

REESIE'S HOLIDAY RECIPES



Caramel Apple Bread Pudding

Ingredients

- 1 cup unsweetened applesauce
- 1 cup fat-free milk
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup egg substitute
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 5 cups cubed day-old bread
- 1/2 cup chopped peeled apple
- 1/2 cup fat-free whipped topping
- 1/2 cup fat-free caramel ice cream topping

In a large bowl, combine the applesauce, milk, brown sugar, egg substitute, vanilla and cinnamon. Fold in bread cubes and apple. Pour into an 8-in. square baking dish coated with cooking spray. Bake, uncovered, at 325° for 35-40 minutes or until a knife inserted near the center comes out clean. Serve warm with whipped topping and caramel topping. Refrigerate leftovers.

Twice Baked Sweet Potatoes

Ingredients

- 6 medium sweet potatoes
- 1/4 cup butter, cubed
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 6 bacon strips cooked and crumbled
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/8 tsp. pepper

Scrub and pierce sweet potatoes. Bake at 375 for 1 1/4 hours or until tender. When cool, cut a thin slice off the top of each potato and discard. Scoop out the pulp leaving thin shells. In a large bowl mash the pulp with butter. Stir in remaining ingredients. Spoon into potato shells. Place on a baking sheet. Bake for 20 - 30 minutes or until heated through.

Pineapple Salad

- 1 1/2 cups buttermilk
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple in syrup, drained
- 1 (8 ounce) Cool Whip, thawed

In a bowl, combine the buttermilk, sugar and pineapple; mix well. Fold in the whipped topping. Pour into a 13-in. x 9-in. x 2-in. dish. Cover and place in freezer until firm. Remove from the freezer 20 minutes before serving.

Ginger Streusel Pumpkin Pie

- 1 refrigerated pie crust
- 3 eggs
- 1 (15 ounce) can solid-pack pumpkin
- 1 1/2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/4 cup brown sugar, packed
- 1 1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground allspice
- 1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves

Streusel

- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup brown sugar, packed
- 1/2 cup butter, cold
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts
- 1/3 cup crystallized ginger, finely chopped

On a lightly floured surface, unroll pastry. Transfer pastry to a 9 inch pie plate. Trim pastry to 1/2 in beyond edge of plate; flute edges. In large bowl, whisk eggs, pumpkin, cream sugars, cinnamon, salt, allspice, nutmeg and cloves. Pour into pastry shell. Bake at 350 for 40 minutes. In small bowl, combine flour and brown sugar; cut in butter until crumble. Stir in walnuts and ginger. Gently sprinkle over filling. Bake 15-25 minutes longer or until a knife inserted near center comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack. Refrigerate leftovers.

Creamed Corn with Bacon

Ingredients

- 1 small onion finely chopped
- 1 Tbsp. butter
- 4 cups frozen corn, thawed
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1/4 cup chicken broth
- 4 bacon strips cooked and crumbled
- 1/4 tsp. pepper
- 1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
- 3 Tbsp. minced fresh parsley

In a large skillet sauté onion and butter for 3 minutes. Add corn, sauté for 1 to 2 minutes longer or until corn and onion are tender. Stir in cream, broth, bacon and pepper. Cook and stir for 5 to 7 minutes or until slightly thickened. Stir in cheese and parsley.

Pilgrim Hat Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 cup vanilla frosting
- 7 drops yellow food coloring
- 32 miniature peanut butter cups
- 1 (11 1/2 ounce) package fudge-striped cookies
- 32 chewing gum, mini orange chiclet

In a small shallow bowl, combine frosting and food coloring. Remove paper liners from peanut butter cups. Holding the bottom of a peanut butter cup, dip top of cup in yellow frosting. Position over center hole of a cookie, forming the hatband and crown. Add a buckle of Chicklets gum. Repeat with remaining cups and cookies.

Perfect Dinner Rolls

Ingredients

- 1 Tbsp active dry yeast
- 2 1/4 cups warm water
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1/3 cup shortening
- 1/4 cup powdered nondairy creamer
- 2 1/4 tsp. salt
- 6 to 7 cups bread flour

In a large bowl, dissolve yeast in warm water. Add the sugar, shortening, creamer, salt and 5 cups of flour. Beat until smooth. Stir in enough remaining flour to form a soft dough (dough will be sticky). Turn onto a floured surface, knead until smooth and elastic, about 6 to 8 minutes. Place in a bowl coated with cooking spray. Cover and let rise until doubled, about 30 minutes. Bake at 350 for 12 - 15 minutes or until lightly browned. Remove from pans to wire racks.

Honey Butter

- 1 Cup butter or margarine, softened
 - 1/4 Cup honey
 - 1/4 Cup Powdered sugar
- Blend ingredients until smooth.

Turkey A La King

- 1 can (6 oz) buttermilk biscuits
- 1/4 cup butter, cubed
- 1/2 cup all purpose flour
- 1 can (14 1/2 oz) chicken broth
- 1 cup milk
- 2 cups cubed cooked turkey
- 1 cup sliced cooked carrots
- 1 cup cut green beans
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/4 tsp. pepper

Bake biscuits according to directions on package. Meanwhile in a large sauce pan melt butter. Stir in flour until smooth: gradually add broth and milk Bring to a boil, Cook and stir for 1-2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in the turkey, carrots, green beans, salt and pepper. Heat through and serve with biscuits.

A Word In Season

And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses. Mark 11:25-26

So many of us today pray daily for forgiveness of our sins and when we do Jesus forgives our sins and not only that but he puts them behind him never to be remembered again. But how many of us judge others for what they have done. Everyone of us have something behind closed doors that we have done in the past. There are times when we are hurt by someone we know and forgiving them can be difficult but it is our duty as Christians to do so.
