

Rules are Rules



In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. 1Thessalonians 5:18

REESIE'S RECIPES

Peanut Butter Pudding Dessert

1 cup all-purpose flour
1/2 cup cold butter, cubed
1-1/2 cups chopped cashews, divided
1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, softened
1/3 cup creamy peanut butter
1 cup confectioners' sugar

1 carton (12 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed, divided

2-2/3 cups cold milk

1 package (3.9 ounces) instant chocolate pudding mix
1 package (3.4 ounces) instant vanilla pudding mix
1 milk chocolate candy bar (1.55 ounces),
coarsely chopped

Place flour and butter in a food processor; cover and process until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Add 1 cup cashews; pulse a few times until combined. Press into a greased 13-in. x 9-in. baking dish. Bake at 350° for 25-28 minutes or until golden brown. Cool completely on a wire rack. In a small bowl, beat the cream cheese, peanut butter and confectioners' sugar until smooth. Fold in 1 cup whipped topping. Spoon over crust. In another bowl, whisk milk and both pudding mixes for 2 minutes. Let stand for 2 minutes or until soft-set. Spread over cream cheese layer. Top with remaining whipped topping. Sprinkle with chopped candy bar and remaining cashews. Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour before serving.

Pecan Pie Cobbler

Pie Crust
3 cups sugar
2 1/2 cups Karo syrup
1 1/2 stick butter, melted
9 eggs
3 cups pecans

Pre-heat over to 350. Roll out crust and place in 9x13 pan. Mix sugar and syrup, then add melted butter until well blended. In a separate bowl beat eggs. Add eggs to mixture, then stir in pecans. Bake approx. 1 hour and 5 minutes or until butter knife inserted in middle comes out clean.

Peach Glazed Ham

1 fully cooked bone-in ham (8 to 10 pounds)
Whole cloves
1 can (12 ounces) lemon-lime soda
1-1/2 cups packed dark brown sugar, divided
1 cup water
1 jar (12 ounces) peach preserves
6 tablespoons butter, cubed
1/4 cup honey
1 teaspoon prepared mustard
Dash ground cloves
1 can (8 ounces) sliced pineapple, drained
3 canned peach halves

Score surface of the ham, making diamond shapes 1/2 in. deep; insert a clove into each diamond. Place on a rack in a well-greased foil-lined roasting pan. Pour soda over ham. Spread 1 cup brown sugar over ham. Add water to pan. Cover and bake at 325° for 1-1/2 to 2 hours. In a large saucepan, combine the preserves, butter, honey, mustard, ground cloves and remaining brown sugar. Cook and stir over low heat until butter is melted and sugar is dissolved. Uncover ham; brush with glaze. Arrange the pineapple slices and peach halves over ham, securing with wooden toothpicks. Bake, uncovered, for 25-30 minutes or until and ham is heated through.

White Cheddar Scalloped Potatoes

1/4 cup butter

1 medium onion, finely chopped
1/4 cup all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon dried parsley flakes
1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
1/2 teaspoon pepper
3 cups 2% milk

1 can (10-3/4 ounces) condensed cream of mushroom soup, undiluted

1 cup (8 ounces) sour cream

8 cups thinly sliced peeled potatoes

3-1/2 cups cubed fully cooked ham

2 cups (8 ounces) shredded sharp white cheddar cheese

Preheat oven to 375°. In a large saucepan, heat butter over medium-high heat. Add onion; cook and stir until tender. Stir in flour and seasonings until blended; gradually whisk in milk. Bring to a boil, stirring constantly; cook and stir 2 minutes or until thickened. Stir in soup. Remove from heat; stir in sour cream. In a greased 13x9-in. baking dish, layer half of each of the following: potatoes, ham, cheese and sauce.

Repeat layers. Bake, covered, 30 minutes. Bake, uncovered, 40-50 minutes longer or until potatoes are tender.

"You Need the Baptism in the Holy Ghost!" conclusion

People's tongues began to praise Him - in new tongues. The Holy Ghost took full control! At Pentecost he came with a mighty, rushing wind! Fire fell! Acts 2:4 - And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Can you imagine what this crowd looked like to passersby - 120 people, all preaching and praising God at the same time and in different tongues? It must have looked like drunken chaos! When the Holy Ghost comes down, things get shaken up. Acts 4:31 - And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. Some say, "The Spirit came down at Pentecost. We don't need to pray for Him to fall on us now." But throughout the Book of Acts, after Pentecost, the Holy Ghost was still falling on believers! He fell at the house of Cornelius: "While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them" (Acts 10:44). Again, they spoke with tongues! He fell at Ephesus: "The Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied" (Acts 19:6). The Holy Ghost will never make you do anything stupid. But He will come upon you in such a way that sinners may think you are drunk! He is not welcome in many churches because He is thought to be too noisy, too upsetting, too unpredictable! The Holy Ghost Is Received by Faith! Galatians 3:2 - This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? Saints, this message should ignite your faith, - and by faith you should lay hold of God's great promises! James 1:6-7 - But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. 7 For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord. The Lord says, "Open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it" (Psalm 81:10). Praying for the gift of tongues should not be our focus; we ought to pray to be baptized in the Holy Ghost - and speaking in tongues are an expression of His indwelling. Have you asked God for this gift? Are you seeking the Holy Ghost? Are you continually knocking? Luke 11:13 - If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him? Simply ask and you will receive! Seek your heavenly Father for the baptism of the Holy Ghost, and He will give it to you!
