Spiritually some things we do or allow, that we might think is little or insignificant, can also be disastrous for us. Some may consider celebrating Halloween as only a little compromise. However, it is the "little foxes" that spoil the vines and this little compromise can open the door to other evils. Many Christians do not realize that certain traditions that are celebrated in the world have evil origins. Just because our society partakes in certain activities does not make them acceptable for Christians. We must look to Christ and His Word to see if the traditions of this world are good or evil. One very evil tradition is the celebration of Halloween. No Christian should partake in the activities of this holiday, nor should they allow their children to do so. We can discern the evil of this day by taking a look at the festivities that are associated with its celebration. Children are dressed as witches, goblins, ghosts, little devils and fortune tellers. All these are representatives of Satan's kingdom. Games played at carnivals promote fear in children as they are ushered through spook houses and horror rooms. Skeletons, black cats and bats represent death and darkness. No carnival is complete without the gypsy who tells fortunes. Satan has gained man's approval to celebrate his day by simply making it a tradition that seems like a fun day. The opposite is true, however, as more damage and harm are done on this day each year than any other holiday. Because so many of us have grown up celebrating Halloween, and seemingly did not experience any negative effects, some feel that not celebrating Halloween at all is an extreme measure. However, we would encourage you to pray about this. Is any holiday tha glorifies death and darkness (even in fun) a proper thing for a Christian to do since we have been called out of darkness into His marvelous light? 1 Peter 2:9: "But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light." Whether we feel that we have been really hurt by celebrating Halloween or not, is only part of the issue. How does God feel to see His people making light of demons and witchcraft? Shouldn't we be thinking about how to honor Him and show our love to Him? Where do our loyalties lie? Most Satanists celebrate this as their high holy day and even offer human sacrifices to the devil. Until recently, most Christians have not questioned this traditional celebration, but rather have gone along with it by even bringing Halloween parties into the church. The earliest Halloween celebrations were not held by the early church, but the Druids in honor of Samhain, the "lord of the dead", and his demons, whose festival fell on November 1. Halloween actually means "holy or hallowed evening." Parents have a responsibility not to allow their children to be exposed to these evil celebrations. The CHURCH has a responsibility to warn of this danger. What might seem to some as innocent children's games is a "little fox" that can open the door to satanic influence and even demon possession in some cases. Children can be tormented with a spirit of fear that can come through this involvement that stays with them throughout their lives. It also introduces children to witchcraft, making it easier for them to become involved in cults and occultic activities. When children are taught it is alright to play with the things of darkness, it does not give them the repulsion and resistance that they need to stand against greater Satanic involvement. When the things of Satan are taken lightly, as games and fun, it sets our children up to accept evil rather than to resist it. This "little fox" is not only spreading evil to children but has been a curse for the church and our nation as well. 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REESIE'S RECIPES



Easy Woman's Cobbler by Vonnie St.Clair

1 c. flour

1 c. sugar

1 c. milk

1 stick margarine

1 (15oz) can of any fruit (fruit cocktail, peaches, cherries, ect.)

Mix together first 3 ingredients: pour into a 8x8 inch baking dish. Melt butter and add to flour mixture. Add fruit of your choice. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes or until done.

Rotel Chili

1 lb. ground beef

1 lb. Tennessee Pride sausage

1 chili roll

1 box of cut spaghetti

64 oz. can tomato juice

2 cans diced tomatoes, with sweet onion

1 can rotel tomato

1 cup ketchup

2 cans chili beans

1 envelope of Mccormick mild chili seasoning

Brown ground beef, sausage in large skillet, drain well. Cook spaghetti as directed on package, drain. In a large pot combine meats, spaghetti and remaining ingredients. Bring to a boil over medium heat, stirring occasionally. Reduce heat to simmer and simmer for 30 minutes.

Hawaiian Roll Casserole

2 pkg. Hawaiian rolls

1 lb. shaved ham

9oz. Grated or sliced swiss cheese

1 cup butter

1 1/2 T. poppy seeds

2 T. dried onion flakes

2 T. Worcestershire sauce

2 T. Dijon mustard

Cut rolls in half: Place the bottoms of the rolls in greased 9x13 pan. Layer with ham and cheese on top of rolls. For the glaze mix butter, seeds, onion flakes, sauce and mustard. Spread half of glaze on top of ham and cheese. Cover with tops of rolls. Spread the remaining glaze on top. Bake at 350 for 20 minutes.

Creamy Chicken Enchiladas

1 lb. chicken breast

1 onion, chopped

1 (8oz) cream cheese

1 (4.5oz) can chopped green chiles

1 (12 ct.) floured tortillas

1 cup shredded cheese

Preheat oven to 400. Cook chicken over medium heat with 2 tablespoons oil and onion until done. Add cream cheese and chiles. Cook and stir over medium heat until blended. Spoon filling onto tortillas, roll and place seam down in lightly greased 9x13 pan. Pour enchilada sauce over top and sprinkle with cheese. Bake for 20 minutes.



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7 Indictments Against God's People -- Amos 6: 1-7

Pride is the mother of all sin; every "lesser" sin springs from her devilish womb. It led to Israel's (and America's) apostasy. It breeds a discontent for God, contempt for His word, and an overwhelming urge to "walk" in our own ways. Pride is often hard to recognize within oneself and at times within one's nation. The spirit of pride is often found in the indulgence of excessive physical appetites and a love for ease. These two characteristics of pride have always resulted in spiritual decay, financial ruin and death. Even as God brought Israel out of Egyptian slavery by His mighty Hand of mercy, God also miraculously took a small country of thirteen colonies out from under England's tyrannical rule and the nation of the United States of America was born. Both Israel and America worked hard and faithfully worshipped the One True God, both lived humbly before God with a contrite heart; therefore, God prospered these nations. However, as prosperity often does, it planted, cultivated, and grew the seeds of pride and selfexultation which claimed the souls of both these great nations. Both have exchanged their God for those which are no gods and have gotten too big for their britches. Even as the prophets of Israel would call their people to repentance and a turning away from pride and a turning to the One True God, so America has had presidents, governors, and generals who have called the American people away from their pride to observe days of humiliation, fasting and prayer - encouraging the American people to humbly seek the face of Almighty God. Look at Amos 6:1-7, look at your own life to see if God's indictments which were aimed at Israel of yesteryear are aimed at you today. Certainly we can see these in our nation, but can we see them in ourselves? Remember Paul's admonition in Romans 15:4, "For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope." These warnings were written to Israel that we might see, be receptive, repentant, and finally, have hope in the Living Christ. God's indictments against Israel fall into three main categories: Self-indulgence, Secular revelry, and Shameful debauchery. Sadly these things permeate our once-great nation; sadder yet, too often these same things permeate the church of America and many of its members. Friends, let me first say that sin does not cease to be sin just because the church accepts it! When God says it is wrong....it is wrong! Indictment #1: They "Lie upon Beds of Ivory." They had expensive and far-fetched furniture. Abraham searched for and lived for a city whose builder and maker was God. These people chose to live in luxury here, neglecting their poor and hungry brothers. They wanted the best of everything. Sound familiar? Indictment #2: They "stretch themselves upon their couches" They embraced their lives with the love of ease and laziness. Seeking ease instead of seeking God, loving luxury more than loving the Lord, that is NOT what we are called to. Many in the church today are stretched out in front of the television when they'd be much better off being stretched out before God, seeking Him. Indictment #3: They "eat the lambs out of the field and calves out of the midst of the stall": They ate luxuriously and as gluttons. They had to have everything of the very best and abundance of it. They didn't eat to live, they lived to eat! They ate without gratitude and indulged in their appetites without restraint. Paul calls us to temperance and moderation but how does your food and drink measure up to moderation. Paul tells us to glorify God in ALL that we do (1 Cor. 10:31) Indictment #4: They "chant to the song of the vial" Israel devoted much time to entertainments, fun with music and dancing. They didn't have 24 hour television programming and DVD players. They didn't have MP3 players and smart phones or the internet. They didn't have their favorite sports with games being played year round. We have much more available to us today- do we use it for the glory of God or abuse it to the glory of self? Is it God-gratifying or self-gratifying? God gives us a general feeling of what our music should be in Colossians 3:16. The music wasn't used for the worship of God, it was ungodly and self-serving. Much music today either glorifies sin or is just silly and frivolous; same can be said for our entertainment. I would remind you of Paul's exhortation when it comes to ALL things: "And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him." (Colossians 3:17) As we look around our nation, this is a time for weeping not a time for merriment. Within the church there is much need of weeping as well. There is great joy in knowing Christ but there is place for great weeping as well as we see an unhealthy body. indictment #5: They "Drink wine in bowls": Again, there was no moderation, only excess. Cups and glasses didn't hold enough. They had to drink from bowls. Not your normal cereal bowl either, these were the big bowls which were used in religious sacrifice. They robbed the altar of God that they might drink to themselves. When's the last time you fasted instead of super-sized? When's the last time you saved a couple of bucks and drank water instead? Have you ever robbed from God in either his tithes and offerings or even robbing from Him His holy day to live unto yourself? Indictment #6: They "anoint themselves with chief ointments": They were extravagant with perfumes and cosmetics. They were more intent in preparing the face to be admired by folks than preparing the heart to be approved of God. Regardless of how beautiful you make yourself on the outside, if your inside is ugly, God isn't impressed. Take into account God's word on the subject-1 Timothy 2:9-10 &1 Peter 3:3-4. In all these indictments so far we see how luxury and selfishness leads to excess. Also remember that sensuality and mirth often lead to irreverence. What you must realize is that these things always lead to a sinful apathy of both our own condition and the condition of our brothers and sisters, apathy to Jesus Himself. This is what we find in God's last indictment to His people. Indictment #7: They were "not grieved for the affliction of Joseph vs. 6 They had no concern for the church, though it was in distress and peril. They had more sinful pride in taking care of their own wants than they had for meeting the NEED of their brothers and sisters. How often do you pray for and financially support the persecuted church throughout the world or in your own country? Do your support ministries which proclaim the True WORD of God, like VOTL? Do you have a real concern for the body of Christ? Don't be like the believers James talks about in James 2:15-16. Lay up your treasure in heaven, not here on the earth where its value diminishes. I often see God's people more concentrated on worldliness than concerned for the church! When will you really care about the state of our nation and of the body of CHRIST around the world? Too often people only care when it starts to hit their own home or pocketbook, by then it's too late. Today is the day to pray and fast. Today is the day to give up your sinfulness and the things which are offending the Holy God you say you serve. Today is the day to give all to the Lord and allow the Spirit to cleanse you throughout! Just because you can do something or even have the right to do something doesn't make it right! They were weighed in the balances, found wanting and guilty. Allow the Spirit to search your heart. 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"Are You Listening For God?"

And he said, Go forth, and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; but the LORD was not in the wind: and after the wind an earthquake; but the LORD was not in the earthquake: And after the earthquake a fire; but the LORD was not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice. 1st Kings 19:11-12

Have you heard God speak to you today? If that question is a little upsetting, if you're feeling somewhat defensive or guilty... Probably, the better question would have been, "Have you been listening for God?" This is a very difficult subject, but I think it's a matter that can benefit all of us if we'll give it a little thought. For starters, if we're interested in how to hear God speaking to us, let's examine just how He does communicate with His children. Most loudly and clearly, God's voice thunders to us from the pages of His Holy Biblble. Unfortunately, we too often close our ears when He speaks to us from Scripture. You want to hear from God? Read His Book. Memorize His Word. Obey His commands. That's the best way to really listen to God speaking. Well, you say, everybody knows that the Bible is the Word of God - that God "speaks" to us in the Scriptures. "But," you say, "that's just too conventional - that's no fun - I want a personal message to boom down from the clouds with maybe a little lightning and thunder thrown in to impress the neighbors. It seems like God could turn up the knob on His amplifier just a little bit. I don't want to strain to listen - I want stereo with hi-fidelity. I wouldn't mind if I even needed earplugs." But God doesn't speak to us like that. And I think we already knew it. If we pay attention, listen intently, we can hear God in the Bible. It's not glamorous. It's "blue collar" work. The Apostle Paul tells us in 2nd Timothy 2:14-16 - Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, but to the subverting of the hearers. [15] Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. [16] But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. Be one of God's "workmen" - a blue collar guy or gal - work at it, study the Bible, and you can hear God speak to you from His Word. Another way that God speaks to us is through answered prayer. If we don't faithfully and regularly go to God in prayer - how can He speak to us through answered prayer? Yes, God does answer our prayers. Sometimes He says "yes," sometimes He says "no," sometimes we have to wait. Probably, more than we like to admit, He answers, but we don't listen close enough to hear Him. We really do need that amplifier, don't we? But think about it - what wonderful, soothing "words" God provides when He answers prayer. What would you rather receive - a loud, 30-second sound byte from heaven proclaiming, "I feel your pain" - or the gentle peace that surpasses all understanding to calm your soul that only God can provide? How else does God speak to us? He speaks to us through His written Word the Bible. He also speaks to us in the answers He is faithful to provide to our prayers. Sometimes the listening for the answer to prayers - the ability to pick out God's voice - becomes very difficult, especially when the answer to our prayer is "no." Nevertheless, some of you are still seeking an audible voice to speak directly to you, preferably in your own language, maybe something you could put on tape and play back, time-after-time. I don't think it's going to happen that way. Someone is going to say, "It just isn't fair - God used to speak out loud to His children." That's true. Right from the beginning, the Bible (God's voice today) has recorded examples of God speaking to various people here on earth. But it wasn't always pleasant. Shortly after Adam and Eve ate of the forbidden fruit in the Garden of Eden, God spoke to them as they were hiding in their nakedness. Genesis 3:9 - And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou? Then God gave quite a lecture to the serpent as well as to both Adam and Eve, concluding in Genesis 3:19 - In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return. To Adam and Eve that probably seemed as if God had every loud speaker in the universe turned on. Surely, they were able to hear God speaking. And He continued speaking throughout Old Testament times. Just a few years later He questioned Cain after he had killed Abel. In reply, Cain, we might say, smarted off to God by shouting back in Genesis 4:9 - And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper? God didn't stop with Cain. He kept on speaking - clearly, loudly, distinctly - to Abraham, Moses, and many others. Many, many examples of God speaking are recorded in the Old Testament. In the New Testament, after the resurrection, we find Jesus talking to Saul on the road to Damascus in Acts 9:4 - And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? And finally, in the Book of Revelation, we find these spoken words in Revelation 1:8 - I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty. and in Revelation 22:20, John records Jesus saying: He which testifieth these things saith, Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.But since that time, God's voice comes to us more like the voice of our conscience than from some celestial loudspeaker. That brings up another problem. By hardening our hearts down through the years, we've been able to pretty well drown out our conscience. Walt Disney gave Pinocchio a talking conscience in Jiminy Cricket. If we're going to be like Pinocchio and not listen to our conscience - we're in for something worse than our nose growing longer. Also, if the voice of our conscience has grown a little faint - how can we expect to ever hear God? Is there still today some way to hear God? That's a common question asked over and over again... C.S. Lewis said, "God whispers in our pleasures, speaks in our conscience, but shouts in our pain." Someone else said, "to hear God, you must use the ears of your heart." The Book of Job tells us in Job 33:14 - For God speaketh once, yea twice, yet man perceiveth it not. I think you've realized by now that I'm not going to be able to tell you exactly how to listen to God. But I can say with a certain amount of certainty that, when He speaks, it may not be loud. You have to pay attention. The prophet Elijah learned this lesson in 1st Kings 19:11-13 - And he said, Go forth, and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; but the LORD was not in the wind: and after the wind an earthquake; but the LORD was not in the earthquake: [12] And after the earthquake a fire; but the LORD was not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice.[13] And it was so, when Elijah heard it, that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out, and stood in the entering in of the cave. And, behold, there came a voice unto him, and said, What doest thou here, Elijah? Read your Bible, pray, and wait for God's answer to your prayers. Quiet yourself to listen for the still, small, gentle whisper of God. Don't miss it. God is speaking to you.

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Halloween And The Occult

Witchcraft is very real but greatly misunderstood. I know because witchcraft goes back on the paternal side of my family for over five generations to Chesterfield, Massachusetts in 1770. My great grandmother became a wellknown witch in Wisconsin in the early days of this century. Caroline was a blind witch and used her fingers to read palms and also became adept at putting "the hex" on people. Many spooky things would happen in our family. Dishes would slide off from shelves, light bulbs would unscrew and fall to the floor, filmy apparitions would appear and vanish, and this sort of thing became a way of life. In one instance, my father was riding with my grandfather in a horsedrawn wagon, when a filmy white apparition appeared in front of the horse, causing the horse to rear up on its hind legs.
