13 The hireling fleeth, because he is an hireling, and careth not for the sheep. 14 I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine. 15 As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep. If you have not entered through the door, in other words the Lord Jesus Christ, then you are attempting to steal your way into heaven. I am here to warn those today who have a form of godliness but deny the power thereof by claiming to be saved and continuing in a God denying wicked lifestyle. I am here to warn those that claim they are saved and continue to live a worldly, sensual lifestyle because they have not the spirit of Christ abiding in them. I am not here to leave you in your comfort zone. I am not here to tell you that it is okay for you to continue in your sin. I am here to tell you that you are still lost and dying in your sin and on your way to hell. Isaiah 5:20-23 - Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! 21 Woe unto them that are wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight! 22 Woe unto them that are mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink: 23 Which justify the wicked for reward, and take away the righteousness of the righteous from him! Those that justify the wicked for reward are those false preachers that take bribes to tell the wicked that they are okay in their vile life style. These false preachers are hirelings. They will not preach repentance unto them. They are those preachers that have prophesied unto them smooth things. They have told them that all they have to do is repeat this prayer after me. The Correct Church Response to BLM

During these turbulent times, remember that God is sovereign and that we can trust Him regardless of what comes our way. To trust God is to trust His Word, even when dealing with social issues and divisive politics. Why are Christians supporting organizations like Black Lives Matter (BLM) in person, through social media, or through apathetic silence? Are their actions based on the whole counsel of God or have they been led by feelings rather than faith-based fact? If deceived, how can we compassionately explain to them why they are wrong in doing so? Let's pray for Biblical discernment and reason solely from the Bible. Let us fix our hearts to stand alone on the Word of God; even when that means standing alone. Such a stand means we must better know our Bible, research organizations/situations, ask God to show us where our choices will lead, then stand firm regardless of opposition, even from the church. David did so in Psalms 119:23-24; "Princes also did sit and speak against me: but thy servant did meditate in thy statutes. Thy testimonies also are my delight and my counsellors." First, we need to deal with terms. There is a big difference between supporting black people whose lives matter and the organization Black Lives Matter (BLM), which is an extremist organization whose ideology is Maoist. It's a militant arm of the Left meant to divide and allow a political agenda that other leaders throughout history have implemented to starve and murder their citizens. Their end goal is to replace the God of the Bible with man. Ironically, it ends in slavery. How should the church respond to BLM? Christians should always stand for lawful behavior. Lawlessness accepted breeds further lawlessness. BLM is lawless—vandalism, wanton destruction, taking of life, and forcing others to submit to their senseless demands. All these things have been done indiscriminately, ethnicity hasn't played a role. Christians should call for Biblical justice not "social justice." Their terminology is a great marketing tool. Who can be against "social justice" or against saying, "black lives matter?" They grab one's emotions, hijack the word, and redefine it to mean its opposite. If we demanded Biblical justice, there'd be real social justice. Christians must promote forgiveness and are labelled ministers of reconciliation (2 Cor. 5). The BLM narrative has no desire to forgive; it's about historical revenge (reparations, demands of kneeling and submission, etc.). This organization desires domination not reconciliation. How does devaluing the lives of other ethnicities show that black lives matter? Instead of kneeling and admitting to "white guilt," Christians must submit to Christ and be concerned about sin guilt. We shouldn't feel guilty about being the color/ethnicity that God has created us to be; nor should we feel guilty about that which our ancestors have done. How many white men lost their lives in the Civil War in an effort to set slaves free? Hate and violence only perpetuates more of the same. Instead of ascribing guilt, let us cry out against sin and recognize our own guilt against a most holy God. Christ's work upon the cross was to atone for men of all colors, assuaging our guilt and allowing us to be seen as blameless. Christians need to oppose the false gospel narrative and embrace the true gospel which is color-blind. Jesus holds the only cure for "racism" so-called. Jesus died for all people of all color; we must lead them to the cross, not follow them into the cross-hairs of a holy God who will punish sin. We need to encourage others to love their enemies. This can only be done in Christ, by the power of the Spirit. The church needs to promote one race (unity). According to Genesis we are all one race. Many years ago, the church refused to stand strongly against the theory of evolution. The "Princes" (Ps. 119:23) of Science and Political Correctness spoke against us and we didn't take counsel from God's testimonies. This theory has run its course and now we taste its poisonous fruits. The Bible must be our only source of truth, recognizing that God is infinitely wiser and more knowledgeable than we. Christians must ascribe to God's view of sexuality and authority. BLM is a huge proponent of homosexuality and transgenderism. Quoting a part of their manifesto: "*We foster a queer-affirming network. When we gather, we do so with the intention of freeing ourselves from the tight grip of heteronormative thinking.*" Like God, we are to be an ordered people. BLM wants to do away with the police force and prisons which only leads to further anarchy and chaos. Are there problems in the police force? Of course, even as there are problems in any organization. But there is no systemic "racism" here. Nine unarmed "blacks" were killed by police last year and 19 unarmed "whites." The number of police killed is greater than those numbers. The BLM riots are responsible for even more deaths than those listed above. The answer isn't to defund police or to remove statues of historical significance. The only answer for America, and for the church, is to return to the Word of God; repent of our wrongdoing and sin; demand lawful behavior from ALL people of ALL ethnicities; and to demand the lawful implementation of our Constitution to ALL our citizens—from the highest in government to the lowest "man on the street;" and to stand firm in our God-given, Constitutionally-protected, freedoms. Jesus is our only Hope; freedom is our best weapon; and the Constitution is our government! I urge you to read 1 Thessalonians 5:11-22; these are Paul's instructions for dealing with our brothers in Christ. "Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men." (v. 14)



Lemon Delight

- 1 package 14.3 oz golden Oreo cookies
- ½ cup melted butter
- 8 oz package cream cheese softened
- 16 oz container cool whip divided
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- Lemon juice from 1 lemon
- 1 package 3.4 oz instant vanilla pudding mix
- 1 package 3.4 oz instant lemon pudding mix
- 3 cups milk Lemons for garnish optional

Layer one: Place whole golden Oreos in a food processor and pulse until fine crumbs are formed. Set aside one cup of crushed Oreos for topping. In a medium bowl, combine crushed golden Oreos with ½ cup melted butter. Press the cookie mixture evenly into the bottom of a 9x13" pan. Chill in the refrigerator. **Layer two:** In a large mixing bowl, mix softened cream cheese, 8 oz cool whip, one cup powdered sugar and lemon juice from 1 lemon until smooth. Spread evenly over cookie layer. Chill in the refrigerator. **Layer three:** In a medium mixing bowl, whisk together 3 cups milk with both instant pudding flavors until pudding thickens. Spread evenly over cream cheese layer. Chill. **Layer four:** Top with remaining cool whip. Chill for at least one hour before serving. Cover with remaining Oreo crumbs and lemon slices for garnish, if desired.

3 Bean Salad

- 1 (16oz) can wax beans
 - 1 (16oz) can kidney beans
 - 1 (16oz) can French style green beans
 - 1 cup chopped onions
 - 1 cup chopped green peppers
- Drain beans. Add onions & peppers.
Cover with oil dressing and chill.

Sweet & Sour Pork Skillet

- 1 (16oz) can pineapple tidbits
- 2 T. cornstarch
- 2 T. brown sugar
- 1 cup chicken bouillon
- 2 T. vinegar
- 1 T. soy sauce
- 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- 1/4 tsp powdered ginger
- 2 cups pork chop, cooked and cubed
- 1/2 cup green pepper, chopped and sauteed

Drain pineapple, reserve juice. In saucepan blend cornstarch and brown sugar. Add reserved juice and the next 6 ingredients. Cook stirring constantly until thickened and clear. Stir in meat, green pepper and pineapple. Heat through and serve over cooked rice.

Amish Meatloaf

- 1 1/2 lb. ground beef
- 1 cup tomato juice
- 1 egg, beaten
- 2 Tbsp brown sugar
- 1/4 cup chopped onion
- 1 1/2 tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp pepper
- 3/4 cup quick oats

Preheat oven to 350. Combine all ingredients and mix well. Form into six small loaves and place in baking dish.

Sauce

- 1 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 tsp garlic powder
- 1 cup water
- 1 Tbsp liquid smoke
- 1 cup ketchup

Combine all ingredients and mix well. Pour over loaves and bake at 350 for 75 minutes. Let stand 5 minutes before serving.

Through The Trials - It Is Well With Your Soul

A few days ago I received a very detailed call from a friend dealing with trials that seem nearly impossible to bear. Often the best thing a friend can do is simply listen, and while doing just that I was reminded of Horatio Spafford. Horatio Gates Spafford was a 43-year-old Chicago Businessman who suffered financial disaster in the great Chicago fire of 1871. He and his wife, still grieving the death of their son who had died shortly before the fire, were in great need of a retreat, and decided to take their remaining children to England for a vacation. Their friend Dwight L. Moody would be preaching in evangelistic campaigns there that fall, and so Spafford arranged to send his wife and four daughters ahead of him on the SS Ville du Havre. He planned to follow in a few days. During the voyage on the Atlantic Ocean, the Ville du Havre was struck by an iron sailing vessel and sank within 12 minutes. Two hundred twenty-six lives were lost – including the Spafford's four daughters. When the survivors were brought to shore at Cardiff, Wales, Mrs. Spafford cabled her husband two words: "Saved alone." Spafford booked passage on the next ship. As they were crossing the Atlantic the captain pointed out the place where he thought the Ville du Havre had gone down. That night, Spafford penned the following words:

When peace like a river attendeth my way
When sorrows like sea billows roll

Whatever my lot, Thou hast taught me to say
It is well, it is well with my soul.

Spafford lost his business and his children but found comfort in His savior. This world has been called a "veil of tears", not without reason. The weight of anguish and sorrow is incalculable and may feel utterly unbearable at times. Who can understand how Horatio and his wife bore up under their excruciating losses? Jesus can, because He himself bore far greater agony and sorrow, and because He rescued us from an eternity of it. If you truly know Him you also can sing, "It Is Well With My Soul."

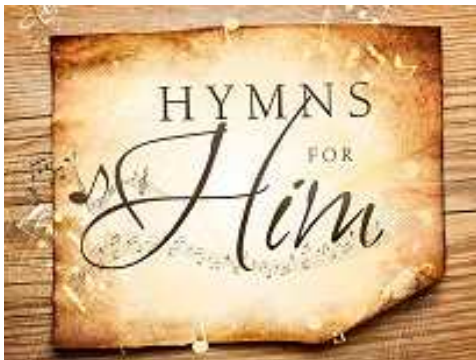

Gideon Ouselye

Mr. Gideon Ouselye was an Irish Methodist minister from the early 1800s. Here is an interesting account from his life. May we be careful in how we treat the "prophet" of God: In May, at Ennis, as Mr. Ouseley returned one night from the stable, where he had been looking after his own horse and that of Mr. Reilly, he was watched by some fellows, one of whom, taking aim at his head, threw a stone with all his force.

It struck the handle of the missionary's umbrella, and having glanced off, laid open his thumb "from the tip to the joint." He calmly said, "Thank you, you have drawn my blood at last." It was proposed to pursue the assailant, but Ouseley, rejoicing that he was counted worthy to suffer, would not hear of it. A few days subsequently, when a young carpenter was standing on a wall by the river Fergus, about to plunge in and bathe, a stone under his feet slipped, and he fell on his stomach. Inflammation set in, and in a few days he died. His comrades stated that he was the man who had aimed the stone at the head of the missionary. God says, Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm. Psalms 105:15

Thought for Today: Though the sun may move and it's rotation change the look on things we see; giving shadow and light in various places, our Heavenly Father is unchanging and is able to give light to all continuously. No matter what is going on around us, we can stand firm, unchanging and giving His light to this world.

Story for Today: "Don't be a stick in the mud, change with the times! We are not an old testament church, we love everyone." The loudspeaker droned on as Allison walked the long hall at Corner Hope University. Excitement at entering her final year of college was dampened by the "public announcements" that seemed to continuously resound in the airwaves. Allison had enjoyed a good "Christian" home where church attendance and family devotions were a normal routine that brought peace and security to her and her siblings. She loved the chats and games that continued to entice her to learn more about God as they had their family nights on a regular basis. Going to a "Christian" college seemed like a natural step in the next phase of her life after completing High School; and with Corner Hope being just a couple hours from the family home, she had looked forward to the new independence with great enthusiasm. Attending the school's Bible classes had been fun the first couple years; but last year the college had begun something called interfaith dialogue. There was also a mandatory course called FOCUS, which was a class that taught the CO-EXIST theory that all religion was equal and Christians should accept all religious beliefs as truth. Professor Achmed was constantly at odds with the beliefs that Allison had learned from her childhood; and he constantly challenged the students to "start thinking for themselves," rather than believing what they had grown up hearing. Grateful that God had given her parents who taught her to meditate and study the scriptures, Allison took those childhood lessons and applied them to those of her professor. She had researched all of the weekly topics and had grown in her walk with the Lord. She often felt isolated as her answers to the questions during group discussion were the opposite from most of the kids that gave the answers Professor Achmed was looking for. While her grades slipped in his class, her love for God and understanding of His character grew and she felt a calmness that covered her as she remained strong in declaring truth. As she quietly, yet firmly fought the daily battle, she became aware of a few of the students that, while hesitant to speak out in class, would approach her with something they found that didn't mesh with the presentation from the lecture. Today, that battle continued. She was no longer a student of Prof. Achmed; but she would be in the library, available to discuss and help his students who really wanted to learn truth and how to defend their faith. She would point out scriptures that teach truths about the unchanging character of the Most Holy God, our Father and Creator. The loving God, of both the Old and New Testaments, shows His love through Grace, Mercy and Judgment. She would help any and all that she could be protected from the false doctrines that had begun to permeate the church as denomination after denomination began accepting and promoting fallacies that had become socially acceptable. It was hard to constantly hear the propaganda that the professors and administration of this "Christian" college broadcasted daily; but, God—her God that is the "Father of Lights"—had given her a mission field. She would do her best to live a life that would reflect the character of her unchanging God and point her peers to more wisdom and a better understanding of spiritual things, as they learned of Him.

Questions for Today: Have you learned to study and meditate on the Word of God? What is your mission field?

Prayer for Today: Heavenly Father, Thank you for being the unchangeable Father of Lights. Help us to reflect you so boldly that many will be drawn to you! In Jesus' Name AMEN

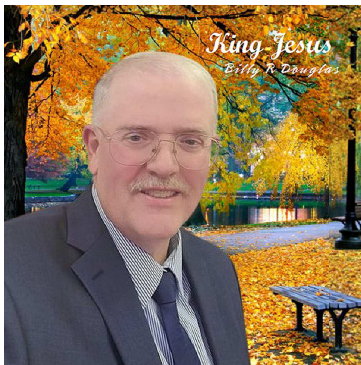
