You're Always There for Me

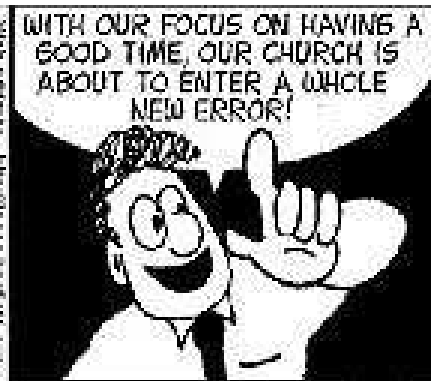
When the world comes crashing in And chaos rules my mind,

Another Gospel

But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed. Galatians 1:8

This month we continue looking at the false doctrines and teachings of the Catholic church. Once again we will be taking the actual teachings from the Catholic Catechism which is the document laying out the doctrines of this church and comparing them to what the Word of God says.

“Salvation Through The Catholic Church Alone?”

The Second Vatican Council's Decree on Ecumenism explains: *"For it is through Christ's Catholic Church alone, which is the universal help toward salvation, that the fullness of the means of salvation can be obtained."* Here we see the unbelievable heresy that states that salvation can only be obtained through the Catholic Church. This is why it is such a traumatic thing for one who belongs to the Catholic Church to be thrown out or excommunicated. Because according to their teachings if a person is not allowed to be a member of the Catholic church or to take communion then their soul is lost and there is no salvation for them. Unfortunately this is not the only denomination that teaches this damnable doctrine...there are others as well that claim unless you are "part of their denomination" you cannot go to heaven. How sad and HOW WRONG! The way to heaven is not through a denomination or religious organization...the way to Heaven is the same today as it has always been. The way to heaven is JESUS nothing more nothing less. When he said on the cross as he was dying "IT IS FINISHED" he meant what he said and he said what he meant. Calling on Jesus and accepting his finished work on the Cross is the only way of salvation...not baptism...not communion...not works...not having your name on a church book **BUT** having your name in the Lambs book of life by accepting Jesus as LORD and Saviour! The Catholic Catechism goes on to state..."*Basing itself on Scripture and Tradition, the Council teaches that the Church, a pilgrim now on earth, is necessary for salvation ... thereby affirmed at the same time the necessity of the Church which men enter through Baptism as through a door."* Anyone that is taught this doctrine would think that one could not be saved unless they were a part of the Catholic church. There is only one scripture from the word of God needed to disprove this teaching, Jesus said in **John 10:9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture**. There is no salvation by any other means than JESUS! The Catholic Church also teaches that as long as you believe in the "Creator" you can be saved...The Catholic Catechism makes this clear when it states the following *"The plan of salvation also includes those who acknowledge the Creator, in the first place amongst whom are the Muslims; these profess to hold the faith of Abraham, and together with us they adore the one, merciful God, mankind's judge on the last day."* This is one of the most damnable doctrines in the world today...in other words forget that Jesus said in **John 14:6...I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. And as long as you believe in God the Father you can be saved**...the Word of God plainly teaches that you cannot get to the Father...the Creator...the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob UNLESS you go through the Son, Jesus! It is not enough to just believe in a God...you must believe in Jesus. We have seen this gospel of **compromise** rear its ugly head even in Church's and preachers that should know better...preachers like Joel Osteen and Billy Graham who in an effort to be politically and religiously correct have made statements that lead people to believe that you "might" be able to go to heaven even if you reject Jesus...my friend there is no message any more clear in the Bible than this...you MUST be born again and that ONLY Comes through the one who died for your sins on the old rugged cross. Letting Down or Posting Guards

Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life. Proverbs 4:23

I realize that there are many Americans who still love our country and would go out of their way to help their fellow-man, friend or stranger. I recognize the fact that mainstream media (MSM) has rejected the truth and paints a bleak picture which is nothing more than propaganda to help corral the masses into a boxcar of government-driven agenda meant to destroy the foundations, play a role in the ongoing Marxist revolution, and force America into submission to a globalist cabal. Although these pictures and the current administration does not reflect the majority of "We the People," we cannot deny that there are many who have been deceived and are pushing for an "Amerikka" that is diametrically opposed to the America for which our founders were willing to give their lives, fortunes, and sacred honor. We must admit, sadly, that this has also infected the church. Why are we who have been given so many blessings and advantages, among which are our Constitution, tremendous access to the Word of God, and a heritage focused upon virtue and the liberty of self-governance; find ourselves now to be a byword among nations? With all these advantages, why are we in such a position that China's Xi Jinping, speaking to a closed-door gathering of Communist Party leaders, rightly states, "The biggest source of chaos in the present-day world is the United States. It is also the biggest threat to our country's development and security. The East is rising and the West is declining." He also knows that they have strategically, over many decades, planted seeds of rebellion, have actively played a role in stirring up dissention, and have recently interfered with America's politics. A word of recognition and warning, often attributed to Alexis de Toqueville, helps to set the stage for our understanding. "I sought for the key to the greatness and genius of America ... I sought for it in her democratic Congress and in her matchless Constitution. Not until I went into the churches of America and heard her pulpits flame with righteousness did I understand the secret of her genius and power. America is great because America is good, and if America ever ceases to be good, America will cease to be great." Toqueville had much to say about Christianity and the positive and uniting role it played in America. What happened? Why are we, who call ourselves Christians, who have been given new life in Christ, have had our sins atoned for, and are blessed to be part of the Body of Christ—called the Church; why are we so weak and feeble in influence today? Why do the lives (entertainment, attitude, work, and life in general) of many who are in the church so closely resemble those outside the church? Why are there so few pulpits that "flame with righteousness" and so many that are willing to close their doors at tyrannical mandates? Isn't it because too many could be described as James Buchanan, 15th president of the United States, described himself in a letter to his brother? "I am a believer; but not with that degree of firmness of faith calculated to exercise a controlling influence on my conduct. I ought constantly to pray, 'Help Thou my unbelief.' I trust that the Almighty Father, through the merits and atonement of His Son, will yet vouchsafe to me a clearer and stronger faith than I possess." Whether nationally, ecclesiastically, or personally, the greatest threat to our existence is not diligently guarding our heart; and not setting a guard at all the rivulets that flow into our being, streams that will either purify or pollute our heart. Listen to the words of Solomon: "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life. Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee. Let thine eyes look right on, and let thine eyelids look straight before thee. Ponder the path of thy feet, and let all thy ways be established. Turn not to the right hand nor to the left: remove thy foot from evil." (Proverbs 4:23-27) The word "keep" means to protect or guard. We are in trouble nationally because we and those who represent us have neglected to "keep" —protect- the Constitution. Anything that does not pass the "Preamble Test" we should not have done. I encourage you to learn the Preamble to the Law of OUR land. Do your part in protecting it. The church has faltered and its people are confused because we have failed to "keep"-protect and hold in highest regard- the Law of God, His commandments. Instead of compromising the Word in order to be seen as intelligent or acceptable to the world, we should have stood steadfast and taught our children the difference between the holy and the profane. Had we taken heed to diligently protect our heart, setting guards at what comes into our ears and eyes while taking care what comes out of our mouths, we would be in much better condition today than we are. I urge you to repent where repentance is needed; set a watch at the gates of your eyes, ears, lips, and feet. With God's help, cleanse your hands and purify your hearts. In the words of Nineveh's king, "Who can tell if God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not?" Will salvation come to America or is it too late? Only God knows; but He still draws men to Himself that they might be saved.

Reesie's Recipes



Fresh Apple Cake

- 1 cup oil
- 3 eggs
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 cup nuts, chopped
- 1 cup coconut
- 3 fresh apples, shredded
- 2 cups sugar
- 2 cups flour
- 1/2 tsp nutmeg

Preheat oven to 350. Combine all ingredients. Bake for 35 minutes or until middle springs back when touched. Frost with cream cheese frosting.

Brown Sugar Baked Beans

- 4 slices bacon, cut into 1/2" pieces
- 1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 2 (21oz) cans pork and beans
- 2 Tbsp mustard
- 1 Tbsp Worcestershire Sauce
- 1/2 tsp hot pepper sauce

Preheat oven to 325. Cook bacon over medium heat in skillet, stirring occasionally until bacon is browned. About 4 to 6 minutes. Place bacon on a paper towel, drain. Stir together bacon and all remaining ingredients in a large bowl. Pour into 2 qt. casserole dish. Bake stirring occasionally for 1 1/2 to 2 hours or until slightly thickened.

Sour Cream Cornbread

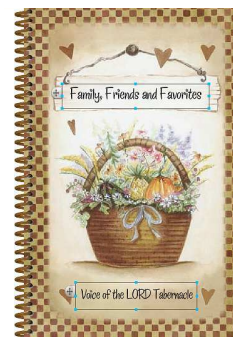
- 1 cup self rising corn meal
- 1 (8oz) sour cream
- 2 eggs
- 1 small can cream style corn
- 1/4 cup oil

Preheat oven to 425. Mix all ingredients well. Pour into hot well greased iron skillet. Bake for 18 to 20 minutes.

Pork Chop Casserole

- 5 pork chops
- 3 medium onions, sliced
- 5 medium potatoes, sliced
- 1 can mushroom soup

Preheat oven to 350. Brown chops in baking dish. Layer pork chops, onions and potatoes. Add 1/2 can of water to the soup and mix well. Pour over casserole. Cover and cook for about 1 hour.

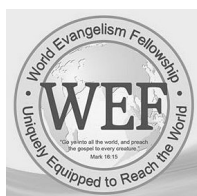

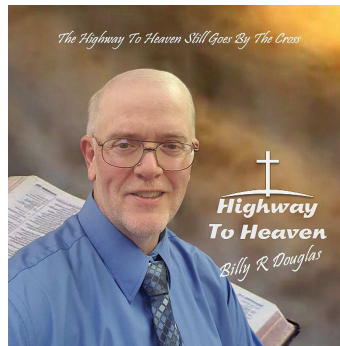
