

I was born in what is known as the Daniel Boone Forest in Eastern Kentucky. As a very young girl, I remember when my Daddy crossed the fields to Mrs. Gilbert's farm. They had a battery radio and the news had gotten deep into the mountains that President Roosevelt was going to speak to America. Daddy walked home and told all of us, "We are in a war. Pearl Harbor has been bombed and many of our soldier boys have been killed." Every young man of age was drafted, and many volunteered to go to war and fight for our freedom. I share my memories, for it was a different time - World War II. It seemed like everyone wanted to help in every way. The government gave us sugar stamps and shoe stamps. No one complained. Whatever was required, we did. The mothers would exchange shoe stamps for sugar stamps. If one family had not worn out their shoes, and another needed shoes, they exchanged for sugar. There was no selfishness. When a son or father had to enlist there were tears and sorrow as they kissed their loved ones goodbye. Christians from every church called out to the Lord - Oh Lord, bring him back home safely. There was crying and praying everywhere. We knew America's hope for victory was in the Lord Jesus Christ. So many gave their lives - I lost an uncle in a battlefield in Germany, and a cousin shot down over Tokyo. We were so proud of our American soldiers. I remember Victory Day for America - the war was over! Church bells were ringing everywhere. It is different now. There have been many wars since then. So many blessed American servicemen and women have given their lives. Many of this nation's citizens have forgotten the Lord Jesus Christ. I remember in my childhood, the newspaper told of our loss on the battlefield every day. I find now, maybe on the back page of the daily newspaper, that there might be such words printed as, "Three American soldiers were killed in battle this week." My beautiful America - her heart is so sick. Dear Lord, You must be sad, You love her so much. Lord Jesus, You told us in Your word that "If my people, who are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land" (2 Chronicles 7:14). Oh Lord, may the tears of repentance dampen our altars again, for America's only hope is You, Lord Jesus! Never forget - He is a merciful God, and "The effectual, fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:16). Now I can wipe the tears from my eyes.

REESIE'S RECIPES



Chicken and Dumpling Casserole

- 2 chicken breasts, cooked and shredded
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 1/2 stick of butter
- 2 cups Bisquick
- 2 cups whole milk
- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 3 teaspoons of chicken granules
- 1/2 teaspoon dried sage
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon of salt or more to taste

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Layer 1 - In 9 x 13 casserole dish, melt 1/2 stick of butter. Spread shredded chicken over butter. Sprinkle black pepper and dried sage over this layer. Do not stir. Layer 2 - In small bowl, mix milk and Bisquick. Slowly pour all over chicken. Do not stir. Layer 3 - In medium bowl, whisk together 2 cups of chicken broth, chicken granules and soup. Once blended, slowly pour over the Bisquick layer. **DO NOT STIR.** Bake casserole for 30-40 minutes, or until the top is golden brown

Party Cheese Dip


- 1 8 oz. package cream cheese
- 2 cups grated cheddar cheese
- 1 cup miracle whip
- 1 small purple onion,

Place all ingredients in a shallow baking dish. Microwave on high until the ingredients are melted enough to stir together. Stir until all ingredients are mixed together well. Bake at 350 in oven until lightly browned. (20 minutes)

Caramel Pecan Delight Pie

- 2 cups chopped pecans
- 1 stick butter
- 2 (8 oz) cream cheese, softened
- 14 oz can condensed milk
- 16 oz cool whip
- 1 jar caramel ice cream topping
- 2 graham cracker crusts

In a skillet, lightly brown the pecans in the butter. Set aside to cool. With an electric mixer, blend the cream cheese, condensed milk and cool whip. Divide evenly between two pie crusts. Top each pie with the pecans. Drizzle the entire jar of caramel topping over the tops of both pies. Freeze for at least 3 to 4 hours. Top with extra cool whip if desired.

The Residue of the Church

"Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God." Revelation 3:2 (KJV)

There is, now, more than ever... a turning from the ways of God. Most preachers will immediately look at the church of Laodicea when speaking of end-times events, but as my wife and I were out doing our daily routine this morning early, The Lord quickened to my spirit the church at Sardis, and I want to speak on that just briefly. The Name of Sardis actually means "remnant". Whether this is due to the terrorism and mass slaughter of the Christians in 70 AD - (they had a few Christians yet alive when John wrote this letter some 20years later), or whether this is the state to which the Church of Christ had fallen in the then known region, is really unknown and left to speculation. I believe that by her Name alone, it had a great deal to do with both. The Name Sardis (remnant) signified a church in transition - possibly dying on the vine. This is probably more like most of our churches of today than any other, in that we still have a few of the "old-guard" as they are called, who believe that "faith in the Lord Jesus Christ" is paramount to anything else and they are faithful to the Lord and their local church body... yet, there are a few of those today who only see "church growth" as new buildings, and larger congregations with no substance as the norm. The Church board votes on a Pastor who is well-credentialed and has a track-record of being a renowned orator, even though the altars are yet barren. They have been lulled to sleep by the Life-styles of the rich and famous, while no one is challenged, and no one is saved, and the congregation slips deeper into the pocket of being saved and satisfied, becoming numb to the lost and dying, and deaf to the voice of the Spirit of God. Many of this sort of Christian loses touch with the spirit completely as they have fastened their ears and belief system to what they hear from their preachers only, and anyone else is considered "not of God". But Jesus says to those that are members of this kind of church, "I have not found thy works perfect before God." In fact, he points out very clearly that they are to "Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die..." In many churches, even the "old guard" have given up. You can't fight "city hall" is the attitude many have. It seems like an insurmountable task to fight against what every one else is calling progress. I mean when statistics go up in the church - no harm no foul; the problem is the commitment of those that are there. Church is not meant to be a social club; it is meant to be a hospital for the lost and dying. So, Jesus makes it very clear to the Church at Sardis as well as us today, "Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee." Friend, it's time to start stirring up the gift that is you; That spirit of evangelism. When You Sup With The Devil...

Greetings in the mighty name of Jesus! Our regular readers know that this section of the newsletter is used each month for an article from the desk of this Pastor...this month is a little different format but one that I feel lead of the Lord to bring to you. I want to share with you an article that we shared in The Trumpet a couple of years ago concerning the subject of Halloween by best selling author and Evangelist Rev. Bill Schnoebelen. An old proverb says, **"When you sup with the devil, use a long spoon."** Presumably, NO genuine Christian would want to sup with the devil at all and yet many may be doing so in ignorance. As a former Wicca high priest now saved by Jesus, I was astonished by how many Christians let their kids celebrate Halloween. Some churches even sponsor "haunted houses" and similar events on what is the number one satanic "helliday" of the year. Halloween used to be called Samhain, and is still celebrated as an ancient pagan festival of the dead by witches all over the world. Unfortunately, just giving the date a "holy" name like All Hallows' Eve or All Saints' Eve cannot change its grisly character. Halloween is an occasion when the ancient gods (actually demons) are worshiped with human sacrifice. The apostle Paul warns us: "But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils" (1 Cor. 10:20). If you are a Christian parent, God has given you a precious responsibility in your children. Remember, their ability to resist spiritual wickedness is much less than yours. If you allow your children to participate in Halloween (Trick or Treating, costume parties, etc.) you are allowing them to play on "the devil's turf," and Satan will definitely press his home court advantage. You are opening up doorways into their young lives for evil by bringing them into a kind of "fellowship" with these ancient "gods." We are commanded not to become involved with the unfruitful works of darkness (Eph. 5:11). Both from my experience as a witch, and since getting saved, as a minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ, I have seen far too many examples of how breaking this command works out in lives. Remember, while we have God's promise of protection for ourselves and our children, that promise may not hold if we allow our children to celebrate this dark holiday. Case after case has come to us of children in rebellion. In many of these families, the problem can be traced back to the children being exposed to Halloween and the occult at a young age. On Halloween night my fellow Wiccans and I would call up dead spirits such as George Washington, King Arthur, Aleister Crowley (A satanist that called himself "The Great Beast"). They would appear and talk in conversations during the ceremonies. And we would also cast spells on the countryside giving spirits the access to possess whoever they pleased. We would especially cast spells on the children going about Trick or Treating. My friend It is hard enough to raise children these days in a Godly way without exposing them to Satan's realm.

Few There Be That Find It

As we look around and see the many sins being accepted by people without a second thought because we are told not to judge, as we refuse to warn because we don't want to be accused of being an extremist, as we sit in silence because "it's a matter of conviction," we have forgotten something. We have forgotten that Jesus said, "the way is narrow." Every time someone says "Judge not" they try to make the way a little broader. Every time we try to live a little less holy because of the things we desire to do, we try to make the way a little broader. Every time we make an excuse for our sin instead of obeying the Spirit's call to purity we try to make the way a little broader. It seems that we have forgotten that "the way is narrow." Matthew 7:13-14 "Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it." "Few there be that find it." If you will be silent in the face of ungodliness in the "church" I think fewer there be that find it may apply. Let us give a clear call to those who say they love Christ but do not obey His commands. Let us give a clear call to those who desire to hold themselves in higher regard than they do the One who died for their sin. Let us remember and tremble at the fact that the way is narrow and few there be that find it.
