Psalms 91:1-16

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. 15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

We all know of some assassinations and assassination attempts, rather we are old enough to remember the experience or if we only read of them in history class we are familiar with them. For example: - Abraham Lincoln was assassinated on April 14, 1865 at Ford Theater in Washington D.C. Martin Luther King was assassinated April 4, 1968 on the balcony of a hotel in Memphis Tennessee. John F. Kennedy was assassinated November 22, 1963 while riding in a motorcade in Dallas Texas. March 30, 1981 there was an assassination attempt on then President Ronald Reagan. These assassinations or attempts were done on people that had the potential to turn the world upside down. Definition of Assassination/Assassinate: - To injure or destroy unexpectedly and treacherously, to murder by sudden or secret attack for impersonal reasons. September 11, 2001, America was forever changed. We lived in a comfortable state of existence. We really didn't worry about terrorist or fear any opposition from any other country. Our lifestyles were relaxed and comfortable. However, on 9/11 we were abruptly made aware of an assassination attempt on our way of living. Instantaneously we moved from a comfortable way of existence to literally living in fear. 2nd Timothy 1:7 - For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. There had been an attack upon our peace, an attack on our security, an attack on our lifestyle. The enemy, without any personal reasons, set out to destroy unexpectedly America's standard of living. 1st Peter 5:8 - Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: In the spiritual many-times although we have the ability to turn this world upside down, we get into a comfort zone. We get used to a comfortable state of spiritual existence. We get caught up in the normalcy of having church, we become conditioned to programs failing to realize that an assassination attempt has been done against our lives because we have the potential to turn the world upside down. You must understand that you have been marked for assassination. We find in Jeremiah 1:5 the Bible says - Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations. This scripture is so very powerful and is loaded with clues to the time and realm that transcends what we can fathom in our minds. Let's break this scripture down. Before = at an earlier time. It is stating that at a time prior to a particular time. Formed = mold into a certain shape. Womb = the place something is generated. Sanctified = set apart. Ordained = to invest officially with priestly authority. Prophet = one that utters/speaks inspired revelations. Nations = refers to people. You see in an earlier time before you were formed God knew you, this is spiritual it has nothing at all to do with the natural, it is 100% spiritual. In the spiritual realm God sanctified you, which means He set you apart and ordained you, which means He officially invested in you the priestly authority to proclaim the name of Jesus to the people of the world. Then He placed you in the womb, which was the incubation process. While in the incubation process this calling was being generated in you. When you were born in the natural there was a mark that was placed upon that you cannot see in this natural realm because it is a spiritual mark that God placed upon you in an earlier time. However, the devil, which is a spiritual being, is able to see the mark of God upon your life and he is determined to assassinate you. The trial and tribulations you go through are assassination attempts on your life. The Bible says in 1st Peter 4:12 - Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: (It's assassination attempts.) However, we can rest assured because in Isaiah 54:17 - No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD. There is no weapon that the devil can form that will be able to do you any harm, there is no assassination attempt that can cause you to lose your life, but it's conditional. Psalms 91:1 - He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. The word dwell means to live as a resident of. When we use the word "Dwelleth", it makes that word go to another level. It makes the responsibility upon us a continuous one. The phrase secret place means that no one else knows where this place is. It is referring to here, the presence of the Lord. There is a song that says: In the Word of God I've got a hiding place! The Word of God is the presence of the Lord. 1st John 1:1 - That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life; When we dwell in the Word of God our secret place, the devil is not able to attack us. The word abides means to remain stable or fixed to continue in a place to endure without yielding to bear patiently. There is an assassination attempt on your life, but if you dwell in the secret place you will abide under the shadow of the all mighty. When we are under the shadow of the all mighty no weapon that comes our way will be able to do us any harm. If you just abide under the shadow of the almighty he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, [and] from the noisome pestilence. If you abide under the shadow: Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies Envy, murders, drunkenness, reveling, jealousy, hatred, backbiting, and slander may come against you but abide under the shadow of the almighty for He will be your shield and buckler. If you abide under the shadow of the almighty you can walk through the valley of the shadow of death and fear no evil, why because I am dwelling in the secret place of the most High. There is an assassination attempt on your life, but dwell in the secret place.

Veggie Bars

First Layer:

2 cans crescent rolls
1 (8oz) pkg. cream cheese
1/2 pkg. hidden valley ranch mix
1/4 cup mayonnaise

Spread crescent rolls on cookie sheet and bakes ad directed on pkg. Let cool, mix next 3 ingredients. Spread on top of cooked rolls on cookie sheet.

Topping:

1/4 cup shredded carrots
1/4 cup shredded broccoli
1/4 cup shredded cauliflower
Your choice of any other veggies
Top with veggie mixture, chill and serve.

Apple Dumplings

2 cans crescent rolls
2 large granny smith apples, peeled and cored
1 1/2 cup sugar
2 sticks butter
2 tsp. cinnamon
1 (12oz) can of sprite

Cut apples into 8 pieces each. Unroll and separate rolls. Wrap one apple slice in each piece, starting at wide end. Place in greased 9x13 baking dish. In separate pan, melt butter and then add sugar and cinnamon. Stir until sugar is dissolved. Spoon over rolls, then pour spirit over all. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes. Turn apples over and continue baking for an additional 15 minutes.

Lincolns Baked Beans

1/2 pound pork sausage
1 small onion, chopped
1 (32oz) can baked beans with pork
1/2 tsp. mustard powder
1/2 cup brown sugar
1/4 cup white sugar
2 T. ketchup
4 T. barbeque sauce

Cook sausage and onion in skillet until sausage is browned. Drain, mix remaining ingredients into sausage and onion. Pour into a 9x9 dish. Bake 40-50 minutes on 350.

You Never Know Whose Life Your Touching

His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. Matthew 25:21

In the mid 1850's a troubled teenager from Northfield, Massachusetts moved to Boston to try to find work. He hadn't gone to school beyond the fifth grade; he couldn't spell, his grammar was awful and his manners were brash and crude. Thankfully, an uncle took him on as a shoe salesman—on condition that he be obedient and that he attend church. The boy had been raised in a Unitarian church which denied the full divinity of Messiah and did not emphasize human need for salvation from sins. At his uncle's church, he began learning about these things, but decided that he wanted to enjoy the pleasures of the world and wait until just before he died to give His life to the Lord. However, through the kindness and persistence of his Sunday School teacher, Edward Kimball, the rebellious teen was encouraged to continue coming to church and study the Bible regularly. Kimball said he had never seen anyone whose mind was as spiritually dark. On April 21, 1855, Kimball decided to pay a special visit to the boy at his uncle's shoe store in order to ask if he would commit his life to the Lord. The boy listened closely and gave his heart to God that day. Immediately he began sharing his faith with others. Later, the young man moved to Chicago. He wandered the streets to find other young boys to bring to his Church. He had a passion for saving souls and determined never to let a day pass without telling someone about the gospel. The boy's name was D.L. Moody....and he became a great man of faith. Among his many achievements on either side of the Atlantic was the founding of Moody Bible Institute. In fact, to this day, Moody Bible Institute and the Moody Broadcasting Network continue to reach thousands of souls on a daily basis! It was estimated that before D.L. Moody passed away that as many as a million souls were brought to the Lord. What a testimony Moody's is! But we overlook the fact that it was a faithful Sunday school teacher's obedience and persistence that changed the course of history! We may think we are doing very little for the the Lord... that we're merely teaching a few kids at Sunday school. But the Lord can use anyone in His service — those whose hearts are given to Him. 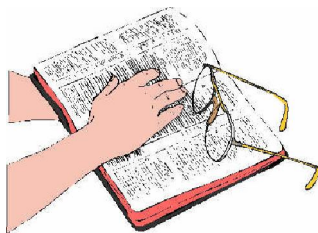


Anger Resteth In The Bosom Of Fools



"Be not hasty in thy spirit to be angry, for anger resteth in the bosom of fools." Ecclesiastes 7:9

The above passage of scripture is taken from the writings and the wisdom of Solomon. This man in all of his wisdom had come to learn that anger was not a friend but an enemy, it was not helpful but harmful to anyone who allowed it to *rest in their bosom*. Do we all have anger? Of course we do...BUT allowing that anger to "rest" in our bosom is a whole other thing. The word "resteth" there means "to rest, to settle down; to dwell, stay, let alone, give comfort". In other words instead of dealing with it through repentance and taking it to the altar and asking the LORD for his help many times we let it rest...we leave it alone...we allow it to stay and not only that BUT many times we have taken "comfort" in that anger as well!! Feeling justified in our anger...as though it is our right and we are going to take it!! When in reality the truth is when anger is left alone in our lives it is dangerous...AND the longer it is allowed to remain the more dangerous it becomes. Let us look for a moment at the first time that the Bible mentions anyone getting angry. In Genesis the 4th chapter we find Cain and Abel both bringing offerings to the LORD...Abel offers a blood sacrifice and Cain offers a sacrifice of the work of his hands. As you know, Abel's sacrifice was accepted and Cain's sacrifice was rejected...we will pick it up in verse 6 and we find that Cain is "angry"...*Genesis 4:6 And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?* The word "wroth" there means to burn with anger! There is no question here that Cain was indeed angry...the question is what would he do about it? The LORD would deal with him in the very next verse and give him the opportunity to repent when he would say to him *"If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him."* What takes place next not only lets us know that he didn't repent but it also shows us that he allowed that anger to "rest in his bosom"!! *Genesis 4:8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.* We see here that not only did he not deal with his anger but when he allowed it to rest it became stronger...it grew into something more...it lead to murder! That's exactly what anger will do in our life...and not just anger but bitterness, un-forgiveness, malice, strife...ALL of the works of the flesh...IF we allow them to "rest" in our lives...to go un-dealt with...un-repent-ed of they will all grow and become stronger and stronger. They will quench the Spirit. They will hinder the Holy Spirit from bringing forth fruit in our lives! And not only will they effect our life but they will hinder us from being an effective witness to others as well...thereby hindering the work that the Holy Spirit may do in the lives of others through the influence of our life! "He said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness'.
2 Corinthians 12:9 (KJV)

"Ancient Babylon"

Ancient Babylon who built it actually? Where was it located? How big was it? Let's get our answers, okay? According to Unger's Bible Dictionary Nebuchadnezzar the grandfather of Belshazzar who saw the handwriting on the wall in the book of Daniel did not build the city. Genesis 10:8-10 ascribes the founding of the city to the descendants of Cush and the followers of Nimrod. Cush was the father of Nimrod. The name "Babylon" is derived by the Hebrews and means, "to confound" and has reference to the confusion of tongues at the tower of Babel. Babylon was in the middle of our modern Iraq. The walls were double! The outer one, 25 feet thick, the inner one 23 feet thick with an intervening space filled with rubble. Population estimated to be about 500,000. It was a fabulous city! With it's hanging gardens. It was not destroyed. Some time after the Medes and Persians got control it just went down and people moved out. It will be rebuilt one more time and God himself will destroy this one. You can read about it in chapter 18 of Revelation! The city did not reach the height of it's glory until the reign of Nebuchadnezzar! The ancient city in time to come decayed and soon became a desert. Alexander the Great thought to restore it as it was in ruins in his day, but was deterred by the prohibitive cost. The queenly Babylon never revived. So much for the great Ancient Babylon.
