

Don't Be Fooled...Hell is Real part 02

Revelation 21:8, But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. Psalm 9:17, The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God. Isaiah 14:9-11, 15 [referring to Lucifer], Hell from beneath is moved for thee to meet thee at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee...all they shall speak and say unto thee, Art thou also become weak as we? art thou become like unto us? Thy pomp is brought down to the grave, and the noise of thy viols: the worm is spread under thee, and the worms cover thee...thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit. Isaiah 66:24, And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcasses of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be abhorring unto all flesh. The following account, told by the Lord Jesus Christ in Luke 16:19-31, gives us the actual words of a man in hell--notice how he is in torment and he can see and he wanted his tongue cooled and he is tormented in the flame. Notice how he wanted his brethren to be warned lest they enter that place of torment. Notice how the only hope that his brethren had was to believe the holy scriptures-there would be no other proof: 19. There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day: 20. And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores, 21. And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. 22. And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; 23. And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. 24. And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. 25. But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented. 26. And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that would come from thence. 27. Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house: 28. For I have five brethren; that he may testify unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. 29. Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. 30. And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent. 31. And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead. In order to be saved, you have to repent of your sins and believe that Jesus died for you, was buried, and rose again the third day. If you continue in his word, the Holy Bible (the Authorized King James Bible, the modern versions are counterfeits), then are you his disciple indeed. God has no pleasure that you should die in your sins. There is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth (Luke 15:10). Going to church will not save you. You have to repent of your sins and believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and obey his holy words until the end (These are the days of the falling away and false doctrine and apostasy, you need to read and study the Bible for yourself.). The thief (the devil) cometh not but for to steal and to kill and to destroy: but the Lord Jesus Christ came that we might have life, and that we might have it more abundantly. The Lord Jesus Christ came to rescue us from sin and from the wages of sin which is death (physical death and everlasting torment in hell and the lake of fire). Hell is real and those who reject the Lord Jesus Christ will be tormented forever without a single, solitary hope. Hell is real but you can be saved, if you repent. Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation (2 Corinthians 6:2). Now, while you are still alive, is the time when you can be accepted by God. Tomorrow is not promised to you--now is the time to make your decision. If you die in your sins, you will not be accepted and you will not get another chance to repent. You will be rejected. Heaven is for God's people. Unrepentant thieves, liars, whoremongers, atheists, agnostics, witches, murderers, sodomites, church hypocrites, false worshippers (people who follow false religions (Islam, Buddhism, Hinduism, etc.) which includes the various so-called "Christian" denominations or churches which make up their own anti-Biblical messages and lies about how to be saved, Catholicism, Jehovah's "Witnesses", Mormons (Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints), Seventh Day Adventist, etc.), all antinomians (self-professed Christians who say that you can do whatever you want to do and still go to heaven. REESIE'S RECIPES



Butterfinger Cake submitted by Sister Lynn Simms

1 (18.25 ounce) box yellow cake mix1 can eagle brand milk1 jar caramel ice cream topping1 (8oz) bowl cool whip

6 snack size butterfingers, crushed

Bake yellow cake as directed on box. Poke holes in warm cake. Pour can of sweetened condensed milk in holes. Pour 3/4 of a jar of caramel topping over that and let run in holes. Let cool in freezer for 15 to 20 minutes. Spread container of cool whip on top. Top with crushed butterfingers. Drizzle all of remaining caramel topping over candy bars and chill for 1 hour or more in fridge.

Baked Mexican Goulash

2 lbs. ground beef
1/2 c. onion, diced
3 tbsp. chili powder
1 tsp. salt
1 1/2 tsp. pepper
1 can refried beans
1/2 c. sour cream
1/4 c. salsa

1/4 c. enchilada sauce 1/2 can tomato sauce

1 lb. macaroni

2 cups shredded cheese

Brown together beef, onion, chili powder, salt and pepper. Add beans. Stir until well mixed. Stir in enchilada sauce, tomato sauce, salsa, and sour cream. Simmer for 20 minutes, stirring occasionally. Cook macaroni while sauce simmers. Stir in cooked, drained macaroni. Pour into 13x9 baking dish. Top with cheese. Place in oven on 350 until cheese is melted.

Chocolate Lasagna

1 package regular Oreo cookies
 6 Tablespoon butter, melted

1- 8 ounce package cream cheese, softened
 1/4 cup sugar

2 Tablespoons cold milk

1- 12 ounce tub Cool Whip, divided

2 - 3.9 ounce packages Chocolate Instant Pudding.

3 1/4 cups cold milk

1 and 1/2 cups mini chocolate chips

Begin by crushing Oreo cookies into fine crumbs in food processor or place them in a large ziplock bag and crush them with a rolling pin. Put the Oreo crumbs to a large bowl. Stir in 6 tablespoons melted butter and use a fork to stir the butter into the cookie crumbs. Put crumb mixture into a 9 x 13 inch baking dish. Press the crumbs into the bottom of the dish. Place the pan in the refrigerator while you work on the additional layers. Mix the cream cheese with a mixer until light and fluffy. Add in 2 Tablespoons of milk, and sugar, and mix well. Stir in 1 and 1/4 cups Cool Whip. Spread this mixture over the crust. In a bowl, combine chocolate instant pudding with 3 and 1/4 cups cold milk. Whisk for several minutes until the pudding starts to thicken. Use a spatula to spread the mixture over the cream cheese layer. Allow the dessert to set for about 5 minutes so that the pudding can firm up further. Spread the remaining Cool Whip over the top. Sprinkle mini chocolate chips evenly over the top. Place in the freezer for 1 hour, or the refrigerator for 4 hours before serving.

Mushroom Gravy Meatloaf

2 lbs ground beef
1/2 large onion, chopped
1 box stove top stuffing, Herb flavor
3 eggs

1/2 (8 oz) jar sliced mushrooms, chopped 1 jar Heinz mushroom gravy

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Combine all ingredients except gravy. Shape into a loaf and bake in a greased 13x9" pan for 45 minutes. Remove from oven, drain grease and top with gravy. Bake for 15 more minutes.



Coincidence or GOD-incidence?

His nightmares began each day when he awoke. James Stegalls was nineteen. He was in Vietnam. Though he carried a small Gideon New Testament in his shirt pocket, he couldn't bring himself to read it. His buddies were cut down around him, terror was building within him, and God seemed far away. His twentieth birthday passed, then his twenty-first. At last, he felt he couldn't go on. On February 26, 1968, he prayed for it all to end, and his heart told him he would die before dusk. Sure enough, his base came under attack that day and Jim heard a rocket coming straight toward him. Three seconds to live, he told himself, then two, then...A friend shoved him into a grease pit, and he waited for the rocket to explode, but there was only surreal silence. The fuse malfunctioned. For five hours James knelt in that pit, and finally his quivering hand reached into his shirt pocket and took out his Testament. Beginning with Matthew, he continued through the first 18 chapters. "When I read Matthew 18:19-20," he said, "I somehow knew things would be alright." Long after Jim returned home, as he visited his wife's grandmother, Mrs. Harris, she told him a night years before when she had awakened in terror. Knowing Jim was in Vietnam, she had sensed he was in trouble. She began praying for God to spare his life. Unable to kneel because of arthritis, she lay on the floor, praying and reading her Bible all night. Just before dawn she read Matthew 18:19-20. Then she immediately called her Sunday school teacher, who got out of bed and went to Mrs. Harris' house where together they claimed the Lord's promise as they prayed for Jim until reassured by God's peace. Having told Jim the story, Mrs. Harris opened her Bible to show him where she had marked the passage. In the margin were the words — "Jim, February 26, 1968." I don't think we are nearly aware enough of how crucial our prayers are for the lost and hurting. Sometimes we don't get to see the fruit, but God hears and answers our prayers! Don't be discouraged today — keep lifting your voice in intercession and expect great things! There's so much work to be done!!
