

Ezekiel 3:18-21 – When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand.19 Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul. 20 Again, When a righteous man doth turn from his righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumbling-block before him, he shall die: because thou hast not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he hath done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at thine hand. 21 Nevertheless if thou warn the righteous man, that the righteous sin not, and he doth not sin, he shall surely live, because he is warned; also thou hast delivered thy soul.

A CONTRAST BETWEEN THEN AND NOW THEN: The four lepers went and told the good news. NOW: We often hoard the blessings to ourselves . . . And that because: 1. Some are still starving in the midst of plenty. 2. Some claim others are not interested. 3. Some are too afraid of offending others. 4. Some are in denial that those around them are lost. 5. Some hide behind their lack of knowledge. Could it be that we just do not care and are just not willing to put forth the effort? THEN: The lepers said in 2nd Kings 7:9 - Then they said one to another, We do not well: this day is a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we tarry till the morning light, some mischief will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household NOW: What have we concluded? Listening brethren . . . We are saved in order to save others. The lost will die at a cost . . . The eternal damnation of their souls! Titus 3:1-6 - Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, 2 To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men. 3 For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. 4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, 5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; 6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; 1. Be ready to the good work of: a. Living in Christ, b. Living for Christ, c. Telling others about Christ. 2. Be ready to the good work of showing the lost the lighted path to Christ. 3. Be ready to the good work of cooperating with God in saving lost souls. 4. Be ready to the good work of teaching God's truth to those who have encompassed error instead. Brethren . . .1. We are not going to bring in the sheaves until we roll up our sleeves. 2. We'll never bring all the world into Christ, until we bring Christ into all the world! 3. We'll have no faith in the mission before us, unless we have faith in the Master behind us! 4. We'll never get others to obey the great commands until we obey the great commission! 5. We cannot expect the world to react to the Word, till we act on it! 6. We'll never get excited over sowing the seed, until we get excited over seeing the need!" 7. We can't make Christ mean anything to others, until we make Him mean everything to us! 8. Let's not jeeringly say, "Look what the world is coming to," but joyfully say, "Look what has come to the world!" 9. We will make more conversions, when we have more convictions! 10. We'll never get others to see the joy of claiming Christ, till we get ourselves to see the joy of proclaiming Christ! 11. We'll never be challenged by seeing through our task, till we recognize the challenge of seeing our task through! 12. We'll never really consider the lost, till we stop considering the cost. 13. We'll quit trying to save money, only when we really start trying to save men! 14. We'll be in a better position to help, when we are in a better disposition to help! 15. We won't have to pay the penalty in the reaping, if we are willing to pay the price in the sowing! 16. Every heart without Christ is a mission field, and every heart with Christ is a missionary! 2nd Corinthians 4:3 – "But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost."

The Awful Truth

And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:32

We MUST know our enemy if we would have any hope of defeating the enemy. In recent decades, Americans have had much difficulty in both understanding who our enemies are and what their goals are. We've been infiltrated—our government, our schools, our universities, our churches, our communities—have been invaded by the enemy. As Pogo said, "We have met the enemy and he is us!" We are not experiencing social distancing—it's social conditioning that's being forced upon us! We, the American people (and most the world), have allowed ourselves to be conditioned to fear, conditioned to believe in a non-existent crisis, and conditioned to believe that the government has our best interest at heart. What we failed to realize is that our best weapon against all these things is our freedom—and we handed that over without a fight! Had we recognized that there are those in high positions, at the state and national levels, that are enemies of freedom and enemies of our country, maybe we would have had the courage that former President Ronald Reagan spoke of. "You and I have the courage to say to our enemies, there is a price we will not pay, there is a point beyond which they must not advance." But we didn't. We didn't have the courage to confront draconian governors or national authorities, saying, "You are not acting constitutionally; this is outside your enumerated powers. We are people with freedoms given to us by God, freedoms that you took an oath to protect. The law limits you, not me!" We were short-sighted and are paying a price now that we would not be paying had we held our freedoms dear and if we respected the law of our land. We have become so used to unconstitutionality that we neglected to say, "There is a point beyond which they must not advance." Instead, homeowners allowed them to unconstitutionally tell us who can and cannot be in our house. If they can get away with that, next they will unlawfully force themselves or others into our homes against our will. Individuals allowed them to unconstitutionally tell us what we must wear if we want to shop or do business (even when it's now proven harmful), the distance we must stand from one another, and if we are essential or not. Business owners complied with unconstitutional orders to close their businesses and those that stayed open agreed to follow guidelines unconstitutionally forced upon them. Private schools and universities succumbed to the unconstitutional pressure to send their students home. Churches felt unconstitutionally pressured to close their doors and are only now beginning to open them timidly and beggarly, almost like Dickens' Oliver Twist—hands out saying, "More please." Some will be angered by these words; but we must remember that with great freedom comes great responsibility. We must take responsibility for what we have allowed (even for a short while). When told that our freedoms were no longer ours and that an overreaching government would decide which freedoms would be doled out to us and in what measure, we should have said, "NO! Not for a minute!" The thing about power is, that like Chinese food, it leaves the eater hungry for more soon after. We thought we were being reasonable; we were being foolish. Those whose motives were to sacrifice freedom for safety should be reminded that our founders believed in self-government first and foremost. If you choose to limit your actions, that's your right—your freedom; but neither you nor the government can lawfully limit someone else's freedom of movement, assembly, speech, government redress, the Second Amendment, or anything that is outside the enumerated powers specifically given to our governing bodies. Asking everyone to walk in lock-step with unconstitutional executive orders because of your fear lacks the compassion for others that you claim freedom lovers lack for you. The fact is we've been fooled; but like Mark Twain wisely noticed, "It's easier to fool people than to convince them that they have been fooled." The only way out of this is to admit our error and move wisely forward, constitutionally every step of the way. It's easier and more comfortable to blame someone else; but that's not helpful. There are many people we could blame; but if we want to emerge victorious, we must not fall into victim mentality. We may want to blame the Chinese for our imminent economic troubles; but if the truth be told, we destroyed our own economy. Nationally speaking, freedom is our weapon against all global attacks. Had the federal, state, and local governments followed the constitution rather than trading on fear; and had "We, the People" stood for our rights en masse, our economy would still be strong, our freedoms would be intact, and (perhaps) we would have set pace for the rest of the world to follow. We needed to follow God's Word and our Constitution. Our hope is in the Lord; but we have a responsibility to live correctly too. Lord, help us! This is bigger than us, our families, our community, and even our nation. It's bigger than this pandemic; it affects the world at large. We must open our eyes to the agenda that has boldly unfolded before us and listen to Trevor Loudon's word of warning: "This is a point I think Americans need to comprehend. If America goes down economically, it will go down militarily. If America goes down militarily, we ALL go down. The free world is finished; and it will be finished for a very, very long time." Some will accuse me of not being compassionate. I can't think of anything more compassionate than speaking the truth and urging my fellowman to follow that truth. In a nutshell, this is the fact: When we succumb to and follow unconstitutional edicts or laws presented by authorities behaving in a lawless manner, we too have become lawless. We are NOT following the law of the land nor are we following Scripture at that point. We must take responsibility for our actions, repent of those actions which are unbiblical, and pray for boldness to live correctly. Let us live in our God-given freedoms and constitutionally make the changes necessary to put America back on track. Be fooled no more; be discerning.





Stuffed Mushrooms

8 oz package baby portabella mushrooms
1 oz cream cheese
1/4 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1/4 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
8 club crackers
1 tbsp butter

1/2 tbsp grated Parmesan cheese shredded gouda and mozzarella cheese for topping

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Wash mushrooms and remove stems. Stir together cream cheese, cheddar cheese and 1/4 cup mozzarella cheese. Stuff mixture into mushroom caps and place in a greased baking dish. Cover with shredded mozzarella cheese and then cover with shredded Gouda cheese. Place club crackers in small food processor and grind into crumbs. Melt the butter in a small bowl add crumbs and parmesan cheese. Sprinkle crumb mixture over top of mushrooms and bake for 20 minutes.

BBQ Ham

1 whole boneless ham (5 to 6 lbs)1 bottle Sweet Baby Rays BBQ sauce (or your favorite if not available)

1/2 cup water

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place whole ham in baking pan. Pour water into the bottom of the pan. Insert a knife into a few places in the top of the ham. Making a few deep cuts. Cover ham with entire bottle of BBQ sauce. Cover with aluminum foil.

Bake for 2 1/2 hours.

All Purpose BBQ Rub

1/4 cup course salt1/4 cup dark brown sugar1/4 cup sweet paprika2 Tbsp pepper

Combine all ingredients. Store in an airtight jar.

BBQ Pit Glaze

1 cup brown sugar
1 cup honey
1/2 cup coke
4 Tbsp honey mustard

2 tsp Weber Brown Sugar BBQ Rub

Combine all ingredients in a sauce pan. Bring to a simmer over low heat (do not boil). Keep warm. Use glaze to baste meats while cooking (baking, grilling or smoking) and to drizzle over meats when slicing.

Old Fashioned Macaroni Salad

pound large elbow macaroni
 ounces American cheese, cut into small cubes
 2 stalks chopped celery
 1 tablespoon lemon juice

Dressing:

2/3 cup mayonnaise
2 tablespoons honey mustard
1 (4-ounce) jar diced pimentos, drained
3 tablespoons sweet pickled relish
salt and pepper

Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil over high heat and add the macaroni. Cook until al dente. Drain and rinse with cold water. Put cooled macaroni into a large serving bowl, add cheese, celery, and lemon juice. Gently stir to combine. In a separate bowl, whisk together the mayonnaise, mustard, pimentos, pickled relish, and salt and pepper, to taste. Add the dressing to the macaroni and toss to coat. Season with more salt and pepper, if needed. Cover and chill for 2 hours for the flavors to meld.

Kenneth Osbeck, author of several books on hymnology, says its revelation to the public came about this way: "One day at the Bible conference in Northfield, Massachusetts, Miss Crosby was asked by D.L. Moody to give a personal testimony. At first she hesitated, then quietly rose and said, 'There is one hymn I have written which has never been published. I call it my soul's poem. Sometimes when I am troubled, I repeat it to myself, for it brings comfort to my heart.' She then recited while many wept:

"Some day the silver cord will break, And I no more as now shall sing, But, O, the joy when I awake Within the palace of the King. And I shall see Him face to face, And tell the story saved by grace.

Some day my earthly house will fall, I cannot tell how soon 'twill be, But this I know, my All in All Has now a place in heaven for me. And I shall see Him face to face, And tell the story saved by grace.

Some day, when fades the golden sun Beneath the rosy-tinted West, My blessed Lord will say, "Well done!" And I shall enter into rest. And I shall see Him face to face, And tell the story saved by grace.


