Nathan Hale, a great American patriot during the Revolutionary War, was captured and hung by British soldiers. His now famous final words were, "I only regret that I have but one life to lose for my country." He was willing to die for his nation and its freedom. During the final days of World War II, it was apparent that the Japanese were fighting a losing battle. Yet many of their pilots, dubbed "kamikaze," willingly flew suicide missions. There was great honor in dying for a cause. The pilots were willing to die for glory. Not long ago, a mother in Philadelphia went back into a burning building to rescue her children who were trapped inside. After saving two, she died in the flames trying to save the other two. The mother was willing to die for her children. In the ancient empire of Persia, a law was passed making it a crime punishable by death to pray to anyone but the emperor. One aged government official refused to obey the edict. It was his conviction to pray three times daily to the one true God. As a result, he was cast into a den of lions. 

"And they came to Jericho: and as he went out of Jericho with His disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging. And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazereth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me. And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have mercy on me. And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; He calleth thee. And he casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus. And Jesus answered and said unto him, What wilt thou that I should do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight. And Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy faith hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way." Mk 10:46-52

Tenacious faith gets results. Bartimaeus employed an unyielding faith when the right opportunity presented itself and it won a new life for himself and his family. Unyielding, dogged and just plain old raw faith will always get God's attention. Why? Because it is the building material for every miracle you've ever seen. (Heb 11:1) God Himself used it to create the universe and all that is, then He gave to every man, woman and child the potential for this kind of faith. (Rom 12:3) Bartimaeus used cantankerous faith. When the reverent crowd began to shush him, he only got louder and bolder. He didn't care that they thought him rude. He didn't listen when they probably said so. His miracle was walking by and he was not going to give it up for anyone! Raw faith will shut your ears, eyes and mind to anything that tries to come against it. When you are using raw faith you will refuse to receive a bad report, instead you will cry out even the more until the doubt and unbelief around you is finally drowned out by faith's cry! I'm sure there were some people around him that day that felt sorry for "poor ole Bartimaeus" and tried to "prepare" him just in case his miracle did not come. They didn't want to see him crushed if his hopes became dashed. I want to tell you right now, that kind of "preparation" is not Biblical. You will receive what you expect. Don't let anyone around you try to "prepare" you to expect the worse, especially when it's a life or death situation. Let your faith cry out even the more. Do whatever you have to do to get away from that kind of reasoning. Get rude if you have to, or just walk away from them if you can. Tell them that they can either believe God with you or remove themselves from the situation. You don't need their sympathy when they are not actively agreeing with your faith. It will only prove detrimental for you. After all, it's not their life on the line, but yours. Be cantankerous with your faith. As far as we know, no one in the crowd was standing with Bartimaeus in faith. He was the only one who believed that Jesus would help him and his cantankerous faith irritated and even angered some of the people. Your's probably will too. There may be some who will whisper that you've gone a little "off your rocker" or you've become too fanatical for comfort. There may be some who will become offended because you refused to listen to their counsel to become quieter with your faith and you refused to prepare yourself in the event that you might not receive. But raw faith will believe God more than even the circumstances surrounding it. Besides, their tune will change when your faith in God has wrought your miracle and the same people who stood against you, will slap you on the back and declare (rather loudly) that they always knew that God would come through for you. When they do, please be kind and just nod and say, "Yes sir, my God is truly good!" This happened with Bartimaeus as soon as Jesus called for him. The attitude of the whole crowd amazingly changed and the same people who were standing against him were suddenly for him. In this account, we are not told if Bartimaeus was already "living the life" or if he had ever attended a faith teaching meeting. We are told that his faith made him whole. It was the same faith that caused Bartimaeus to cry out even the more as the opposition around him became stronger. He used raw faith. He used cantankerous faith. He used tenacious faith. When you use that kind of faith it is always personal. When you use that kind of faith it is always powerful, and ultimately, that kind of faith can stand even when it's just between you... and God. So, be of good comfort friend and don't stop believing. The same faith that made Bartimaeus "whole" can do the same for you.

REESIE'S RECIPES





Blueberry Patch Muffins

Ingredients

1 cup fresh blueberries
1 Tbsp. sugar (for topping)
1 tsp. grated lemon rind
2 cups sifted all purpose flour
1/3 cup sugar (for batter)
3 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp salt
1 egg, well beaten
1 cup milk
4 Tbsp margarine, melted

Pick over berries, wash, spread on paper towel to drain, set aside. Combine 1 tablespoon sugar and lemmon rind in a cup, set aside. Sift flour, 1/3 cup sugar, baking powder and salt into medium size bowl. Combine egg, milk and melted margarine in small bowl: add to dry ingredients; stir quickly and lightly just until liquid is absorbed, batter will be lumpy. Gently fold in blueberries. Spoon into 12 greased muffin pan cups, filling sups 2/3 full. Sprinkle reserved lemon-sugar over tops. Bake at 425 for 20 minutes or until golden brown. Remove from pan and serve.

Bean Tossed Salad

Ingredients

1/2 head iceberg lettuce, torn
1 cup (4oz) shredded cheddar cheese
1 cup ranch style beans, rinsed and drained
1/2 medium tomato, chopped
1/2 cup chopped onion
1/4 cup chopped green pepper
1/2 to 1 cup corn chips
1/2 cup Catalina salad dressing

In a salad bowl combine everything except corn chips and dressing. Just before serving add chips and dressing, toss to coat.

Boston Creme Pie

Ingredients

1 Package loaf size yellow cake mix
Egg
Water
1/2 tsp lemon extract
1 (4 oz) vanilla instant pudding
1 1/2 cups milk
1 tsp vanilla
1 square semi-sweet chocolate
2 Tbsp. margarine
1/4 cup powered sugar

Prepare cake mix with egg, water and lemon extract following label directions. Pour into a greased and floured 9 inch round layer cake pan. Bake at 350 for 25 minutes or until done. Cool in pan on wire rack for 10 minutes. Turn out onto rack and cool completely. Prepare pudding mix with milk and vanilla following label directions. Melt chocolate with margarine in a small sauce pan, remove from heat. Stir in powdered sugar and Tablespoon hot water until smooth. Split cake layer, put back together with vanilla pudding in between layers on a large serving plate. Spread chocolate mixture over top, letting it drizzle down side. Chill until serving time.

Deluxe Ham Balls

Ingredients

2 eggs
1/2 cup milk
3/4 cup dry bread crumbs
1/4 cup finely chopped onion
1 pound ground fully cooked ham
1/2 pound ground pork
1 can (8 oz) crushed pineapple
1/2 cup packed brown sugar
1/3 cup vinegar
1/3 cup ketchup
2 Tbsp soy sauce
1 tsp ground ginger
hot cooked rice (optional)

In a bowl combine eggs, milk, bread crumbs and onion. Crumble ham and pork over mixture, mix well. Shape into 1 1/4 inch balls. Place in a greased 13x9" pan. In a sauce pan combine remaining ingredients, except rice. Cook and stir until sugar is dissolved. Pour over ham balls. Bake uncovered at 350 for 40-45 minutes. Serve over rice (optional).

Butter Nut Balls

Ingredients

1 cup butter
1/4 cup sugar
2 cups flour
1 Tablespoon vanilla
1 1/2 cups mashed pecans
powdered sugar

Cream butter thoroughly. Add balance of ingredients except powdered sugar. Roll into balls about walnut size. Place on ungreased cookie sheet for 35 minutes in 300 degree oven. Roll in powdered sugar immediately and cool on waxed paper.

But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. Galatians 1:8


This month we continue looking at the false doctrines and teachings of the Catholic church. Once again we will be taking the actual teachings from the Catholic Catechism which is the document laying out the doctrines of this church and comparing them to what the Word of God says.

"SALVATION THROUGH THE CATHOLIC CHURCH ALONE?"

The Second Vatican Council's Decree on Ecumenism explains: "For it is through Christ's Catholic <u>Church alone</u>, which is the universal help toward salvation, <u>that the fullness of the means of salvation</u> can be obtained." Here we see the unbelievable heresy that states that salvation can only be obtained through the Catholic Church. This is why it is such a traumatic thing for one who belongs to the Catholic Church to be thrown out or excommunicated. Because according to their teachings if a person is not allowed to be a member of the Catholic church or to take communion then their soul is lost and there is no salvation for them. Unfortunately this is not the only denomination that teaches this damnable doctrine...there are others as well that claim unless you are "part of their denomination" you cannot go to heaven. How sad and HOW WRONG! The way to heaven is not through a denomination or religious organization...the way to Heaven is the same today as it has always been. The way to heaven is JESUS nothing more nothing less. When he said on the cross as he was dying "IT IS FINISHED" he meant what he said and he said what he meant. Calling on Jesus and accepting his finished work on the Cross is the only way of salvation...not baptism...not communion...not works...not having your name on a church book BUT having your name in the Lambs book of life by accepting Jesus as LORD and Saviour! The Catholic Catechism goes on to state..." Basing itself on Scripture and Tradition, the Council teaches that the Church, a pilgrim now on earth, is necessary for salvation ... thereby affirmed at the same time the necessity of the Church which men enter through Baptism as through a door." Anyone that is taught this doctrine would think that one could not be saved who, knowing that the Catholic Church was founded as necessary by God through Christ, if they refused either to enter it or to remain in it. There is only one scripture from the word of God needed to disprove this teaching. Jesus said in John 10:9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. There is no salvation by any other means than JESUS! The Catholic Church also teaches that as long as you believe in the "Creator"...The Catholic Catechism makes this clear when it states the following "The plan of salvation also includes those who acknowledge the Creator, in the first place amongst whom are the **Muslims**; these profess to hold the faith of Abraham, and together with us they adore the one, merciful God, mankind's judge on the last day." This is one of the most damnable doctrines in the world today...in other words forget that Jesus said in John 14:6...I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. And as long as you believe in God the Father you can be saved...the Word of God plainly teaches that you cannot get to the Father...the Creator...the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob UNLESS you go through the Son, Jesus! It is not enough to just believe in a God...you must believe in Jesus. We have seen this gospel of *compromise* rear its ugly head even in Church's and preachers that should know better...preachers like Joel Osteen and Billy Graham who in an effort to be politically and religiously correct make statements that lead people to believe that you "might" be able to go to heaven even is you reject Jesus...my friend there is no message any more clear in the Bible than this...you MUST be born again and that ONLY Comes through the one who died for your sins on the old rugged cross...salvation only comes through Jesus. Next month we will continue looking at the Catholic church... we will be looking at the role of the Pope and the teaching of prayers for the dead. 
