

#### Is Christ Divided? Part 01

\*\*\*By the leading of the Lord, we are putting this article back in the Trumpet again for the readers. Division is at an all time high.

The answer is Christ and what He did at the Cross. - Evangelist Mike Heltsley

1st Corinthians 1:10 - Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

Sadly, many who call themselves Christians see no problem with the situation the Apostle Paul condemned. They see no problem with speaking different things, having divisions, and having differences in mind and judgment. In fact, many seem to thrive on the strife and the confusion that results from division in the church. 1st Corinthians 1:11-13 - For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them which are of the house of Chloe, that there are contentions among you.12 Now this I say, that every one of you saith, I am of Paul; and I of Apollos; and I of Cephas; and I of Christ. 13 Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul? Do you realize that most differences in what we know as Christianity stem from people following the doctrines and commandments of men, and those traditions that get handed down as gospel truth? In discussing a difference of understanding on a particular subject recently, a brother told me that I needed a good book on hermeneutics. After I looked the word up-it means "interpretive"--I realized that I already had a Good Book—the good ole 1611 KJV Bible, and it tells me in: 2nd Peter 1:16-20 - For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty. 17 For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. 18 And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount. 19 We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: 20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. Maybe we ought to concentrate a little harder on the KJV Bible and a little less on hermeneutics, a Western philosophy named after the Greek god Hermes. It might leave less open to private interpretation. 1st Corinthians 1:13-17 - Is Christ divided? was Paul crucified for you? or were ye baptized in the name of Paul? 14 I thank God that I baptized none of you, but Crispus and Gaius; 15 Lest any should say that I had baptized in mine own name. 16 And I baptized also the household of Stephanas: besides, I know not whether I baptized any other. 17 For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect. A division crops up right here because some of my friends following man-made religions quote this verse as proof that Paul was "not in the baptizing business". Taken in context, Paul was saying that he was glad that folks didn't follow him instead of Christ, as they might have done had he himself done all the baptizing personally. It wasn't that baptism wasn't occurring, it's just that Paul left it to the other brethren to do it. 1st Corinthians 1:18-21 - For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. 19 For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. 20 Where is the wise? where is the scribe? where is the disputer of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? 21 For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. We see in our culture today a denial of Christianity. The liberal folks in our culture say that God is dead, Jesus is a myth, and that we are all just soul-less human animals. Man's wisdom says that the universe started with a big bang, and man evolved from a group of chemicals that got struck by lightning. 1st Timothy 6:20-21 - O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: 21 Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with thee. Amen. Acts 17:20-21 - For thou bringest certain strange things to our ears: we would know therefore what these things mean. 21 (For all the Athenians and strangers which were there spent their time in nothing else, but either to tell, or to hear some new thing.) Hermeneutics is described as based upon science and logic. Yet these Greek based processes are the very things that Paul said we must not use. 1st Corinthians 1:22-25 - For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom: 23 But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; 24 But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. 25 Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. Division fades when we stick with God's truth! 1st Corinthians 1:26 - For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: Why is that? The wise think that their knowledge will save them. The strong think that their strength will save them. The powerful and rich think that their power and riches will save them. So they don't need God to save them! 1st Corinthians 1:27-31 - But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; 28 And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: 29 That no flesh should glory in his presence. 30 But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: 31 That, according as it is written, He that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord.



#### What Stirs You?

Acts 17:16 "Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry."

What does the word "stirred" mean? One old holiness commentator put it this way: "his soul was sharpened or whetted. He felt an indignation burn within him to see human beings given to the worship of idols. So he alone, single-handed like little David attacked the whole system." There are times that we are so stirred in our spirits that we must do something...write, talk, act...something. It's like the example of Jeremiah from the Old Testament where he said that he would be quiet and not speak anymore except it would burn him up—friends, HE WAS STIRRED! What Stirred Paul? Athens was recognized as the center of intellect, culture, and religion. In this setting it was also "wholly given over to idolatry." It was said that there were more gods than men in this great Greek city called Athens. This is what stirred Paul. He knew God—he experienced Jesus—he knew that all glory, honor, praise, and worship belong to God, and God alone! He was stirred by the sin of wrongful worship. He was stirred that God wasn't given His rightful place in this place. Worshipful adoration was given to inanimate objects made by the hands of men. As a Pharisee that would bother Paul; but as a man of God, that stirred him to his core. That's much like America today. Most in America don't worship crude idols of wood, stone, silver or gold; but there are many who worship nature the woods and water, sun and stars, or the soil and stones. Some worship stones of quartz and other types for various reasons and others worship being stoned, whether by marijuana, alcohol, or other drugs. A great many people worship silver, gold, or other forms of currency. Also, as in Athens, there are many who worship knowledge, culture, science, art, religion, and the list goes on and on. The list of American idols is as deep and wide as man's mind can invent and imagine. America has her idols! Men and women are idolized—from athletes to actors, from politicians to pundits, from singers to social warriors, multitudes of mere men or women are raised to demi-god status, being worshiped and praised while the One True God receives leftovers if anything at all. While Jehovah, the Creator of the universe, is said to be found upon the mercy seat, America's idols are all found on the altar of self! Whether the seat of this altar is self-gratification, self-adulation, self-preservation, self-worship, or selfish ambition, all of our idols sit upon the altar of self, demanding sacrifice, worship, and expect the dethronement of God in our mind, words, or deeds. Yes. America has her idols, which has led to much brokenness; and it would seem that this country is "wholly given over to idolatry." Does that stir you? Are our spirits stirred out of selfishness or hurt? Are we stirred by lost souls headed for hell? Are we stirred by a holy God not receiving the glory, honor, and praise due His name? What are we stirred by? --Does it stir us that alcohol abuse kills 3 million a yea--Does it stir us that politicians and actors threaten the life of our president with no disciplinary action taken, thereby encouraging lawlessness and undermining respect for authority? Or that those in high positions would call Christian conservatives "deplorables" (Clinton) and "dregs" (Biden) recognizing that it lays the groundwork for Christians to be persecuted since we are made to be seen as sub human and of little to no worth? Again, look to where the road leads! If these things stir you it should be that it is an attack upon God and His righteous ways, not because it is an attack upon us. --Does it stir you that there are 125,000 abortions worldwide DAILY and in the U.S. over 300 souls depart from their mother's womb into the hands of Jesus every single day? -- Does it stir you that each month pornography sites receive more regular traffic than Netflix, Amazon, and Twitter combined? That 64% of young people ages 13-24 actively seek pornography weekly or more often? That 1 in 5 youth pastors and 1 in 7 senior pastors use pornography regularly? --What about the National Debt, child abuse, indoctrination in the public schools, human trafficking, Islamism in America and in our schools, or socialists, communists, and Islamists running for congress—do these things stir you? Why do these things stir you? Does it have anything to do with the glory of God and does it have anything to do with holy compassion? In other words, are you stirred because the people of this nation are like sheep without a shepherd? What was Paul's Response? Paul's response was to show a holy compassion by preaching the truth; to share the gospel with those who were blind and lost. He spoke to the lost sheep about the Good Shepherd. He met them where they were at and brought them along to the truth of who God is, what God has done, and what our reasonable response should be-repentance and holy living. Our response must be the Gospel! Only the Gospel will set men free; only the Gospel will change lives. There aren't enough steps in any program to make a permanent change that doesn't include steps to the cross where Jesus died. Oh that God's Holy Spirit would stir our spirit, just as He did Paul's. Oh that we would be stirred to action—preaching the Gospel and calling for men everywhere to repent and live holy lives. Press on being stirred and sharing the Gospel with all who need to break free from the chains of idolatry—both within the church and without.



### Bacon & Cream Cheese Stuffed Mushrooms

8 oz bacon
1/2 cup finely minced sweet onion
1 clove garlic, minced
16 oz white button mushrooms
4 oz cream cheese
1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
salt and pepper

Preheat oven to 350F degrees. Using scissors or a sharp knife, cut raw bacon into small pieces. In a large saute pan, over medium heat, cook bacon until crispy. While bacon is cooking, remove mushroom stems from caps and chop stems into small pieces. When bacon is done, remove from pan and set aside; reserve 2 tablespoons of bacon grease and pour the rest from pan. Saute onion until soft about 5 minutes. scraping up any brown bits on bottom of pan. Add chopped mushrooms stems and garlic and cook a few minutes longer. Reduce heat to low. Add cream cheese and parmesan cheese and stir until cheeses are melted. Add reserved chopped bacon and season to taste with salt and pepper. Remove mixture from heat and stuff each mushroom cap with mixture. Bake at 350F for about 20 minutes or until mushrooms are soft and filling is hot.

#### Pineapple Salad

1 lb small curd cottage cheese 8 ounces Cool Whip

1 (3 ounce) box jello regular raspberry gelatin powder 1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple in syrup

Mix the dry gelatin powder with the thawed cool whip.

Add the cottage cheese to the mixture and mix well.

Drain the pineapple well and add to the mixture and chill.

#### **Chocolate Chip Pecan Pie**

4 Eggs

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup brown

1 Cup Semi-Sweet Chocolate Chips

6 oz Pecan Halves or Pieces

1 Cup Corn Syrup

1 Stick Melted Butter

1 Tsp Vanilla

1/4 Tsp Salt

2 Frozen deep dish pie shells

Preheat the oven to 350. In a medium glass mixing bowl, melt the butter in the microwave. Use hand mixer to beat in eggs, corn syrup, sugar, vanilla and salt. Add the chocolate chips and pecans to the mixture and stir with a spoon. Pour half of the pie mixture into each pie shell. Bake for 45 minutes. Move them to the bottom rack about halfway through so the top edge of the crust does not get too crispy. At the end of the baking time, open the oven and jiggle the rack a little. The center of the pies should have just the slightest wiggle, too much wiggle and you'll want to leave them in for an extra 10 or 15 minutes.

#### **Stuffed Pepper Soup**

1 lb extra-lean ground beef

1 c onion diced

14-1/2 oz can Red Gold diced tomatoes with Roasted Garlic and Onions

2 c green peppers and/or red peppers chopped

15 oz can Red Gold tomato sauce

3 c beef broth

1/2 t dried basil

1/2 t dried oregano

1 c cooked rice

Brown your beef with your onion in a skillet over medium heat. Drain your beef and onions and place in your 6-quart slow cooker. Add your Red Gold tomatoes (juice and all) and the rest of your ingredients.

Cover and cook on low for 6-8 hours.

#### **Celebration of Evil**

Many Christians celebrate Halloween. Some churches and pastors even do. I recently saw a church advertising they were having a Zombie Run. Seriously? God's House? This pastor does not celebrate Halloween and neither does her church. In a spirit of full disclosure, when I was a brand-new believer, I allowed my son to go trick-ortreating. Part of the reason was because my husband was not yet saved and insisted we do. The other part was because I didn't see the harm in it. After all, many Christians I respected did it, so as a new Christian I justified that it must be OK. Right? Wrong! As I grew closer to the Lord and gained more knowledge of His Word, I began to feel convicted about Halloween. I had thoughts like: God is a God of life, but Halloween focuses on death. Should I celebrate a holiday where people decorate their front yards with tombstones? The Scriptures tell us to put away deeds of darkness (Rom.13:12) and that light has nothing in common with darkness (2 Cor. 6:14). Is celebrating a dark holiday something a child of the light should be doing? I had been delivered from fear and panic attacks and knew that fear comes from the enemy. Should I participate in a holiday that has fear as its very foundation? Witchcraft is clearly detestable to the Lord (Deut 18:10-13). Shouldn't something that glorifies witchcraft (just take a walk through the Halloween store) be detestable to me as well?" Halloween is a sacred, high holiday for Wiccans (the official religion of witchcraft). Is this a holiday Christians should celebrate alongside Wiccans? Is it cute when we dress our kids like the devil (or witches, ghouls, scary characters, etc.)? Isn't it, well, demonic? What if my child dresses in a wholesome fireman costume? Romans 16:19 says that we need to be wise to what is good and innocent of evil. If I let him participate in Halloween, even while dressed as a fireman, aren't I sending him a mixed message by allowing him to participate in a celebration of evil? The Lord said in 2 Cor. 6:17, "Come out from them and be separate ... Touch no unclean thing ..." Doesn't God want His children to be set apart from the world and from sin and evil? Aren't we supposed to be peculiar people? My extended family thinks it's ridiculous that we not allow our son to dress up for Halloween. Should their opinions matter to me more than God's? Shouldn't pleasing God be my utmost concern? If there is even a question in my heart and mind that it might be wrong, shouldn't that be my first clue? Why would I continue to do so with even a lingering thought that it is wrong? Does Halloween bring glory to God? No! It glorifies the devil! Nuff said. So as a new believer, saved only two years, I responded to the conviction of the Holy Spirit, repented of displeasing the Lord and put a stop to Halloween. And as a pastor, after observing firsthand the amount of destruction that the enemy brings into peoples' lives when they give him a foothold, I am even more convinced I made the right decision to close the door to the enemy and on this evil holiday. Setting aside a day to celebrate evil, darkness, witchcraft, fear, death and the demonic brings disdain to God. Period. A Christian celebrating Halloween would be like a Satan worshiper putting up a nativity scene at Christmas while singing, "Happy Birthday, Jesus!" The two just don't go together. Jesus has nothing in common with Satan (2 Cor. 6:14), and neither should we. So stop justifying why it is fine to celebrate this demonic, worldly, evil holiday. There are no muddled lines or gray areas about it. A committed follower of Jesus Christ should not celebrate Halloween.

#### **Seducing Spirits**

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; 1 Timothy 4:1
