Truth and Consequences

Having grown up in a Christian family and in a solid church and in the United States of America, I always wondered how Jesus could ask the following question, "Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?" My questioning ends when I see The Christian Post cite George Barna's research stating that "The data found, among other things, that while 51% of American adults said they have a biblical worldview, only 6% of American adults actually hold this worldview." Dear Reader, do you find it disturbing that of those 51% of self-identifying Christians 49% believes that reincarnation is a real possibility after they die while only 33% of them believe that "human beings are born with a sinful nature and can only be saved from the consequences of sin by Jesus Christ." Does it arouse righteous indignation within you or bring you to weeping to learn from another Christian Post article and different survey that "More than 60% of born again Christians in America between the ages of 18 and 39 believe that Buddha, Muhammad and Jesus are all valid paths to salvation and over 30% say they either believe that Jesus sinned just like other people when He lived on Earth or aren't sure, according to a new study." (Kerby Anderson's Probe Ministries Religious Views & Practices Survey) What about John 14:6? "Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." Jesus is not merely "A way;" He is THE way and NO man comes to God the Father except through Him. The word "wav" indicates a path to travel, not only a set of beliefs to hold in one's head, not only a prayer to have been prayed, but a life to be lived with utter abandon to the magnifying of Christ and the glory of God. The Bible teaches the way to holy and joy-filled living. It is distinctly contrary to the way in which this world would love to mold our mind and life. If we truly believe on Jesus and are walking in His way, our mind, life, and destination has been transformed—His way affects every area of our life. (I strongly encourage you to read Psalm 19:7-14) A Biblical worldview is imperative for the Christian; the consequences of walking outside of truth are devastating. If you don't believe me look around you. Look around our country, around the world, and around the church of America—a church which has stopped being the church militant, and therefore, the church triumphant I might add. While there are many good churches in America and many faithful Christians who are left wondering what happened to their church, there are many more churches (organized) and self-proclaimed Christians who are either ignorant of the Word of God or have chosen to ignore the Bible's truths and warnings, forfeiting a Biblical worldview for an adulterated and idolatrous one that makes them feel better but paves the way to hell with "good intentions." Quoting Family Research Council (FRC) President Tony Perkins, "Every Christian can and should obtain a biblical worldview — which is only achieved when a person believes that the Bible is true, authoritative, and then taught how it is applicable to every area of life, which enables them to live out those beliefs." We have a real problem. What can we do? For our own sake: Let us do some honest, painstaking self-examination, using J.C. Ryle's penned warning on Luke 16:13-18 as the standard. "It is useless to attempt to serve God with a divided heart.... Thousands on every side are continually trying to do the thing which Christ pronounces impossible. They are endeavoring to be friends of the world and friends of God at the same time. Their consciences are so far enlightened that they feel they must have some religion. But their affections are so chained down to earthly things that they never come up to the mark of being true Christians.... They have too much religion to be happy in the world and too much of the world in their hearts to be happy in religion. In short they waste their time in laboring to do that which cannot be done. They are striving to serve God and mammon. "...The more thoroughly we give ourselves to Christ, the more sensibly we shall feel within the peace of God that passes all understanding (Phil. 4:7). The more entirely we live, not to ourselves, but to Him who died for us, the more powerfully shall we realize what it is to have joy and peace in believing. If it is worthwhile to serve Christ at all, let us serve Him with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. Life, eternal life, after all, is the matter at stake, no less than happiness. If we cannot make up our minds to give up everything for Christ's sake, we must not expect Christ to own us at the last day. He will have all our hearts or none. Friendship with the world is enmity with God (James 4:4) The end of undecided and half-hearted Christians is to be cast out for ever." For the sake of others: Put Paul's words in II Timothy 4:2-5 in to practice. What to do: "Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine." Why?: "For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables." That day is here; so: "But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions. do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry." Pray that our eyes will be open to better watch, that the Spirit will strengthen us in these days in preparation to endure affliction, and that we will be faithful in speaking the truth and presenting the gospel of Jesus Christ to a deceived church and a fallen world.





The Little Red Book

IT WAS nothing new for Mariam's uncle to make a gun in his little shop in the mountain village of Hassa Beyli in Turkey, but this one was different, and Mariam often came to see how soon it would be finished. This gun was to belong to a brigand whose home was in the hills, and Mariam had heard dreadful things about what the brigands did with guns. At last her uncle went away with it,

and she waited anxiously for his return that she might ask questions. Was the brigand very big? Did he live in a cave? Did he look very fierce? Patiently he answered all her questions, when he was home again, and then he said: "When I gave him the gun, he said he had nothing with which to pay for it. He should have told me that before I made it for him. I need the money for the gun. When I said he must pay something, he brought out this little red book and said I could have it. There was nothing else to do, so I took the book in payment for my gun. Now you may have it," said the uncle, handing it to her. Mariam was pleased to own a book of her own. The print was not large; there were no pictures in it; but it was a book, and so she carried it to her house to put it away. When she began to read, she would take the book out and try to make out the words. Soon she could make out sentences. Sometimes she would find an interesting story, but it was a long time before she knew that her little red book was called a Bible. When Mariam went away to school at Aintab Seminary, the book went with her, and it began to have an influence in her life. In time she became a Christian. Then she married Mr. Koondakjian, a young native pastor, and they used the book in their splendid work in the village. One day a missionary named Mrs. Coffing came their town and asked to hold a service for the women, the town. When all was ready, Mrs. Coffing found that she did not have her Bible handy, so she asked if one of the women had a Bible. Immediately Mariam Koondakjian passed the little red Bible up to where Mrs. Coffing stood. The missionary looked at the book with a start. Why was it so familiar? Where had she seen it before? She turned to the fly-leaf, and there, in his own handwriting was her own husband's name. For a moment Mrs. Coffing could hardly speak. Then, holding the treasured book her hand, she told the women the story of a trip which her husband had taken many years before. "He went to tell the Good News to the people in the valleys," she said, "but he never came home again. He was attacked by brigands not far from your own village here. They took what he had, and then killed him. This was his book, and here is his name in the front, just as he wrote it. No one ever knew what happened to his things after the brigands took them, but now his little Bible has come back to me and I am so glad. How it came into the hands of Mrs. Koondakjian, I do not know, I only know it once belonged to my dead husband." After she had read a passage, she gave the Bible back to the Armenian woman. Soon all the women were crowding around the little red book, and Mrs. Koondakjian was telling them how her uncle had taken it in payment for a gun when as a very little girl. Then, much as she loved her Bible, she placed it again in the hand of the one who really owned it, and Mrs. Coffing took it away with her. Was the brigand who killed Mr. Coffing the one who bought the gun? Why did he keep the book? One can only guess. Some one killed the teacher, but God sent the red book into the life of a new teacher who is still carrying the Message, even though she is seventy years of age. When Mr. Koondakjian and her two sons were killed in the massacre by the Turks some years ago, it was to the verses that she had learned from the little red book as a girl that Mrs. Koondakjian turned for comfort: "I will not leave you comfortless. I will come unto you...: Let not your heart be troubled; neither let it be afraid.... Lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world." And so, you see, the little red book is still helping.

God's Plan Of Salvation

Some people think it cruel that a loving God would allow unrepentant sinners to go to hell and suffer torment forever. First, God is a loving God: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" (John 3:16). It was not the justice of God that required the Son to pay the penalty of sin. God, in perfect righteousness, could have required sinful man to pay his own penalty for his wrongdoing. The broken law would have been satisfied, for the wages of sin is death; however, to have done so would have destroyed man in every way, with the race ceasing to exist. It was the love of God for a race of lost sinners that was the necessity in the nature of the case, which required that a substitute be found to pay for man's sin. That substitute is the Lord Jesus Christ. Second, God does not "send" anyone to hell. People, using their own free will, decide to either accept God's plan of salvation—Jesus Christ and Him crucified—or reject Him. It is a person's personal rejection, refusal, and denial of the Lord Jesus Christ that separates him, eternally, from God—separated forever from His love, His mercy, His grace, His compassion, and His forgiveness.

Sweet Macaroni Salad

1 pkg elbow macaroni
4 medium carrots, shredded
1 large green pepper, chopped
1 medium red onion, chopped
2 cups mayonnaise
1 (14oz) can sweetened condensed milk
1 cup sugar
1 cup cider vinegar
1 tsp salt
1/2 tsp pepper
1 (4oz) jar pimentos, drained

Cook macaroni according to package. Drain and rinse in cold water. In a large serving bowl combine macaroni, carrots, green pepper, pimentos and onion. In a small bowl whisk remaining ingredients. Pour over macaroni mixture and toss to coat. Cover and refrigerate over night.

Broccoli Soup

1 onion
1 stick butter
1 (16oz) cheese whiz
2 (10oz) pkg chopped broccoli
3 cans cream of mushroom soup
3 small cans evaporated milk

Chop and sauté the onion in the butter. Thaw and drain the broccoli and cook in microwave for about 2 minutes. Combine all ingredients in crock pot and cook on high for 2 hours.

Fried Mashed Potato Balls

2 cups cold mashed potatoes
1 egg, lightly beaten
3/4 cup shredded cheddar cheese
1/2 cup chopped green onions
1/4 cup real bacon bits
1/2 cup dry bread crumbs or batter mix
Oil for frying

Place mashed potatoes in a large bowl, let stand at room temperature for 30 minutes. Stir in the egg, cheese, onions and bacon bits. Shape into 1" balls. Roll in bread crumbs or batter mix. Let stand for 15 minutes. In an electric skillet, heat 1" of oil to 375. Fry potato balls a few at a time for 2 1/2 to 3 minutes or until golden brown. Remove with a slotted spoon and place on paper towels to drain.

Tater Tot Bacon Breakfast Bake

1 bag tater tots
Salt and pepper to taste
1 small onion, diced
1/2 red bell pepper, diced
1/2 green bell pepper diced
1 lb bacon fried crisp, drained & crumbled
Reserve 1 Tbsp of bacon grease
8 eggs
2 cups milk

3 cups Colby jack cheese, shredded

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. In a 9x13 casserole dish add the tater tots, salt and pepper. Bake until tater tots are golden brown. Remove from oven and set aside. Lower oven temperature to 350. In a mixing bowl add eggs, milk and shredded cheese. Mix well and set aside. In the bacon pan sauté onions and peppers in 1 Tbsp of reserved bacon grease until tender. Layer onions and peppers on top of the cooked tater tots. Layer bacon crumbles on top of the onions and peppers. Pour the egg and cheese mixture over the bacon layer. Cover with foil and bake on 350 for 45 minutes. Uncover and bake

Additional passages for Today: Philippians 2:15-16 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

Thought for Today: When you murmur and dispute, who are you really fighting with? If you wish to be an obedient servant of the Most High King, complaining and arguing must not be a part of your character.


Story for Today: Bridgett ran excitedly into the room where her friends were gathered. She was grateful they were watching a movie today. Mrs. Chapman was already talking to some of the others about which movie they would be watching. Hearing Sandy suggest a clubhouse detective movie, Bridgett couldn't help but groan out loud. "Please don't make us watch that one!" she exclaimed as she went on talking about the movie as if it would be torture to have to watch something so childish. Mattie walked in with a plate of cookies. Bridgett accepted the chocolate chip cookie with thanks. However, after taking a bite she couldn't help but sputter about the crumbs that were falling to the floor. With a voice loud enough for everyone to hear, she remarked about how stale the cookie was and that more was on the floor than in her mouth. It wasn't long after the movie finished before there was a lengthy line waiting for the restroom. Heidi and Bridgett were talking about their favorite scene in the movie while they were waiting until Bridgett just couldn't stand it any longer and began letting those in front of her know that they had better hurry up. She had better things to do than stand in line waiting. Mrs. Chapman had taken in all that had transpired and really felt the need to speak privately to Bridgett. She knew that left unchecked, Bridgett would only become more bitter as she found fault with more things. Pulling Bridgett aside, Mrs. Chapman shared Philippians 2:14-16 with her. She explained that murmuring and disputing were things that discontent people did. Christians that followed the guidance of the Holy Spirit are to be content and ready to receive the blessings that the Heavenly Father has prepared for them. Bridgett was eager to learn and thought about how the little things she had complained about were really no big deal. She really didn't even realize that she had been complaining. Mrs. Chapman encouraged her to write down Philippians 2:14-16 explaining that 15 & 16 explain why we mustn't complain and be a disputer. She shared how when we complain about things, we are really complaining about how God is taking care of us. How when we dispute and murmur we cause disunity and often times hard feelings instead of being an encourager. As Bridgett left Mrs. Chapman, she had a plan. She would write out those verses. She would memorize them. Praying that her eyes and ears would be opened so that she would catch herself when she started murmuring and disputing, was the first part of her plan. Physically covering her mouth and stopping the flow of words when the Holy Spirit showed her that her words were a murmur would be the next step and replacing the negativity with a praise or thanks would be the final step. As she headed down the sidewalk deep in thought she stepped in a puddle and had her first opportunity to put her new plan into practice. Just as she began to grumble about getting her sock and shoe wet, she remembered the words of Mrs. Chapman and instantly covered her mouth. Smiling, she thanked God the rain had stopped and began to skip down the sidewalk.

Questions for Today: Do you think about your words and actions? Are you encouraging others or murmuring about things that don't meet your expectations? Are you praising God or re you disgruntled with Him?

Prayer for Today: Heavenly Father, Thank You for bringing every good gift into our lives. Thank You for being with us through the hard times. Please forgive us when we murmur or dispute. Help us to remember to be thankful in all things and to praise You for Your goodness and mercy. Help us to remember when we complain about the weather or anything else we are really complaining about the One who made the weather and allowed the circumstances that we are going through. In Jesus' Name we pray, Amen.

Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit. A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. Wherefore by their fruits ye shall know them. Matthew 7:16-20

Most people reading this passage tend to focus in on the fruit that is produced. Okay...But a closer look will reveal that the Lord is really focusing on the tree. The fruit merely demonstrates the quality of the tree. We have all encountered this: there are trees whose fruit is healthy and delicious, and there are trees whose fruit is scarcely edible, or even useless. The fruit doesn't make the tree -- the tree makes the fruit. A tree that produces good fruit is firmly rooted in soil which provides adequate water and nourishment. Likewise, those of us whose lives are rooted in and dedicated to Jesus produce good fruit. Others who try to produce good works for "religious" reasons, or to prove or approve of themselves, may produce fruit, but it will be much inferior. When our focus is on Jesus, and our lives are centered in Him, the fruit we produce will not be from self-effort, and its quality will be excellent...because it is simply the produce of a good tree. So, stop trying to produce good works in your own strength. Just tap into the Source of your life, Yeshua, allowing the sap of His Spirit to flow through you – and then watch what GREAT FRUIT He is continually able to produce!
