"We will follow You, Lord, but first let us get our children through high school. We have to work six days a week to pay the bills, and the children are so busy with school activities that there just is not time to follow You."

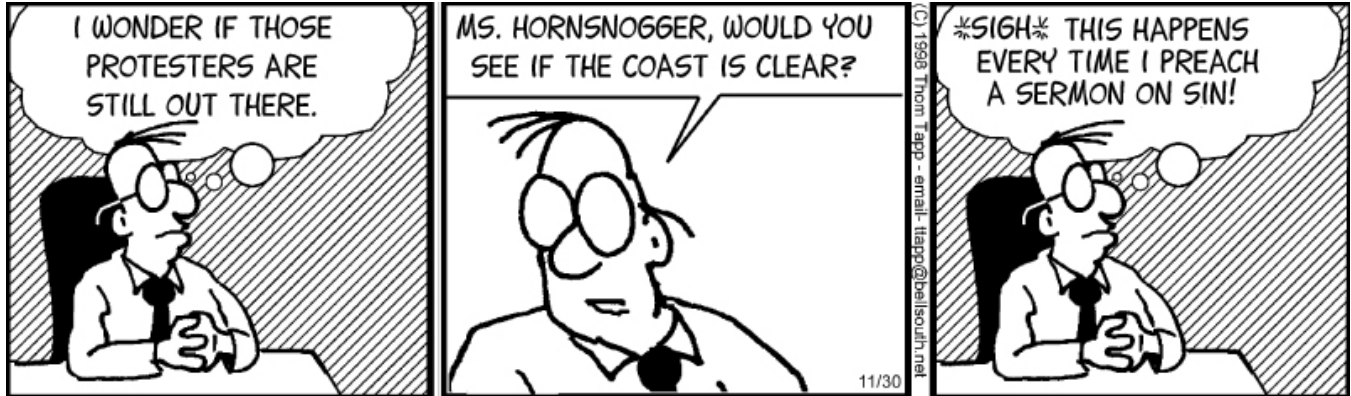
"I would like to follow You now, Lord, but I must first see if my husband will come, too. I do not want to follow You alone."

With the pure Thou wilt show Thyself pure; and with the froward Thou wilt show Thyself unsavoury. And the afflicted people Thou wilt save: but Thine eyes are upon the haughty that Thou mayest bring them down."

REESIE'S RECIPES



Sugar Free French Lemon Pie

Ingredients

- pastry pie shell
- 3 eggs at room temperature
- 1/4 c. fresh lemon juice
- 1/2 c. fructose, natural or equal
- 1 tbsp. cornstarch
- Dash of nutmeg
- 2 tsp. grated lemon peel
- 1 c. Knudsen light sour cream
- 3 tbsp. diet butter

Heat oven to 450 degrees. Beat eggs until frothy, then beat in lemon juice. Mix sugar, cornstarch, nutmeg, and lemon peel with the sour cream in a small bowl. Beat into the egg mixture until well combined. Stir in butter. Pour filling into shell. Bake 10 minutes. Reduce heat to 350 degrees and continue baking 18 minutes. To test ready, place knife in center; when it comes out clean it is ready. Cool.

Butter Pecan Loaf

Ingredients

- 2 c. flour
- 2 1/2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 2/3 c. shortening
- 1 c. sugar
- 3 eggs
- 2/3 c. milk
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 c. chopped pecans or walnuts

Sift the flour, baking powder and salt into a bowl. In a second bowl, cream the shortening with the sugar. Beat in eggs until light and fluffy. Add the flour mixture alternately with the milk and vanilla. Add nuts. Spoon into greased loaf pan (or two small pans), bake 55 minutes at 350 degrees or until cake tester in the center comes out clean.

Macaroni & Cheese Casserole

Ingredients

- 4 Potatoes, cubed
- 2/3 cup Onions
- 2 tbsp Butter
- 2 tsp Salt, optional
- 1 box Macaroni & Cheese
- 1 egg
- 2 cups Shredded Cheese
- 1/2 cup Milk
- 1 tsp Oregano
- 1 tsp Italian Seasoning

Cook potatoes, 1/3 cup of onions, 1 tsp salt. In a separate pot cook macaroni according to box with salt oregano and italian seasoning. Mash potatoes with butter. Combine the egg with milk. Combine the cheese from macaroni box, along with the egg and milk mixture and some of the shredded cheese. Combine the mashed potatoes. Place into a baking dish and sprinkle left over cheese on top. Place in oven for 10 minutes @ 350 degrees.

Stuffed Bell Peppers

Ingredients

- 1 lb. lean ground beef
- 1 medium sweet onion
- 2 1/2 cups cooked rice
- 2 medium/large green bell peppers
- 2 15 oz. cans tomato sauce
- 8 heaping tablespoons honey

Prepare rice, fluff, cover and set aside. Dice sweet onion, add to large non-stick saute/frying pan with lean ground beef. Sauté beef and onion until beef is browned. Drain fat, add 2 1/2 cups of rice to browned beef and diced sweet onion; mix. Cut green bell peppers in half, remove caps and seeds; rinse. Pour 1 15 oz. can of tomato sauce into measuring cup and add 4 heaping tablespoons of honey and blend. Pour tomato sauce mixture over beef and rice; mix. Add second 15 oz. can of tomato sauce to measuring cup and add 4 heaping tablespoons honey; blend. Add beef and rice mixture to green bell pepper halves. Arrange in glass casserole dish. Pour tomato sauce mixture over and around stuffed bell peppers. Bake at 350°F for 1 hour.

Butterscotch - hops

Ingredients

- 1 1/4 c. softened butter
- 1/4 c. brown sugar
- 1/2 c. granulated sugar
- 1 egg
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1 1/2 c. all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 1 tsp. salt
- 3 c. oatmeal
- 1 (6 oz.) pkg. chocolate chips
- 1 (6 oz.) pkg. butterscotch chips
- 3/4 c. chopped nuts

Directions

Heat oven to 375 degrees. Beat together butter and sugars until light and fluffy. Beat in egg and vanilla. Gradually add combined flour, baking soda and salt, mixing until thoroughly blended. Stir in oats, chocolate pieces and nuts. Drop by rounded teaspoonfuls onto ungreased cookie sheet. Bake 9-11 minutes. Cool 1 minute on cookie sheet. Remove to wire cooling rack.

**“ABRAHAM AND THE REVELATION OF EL-SHADDI”**Evangelist, Donnie Swaggart - www.jsm.org

“And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before Me, and be thou perfect” (Gen. 17:1). It had been twenty-four years since the Lord had promised Abraham a son, and thirteen years since the Lord had last spoken to Abraham. No doubt, during this time, Abraham felt alone and isolated. So many of us today would not know what to do in light of so many years of silence. So, the question must be asked, why so many years of silence? I think the answer comes down to two things: Faith and self. In regards to Faith, in all of God’s dealings with us, Faith is the foundation. Do we believe the Lord, or do we not? Do we hang on to His Promises, or do we begin to doubt? Self has to do with the Lord bringing Abraham to the place where “self” was laid aside and total dependence upon the Lord was once again Abraham’s foundation. “EL-SHADDI” Through Melchizedek, Abraham has received a Revelation of God as “El Elyon,” which means “Most High God, possessor of Heaven and Earth.” Through Hagar, he had learned of God as “El Roi,” which means “Thou Art a God who permits Himself to be seen.” Now comes a great Revelation of God, the Revelation of God as “El Shaddi,” “Almighty God,” which means “strong so as to overpower.” This Revelation of God to Abraham was God saying to Abraham, that in spite of his age and the deadness of Sarah’s womb, “the Almighty God” was still able to bring forth a son. “El Shaddi” was saying, that in spite of Abraham’s sin, folly, and shame, a son would come forth. “WHAT THIS MEANS FOR YOU!” This great Revelation of God as “El Shaddi, the Almighty God” is still working on behalf of His people. He is still able to bring forth miracles no matter the time or circumstances. In spite of our failures, in spite of the hindrances that Satan places in our paths, we have “El Shaddi” working on our behalf. Beloved, don’t despair on the past failures and detours into Egypt, “the Almighty God” is still on the throne, and is still working miracles “WALK BEFORE ME AND BE THOU PERFECT” With these words, the Lord was telling Abraham, and us, two things: 1. He must be perfect in his Faith. It must not waver as it had done regarding Hagar, but rest completely in Almighty God. 2. There is no way that one’s “walk” can be as it should, without the Power of Almighty God, which we now have through the Power of the Holy Spirit. His job is to lead us, help us, and empower us. For us to have His Help, we must “walk after the Spirit.” “WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO WALK AFTER THE SPIRIT?” Walking after the Spirit simply means that the Believer places his Faith exclusively in the Cross of Christ, understanding what Jesus did for us on the Cross, thereby placing one’s Faith in nothing else. To place your Faith anywhere else is to “walk after the flesh.” To have a proper understanding of what it means to “walk after the Spirit,” one must go to Romans 8:2, “For the Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the Law of Sin and Death.” A perfect walk, or “walking after the Spirit” is placing one’s Faith in Christ and what He did on the Cross every day of one’s life, understanding that all Spiritual Blessings come to us strictly upon what Christ accomplished on the Cross. When we do this, the Holy Spirit can then do His desired Work in our lives.

Silent Sermon

A member of a certain church, who previously had been attending services regularly, stopped going. After a few weeks, the pastor decided to visit him. It was a chilly evening. The pastor found the man at home alone, sitting before a blazing fire. Guessing the reason for his pastor’s visit, the man welcomed him, led him to a comfortable chair near the fireplace and waited. The pastor made himself at home but said nothing. In the grave silence, he contemplated the dance of the flames around the burning logs. 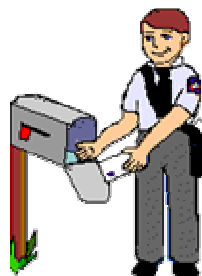
