When The Wind Blows



I remember when old Brother Lankford lifted a little sick baby up to Jesus and said, "Here it is Jesus, heal it" and the little baby would be healed. There were so many miracles across the mountains. Please don't misunderstand me, but there will always be something missing until I see that again. Send down the Holy Ghost rain again, Dear Jesus. I believe it's coming, Lord. I came from an obscure place deep in the Kentucky Mountains, and from little known people. But God knew my name even in my Mother's womb, and He called me. REESIE'S RECIPES

Pecan Cream Cheese Pie

9 inch refrigerated pie crust 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, room temperature 3 eggs, divided 3/4 cup granulated sugar, divided 4 teaspoons vanilla, divided 1/2 cup light corn syrup 3 Tablespoons butter, melted

> 1/4 teaspoon salt 2 cups toasted pecan pieces

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place your homemade or prepackaged pie crust in a 9 inch deep dish pie plate. Using a large bowl, beat the cream cheese, 1 egg, 1/4 cup sugar and 2 teaspoons vanilla together until smooth. Pour the cream cheese mixture into the bottom of the pie crust, spread out evenly, bake for 15 minutes. In another large bowl, add the remaining 2 eggs and 1/2 cup sugar. Whisk together until well combined. Add the corn syrup, butter, the remaining 2 teaspoons of vanilla and salt to the bowl. Whisk until well blended together. Sprinkle the toasted pecan pieces evenly over the baked cream cheese laver in the pie plate. Slowly pour the corn syrup mixture evenly over the pecans. Bake 35 - 40 minutes or until set in the middle. Cool completely. Refrigerate pie.

Watergate Salad

Refrigerate any leftovers.

1 large pkg. pistachio pudding mix 1 (20oz.) can crushed pineapple 2 cups mini marshmallows 1 large container cool whip

Mix dry pudding mix in a medium/large bowl with pineapples. Add cool whip and marshmallows. Mix well and chill before serving. Refrigerate.

Bacon Wrapped Stuffed Mushrooms

1/2 cup green onion, chopped 1 package (8 oz) cream cheese, softened 20 fresh mushrooms, stems removed 1 lb sliced bacon, strips cut in half

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Line a baking sheet with foil. Place a wire cooling rack on the baking sheet. In a medium bowl, mix together green onion and cream cheese. Stuff mushroom caps with the cheese mixture. Wrap each mushroom with half of a slice of bacon, secure with a toothpick, and place on the wire rack. Bake for 20 minutes or until the bacon is crispy.

Breakfast Enchiladas

2 cups diced cooked ham 1 bell pepper, diced 8 green onions, finely sliced 2 cups (8 ounces) shredded cheddar cheese 10 eight-inch flour tortillas 6 eggs 2 cups half-and-half

1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

1/2 teaspoon kosher salt

Lightly spray 13×9-inch (3-quart) glass baking dish with cooking spray. In large bowl, stir together ham, bell pepper, green onions and 1 cup of the cheese. Place 1/3 cup of the ham mixture down the center of each tortilla; roll up and place seam side down in baking dish. In large bowl, whisk eggs, half-and-half, flour and the salt. Pour over the tortillas. Heat oven to 350 degrees. Scatter the remaining cup of cheese over enchiladas. Cover baking dish with aluminum foil and bake for 35 minutes. Uncover, and then bake 10 to 15 minutes longer or until set and cheese melted.

Every Child's True Need

And give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep thy commandments, thy testimonies, and thy statutes, and to do all these things, and to build the palace, for the which I have made provision. 1 Chronicles 29:19

We live in a world that is upside down and topsy-turvy. Even in the church evil is called good and good evil. These things most certainly should not be so. With all the craziness surrounding our souls, we must remember that true peace and joy can only be found in Jesus-nowhere else! There will be the glitter of worldliness that grabs at our eyes but we must refocus and retrain our eyes on Jesus alone. "Looking unto Jesus..." There's an unspeakable passion in the heart of every parent to see their child happy. The devil has sold us, our children, and even the church a false bill of goods, convincing us of things that will bring happiness to our children; but eventually will only bring heartache and pain to parent and child alike. Parent, read on as the word of God makes clear the road to joy and warns us of the path to trouble. It's NEVER too early to take heed against the wrong and place our young ones on the path of early piety. There's not enough room here to do this justice; but we can do a quick flyover and you can do the digging, praying over it, and following the Spirit's leading. That's the best way to learn, anyhow. The real happiness of a child will start with the fear of the Lord in his/her parents. David was a man who feared God and sent solemn prayers for piety for his son heavenward with faith. Let us fear the Lord, pray fervently and solemnly for our children, and then be sure that our actions work with our prayers instead of against them. The Wise-man, Solomon, wrote: "The proverbs of Solomon. A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother. Treasures of wickedness profit nothing: but righteousness delivereth from death." (Proverbs 10:1-2) So often people say they desire happiness for their children and pray for their salvation and purity, only to provide them with "treasures of wickedness," working against their own happiness, against their child's happiness, and sadly, against their very own prayers. As we pray for our children to have a perfect heart and a pious mind, let us insist on their obedience to parents and authority—in training them to obey the highest Authority—Heavenly Father. Let us fill their minds with heaven and the heavenly graces, that such wonders may be their goal. Let's speak often with them about the beauties of heaven and the torments of hell, reminding them that no one is guaranteed their next breath. Talk with them often of where their destination would be should they die now and what their assurance is of their chosen destination. Encourage them to works of righteousness. Oh that we would be more concerned about the state of their soul than we are about what sport they play, the school they'll attend, or the job they will someday work. Oh that we would take caution of the worldly influences we surround them with: the television or videos we allow them to watch, the games they play, and the friends we allow them to have. There is nothing more important than the salvation of their souls by faith in Jesus. Let us look at some of the signs of conversion, recognizing that only God can see the heart. Dr. Cotton Mather, in 1721, had a few things to say about this. Although written long ago, they are still true today. "A young person brought home to God has his understanding enlightened, his fantasy regulated, his memory purified, his will rectified, his affections brought into order. He gives up his whole heart unto God. He reserves no powers of his mind, but concerning all of them, He says, "Oh! Let my Saviour take possession of it." "Secondly, as we would bring out children to a profession of piety, so we would exhort them to sincerity of in their profession...You must have your heart engaged in what you do about the service of God." Not only is the heart to be washed from wickedness, but EVERYTHING that is offensive to God must be banished from it as well. God's call to Abraham—"Walk before me and be blameless"—is the same call given to the Christian. We do not aim at the praise of men; rather, we aim at pleasing God and praising Him with all that we do. "Thirdly, we cannot be satisfied, except our children endeavor to have a universal obedience unto God... A young person willing to be made perfect and whole, lacking nothing in his obedience to God, willing and wishing to be made perfect in every good work, doing the will of God, denying all ungodliness and leading to a godly, sober, and righteous life, this is one of a perfect heart." Finally, our children—and all who claim the name of Christ—need to have a heart that is fixed on holiness. Our highest aim is to glorify God in all that we do and in all that we are. Let us be holy as He is holy.

THE GLORY IS DEPARTED

And his daughter in law, Phinehas' wife, was with child, near to be delivered: and when she heard the tidings that the ark of God was taken, and that her father in law and her husband were dead, she bowed herself and travailed; for her pains came upon her. And about the time of her death the women that stood by her said unto her, Fear not; for thou hast born a son. But she answered not, neither did she regard it. And she named the child Ichabod, saying, The glory is departed from Israel: because the ark of God was taken, and because of her father in law and her husband. And she said, The glory is departed from Israel: for the ark of God is taken. 1st Samuel 4:19-22

Around 3,100 years ago, a little boy came into this world with the curious name of Ichabod. His mother, who died giving him birth, named him that as she died. The word means, "the glory is departed." The Bible record indicates that the little boy's father, mother, and his grandfather, Eli the priest, all died on the same day. Ichabod's mother gave him that name because the Philistines had stolen the ark of Israel and because her husband, Phinehas, and his father, Eli, had both died. The final verse of the chapter gives more emphasis to the taking of the ark for the choosing of the name, Ichabod. Ichabod - THE GLORY IS DEPARTED! All of his life, this child's name remembered the fact that the ark of God, which contained the word of God, had been taken by the Philistines. When the Word Of God departed, the glory departed. I repeat: When the scriptures were taken from Israel, the GLORY was taken from Israel. When the word of God was removed, the glory was gone, for the LIGHT was gone. God's word is LIGHT! Psalms 119:105 - Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path Isaiah 8:20 - To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. 2nd Peter 1:19 - We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: Psalms 119:130 - The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.
