Daniel probably did not have much influence down in Babylon at first, but God soon gave him more because he was faithful and used what he had." God is looking for those who are willing to be faithful! He wants to use us in ways we could never or would never have imagined – but in order for that to transpire we need to be faithful in the little things and we need to be available when He calls!




Cousin Leroy

"FREE AT LAST"

Scripture Reference: John 8:31-32

*Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;
32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.*

What is truth? Truth is not a feeling. Truth is not an idea. The truth is found in the Bible. We need God, for ourselves, in our school, in our government, in our homes, and in our churches! Galatians 5:1 - Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage. He wants us free from the bondages that has kept us. Freed From The Bondage Of Possessions. Matthew 6:19-21 - Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: 20 But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: 21 For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. Don't be possessed by possessions! We should be worshipping the Almighty God, not the almighty dollar! Two choices you have... you can be a servant to God or be a slave to possessions! Freed From The Bondage Of Worry. Matthew 6:25-34 - Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? 26 Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they? 27 Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature? 28 And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin: 29 And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. 30 Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? 31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? 32 (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. 33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. 34 Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof. God has put us here for a purpose and so He won't let us die in want, so that we can be used to accomplished His will. The old song says it like this: He didn't lift us up to let us down, He didn't bring us this far to leave us! Romans 8:31-32 - What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? 32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? Seek first -This is not just a statement, this is a promise! If we make God's business our business, He'll do the rest. Example: In the wilderness - The children of Israel's shoes did not wear out! Freedom From The Bondage Of Hate. Matthew 5:43-48 - Ye have heard that it hath been said, Thou shalt love thy neighbour, and hate thine enemy. 44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; 45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. 46 For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? do not even the publicans the same? 47 And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? do not even the publicans so? 48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect. I will not let any person make me hate them. It's a choice!!! It actively seeks the well-being of an enemy. Turn the other cheek, do good to them that hate you?some would say that's being passive or non-resistance but it's not it's very active. Proverbs 25:21-22 - If thine enemy be hungry, give him bread to eat; and if he be thirsty, give him water to drink: 22 For thou shalt heap coals of fire upon his head, and the Lord shall reward thee. Coals of fire are not to harm them but to shame them!!! Freedom From The Bondage Of Sin. Romans 6:20-23 - For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. 21 What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of those things is death. 22 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. 23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. We are no longer slaves to sin, in other words sin does not have the hold it once did. Freedom From The Bondage Of Darkness. John 3:19-21 - And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. 20 For every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. 21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. You'll be able to say with me, that old spiritual song: Free At Last, Free At Last, Thank God Almighty, I'm Free At Last!!!

REESIE'S RECIPES



Blue Ribbon Banana Puddin'

- 4 cups milk (cold)
- 7 oz instant banana or vanilla pudding
- 8 oz cream cheese (softened)
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 1 1/2 cup cool whip (thawed)
- 12 oz vanilla wafers
- 4 bananas (sliced)

In a large bowl combine milk and pudding mix according to package directions. In a small bowl stir together cream cheese and sugar until smooth. Mix into pudding mixture using a mixer. Fold in cool whip and gently stir with spoon until mixed well. In a 13x9 inch baking dish layer half the cookies, half the bananas and half the pudding mixture. Repeat layers. Cover and refrigerate 2 hours.

Chicken and Rice Casserole

- 2 (14 1/2-ounce) can green beans, drained and rinsed
 - 3 cups diced cooked chicken breast
 - 1 medium onion, diced and sauteed
 - 1 (8-ounce) can water chestnuts, drained and chopped
 - 1 (4-ounce) can pimentos, drained
 - 1 (10 3/4-ounce) can condensed cream of celery soup
 - 1 cup Miracle Whip salad dressing
 - 1 (6-ounce) box long-grain and wild rice, cooked according to package directions
 - 2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese, divided
- Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix all ingredients together, except 1 cup of cheese, and pour into a greased 3-quart casserole dish. Sprinkle top with remaining cup of cheese. Bake for 20 to 25 minutes or until bubbly.

Chocolate Peanut Butter Cup Dessert-

- 1 (3.9 oz) chocolate fudge pudding
- 1 cup milk
- 1 8oz cream cheese
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 cup peanut butter
- 12 oz Cool Whip
- 3 tablespoons butter
- 20 crushed Oreo's

Wisk the pudding with the milk. Let set for 5 min. Crush cookies and place in bowl Melt the butter in the microwave. Toss the cookies and the butter. Press into 13x9" dish Beat in cream cheese, powdered sugar, peanut butter into the pudding. Mix in the whipped topping until all is mixed well. Place mixture over cookie crust and refrigerate until cold. (about 1-2 hours) Decorate with crumbled cookies.

Chili Pie

- 1 pound lean ground beef
- Small onion, chopped
- 2 teaspoons chili powder
- 1 (15-ounce) can chili beans, drained
- 1 (14.5-ounce) can diced tomatoes, drained
- 3/4 cup jarred salsa
- 1 box jiffy corn bread mix
- 1 large egg
- 1/3 cup milk
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

Heat oven to 400°. In a large skillet, over medium heat, cook the ground beef and onion, crumbling it with a fork, until no trace of pink remains. Add the chili powder and cook for 1 minute. Drain fat.. Add the beans, tomatoes, and salsa and simmer for 3 minutes. Pour into a 9x9" 2 qt. baking dish. In a bowl, combine the jiffy mix, egg, and milk, then stir in the Cheddar cheese. Spread the corn bread batter over the top of chili. Bake until golden, 15 to 20 minutes. Let cool for 5 minutes before serving.

I'm not offering you any gifts or "specials" or making any promises at all. I'm just bring the truth of the WORD today under what I believe to be the Leading of the Lord and I'm leaving the rest to Him. Quite frankly, we're tearing one another apart. We are bearing false witness (lying) about one another; cheating on one another; stealing from one another; speaking horrible things to one another all because we live with unbridled tongues and fingertips (emails) and do nothing more than declare war on one another because our lives are so miserable that we can't stand someone else having a moment's peace and happiness. Last Saturday I watched some good old Andy Griffith reruns and one of the episodes showed the awesome fellowship between a father and his son. The young boy we have all come to know as OPIE (Ron Howard), would come to the Sherriff's office to be with His daddy (Andy) and talk to him about life and learn about life and be influenced by his daddy who took the time for his boy no matter what. Well, Aunt Bea (Frances Elizabeth Bavier), decided the jail house wasn't a place for little Opie to hang out. She meant well, but when that kind of correction in Opie's life was implemented - it meant that he didn't get to see His "Pa" as he called Andy. There was a darkness that came over Opie's life and he started kicking a can that took him far away from home and bought him into some danger and he even got lost - falling asleep in a delivery driver's truck and being driven out of Mayberry to another town. The Driver knew Andy and knew Opie apparently and called Andy and told him of his "extra" passenger. Andy went and picked him up and hearing the story of all the places Opie ended up having no direction by his Father and no daily fellowship and instruction of his Father... Aunt Bea suggested that the arrangement they had before was what Opie needed most. I'm sure you're already getting the just off that story and I need not say a whole lot more. But I need to tie it in together with the devotional message for today. But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal. Romans 11:4

The Harvest is Come

There is a beautiful little parable nestled away in the gospels, and is only found in Mark 4:26-29, "And he said, so is the kingdom of God, as if man should cast seed into the ground; and should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how. For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come." The Galilean farmers relied heavily on agriculture in Jesus' time, as they do today, and would have certainly understood what Jesus was saying. They sowed the seed in the earth along the sloping hills of Galilee, and after a few days they would go out to their field one morning and notice that their crops had broken through the crust of the earth while they were sleeping in the night. Their job was to make sure that the seed had been planted properly in the earth, and growth would come little by little. But it would come! Jesus said that God's kingdom is that way, as the disciples would go into the world their job was to make sure that the seed of God's Word was properly planted in the hearts of the people. They may not see the results immediately, but God's kingdom would be enlarged in a wonderful, mysterious way. Because those disciples were faithful in sowing the seed of the Word of God, you and I became followers of Jesus thousands of years later. Jesus could look ahead into the future and see the history-changing power of God's kingdom, even though it started in a remote part of the world in the 1st century. There have been so many testimonies over the years that were sent into our office that someone's life was changed as a result of a TV program, or a revival service, or a song, or by watching a DVD. Maybe we have never even seen those people before, and may never see them until we get to Heaven. But our job is to do what Jesus said, and just keep preaching God's Word and leave the results up to Him.
