

“Do You Have A Wait Problem?”

Scripture Reference: Isaiah 40:27-31

Why sayest thou, O Jacob, and speakest, O Israel, My way is hid from the Lord, and my judgment is passed over from my God? 28 Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding. 29 He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength. 30 Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: 31 But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

The Hebrew word for wait in Isaiah 40:31 means: To bind together (perhaps by twisting) to expect:- gather (together), look, patiently, tarry, wait (for, on, upon). What does it mean to wait upon the Lord? In the Word of God, we are told to that if we want to be blessed by the Lord, we must learn to wait upon the Lord Now the question is, what does it mean to wait upon the Lord? 1.To wait upon the Lord means to put your trust in the Lord. Proverbs 3:5-6 - Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. 6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Psalm 37:3-5 - Trust in the Lord, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed. 4 Delight thyself also in the Lord: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart. 5 Commit thy way unto the Lord; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass 2.To wait upon the Lord means to have faith in the Lord. Mark 11:22-24 - And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. 23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. 24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. 3.To wait upon the Lord means to call upon the Lord in prayer. Jeremiah 33:3 - Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not. 4.To wait upon the Lord means to serve the Lord with gladness. Psalm 100:1-2 - Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands. 2 Serve the Lord with gladness: come before his presence with singing. 5.To wait upon the Lord means to be patient with the Lord. Hebrews 10:35-36 - Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. 36 For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. 6.To wait upon the Lord means to be obedient to the Lord. James 1:22 - But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. 7.To wait upon the Lord means to trust in the Lord for your soul salvation. Romans 10:9-10 - That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 8.To wait upon the Lord means to have hope in the Lord. Psalm 42:11 - Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God. Jeremiah 17:7 - Blessed is the man that trusteth in the Lord, and whose hope the Lord is. Now another question is asked: What happens when I wait upon the LORD? 1. Job 14:14 tells us that if we wait upon the Lord, our change will come.2.Isaiah 30:18 says if we wait upon the Lord, God will be gracious, compassionate and have mercy upon us 3.Lamentation 3:25 says that the Lord is good to those who wait upon Him 4.In Isaiah 64:4 tells us that the Lord has some great things for us if we wait on Him.5.In Micah 7:7 says that our salvation will come ,and our prayers will be heard by God if we wait upon the Lord. 6.And in Isaiah 40:31 - But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. That is He will you the strength to overcome your problems, overcome your tribulations, overcome your disappointments, overcome your setbacks, overcome your sickness, all because you wait upon the Lord. REESIE'S RECIPES

Loaded Potato Quiche

Crust

- 2 1/2 cups Original Bisquick mix
- 6 tablespoons cold butter or margarine
- 1/4 cup boiling water

Filling

- 1 1/2 cups chopped cooked ham
- 1 1/2 cups frozen diced hash brown potatoes, thawed
- 1 1/2 cups shredded sharp Cheddar cheese
- 3 medium green onions, sliced (3 tablespoons)
- 5 eggs
- 3/4 cup half-and-half
- 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- 3 slices bacon, crisply cooked, crumbled
- Sour cream, if desired

Heat oven to 350°F. Spray 9 1/2-inch glass deep-dish pie plate with cooking spray. Place Bisquick mix in medium bowl. Cut in butter, using pastry blender (or pulling 2 table knives through mix in opposite directions), until crumbly. Add boiling water; stir vigorously until soft dough forms. Using fingers dipped in Bisquick mix, press dough on bottom and up side of pie plate, forming edge on rim of plate. Sprinkle ham, potatoes, cheese and 3 tablespoons onions in crust. In medium bowl, beat eggs, half-and-half and pepper until blended. Pour over ingredients in crust. Bake 1 hour 5 minutes or until knife inserted in center comes out clean. Let stand 15 minutes before serving. Top with bacon, sour cream.

Chicken Mexicana

- 2 1/2 lbs. chicken breast, cooked and diced
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1 medium onion, finely chopped
- 1 green pepper, finely chopped
- 1 1/2 tsp. chili powder
- 1 can rotel tomatoes with green chilies
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1/2 pnd. Velveeta cheese, save half for topping
- 1 pkg. Doritos nacho flavored chips, crushed to bite size pieces.

Mix all ingredients except chips and 1/2 of cheese. In a large casserole dish, alternate layers of mixture and chips. Place remaining cheese on top. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes.

Cinnamon Roll Pancakes

- 2 cups powdered sugar
- 1/4 cup whipping cream
- 1 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 2 cups Bisquick Heart Smart® mix
- 1 1/3 cups milk
- 1 egg
- 1/2 cup raisins

In small bowl, mix powdered sugar and 1/4 cup whipping cream with whisk; set icing aside. In 2-quart saucepan, cook brown sugar, butter and cinnamon over medium heat, stirring often, until butter is melted and sugar is dissolved. Remove from heat; cover to keep warm. In medium bowl, stir Bisquick mix, milk and egg with fork or whisk until blended. Stir in raisins. Heat griddle or skillet over medium-high heat. Grease griddle with vegetable oil if necessary (or spray with cooking spray before heating). For each pancake, pour about 2 tablespoons batter onto hot griddle. Cook until edges are dry and bubbles form on top. Turn and cook other sides until golden brown. Serve pancakes stacked with warm cinnamon mixture between each pancake. Drizzle with icing

Milky Way Cake

- 8 Milky Way candy bars
- 3 sticks butter
- 4 1/2 cups sugar
- 4 eggs, beaten
- 2 1/2 cups flour
- 1/2 tsp. soda
- 1 1/4 cup buttermilk
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1 small can evaporated milk
- 1 (6oz.) pkg chocolate chips
- 1 cup marshmallow crème

Combine candy bars and 1 stick of butter in sauce pan. Cook over low heat, stirring until melted. Set aside. In a mixing bowl cream 2 cups sugar and 1 stick of butter, then beat in eggs. Sift flour and soda, add to creamed mixture alternately with buttermilk. Stir in candy mixture. Add pecan, mix well. Pour into greased and floured oblong baking pan. Bake at 325 for 1 hour 10 minutes. In a sauce pan combine remaining sugar, milk and 1 stick butter. Cook to soft ball stage stirring frequently. Remove from heat and add chocolate chips and marshmallow crème. Cool slightly. Beat until thick and spread over cake.



The Fortified WORD of God

*"Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly But his delight is in the law of the Lord."
Psalms 1:1-2. (KJV)*

If you knew - or could ascertain in some way, the mind and will of God, would you do it? Once you were fortified in spirit and soul and body - what would you do with it? (Psalms 119 97) If you drop back all the way to the beginning of this Psalms you will find David saying, "Blessed are the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD. Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart. They also do no iniquity: they walk in his ways. Thou hast commanded us to keep thy precepts diligently. O that my ways were directed to keep thy statutes! Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all thy commandments." Psa 119:1-6 (KJV) What we all need today is a passionate love for the will and commands of God. To willingly learn, and have the faith to fulfill the qualities by which our heart may be kept pure and childlike, and through which we shall come to understand the Bible, nature, and human life. If we refuse to walk in the counsel of the wicked, we shall never sit in the seat of the scornful. Our Christian walk will be fed from the hidden springs of His WORD, as the roots of the tree "planted by the rivers of water, bringeth forth His fruit in his season. Such a life becomes fruitful and beautiful. (Psa_1:3) It is also prosperous, because it abides in the will of God. It cannot be really injured by evil, and in the deepest sense it realizes the purpose for which God commissioned it. On the other hand, any life which refuses reverence and obedience to God's will must resemble the rootless, fruitless, and lifeless chaff, which is scattered by the winnowing wind. So which type does your life resemble today? Are you the deeply-rooted tree, yielding beauty and fruit and shelter to many, or is your life being frittered away like the worthless chaff? Only you and God know the answer to that question.

Halloween...The Occult Connection



It is impossible to talk about **the occult in America** without mentioning halloween. Many people have the "mistaken" idea that Halloween is a Christian holiday. The truth is halloween is not nor has it ever been a "Christian" celebration. Known as the Festival of the Dead in Great Britain it was a night of satanic activity by a people known as the Celts and the Druids...it was on this night that they worshipped who they believed to be the god of the dead who they called "Sah-ween". As the Catholic missionaries swarmed Britain and Ireland seeking the mass conversion to Catholicism their orders from Pope Gregory in 601 A.D. was to cunningly convert the Druid rituals into Catholic rituals. The Catholics converted the ritual of Samhain (sah-ween) into the festival of All Saint's Day, a day of celebration and prayer to dead "Saints." How Biblical is that? In 835, Pope Gregory IV "blessed" All Saint's Day as a sacred "day of obligation," consequently on that day, the Catholic Church officially "ordained" Halloween. This celebration may have very well breathed its last breath many years ago if not for the "ordination" of the Catholic Church. So How did this celebration that began across the seas make its way to America? Halloween was not celebrated in this country until 1845. At that time multiplied thousands of Irish emigrants flooded into New York because of the Great Famine of 1845-46. They brought with them the old Druid Holiday the Festival of the Dead now known as halloween. Gradually celebrating this day spread throughout the rest of the country. Over the years halloween has become a highly commercialized event involving most communities, schools, business, government offices, and even churches throughout the U.S. Today, children and adults alike wear the costumes and play out the rituals of this seemingly harmless event without ever considering their origins and true meaning or possible consequences.
