“What Wilt Thou Have Me To Do?”

Acts 9:6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and it shall be told thee what thou must do.

Acts 19:1-8 And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples, 2 He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. 3 And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. 4 Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. 5 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. 6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied. 7 And all the men were about twelve. 8 And he went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God.

And as soon as Paul was willing to yield he was in a condition where God could meet his need; where God could display His power; where God could have the man. Oh, beloved, are you saying today, “What wilt thou have me to do?” The place of yieldedness is just where God wants us. People are saying, “I want the baptism, I want healing, I would like to know of a certainty that I am a child of God,” and I see nothing, absolutely nothing in the way except unyieldedness to the plan of God. The condition was met which Paul demanded, and instantly when he laid hands on them they were filled with the Spirit and spake in other tongues and prophesied (Acts 19:6). The only thing needed was just to be in the condition where God could come in. The main thing today that God wants is obedience. When you begin yielding and yielding to God He has a plan for your life, and you come in to that wonderful place where all you have to do is to eat the fruits of Canaan. I am convinced that Paul must have been in divine order as well as those men, and Paul had a mission right away to the whole of Asia. Brothers and sisters, it is the call of God that counts. Paul was in the call of God. Oh, I believe God wants to stir somebody's heart today to obedience; it may be for China or India or Africa, but the thing God is looking for is obedience. “What wilt thou have me to do?” (Acts 9:6). Acts 19:11-12 - And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul: 12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them. If God can have His way today, the ministry of somebody will begin; it always begins as soon as you yield. Paul had been bringing many people to prison, but God brought Paul to such a place of yieldedness and brokenness that he cried out, “What wilt thou have me to do?” (Acts 9:6). Paul's choice was to be a bondservant for Jesus Christ. Beloved, are you willing that God shall have His way today? Acts 9:16 - For I will shew him how great things he must suffer for my name's sake. But Paul saw that these things were working out a far more exceeding weight of glory. When the prodigal son had returned and the father had killed the fatted calf and made a feast for him, the elder brother was angry. Luke 15:27-31 - And he said unto him, Thy brother is come; and thy father hath killed the fatted calf, because he hath received him safe and sound. 28 And he was angry, and would not go in: therefore came his father out, and intreated him. 29 And he answering said to his father, Lo, these many years do I serve thee, neither transgressed I at any time thy commandment: and yet thou never gavest me a kid, that I might make merry with my friends: 30 But as soon as this thy son was come, which hath devoured thy living with harlots, thou hast killed for him the fatted calf. 31 And he said unto him, Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine. He could kill a fatted calf at any time. Beloved, all in the Father's house is ours, but it will come only through obedience. And when He can trust us, we will not come behind in anything. Acts 19:11 - And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul: Let us notice the handkerchiefs that went from his body; it means to say that when he touched and sent them forth, God wrought special miracles through them, and diseases departed from the sick, and evil spirits went out of them. Is it not lovely? Story that Smith Wigglesworth told: A woman came to me one day and said, “My husband is such a trial to me; the first salary he gets he spends it in drink, and then he cannot do his work and comes home; I love him very much, what can be done?” I said, “If I were you I would take a handkerchief and would place it under his head when he went to sleep at night, and say nothing to him, but have a living faith.” We anointed a handkerchief in the name of Jesus, and she put it under his head. Oh, beloved, there is a way to reach these wayward ones. The next morning on his way to work he called for a glass of beer; he lifted it to his lips, but he thought there was something wrong with it, and he put it down and went out. He went to another saloon, and another, and did the same thing. He came home sober. His wife was gladly surprised and he told her the story; how it had affected him. That was the turning point in his life; it meant not only giving up drink, but it meant his salvation. God wants to change our faith today. He wants us to see it is not obtained by struggling and working and pining. John 16:27 - For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God. Matthew 8:17 - That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. Matthew 11:28 - Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Who is the man that will take the place of Paul, and yield and yield and yield, until God so possesses him in such a way that from his body virtue shall flow to the sick and suffering? It will have to be the virtue of Christ that flows. Don't think there is some magic virtue in the handkerchief or you will miss the virtue; it is the living faith in the man who lays the handkerchief on his body, and the power of God through that faith. Praise God, we may lay hold of this living faith today. “The blood has never lost its power.” As we get in touch with Jesus, wonderful things will take place; and what else? We shall get nearer and nearer to Him. There is another side to it. Acts 19:13-15 - Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth. 14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so. 15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? Paul had the resemblance. You are not going to get it without having His presence; His presence changes you. You are not going to be able to get the results without the marks of the Lord Jesus. The man must have the divine power within himself; devils will take no notice of any power if they do not see the Christ. “Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye?” The difference between these men was they had not the marks of Christ, so the manifestation of the power of Christ was not seen. You want power: don't take the wrong way. Don't take it as power because you speak in tongues, and if God has given you revelations along certain lines don't take that for the power; or if you have even laid hands on the sick and they have been healed, don't take that for the power. Luke 4:18 - The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, that alone is the power. Don't be deceived; there is a place to get where you know the Spirit is upon you, so you will be able to do the works which are wrought by this blessed Spirit of God in you, and the manifestation of His power shall be seen, and people will believe in the Lord. What will make men believe the divine promises of God? Beloved, let me say to you today, God wants you to be ministering spirits, and it means to be clothed with another power. And this divine power, you know when it is there, and you know when it goes forth. The baptism of Jesus must bring us to have a single eye to the glory of God; everything else is wasted time and wasted energy. Beloved, we can reach it; it is a high mark but we can get to it. You ask how? “What wilt thou have me to do?” That is the plan. It means a perfect surrender to the call of God, and perfect obedience. God wants us to see that the power of God coming upon people has something more in it than we have yet known. The power to heal and to baptize is in this place, but you must say, “Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?” You say it is four months before the harvest. If you had the eyes of Jesus you would see that the harvest is already here. The devil will say you can't have faith; you tell him he is a liar. The Holy Ghost wants you for the purpose of manifesting Jesus through you. Oh, may you never be the same again! The Holy Spirit moving upon us will make us to be like Him, and we will truly say, “Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?”



REESIE'S RECIPES

Peanut Butter Chocolate Éclair Cake

- 1 box chocolate graham crackers
(there will be a few graham crackers left over)
- 2 (3 1/4-ounce) boxes vanilla instant pudding
- 1 cup peanut butter
- 3 1/2 cups milk
- 1 (8-ounce) container Cool Whip, thawed
- 1 can chocolate frosting

Spray the bottom of a 9x13 pan with cooking spray. Line the bottom of the pan with whole graham crackers. In bowl of an electric mixer, mix pudding with milk and peanut butter; beat at medium speed for 2 minutes. Fold in whipped topping. Pour half the pudding mixture over graham crackers. Place another layer of whole graham crackers on top of pudding layer. Pour over remaining half of pudding mixture and cover with another layer of graham crackers. Heat the container of prepared frosting, uncovered in the microwave for 1 minute. Pour over the top of the cake. Refrigerate for at least 12 hours.

Cake Batter Crispy Treats

Top Layer:

- 4 TB butter
- (1) 12-ounce bag of mini marshmallows
- 1/4 cup yellow cake mix
- 6 cups rice krispies cereal
- (1) 1.75-ounce container of sprinkles

Bottom Layer:

- 3 TB Butter
- (1) 10 oz bag mini marshmallows
- 4-5 cups fruity pebbles

Melt butter in a large saucepan over low heat and add marshmallows. Stir until they begin to melt, adding in cake mix one spoonful at a time so its combined. Stir in cereal so it is completely coated with marshmallow mixture. Sprinkle in half of the sprinkles and mix. You'll make the fruity pebble krispy's using the recipe above (bottom layer)... however only let the marshmallows melt about half the way. Press the fruity pebble mixture into the baking dish (9X13). Next, add the cake batter recipe and top with remaining sprinkles. Let sit for about 30 minutes before cutting.

Crescent Sausage Bites

- 1 lb. hot sausage (pork or turkey)
- 1 (8 oz.) package cream cheese
- 2 packages crescent rolls
- Dash salt & ground black pepper

In a saute pan, brown sausage; drain. Add a dash of salt and pepper. Blend in cream cheese until the cream cheese is melted. Unroll one package of crescent rolls and place on a baking sheet. With your fingers, gently press the seams together to seal them. Spread the sausage mixture evenly over the crescent roll dough, leaving about a 1/2-inch border along the edges. Unroll the remaining package of crescent rolls and place on top of the sausage mixture. Press the edges together to seal. Gently press the seams together. Bake at 375 degrees for about 20 minutes, or until crescent roll dough is golden brown. Cut into small squares with a pizza cutter and serve.

Mexican Lasagna

- 1 can (10 3/4 ounces) Campbell's Condensed Cheddar Cheese Soup
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1 package (about 1 ounce) fajita seasoning mix
- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 can (10 3/4 ounces) Campbell's Condensed Golden Mushroom Soup
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 tablespoon chili powder
- 1 1/2 teaspoons dried oregano leaves, crushed
- 12 corn tortillas (5-to 6- inch)
- Chopped tomatoes (optional)
- Sliced green onions (optional)

Stir cheese soup, milk and half the fajita seasoning in medium bowl until mixture is smooth. Cook beef in a 10-inch skillet over medium-high heat until well browned, stirring often to separate meat. Pour off any fat. Stir mushroom soup, water, chili powder, oregano and remaining fajita seasoning in skillet and heat to a boil. Reduce heat to low. Cook for 5 minutes. Remove skillet from heat. Place 3 tortillas in the bottom of a 2-quart shallow baking dish, overlapping slightly. Spread 1 cup beef mixture over the tortillas. Repeat layers twice. Top with remaining tortillas. Spread the cheese soup mixture over the tortillas. Bake at 350°F. for 30 minutes or until hot and bubbling. Let stand for 10 minutes. Sprinkle with the tomatoes and onions, if desired.



"God is SO Good"

"Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning. James 1:17"

In verses 12-18, the writer returns to his discussion of temptation. He emphasizes here the fact that God never tempts anyone. (although we are tested, and tried) I think it's important that we understand that "Evil does not come from God". But every "good and perfect gift" does. God always has, and always will be the source of all good. So, what's your take on God today? One of the Names that the Bible uses to describe God is "ABBA" - meaning "Daddy". There is no second guessing how God sees us in that word picture is there? In fact, God's WORD tells us over and over that he loves us, but he also says... "For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth." Proverbs 3:12; Hebrews 12:6; Revelation 3:19 Most in the WORLD sees Him as a God Of "Judgment, and a God of Wrath; and there are times when He must punish the wicked for their sin. But He would so much rather love them. In fact, He tells us that he chastens those that He does love. You and I get up every morning, as it is our routine... get ready for our jobs, and take off so as not to be late - forgetting all the time that it is He that wakes us in the mornings. It is He who has numbered our days, & counted the very number of hairs on our heads. It is He who listens to our heartbeat, and knows every thought and intent therein. It is He who hears our prayers, and has told us that He wants to give us the very desires of our hearts. (Psalm 37:4) What's more is - that our text for today doesn't just paint Him as a Gift Giver - but it proclaims the nature of His Parentage. He was the Father of Lights. This was the Same Father That hung the Galaxies in their place and then flung the stars across the heavens so that man would never be in total darkness. This was the same Father who took Abraham out beneath those stars and promised that his seed would be even greater that he could count. Then the writer goes on to say that "in Him", "...there is no variableness, nor shadow of turning". That's a hard thing to find in a Father today. In fact, that's a pretty tough thing to find in the character of most anyone that we meet on a Daily basis. How many times have you made promises to your children - and had to break them? What about your best friend? Your own Mother? Saying one thing and doing another, tends to leave a bad taste in the mouth. Our scripture reminds us today - that Our God is not like that. Our text tells us that this same "Father of Lights" is unchanging, and that there is "no shadow of turning" in Him. I can guarantee you that my Kids will never say that about their dad. But YOU AND I can be sure of it! What do you have need of today? Call on Him... He'll be excited to hear from you.



NIGHT COMETH...

I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work. John 9:4

Greetings in the name of Jesus! This month I want to share something with you that the LORD gave to me in the early morning hours of February 1st. In what started as a dream and ended in a vision the LORD gave me a WORD that he told me to share. He told me that even though He was showing this to me that it wasn't just for me...but that the message is for all that carry His Word in these last days. And although he told me to share it with His ministers first He also told me that the message is not just for preachers BUT for every one...sinner or saint. We have never been closer to the end than we are at this moment. There is a cry going out in the Spirit get ready NIGHT COMETH!! We all must work while it is day for there is no doubt that night is on the horizon. I pray that this Word touches you the way that it has me.

The dream - We were in our home and I could hear the tornado sirens going off. I opened the back door and the wind was so strong it was all I could do to hold on to the door. I looked to the right and when I turned to look to the left I was looking at what I thought was the tail of a tornado no more than 3 feet from me. I began praying and saying the name of Jesus. And it moved a little closer and began to lift but it was still eye level. It moved to in front of me and I thought it was going to go on over us when it stopped and the tail began to come down...it's close enough now that I can touch it. *This is where the dream ended and The Vision began*

The Vision - The tail of the tornado is right in front of me now and I raised my right hand up into the center of the bottom of it and I began to go up through the middle of it...now I am thinking its more like a "whirlwind" than a tornado. As I began to ascend up through it I could see lightning, and the smoke-like clouds of the inside of it circling around and around me. Now I can see that I am nearing the top and as I came up out of it I was looking down across a dark and stormy sky...then as I rose a little higher I could see above me the clearest calmest blue I had ever seen in my life. Finally I am now completely out of the whirlwind and looking down across this endless dark sky when I begin to see the clouds changing colors...looking less and less black and stormy until they seem more transparent and I realize they have now turned to water as far as I can see. As I am standing there suspended in mid air... looking across this endless sea and above me is what seems like an endless sky that is the bluest clearest I have ever seen. At this point I heard a voice that said "Here take THE BOOK!" Then the Voice said "take THE BOOK and preach THE BOOK." I took the book and began to preach and as I was preaching I began to see people come up out of the sea, not all in one place but here...there...to the left to the right...different places one at a time and not even a great number or at least it didn't seem to be a great number. I am still preaching and by this point I am feeling a level of anointing that I have never felt and something catches my attention to the right of me. There was something...it was still a good distance from me but I could see it good enough to tell that there was something there and that it wasn't stationary it was moving although it was moving very very slowly.
