REESIE'S RECIPES



Breakfast Pizza

Ingredients

- 1 (8 oz) low fat crescent rolls
- 1 1/2 cups frozen hash browns
- 1/4 tsp seasoned salt
- 1/2 cup chopped vegetables (such as bell peppers, mushrooms or broccoli)
- 1/4 cup cooked and crumbled bacon and or ground beef
- 1 cup egg beaters
- 1 cup shredded reduced fat cheddar cheese

Preheat oven to 400. Unroll crescent dough, pat on to bottom and 3/4 inch up sides of a 13x9 pan. Bake for 8 minutes. Sprinkle potatoes over crust. Sprinkle with season salt. Arrange vegetables and bacon over potatoes. Carefully pour egg beaters over all and sprinkle with cheese. Bake 12 to 15 minutes or until cheese is melted and crust is brown.

Chicken Cheese Dip

Ingredients

- Non stick cooking spray
- 1 bottle (16 oz) ranch salad dressing
- 2 (8 oz) cream cheese
- 1 1/2 cups bottle buffalo wing sauce
- 3 cups shredded mozzarella cheese
- 5 cups chopped or shredded cooked chicken breast
- Corn chips

Preheat oven to 350. Spray 3 quart baking dish with cooking spray. In large sauce pan heat dressing, cream cheese, buffalo wing sauce and one cup of cheese over low heat until cheese is melted and smooth. Stir in chicken, heat through. Spoon into prepared baking dish. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake uncovered for 20 minutes or until heated through and cheese melts. Let stand 10 minutes before serving. Serve with chips.

Peanut Butter Pie

Ingredients

- 1 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1 (8 oz) cream cheese, softened
- 1 (8 oz) Cool Whip, thawed
- 1 (6 oz) graham cracker crust

In a large mixing bowl beat peanut butter and cream cheese with a mixer on medium speed until well combined. Fold in half of the cool whip until well combined. Spread evenly in pie shell. Top with remaining cool whip. Cover and chill for 1 hour before serving.

Baked Potato Soup

Ingredients

- 2 to 2 1/2 pounds russet potatoes
- 2/3 cup butter
- 2/3 cup all purpose flour
- 3/4 tsp. salt
- 1/4 tsp ground white pepper
- 6 cups milk
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 (8 oz) sour cream
- 1/4 cup thinly sliced green onions

10 slices bacon, cooked crisp, drained and crumbled
Preheat oven to 350. Scrub potatoes and prick with a fork. Wrap potatoes individually in foil. Bake for 55 to 65 minutes or until tender. Cool, peel and cube potatoes. Meanwhile in a 4 quart Dutch oven melt butter. Stir in flour, salt and pepper until smooth. Gradually stir in milk. Cook and stir over medium heat until thickened and bubbly: cook for 1 minute longer. Remove from heat. Whisk in half of the cheese until smooth. Whisk in sour cream until smooth. Stir in potatoes and onions, heat through over low heat do not boil. To serve, garnish with bacon and remaining half of the cheese.

Molasses Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 cup Crisco, all veg shortening
- 2 cups sugar
- 1/2 cup egg beaters
- 1/2 cup molasses
- 4 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/3 cup white sugar

Preheat oven to 400. In medium bowl stir together flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon and ginger, set aside. In large mixing bowl beat shortening and 2 cups sugar with an electric mixer on medium to high speed until fluffy. Add egg beaters and molasses, beat until combined. Beat in as much of the flour mixture as you can with the mixer. Stir in any remaining flour mixture. Shape dough into 1 inch balls. Place 1/3 cup sugar in a small bowl. Roll balls in sugar and place 2 inches apart on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 8 to 10 minutes or until lightly brown.

The Power of Forgiveness

One of President Abraham Lincoln's associates scolded him rather severely for being soft on his enemies. "Why do you insist on trying to make friends of them?" he chided. "You should be trying to destroy them." To which Lincoln replied gently, "Am I not destroying my enemies when I make them my friends?" In speaking of those who were his enemies during the Civil War, Lincoln is reported to have said, "Insane as it may seem, I hold malice toward none of them. I have neither the time nor the energy in this life to hold that kind of resentment."

Following the Civil War, Robert E. Lee was visiting in Kentucky where one lady showed him the remains of what had been an enormous, old tree. This tree stood directly in front of her house. She bitterly cried to General Lee of how its limbs and trunk had been shattered by Federal artillery fire. Having poured out her anguish she looked to the old soldier for a condemnation of the North. Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. 1John 4: 17-18

Recently I watched as a man walked up to someone that has openly rebuked them, slandered them, and has been outspoken about them. I myself probably would not have had the courage to walk up to someone that I knew had shown such contempt for me. However, this person went to them, extended his hand for a handshake and spoke kind words. Instantly this person they were addressing started speaking words that were unkind. Words that were filled with hate and everything that you would not want to hear. When this person finished saying such unkind words at a volume that others standing around could hear, this man that had stood there and took all this verbal abuse, smiled and excused himself and went on his way. He had blessed this man and the person with him. He had shown that you can turn the other cheek and the enemy may slap it as well. 
Quickened

"But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you." Romans 8:11




