The NIV leaves out the entire verse.



REESIE'S HOLIDAY RECIPES



Low Fat Tropical Dream Cheesecake

Ingredients

- 1 Honey Grahams, crushed (about 3 Tbsp.)
- 2/3 cup boiling water
- 1 pkg. (4-serving size) JELL-O Brand Orange Flavor Sugar Free Low Calorie Gelatin
- 1 cup Low Fat Cottage Cheese
- 1 container (8 oz.) Fat Free Cream Cheese
- 2 cups thawed COOL WHIP FREE Whipped Topping
- 1/2 cup chopped fresh pineapple
- 1 medium kiwi, peeled, sliced

SPRINKLE crumbs onto bottom of 8- or 9-inch spring form pan or 9-inch pie plate sprayed with cooking spray. STIR boiling water into gelatin in large bowl at least 2 minutes until gelatin is completely dissolved. Cool 5 minutes. Pour into blender container. Add cheeses; cover. Blend on medium speed until well blended, occasionally scraping down side of blender container; pour into large bowl. Add whipped topping; stir gently until well blended. Pour into prepared pan; smooth top with spatula. REFRIGERATE 4 hours or until set. Remove side of pan. Top with fruit just before serving. Store leftover cheesecake in refrigerator.

Parker House Rolls

Ingredients

- 4 c. flour
- 1 pkg. yeast
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 4 tbsp. sugar
- 1 egg, beaten
- 1/2 c. warm water
- 1/2 c. milk (scalded & cooled)
- 4 tbsp. Crisco (melt then measure)

Put 1 tablespoon of the sugar in 1/2 cup warm water with the yeast. Let rise to top of cup. Mix shortening, egg, salt and remaining sugar. Add to the milk. Next mix in the yeast mixture. Warm the flour and slowly pour the liquid mixture into the middle of flour, stirring well. Then knead. Let rise to twice the bulk in a greased bowl. Then make into Parker House rolls. Let rise again for 3/4 to 1 hour in warm place. Bake 8 minutes in 400 degree oven.

Easy Turtle Pumpkin Pie

Ingredients

- 1/4 cup plus 2 tsp caramel topping, divided
- 1 Honey Maid Graham Pie Crust (6 oz)
- 1/2 cup plus 2 tsp Planters Pecan pieces, divided
- 1 cup cold milk
- 2 pkg (4-serving size each) Jell-o Vanilla Flavor Insta Pudding & Pie Filling
- 1 cup canned pumpkin
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1/2 tsp ground nutmeg
- 1 tub (8 oz) Cool Whip, thawed, divided

Pour 1/4 cup caramel topping into crust; sprinkle with 1/2 cup pecans. Beat milk, dry pudding mixes, pumpkin and spices with whisk until blended. Stir in 1 1/2 cups whipped topping. Spread into crust. Top with remaining whipped topping. Refrigerate 1 hour. Top with pecans and drizzle remaining caramel with fork. Store leftovers in the refrigerator.

Thanksgiving Stuffing

Ingredients


- 1/2 pound sausage
- 1/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1/2 pound fresh mushrooms, sliced
- 3/4 cup chopped celery
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 teaspoon poultry seasoning
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 6 cups unseasoned stuffing croutons or dry bread cubes
- 2 1/2 cups chicken broth

In a large skillet, brown sausage; drain. Add butter, mushrooms, celery and onion; saute 2-3 minutes or until onion is tender. Stir in poultry seasoning, salt and pepper. transfer to a large bowl; add croutons and enough broth to moisten. Place in a greased 2-qt. baking dish. Cover and bake at 350 degrees F for 30 minutes. Uncover and bake 10 minutes more.







Do You Make The Devil Uncomfortable?

And he besought him much that he would not send them away out of the country. Mark 5:10

In Mark the 5th chapter we find the story of a man that was possessed with demons The Bible says that this man “dwelt among the tombs”, and that men had tried to bind him and control him but he was so wild that he would break the chains and fetters He was completely controlled by demonic forces! It goes on to say that "neither could any man tame him"...BUT he was about to meet his match. If you will read the chapter you will find that as soon as he saw Jesus he ran and fell at his feet. Jesus did not call for the man... yet he ran to him and cried out “What have I to do with thee, Jesus, thou son of the most high God". The very fact that Jesus was in the same area as this man caused these demons to be uncomfortable...I wonder how many Christians make the devil uncomfortable? When the people there saw this they ran into the city and told what had happened and of course the people of the city came out to see for themselves what was going on. When they arrived they saw this man that had been so wild and uncontrollable sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind! What happens next tells us a lot about the people and why the demons loved it there so much...were these people excited to see this man set free and delivered? NO, as a matter of fact they were afraid and asked Jesus to leave their country! You see most of these people made a living by raising swine and they were more disturbed about the fact that they had lost some hogs than they were excited about the fact that this man had been set free. It is sad to say but most churches across America do not want revival...oh they say that they do.. BUT real revival changes things and changes people and most are content with the form and routine that they already have. That is why these demons loved living in this place...these folks were *their kind of people*...they didn't want revival, they didn't want deliverance... they were content to stay just the way they were. It is sad to say but these demons would feel right at home in most churches today! Do you make the devil uncomfortable or does he like hanging out with you?

Turkey Treats

Ingredients

- 1 1/2 c. sugar
- 1 1/2 c. sticks butter
- 2 eggs
- 2 tbsp. milk
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 3 1/4 c. all-purpose flour
- 1 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/2 tsp. salt

Heat oven to 400 degrees. Mix ingredients together until well combined, wrap in plastic and chill for two hours.

Roll dough out, cut with floured turkey shaped cookie cutter. Place on lightly greased baking sheet, brush with egg white and sprinkle with decorative toppings. Bake for 8 minutes or until very light brown.

Peanut Butter Bars

Ingredients

- 3 1/2 cups of powdered sugar
- 2 cups of graham crackers
- 1 cup of butter
- 1 1/2 cups of peanut butter
- One 6 oz bag of chocolate chips
- 1/4 tsp oil

Mix together by hand powdered sugar, graham crackers, butter, and peanut butter. Before adding graham crackers, crush the graham crackers up. After you have mixed these ingredients up, put into pan or glass dish. Push the mixture down into the pan or glass dish. Take your chocolate chips and put them into a microwave able bowl, add oil. Mix the chocolate chips and oil together and put into microwave. You want to melt the chocolate chips, so start with 1 minute at a time in the microwave stirring occasionally. When the chocolate chips have melted pour over peanut butter mixture. Then put in refrigerator for one hour, after one hour cut into bars.



Capt. Miles Standish had been much at his wife Rose's bedside. Ours is not some fair-weather faith, but a resilient trust in the midst of pain. The Pilgrims lived close to the edge of survival. Perhaps that is why they were so thankful. How about you? Does your material bounty cause you to neglect thanks? When your family gathers this Thanksgiving will a prayer of thankfulness be forgotten between moist turkey and pumpkin pie? Will your children see you bow your head to give thanks, or merely ask for another helping of dressing and cranberry sauce?
